

Tropical Outlook - Five Day



- Located 30 miles WSW of northern tip of Guajira Peninsula Columbia
- Moving W at 15 mph
- Maximum sustained winds of 35 mph
- Expected to become a tropical storm; later today




<u>Current Situation:</u> FEMA and federal partners continue to support the State of Florida in response and recovery from the impacts of Tropical Cyclone lan. Federal teams, commodities, and equipment are providing support to life saving and life sustaining requirements across the impacted areas. Mission priorities continue to be focused on community lifeline stabilization and expanding recovery operations, including the activation of recovery support functions and additional disaster survivor assistance teams to increase access to individual assistance programs.

FEMA / Federal Response:

- Region I: IMAT deployed to Tampa, FL
- Region III: RWC returned to monitoring; LNO and IMAT demobilized from VA
- Region IV: RRCC at Level II, 24/7 with modified night shift
 - o IMAT-1 deployed to FL EOC; IMAT-2 deployed to Ft. Myers, FL
 - LNOS deployed to FL, GA, SC, and NC
- Region VIII: IMAT deployed to Kissimmee, FL
- FEMA HQ: NRCC is Fully Activated 24/7, w/all ESFs, LNOs
 - National IMAT White deployed to FL EOC
 - Elements of National IMAT Blue deployed to FL EOC
 - o Elements of National IMAT Gold deployed to Ft. Myers, FL
 - US&R White IST deployed to Orlando, FL; Federal Search and Rescue Coordination Group demobilized
 - 3-Type 1 (VA-TF2, OH-TF1, IN-TF1), 8-Type 3 US&R task forces
 (VA-TF1, TX-TF1, PA-TF1, MD-TF1, MJ-TF1, NJ-TF1, MA-TF1) and 22-Canine Search Teams
 Human Remains Detection are conducting search and rescue operations in support of FL.
 - National Responder Mobilization team established a Personnel Mobilization Center (PMC) in Dallas, TX; GA PMC Annex established
 - o HHS: 7 DMATs deployed FL (Lee, Sarasota, and Charlotte counties)
 - DHS: Surge Capacity Force activated
 - o HQ Logistics: SMTs at Maxwell, AFB (Montgomery, AL)



















Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall





Hazards Outlook - Oct 9-13






