

# **Tropical Storm Philippe**

### Situation: (Advisory #48A, as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located 455 miles N of St. Thomas
- Maximum sustained winds 45 mph
- Moving N at 10 mph
- Tropical-storm-force winds extend outward up to 230 miles
- Philippe is then forecast to become a Post-Tropical Cyclone on Saturday





# **Tropical Outlook - Seven Day**

### **Central Pacific**

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- No tropical cyclones expected during the next 7 days
- See Disturbance 2 in Eastern Pacific

### **Eastern Pacific**



### **Tropical Storm Lidia** (Advisory #9, as of 5:00 a.m. ET)

- Located 410 miles SW of Manzanillo, Mexico
- Maximum sustained winds 50 mph
- Moving NW at 5 mph
- Tropical-storm-force winds extend outward up to 70 miles
- Slow strengthening is forecast over the next few days

### Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located SSE of the Gulf of Tehuantepec
- Tropical depression likely form by the weekend
- Formation chance 48-hour: Medium (40%); 7-day: High (80%)

### Disturbance 2 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located 1,200 miles SW of the southern tip of the Baja California peninsula
- Environmental conditions forecast to become less conducive for further development
- Formation chance 48-hour: Low (10%); 7-day: Low (10%)



### Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located Eastern Tropical Atlantic
- Expected to move off the west coast of Africa by Friday
- Some slow development of this system is possible
- Formation chance 48-hour: Low (near 0%); 7-day: Low (30%)






