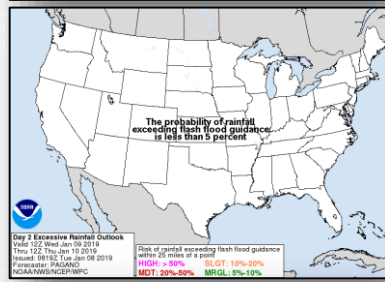
Precipitation / Excessive Rainfall Forecast



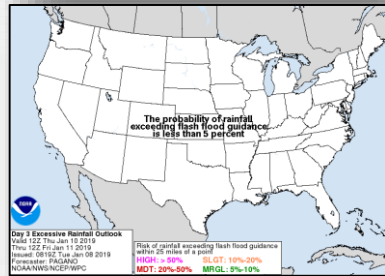

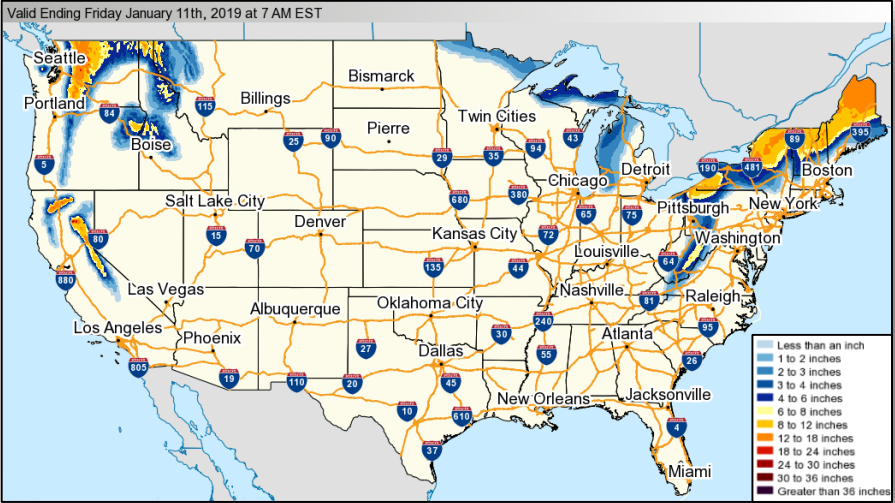

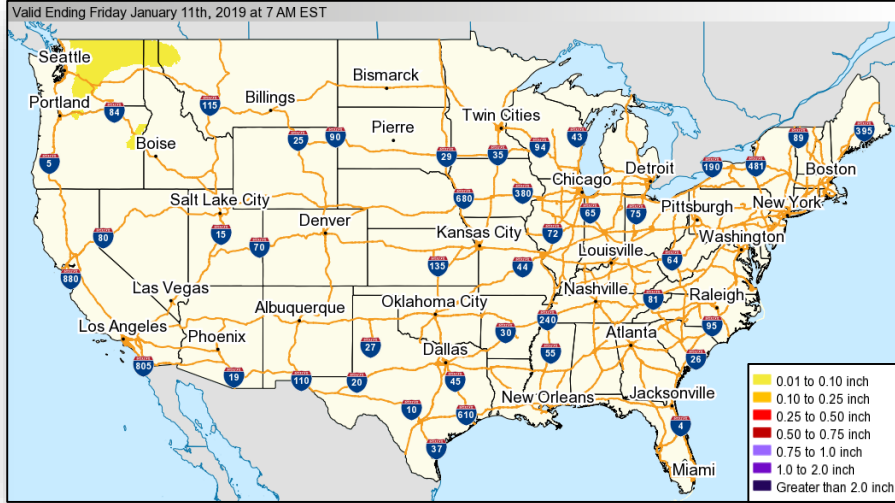

Forecast Snowfall

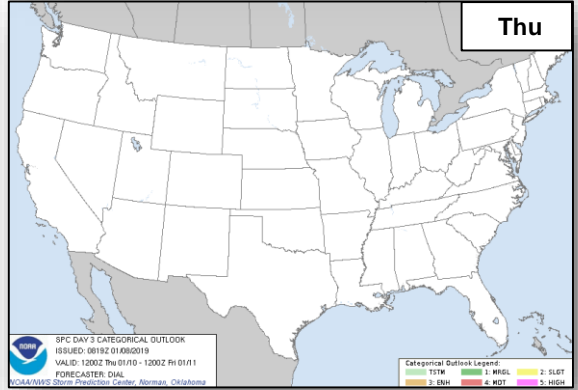
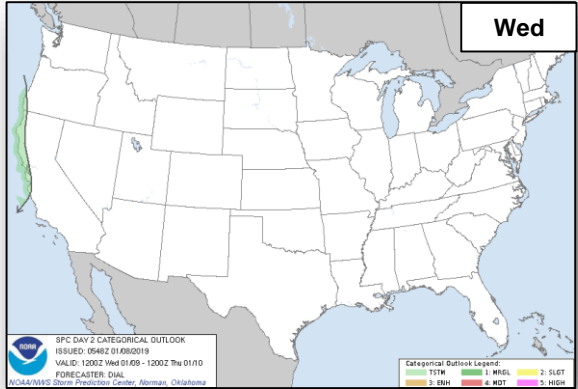
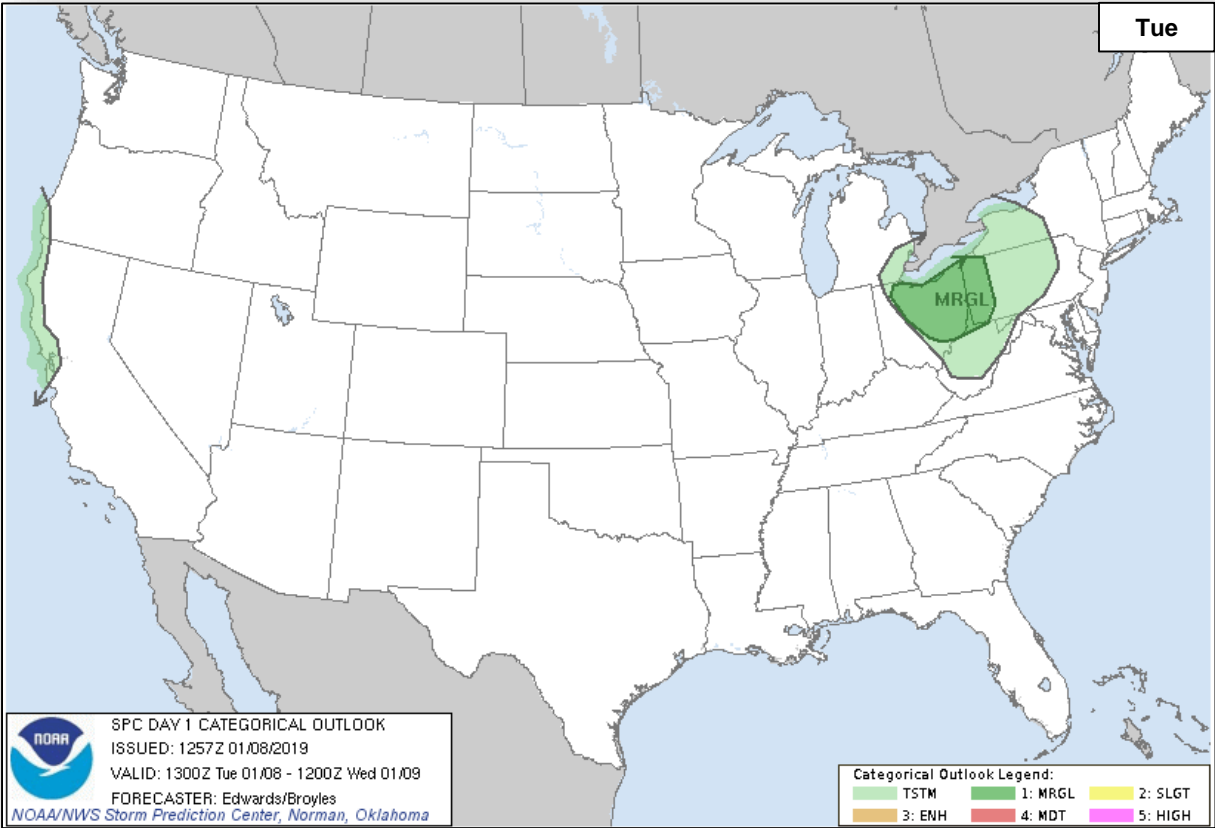


Forecast Ice Accumulation

Severe Weather Outlook



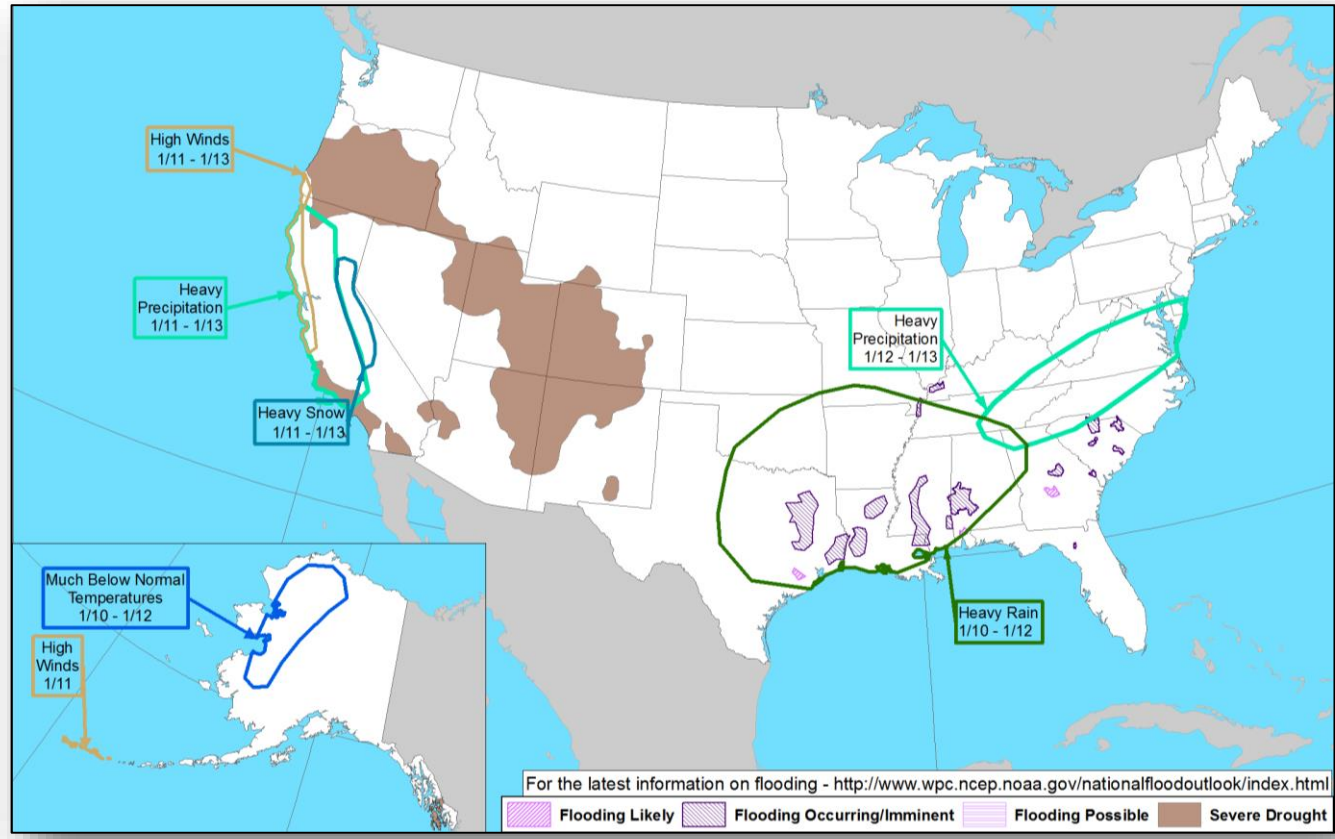

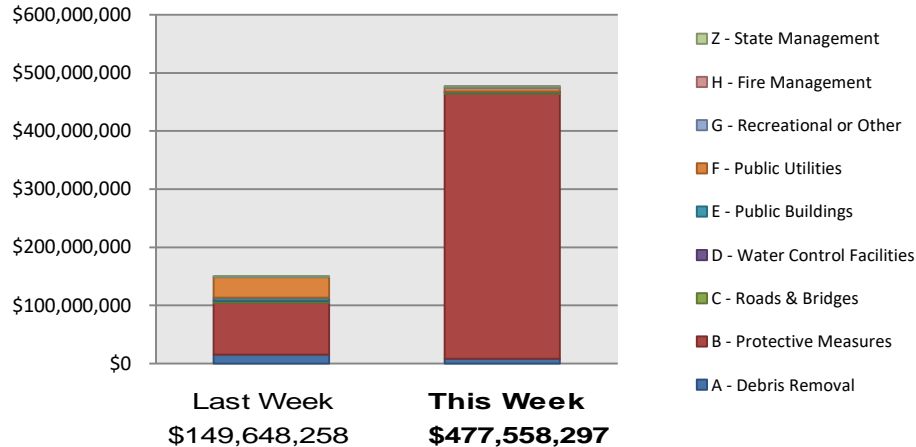

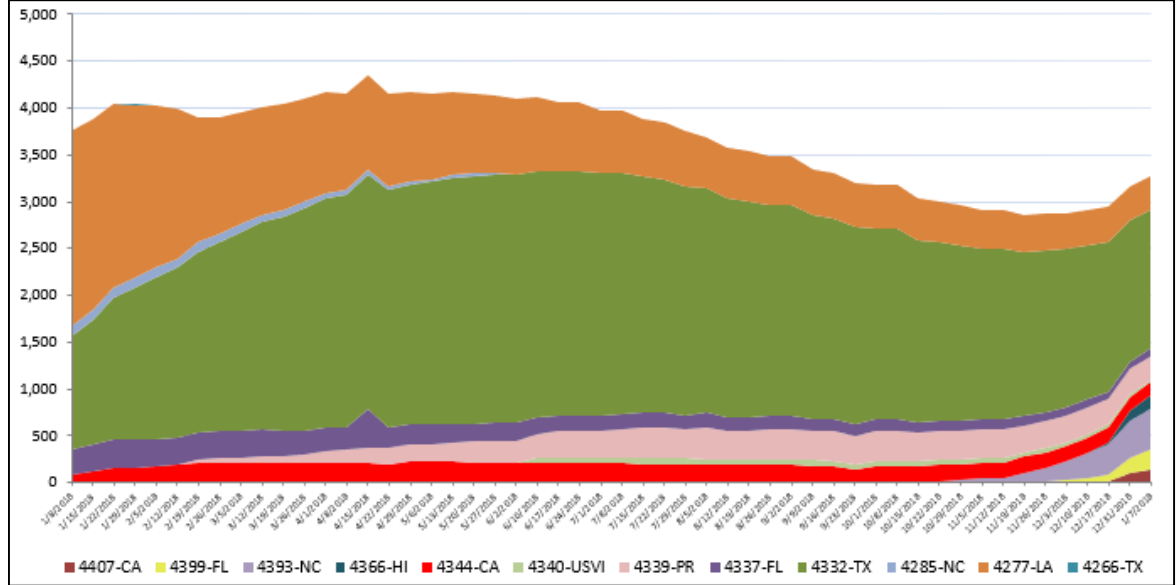

States with Currently Occupied Units

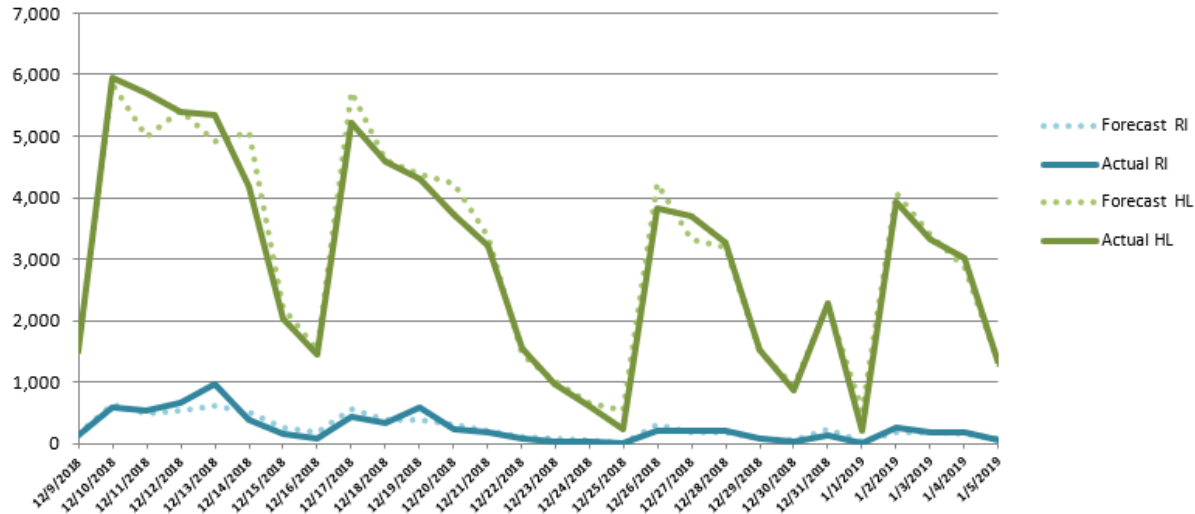

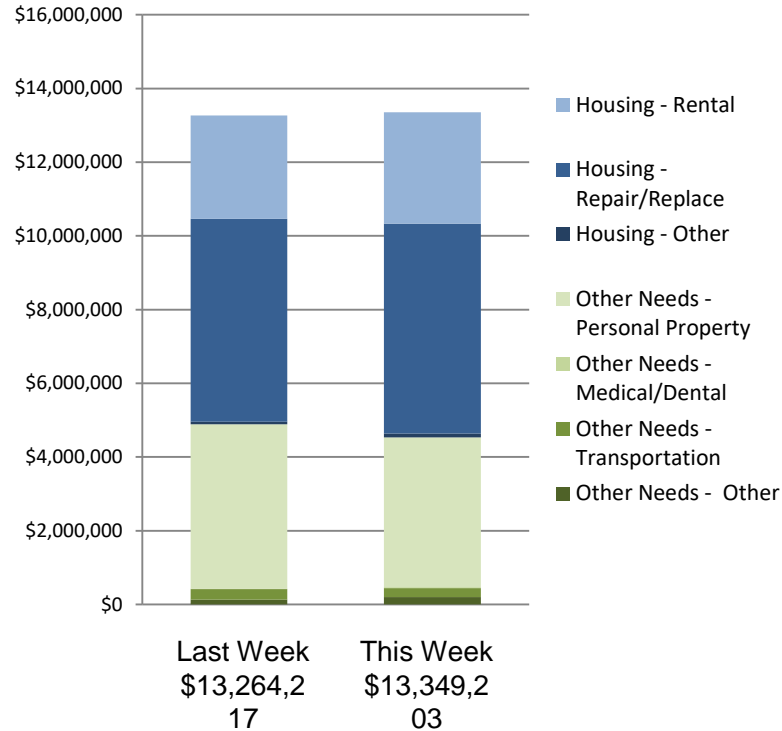
