Significant Weather:

- Dangerous wind chills continue from the Upper Midwest and Great Lakes into the Ohio Valley
- Heavy lake effect snow downwind from the Great Lakes
- Blizzard conditions across portions of the eastern Upper Peninsula of MI and upstate NY
- Heavy snow for the Sierras and Northern Cascades
- Heavy rain possible over parts of the California Coast

Tropical Activity: Western Pacific – No activity affecting U.S. interests

Situation

Dangerous wind chills continue across the Upper Midwest and into the Ohio Valley expected to last through today. Frigid temperatures are creating life threatening conditions, as frostbite can occur quickly and even hypothermia or death.

Lifeline Impacts

Food, Water, & Sheltering

- Warming Centers remain open throughout the impacted regions

Health & Medical

- 3 confirmed fatalities and numerous temperature related injuries (*FEMA Reg V*)

Energy

- Minimal Power Outages reported throughout the effected regions

Communications

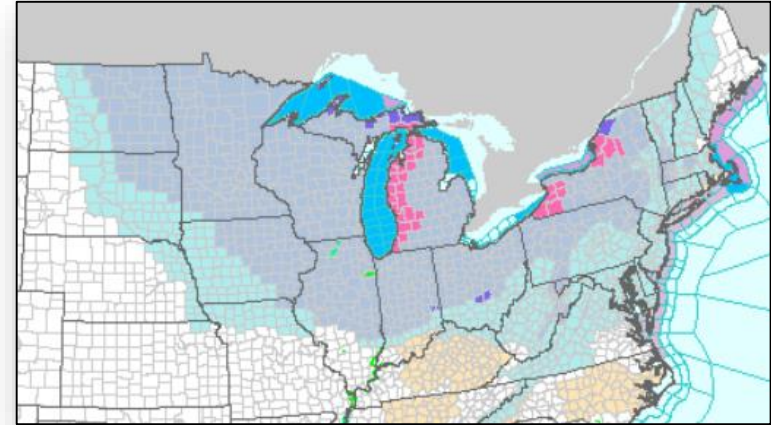
- USPS mail delivery remains suspended for much of the Upper Midwest

Transportation

- 6k flights canceled and 4k delays in the past 24 hours (*FlightAware*)
- Rail service modified or cancelled this week for some Midwest Amtrak routes

State/Local Response

- NYS, IL, and WI EOCs at Partial Activation
- KY and MI EOCs at Monitoring
- Governor declared a State of Emergency for VA, IL, WI, and MI



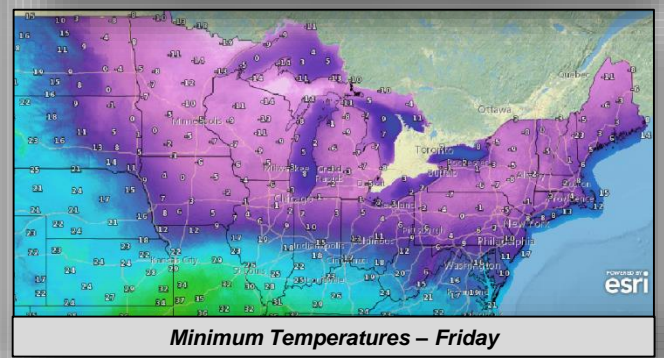
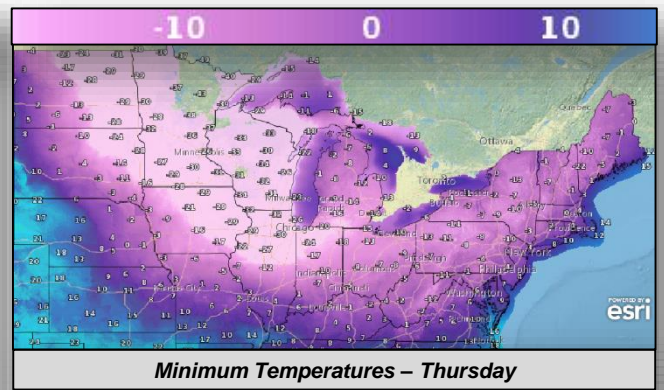

- No FEMA assistance requested

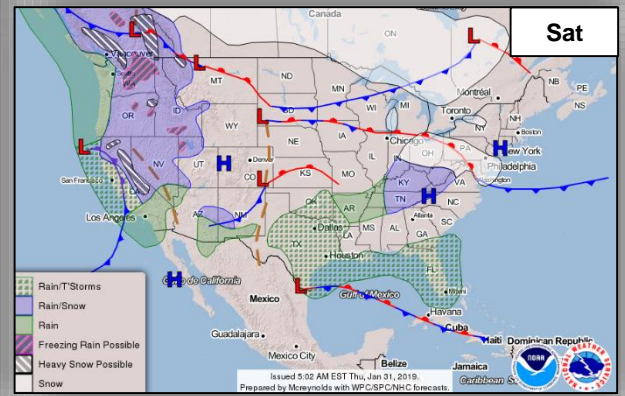
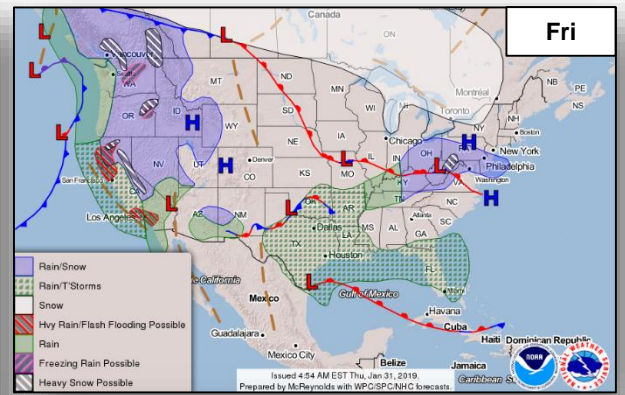
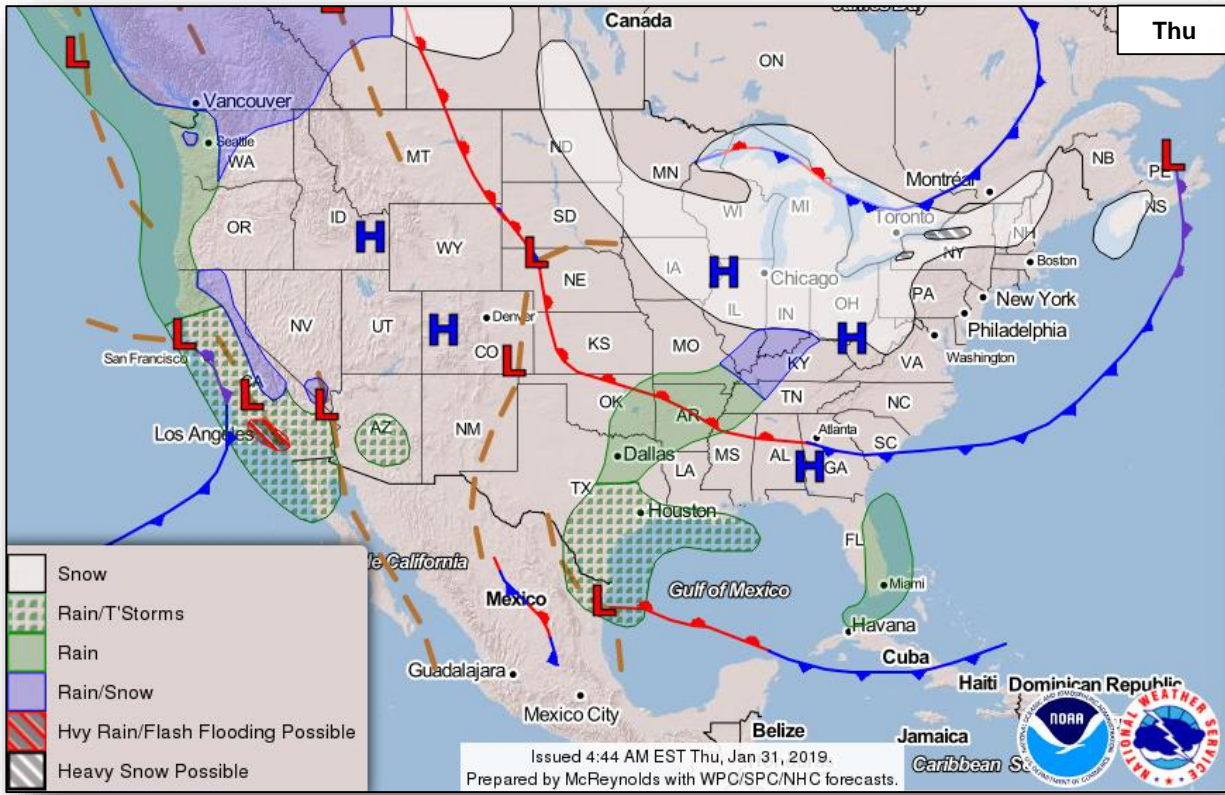
Winter Weather Outlook

National Weather Forecast

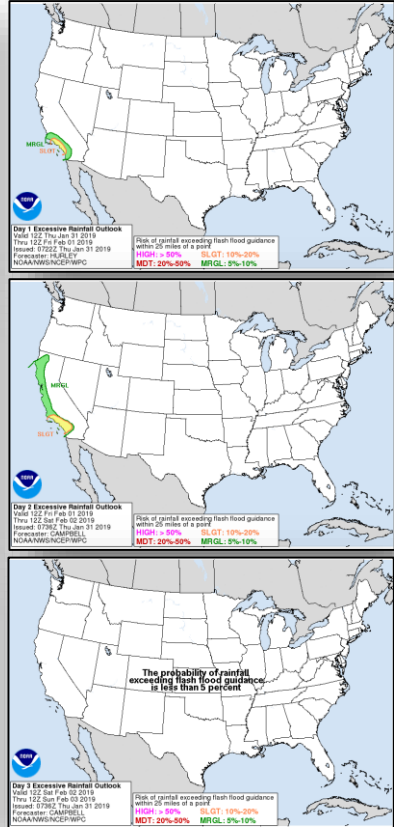
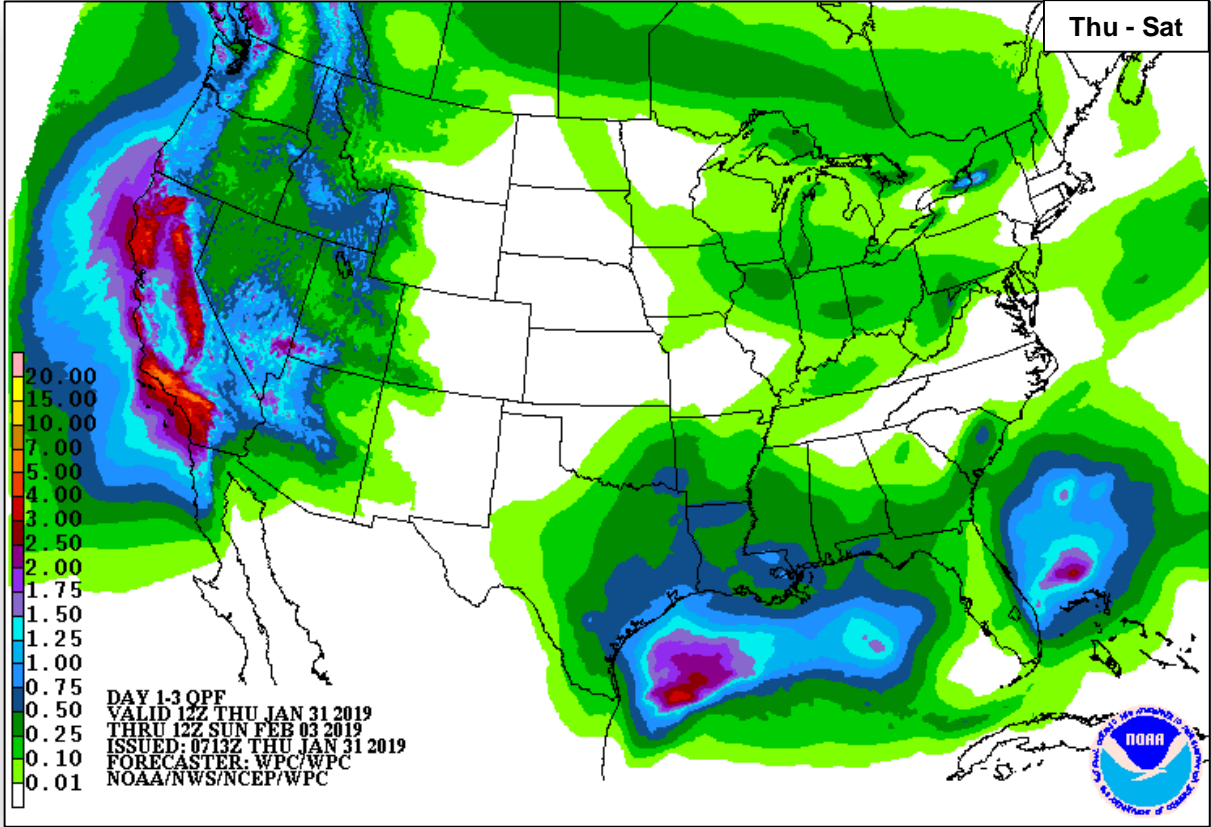

Precipitation Forecast



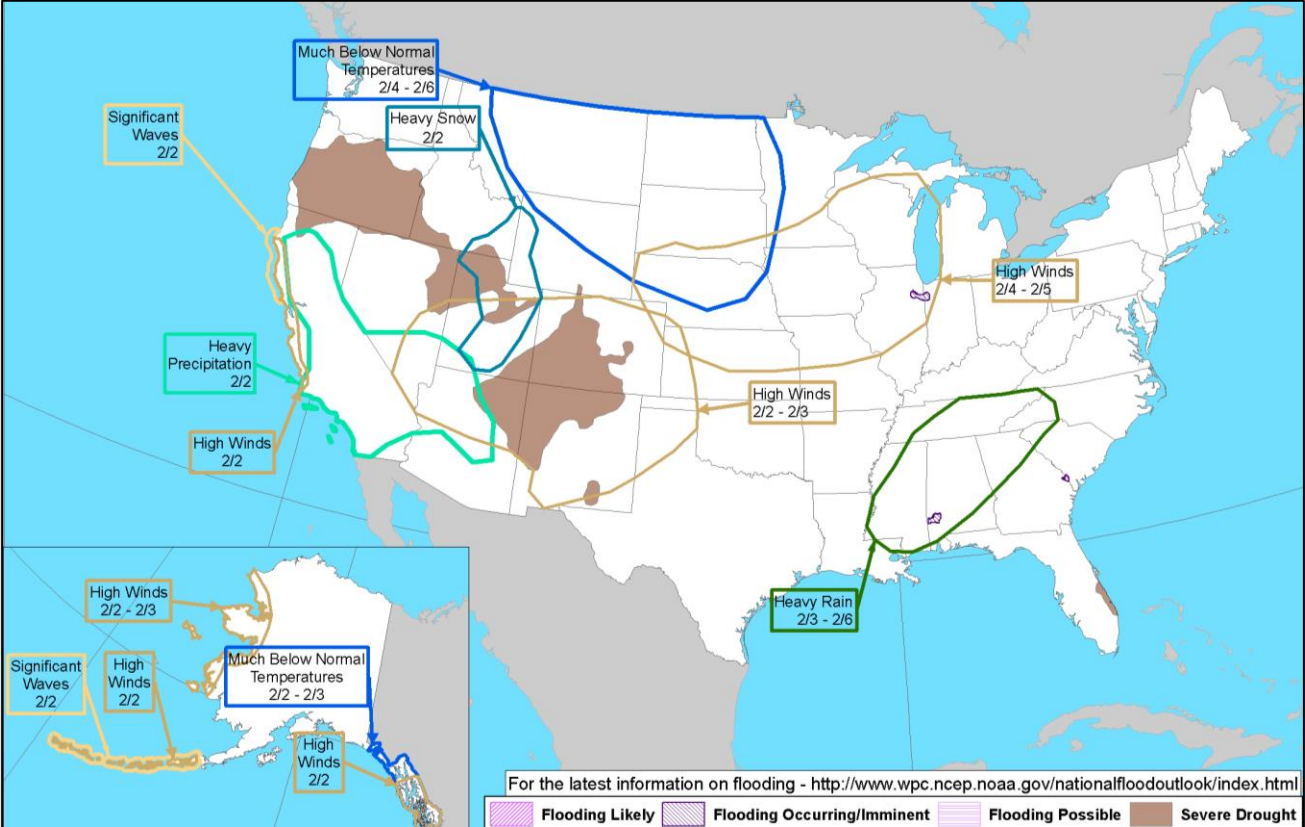

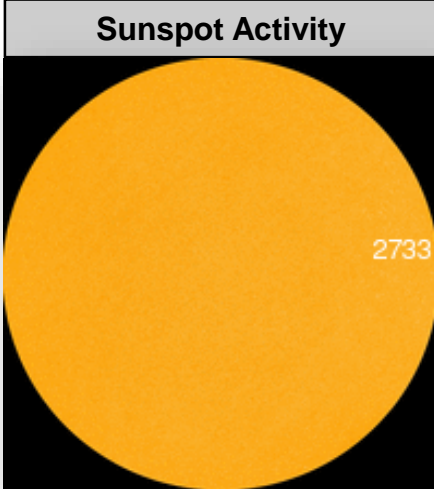
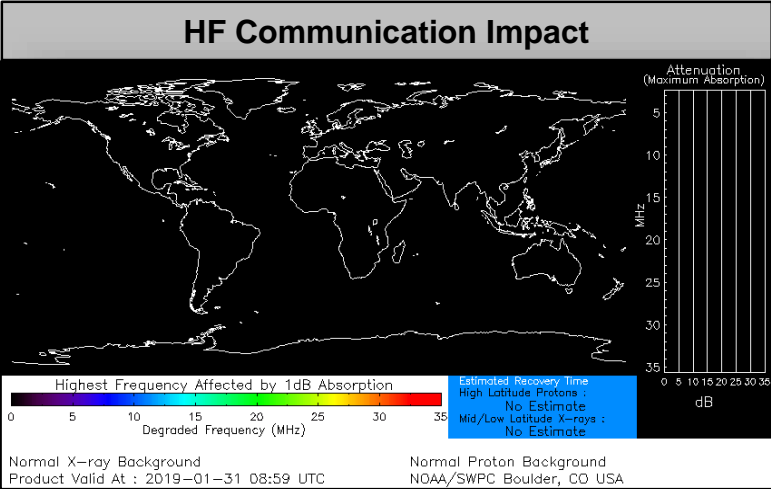
