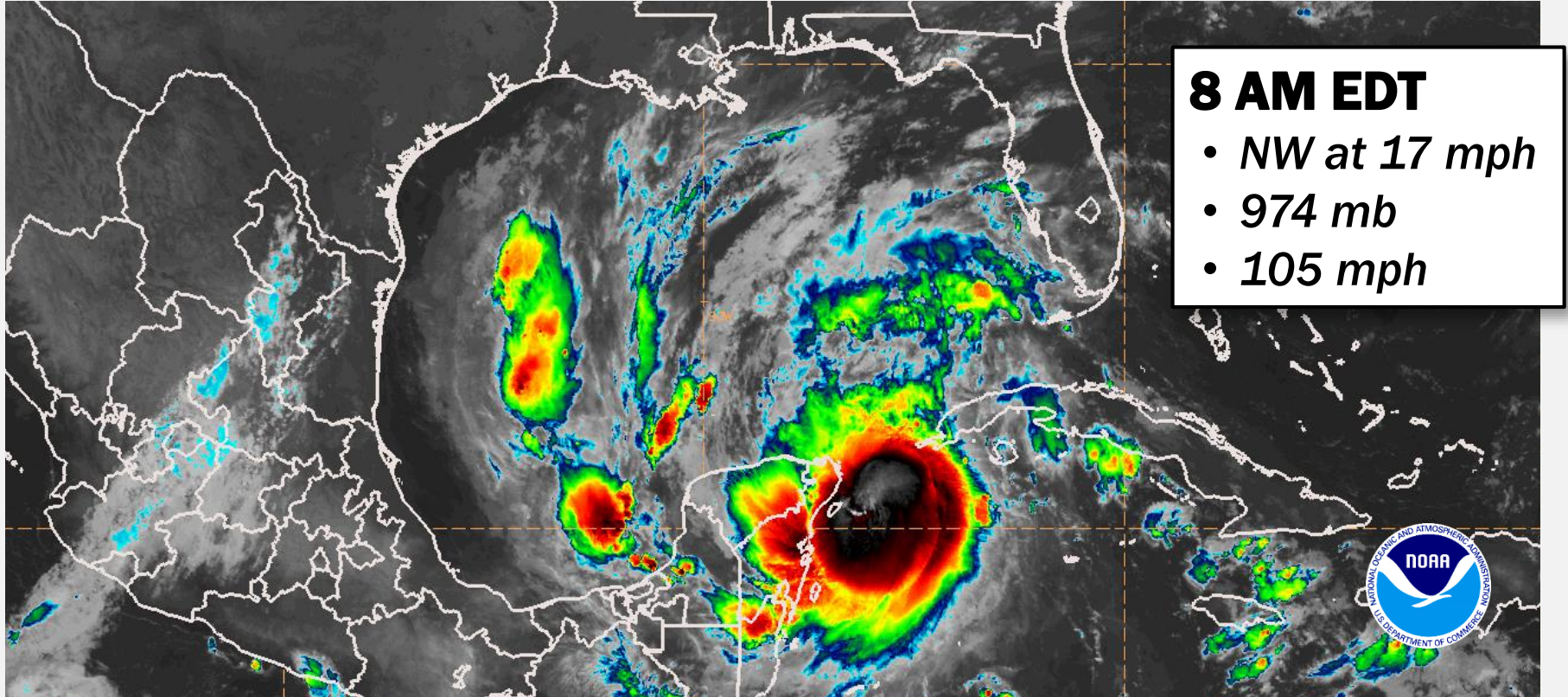

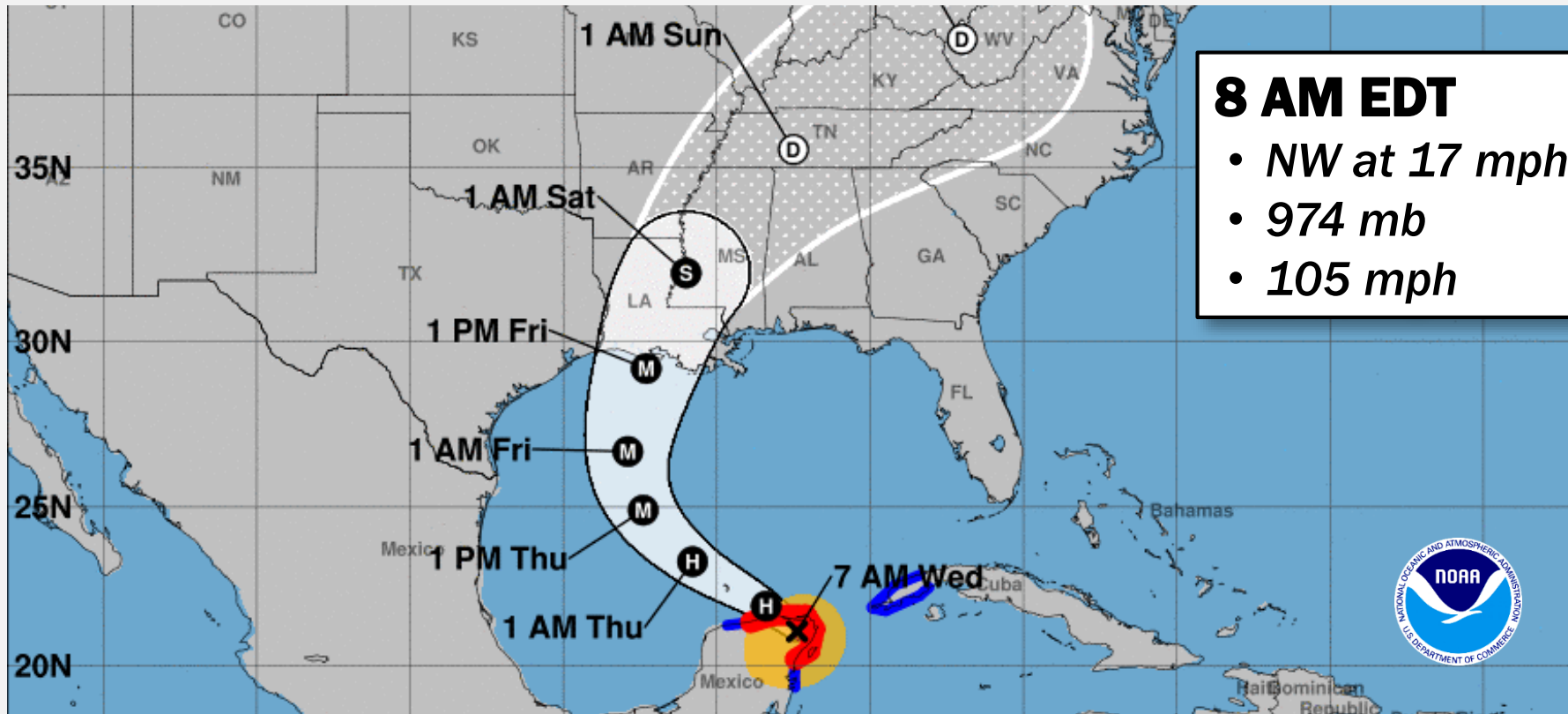

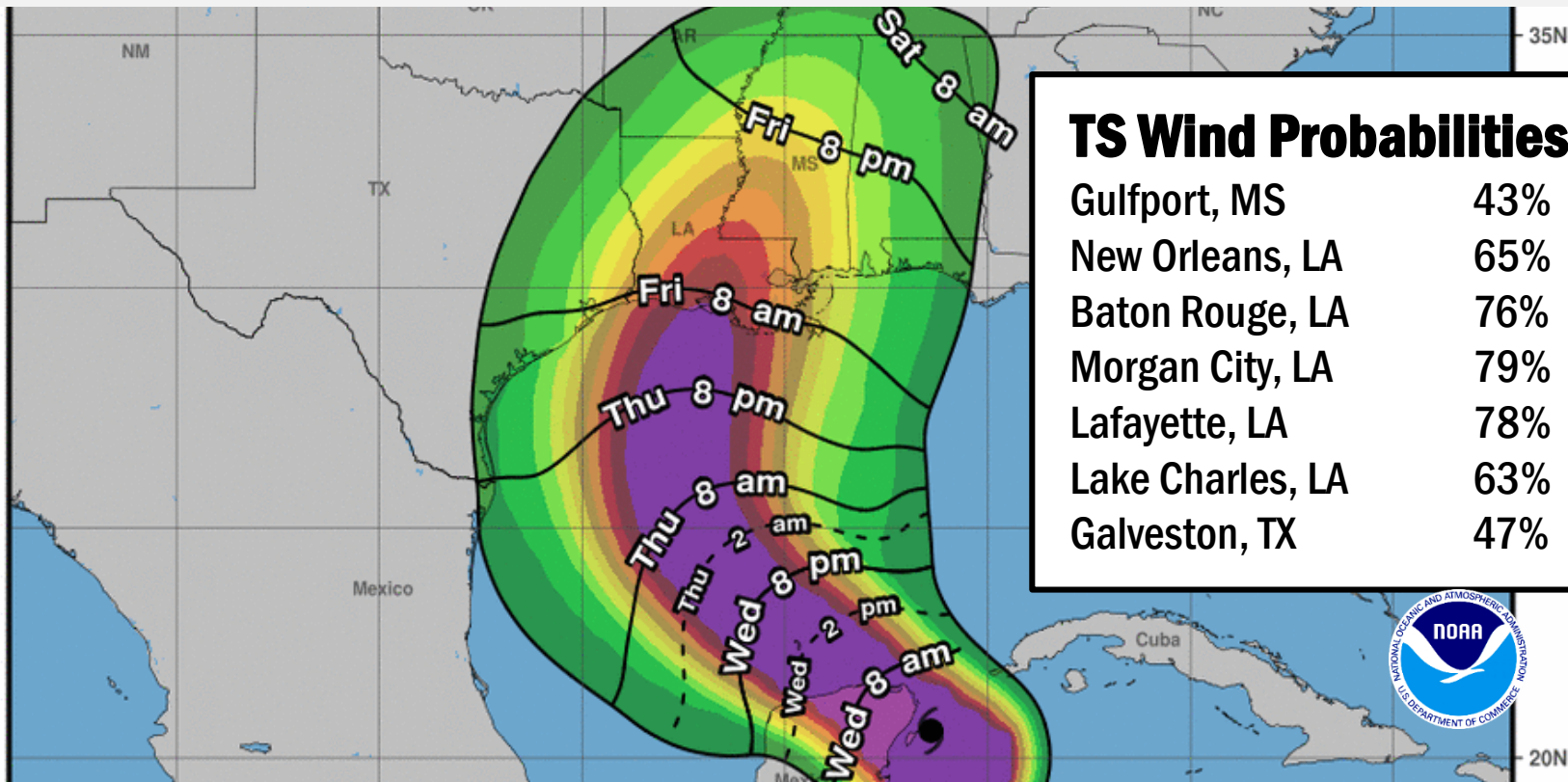

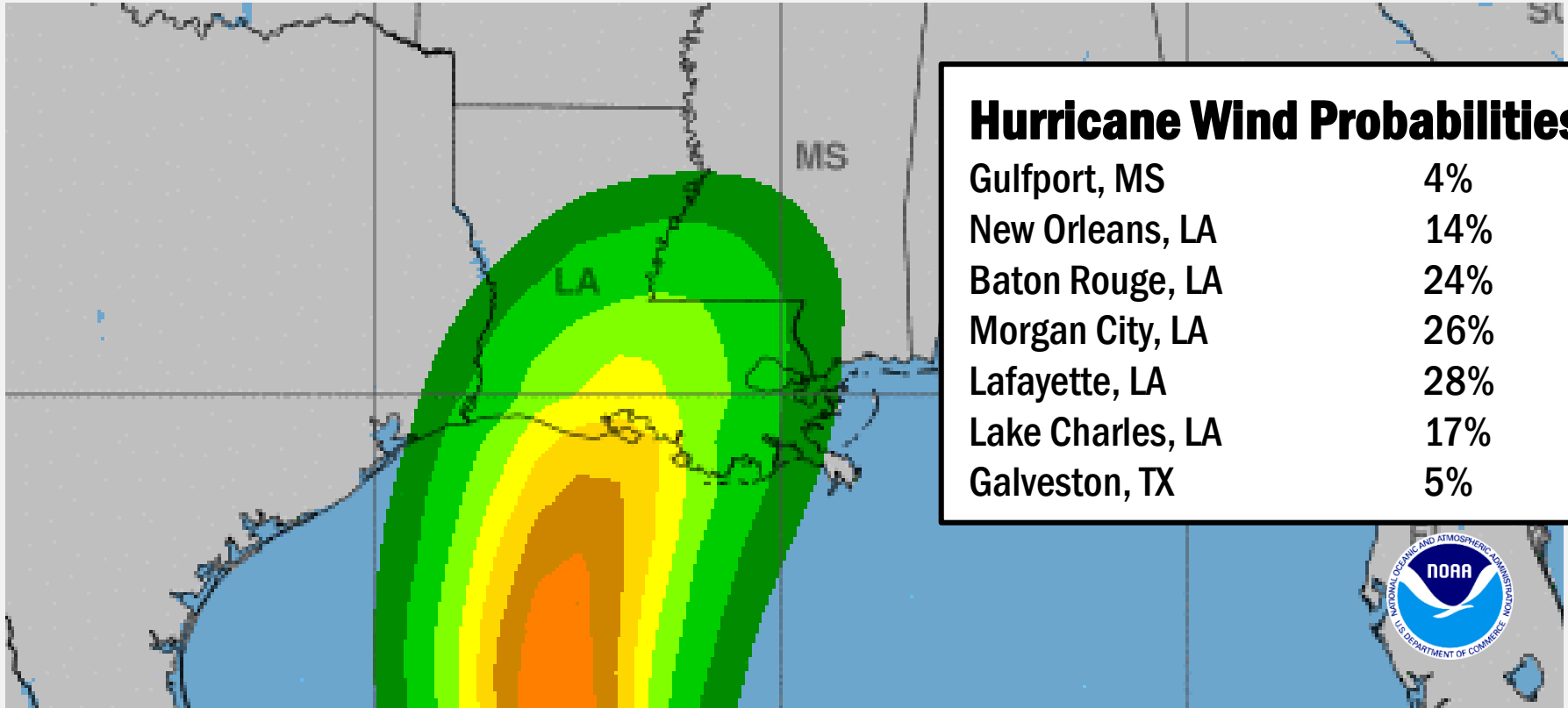

MOST LIKELY ARRIVAL OF TS WINDS



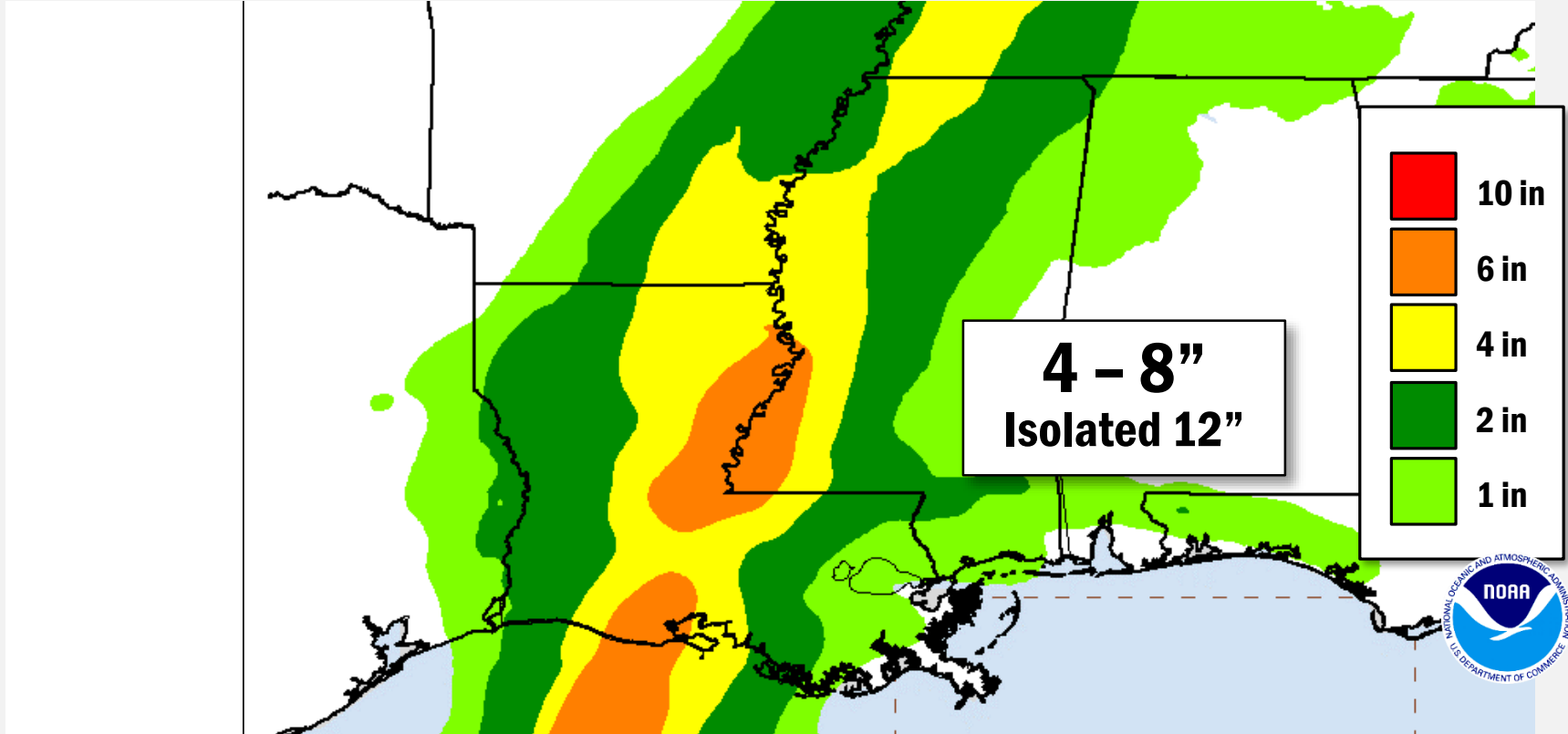

HURRICANE WIND PROBABILITY



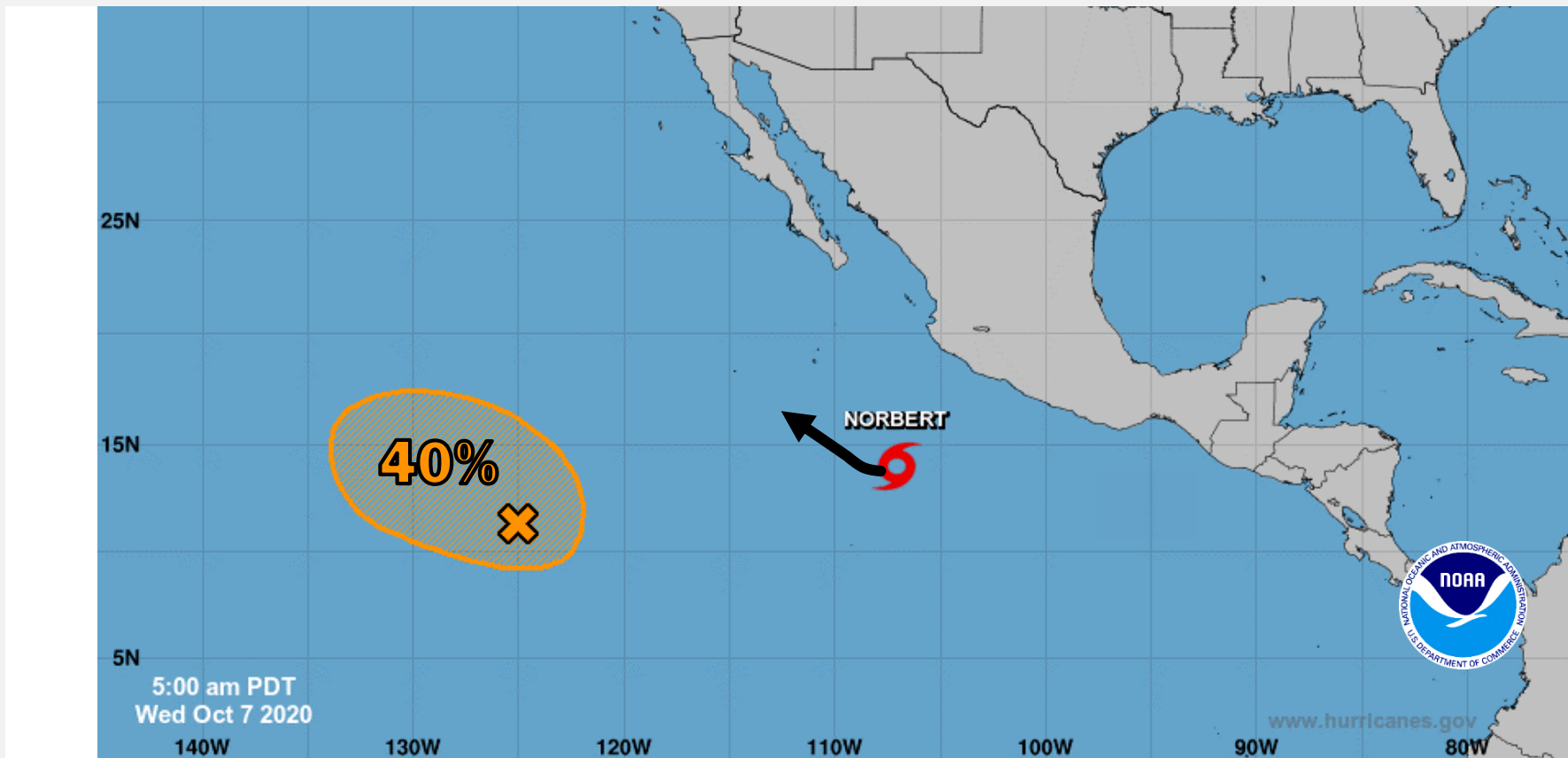

5 DAY RAINFALL



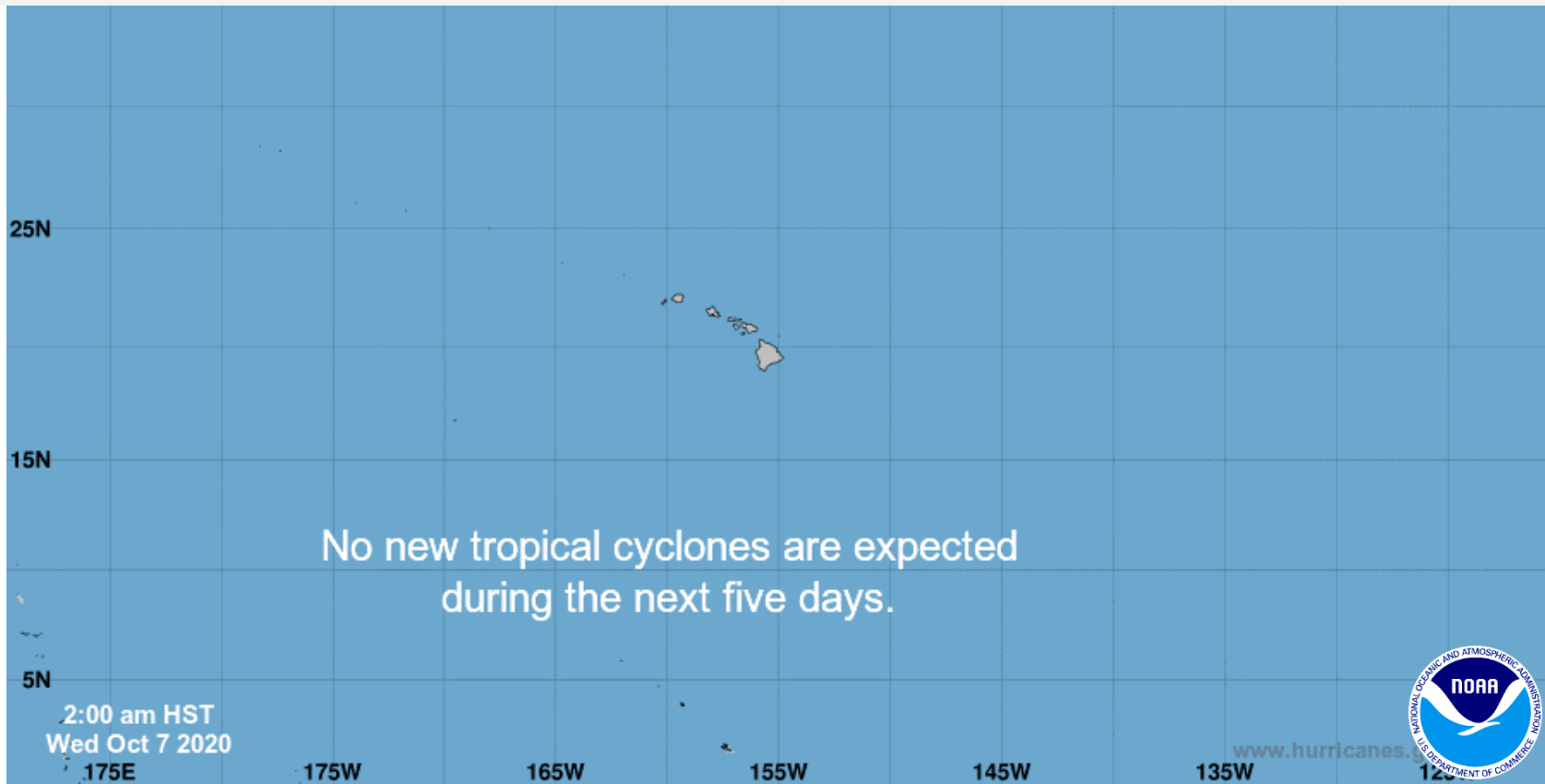

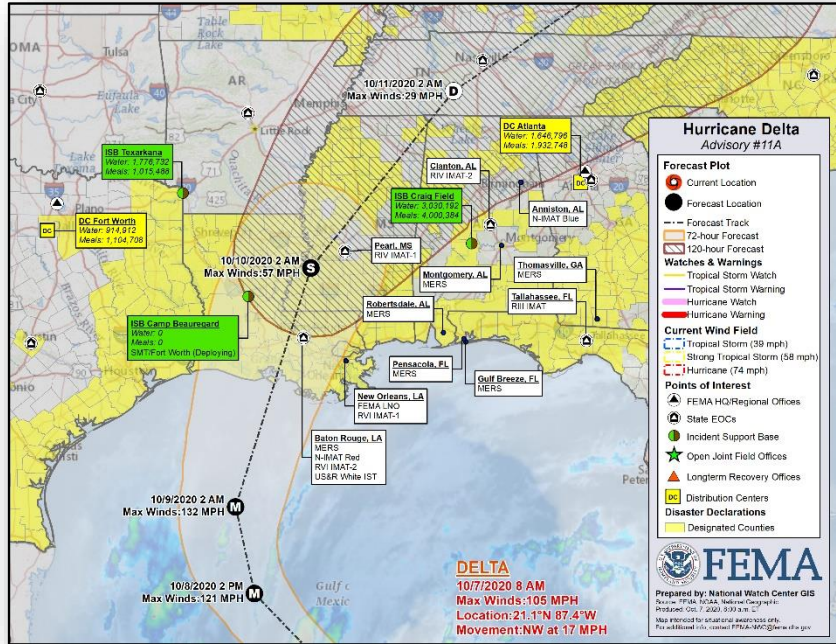
Situation: Hurricane Delta threatens portions of the Gulf Coast. In anticipation, national and regional assets have deployed.

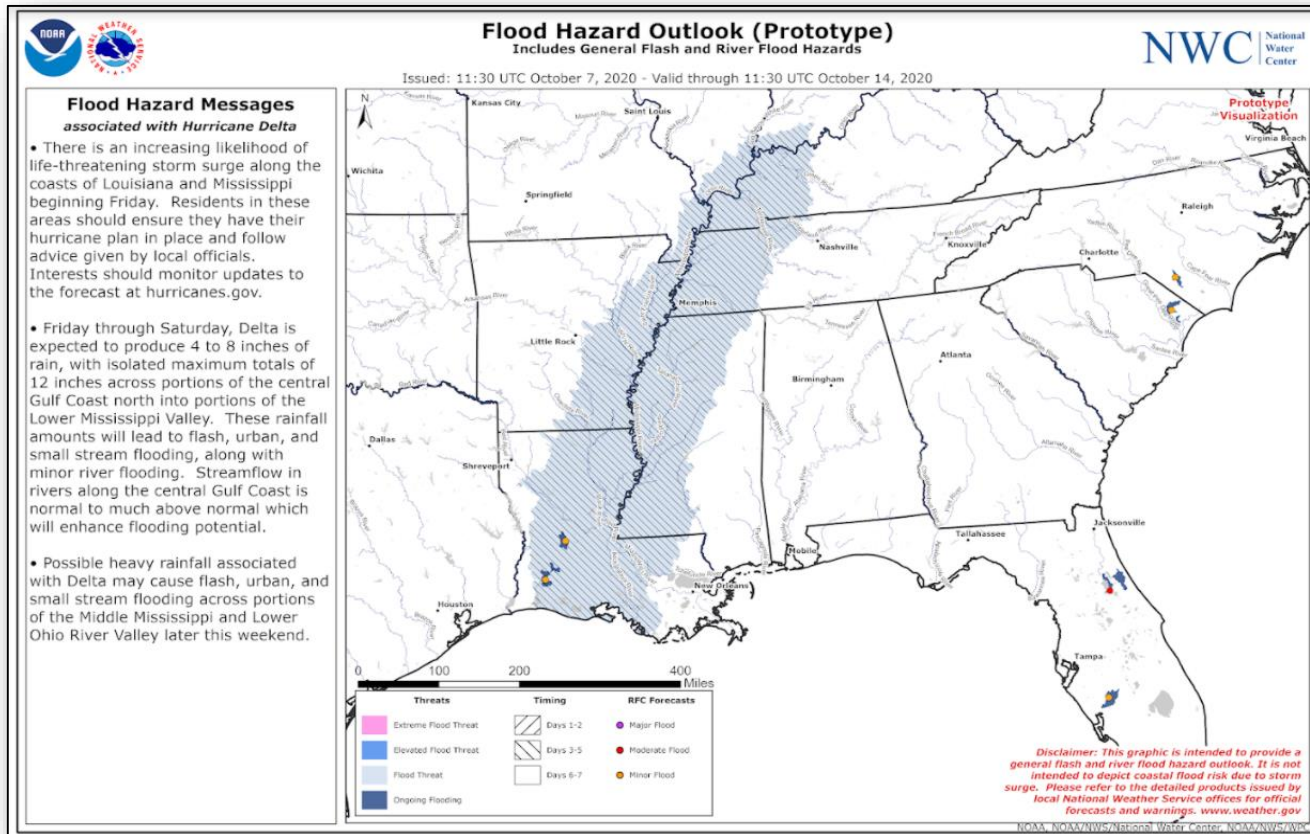

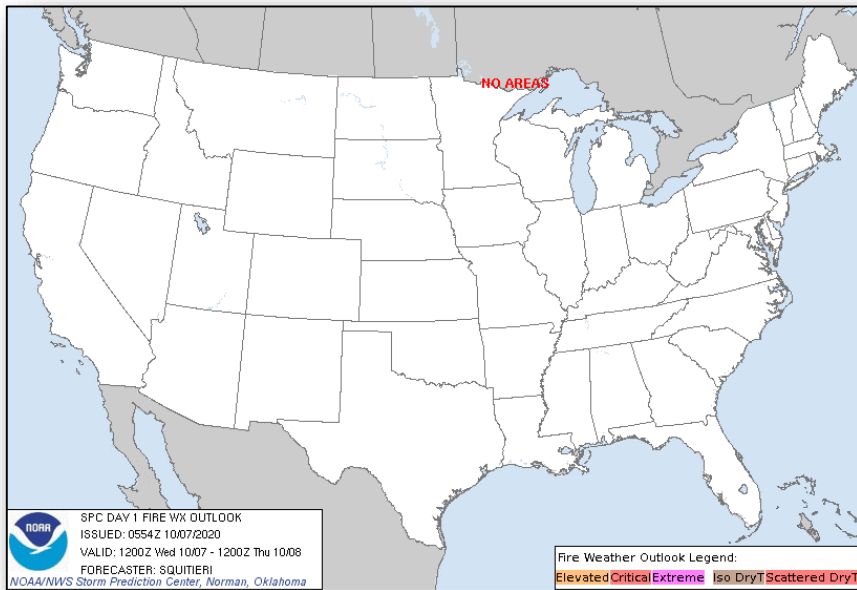

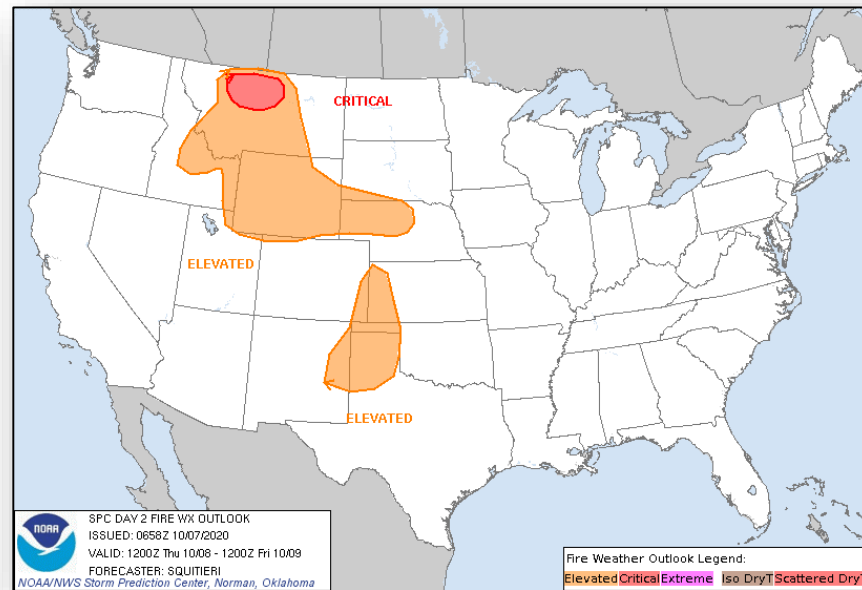

COVID-19 Update

Situation: Upward trajectory in COVID-19 case count continues across **34 (+1)** states/territories, with **6 (+2)** states/territories in a plateau status, and **16 (-3)** states/territories on a downward trajectory. 16,763 National Guard deployed / activated; **1,253 (-13)** FEMA employees deployed. (COVID-19 SLB, as of Oct 6)

Nationwide Testing: **119,383,314 (+886,802)** cumulative (COVID-19 SLB, as of Oct 6)

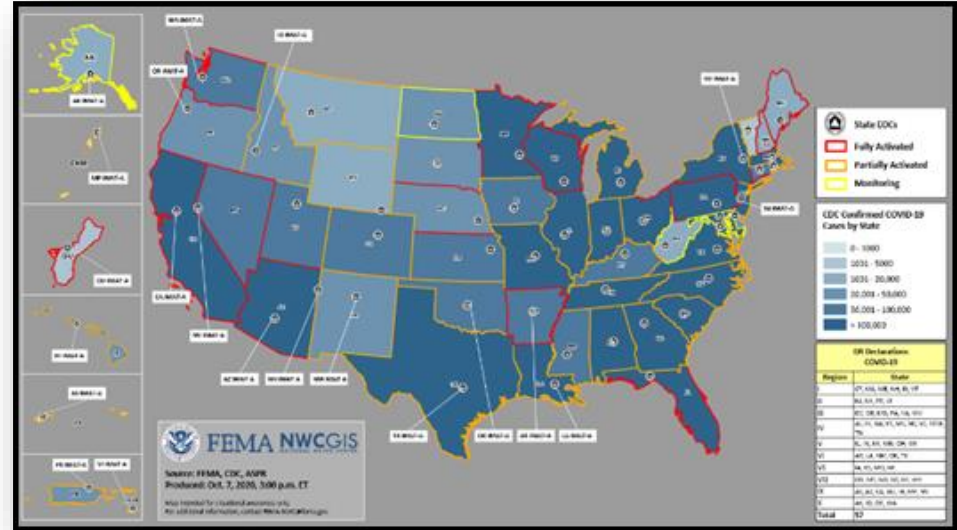
COVID-19 positive cases continue to increase globally

- Confirmed Cases of COVID-19
 - United States: **7,436,278 (+39,548)**
 - Worldwide: **35,274,993 (+247,447)**
 - Deaths caused by COVID-19
 - United States: **209,560 (+361)**
 - Worldwide: **1,038,534 (+3,697)**

(COVID-19 Response Update, as of Oct 6)

Response:

- NRCC conducting COVID response operations
- Regions I, II, III, V, VI, & X RRCCs at Level III
- Regions IV, VII, VIII, & IX RRCCs are rostered
- Regions VII, VIII, & IX COVID-19 working from the Virtual JFO
- NWC, all RWCs, and MOCs are monitoring

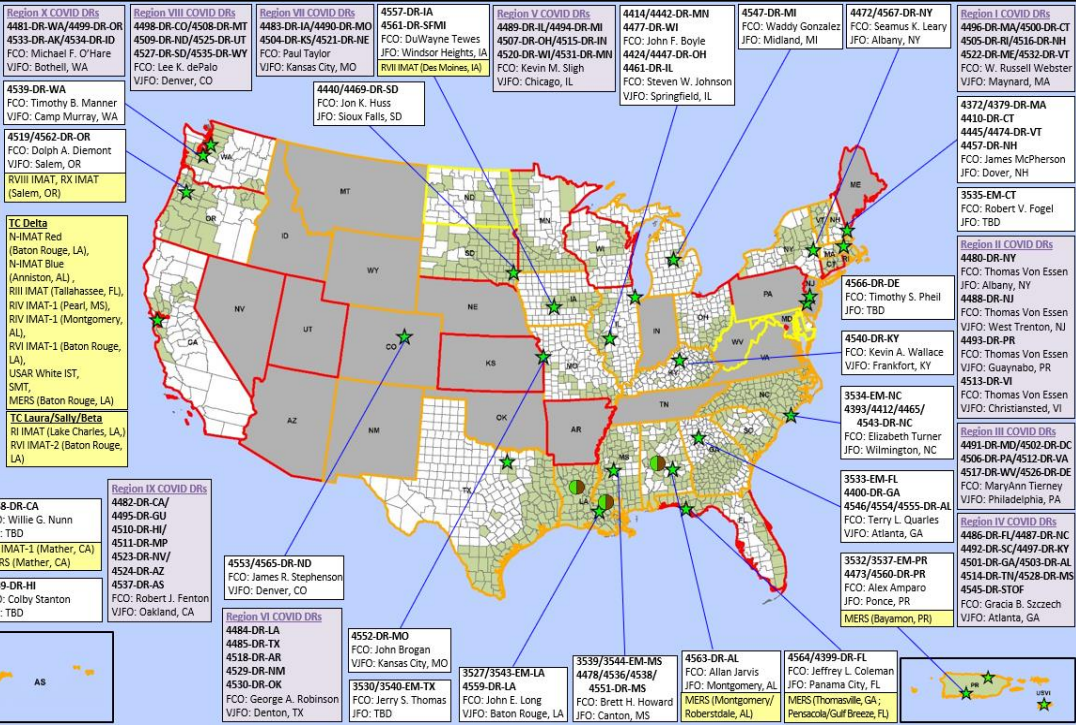
