

Tropical Storm Philippe

Situation: (Advisory #40, as of 8:00 a.m. ET)


- Located 25 miles NNE of Anguilla
- Maximum sustained winds 50 mph
- Moving NW at 8 mph
- Tropical-storm-force winds extend outward up to 175 miles
- Little change in strength forecast during the next day or two;
 could begin to strengthen after midweek






Tropical Outlook - Seven Day

Eastern Pacific




Tropical Storm Lidia (as of 5:00 a.m. ET)

- Located 530 miles SSW of Manzanillo, Mexico
- Maximum sustained winds 40 mph
- Moving WNW at 9 mph
- Tropical-storm-force winds extend outward up to 35 miles
- Gradual strengthening forecast over the next few days, could become a hurricane towards end of the week

Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located a few hundred miles S of the coast of Central America
- Tropical depression likely form by the weekend
- Moving W to WNW
- Formation chance 48-hour: Low (near 0%); 7-day: High (70%)






National Weather Forecast






Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall
