- Critical and elevated fire weather – Southwest to Southern Plains

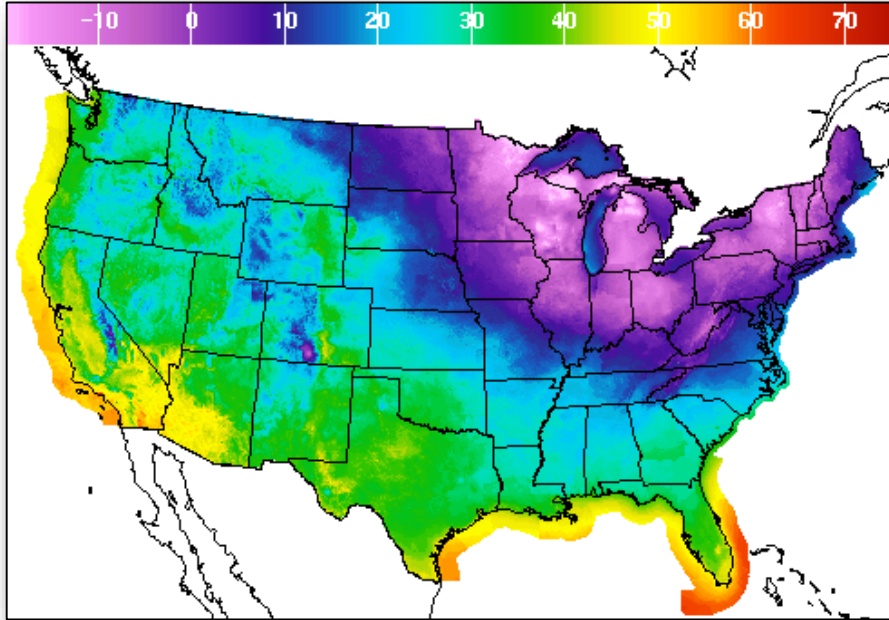

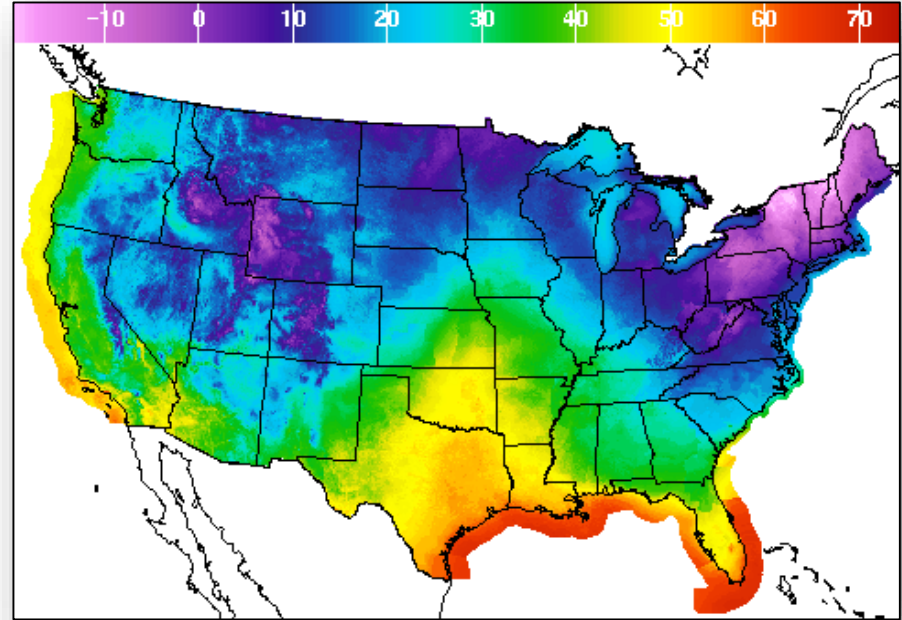

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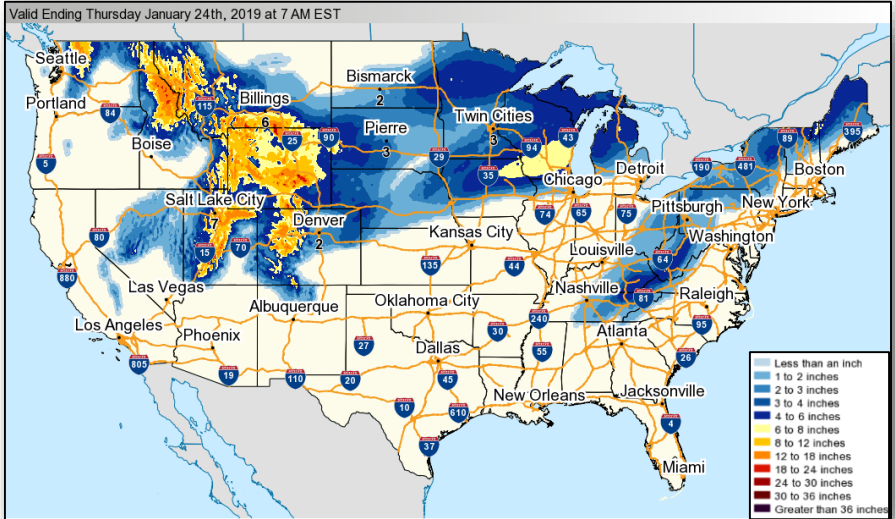

Winter Precipitation Outlook

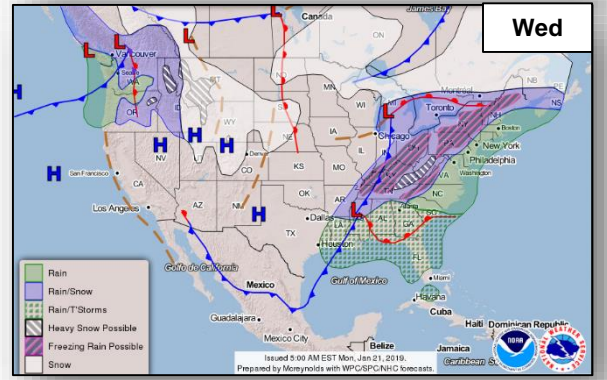
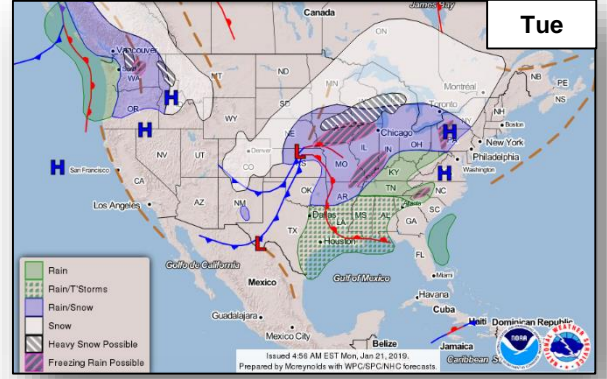
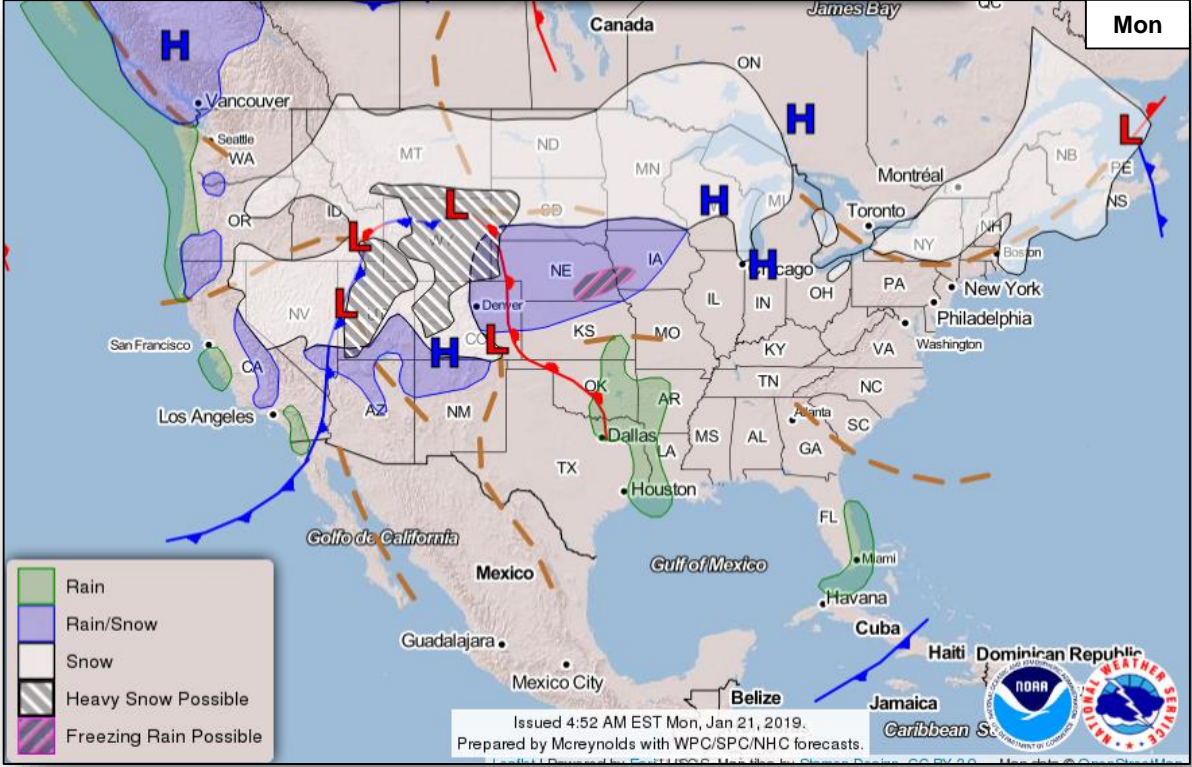


Forecast Snowfall



Forecast Ice Accumulation

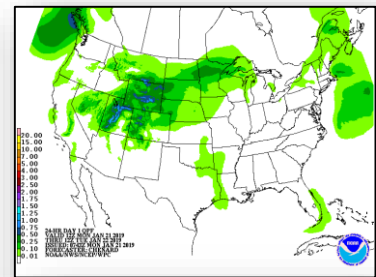
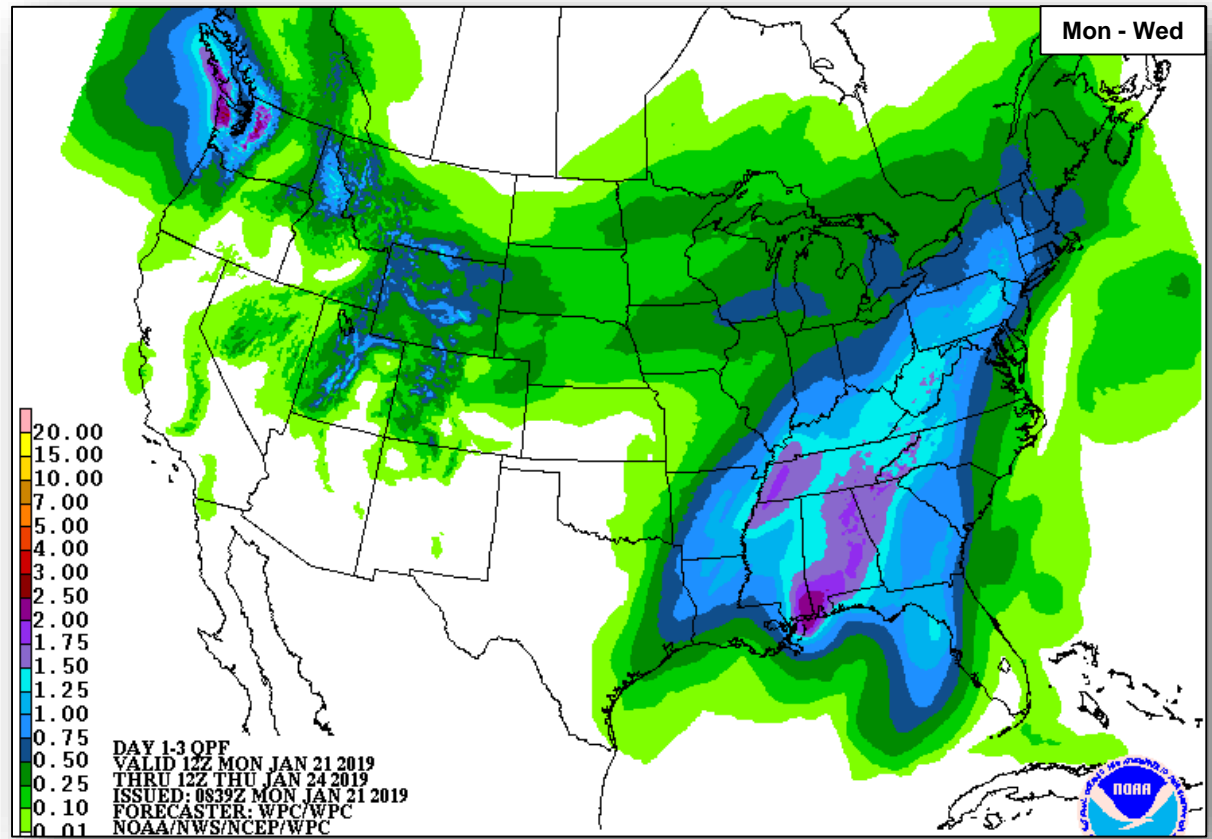

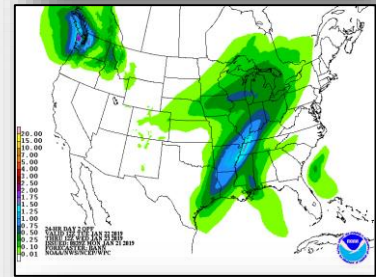
Precipitation Forecast



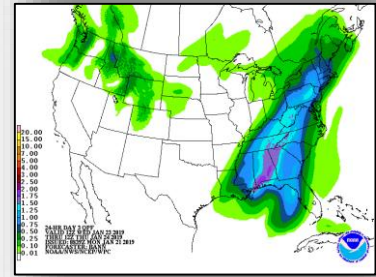

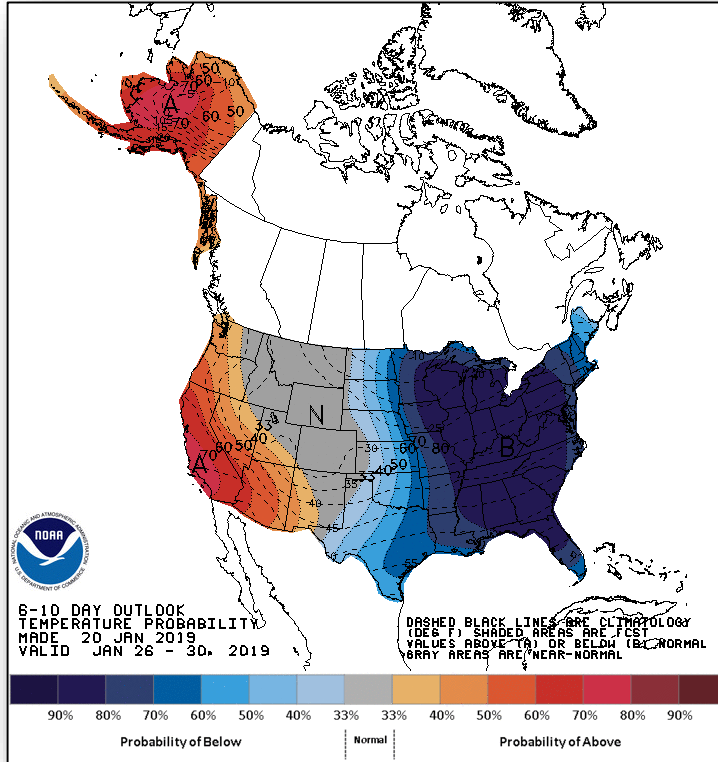

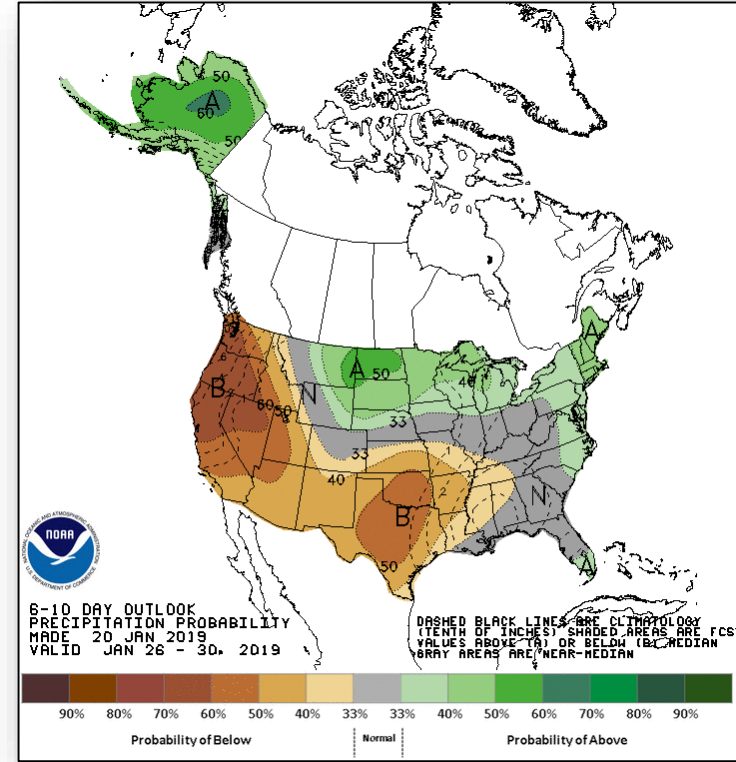
Long Range Outlooks – Jan 26-30

6 - 10 Day Precipitation Probability

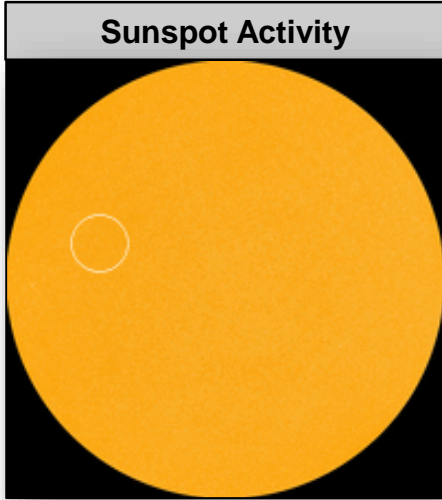
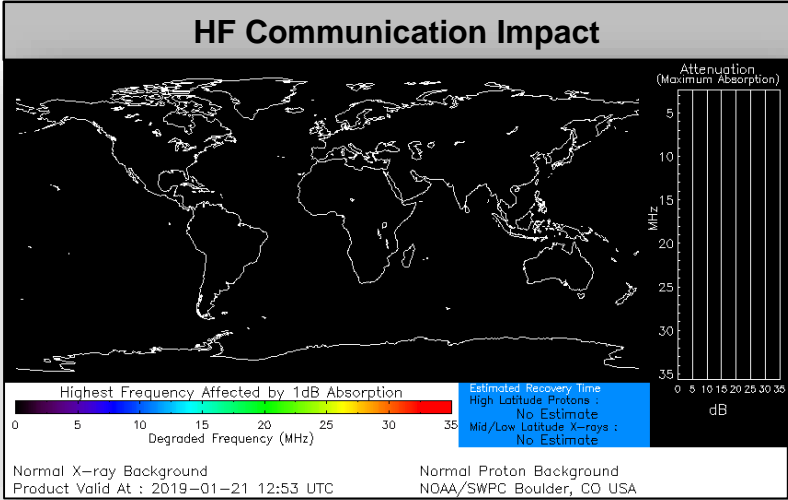
