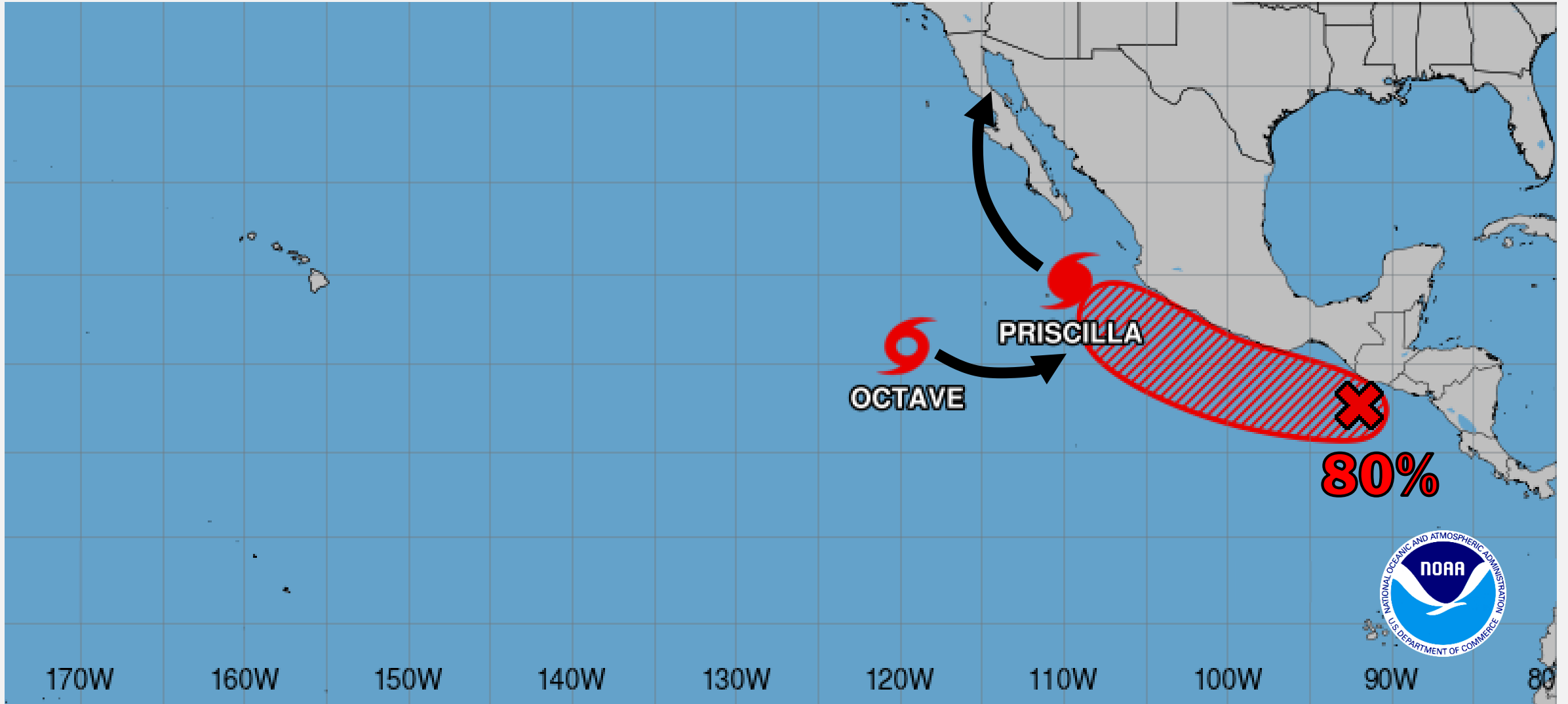

## TROPICAL OUTLOOK



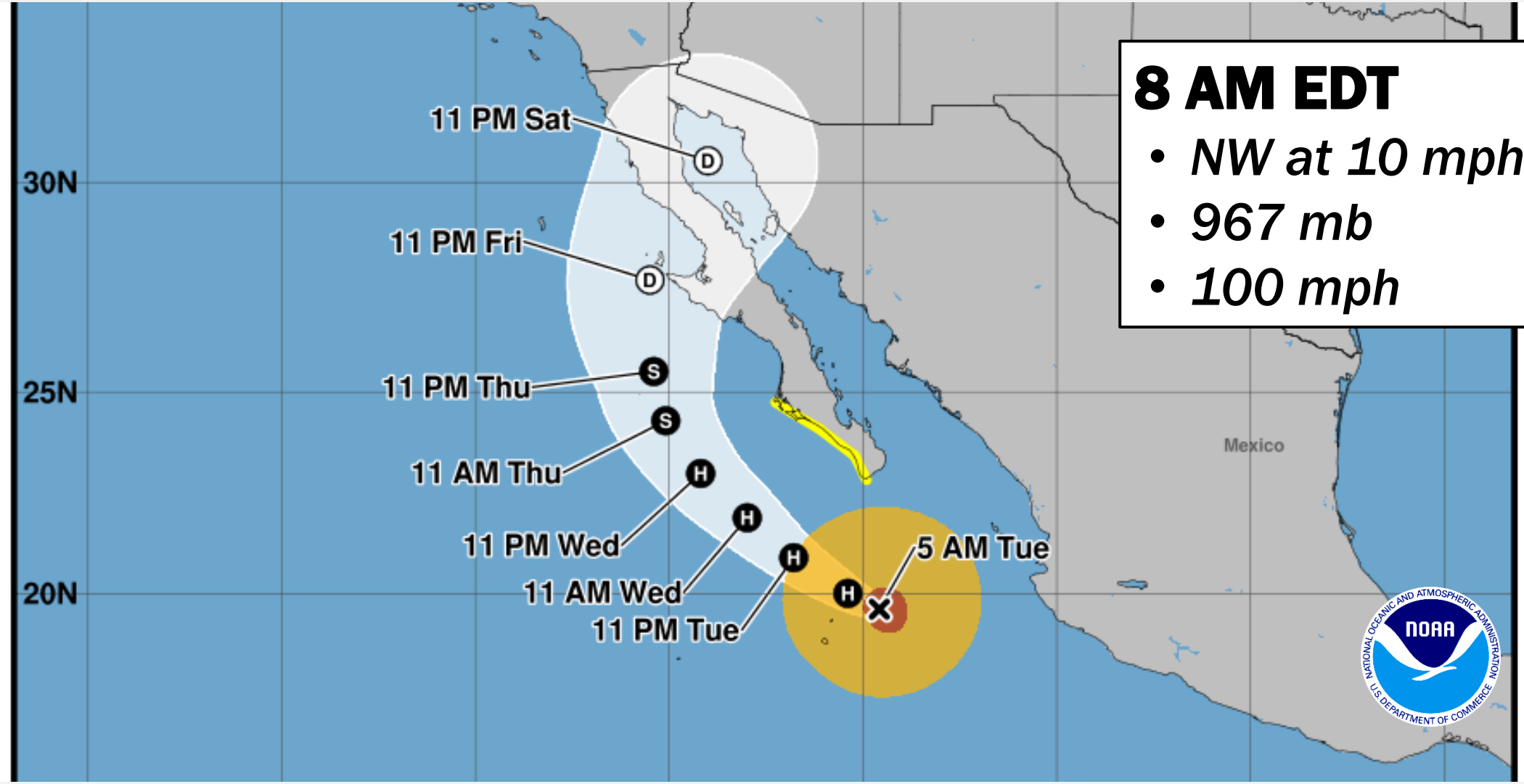

# Atlantic Disturbance (AL95) – U.S. Virgin Islands and Puerto Rico

**Situation:** A Tropical Disturbance has been identified in the Atlantic Ocean that may impact Puerto Rico and the U.S. Virgin Islands in the coming days. FEMA HQ and Region 2 held an operations coordination call on Oct 6 and are positioning resources in Puerto Rico and the U.S. Virgin Islands to support any potential requests from the territories.

**Territorial / Local Response:** (R2 SPOTREP, as of 2:00 a.m. ET)

- PR and USVI EOCs are at Normal Operations

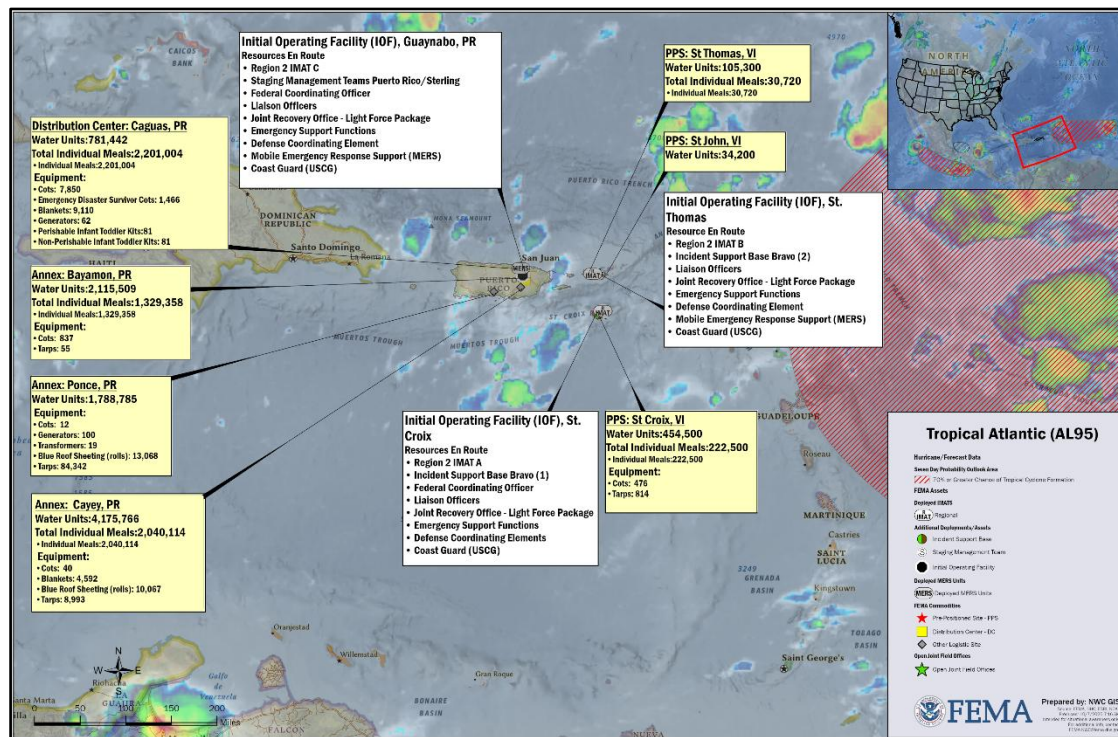
**FEMA / Federal Response:** (IAB, as of 12:30 p.m. ET, Oct 6 and R2 RA, as of 6:23 p.m. ET, Oct 6)

**PR:**

- Interim Operating Facility (IOF) in Guaynabo is active with resources including Federal Coordinating Officer (FCO); Liaison Officers (LNOs); Joint Recovery Office Light Force Package; Incident Management Assistance Team (IMAT)-C; Emergency Support Functions (ESFs) 1, 2, 3, 5, 6, 7, 8, 12, 13, 14, 15; U.S. Coast Guard (USCG), and Defense Coordinating Element (DCE)

**USVI:**

- IOFs in St. Thomas and St. Croix are active with resources including: FCO; LNO; Joint Recovery Office Light Force Package; IMAT-A and B, ESFs 1, 2, 3, 5, 6, 7, 8, 12, 13, 14, 15; USCG; and DCE



The NWC will continue to monitor in coordination with FEMA Region 2. Updates will be provided as the system further develops.

**FEMA / Federal Response (cont.):**

**FEMA Region 2:**

- RWC is Monitoring; RRCC is at Level 3 with ESFs 1-8 and 11-15, USCG, and DCE activated; Region 2 IMAT is deployed to St. Croix, USVI
- FEMA Integration Teams embedded in PR & USVI Emergency Operations Centers

**HQ:**

- FEMA NWC is Monitoring; NRCC is at Steady State (Blue Team Rostered)
- Staging Management Team (SMTs) Sterling and Puerto Rico deployed to Caguas, PR; Distribution Management Power Support Systems Mechanic/Fleet Management LNO will deploy to Bayamon, PR and St. Thomas/St. Croix, USVI (ETA 8:00 a.m. ET, Oct 8) (Region 2 RWC, as of 7:26 a.m. ET)
- Incident Support Base (ISB) Bravo 1 deployed to St. Croix, USVI; ISB Bravo 2 deployed to St. Thomas, USVI
- Maynard Mobile Emergency Response Support (MERS) assets deployed to Guaynabo, PR and St. Thomas/St. Croix, USVI (Region 2 RWC, as of 7:26 a.m. ET)

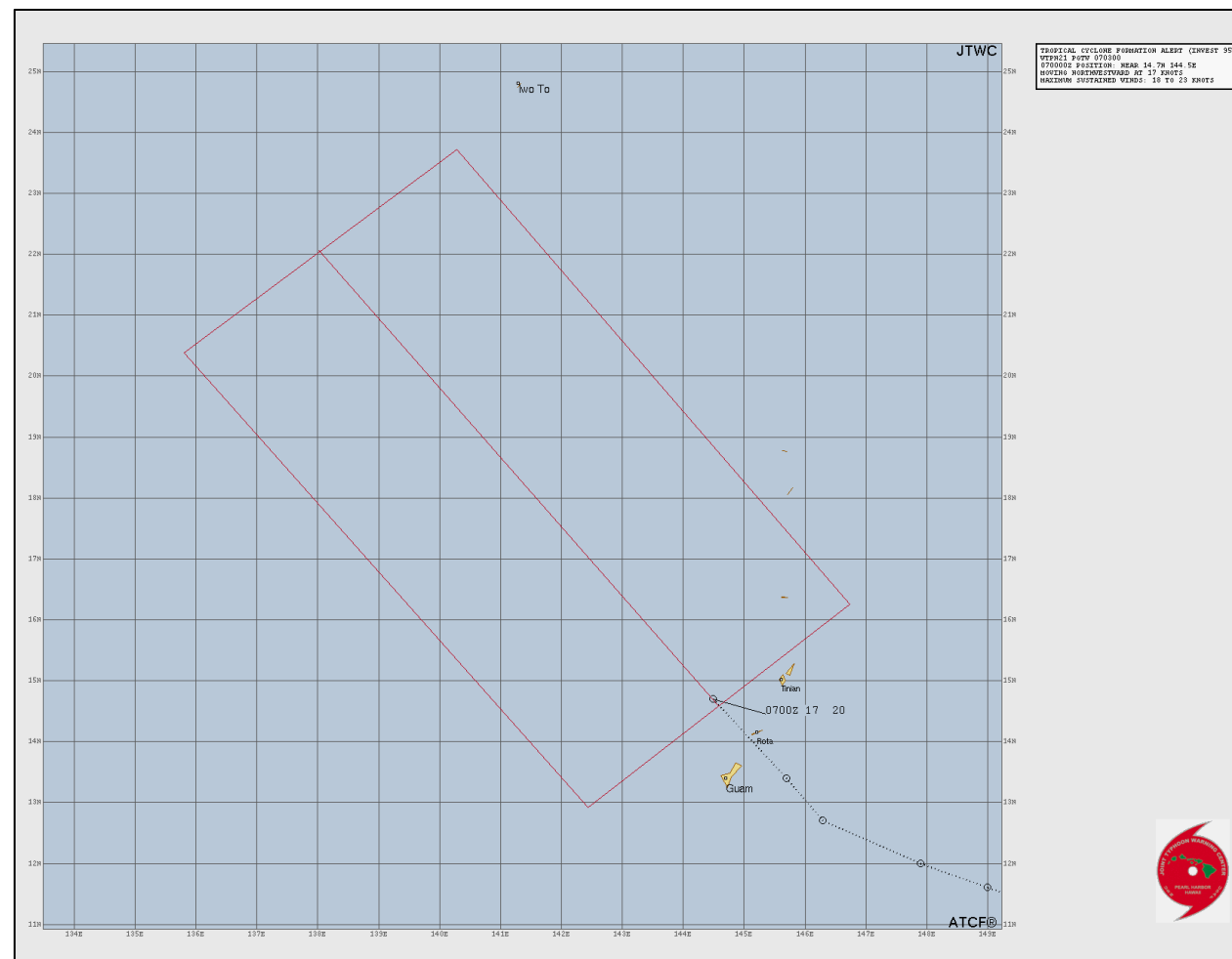


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# Invest 95W – Western Pacific

**Situation:** (JTWC, as of 11:00 p.m. ET and NWS Guam, as of 7:15 a.m. ET)

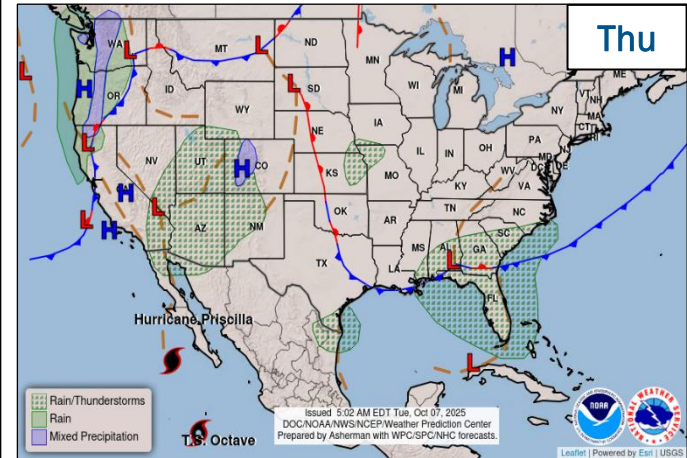
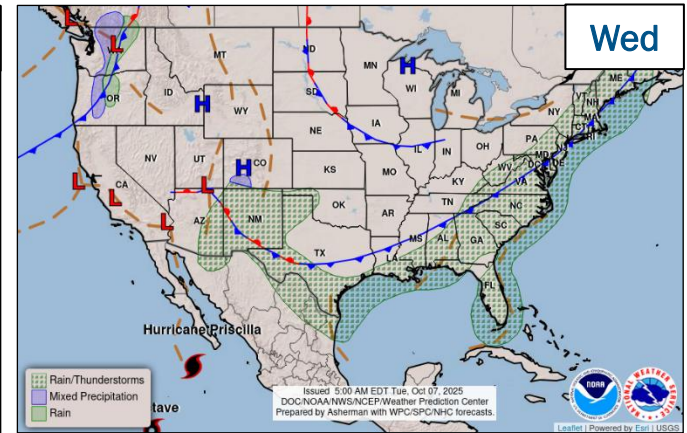
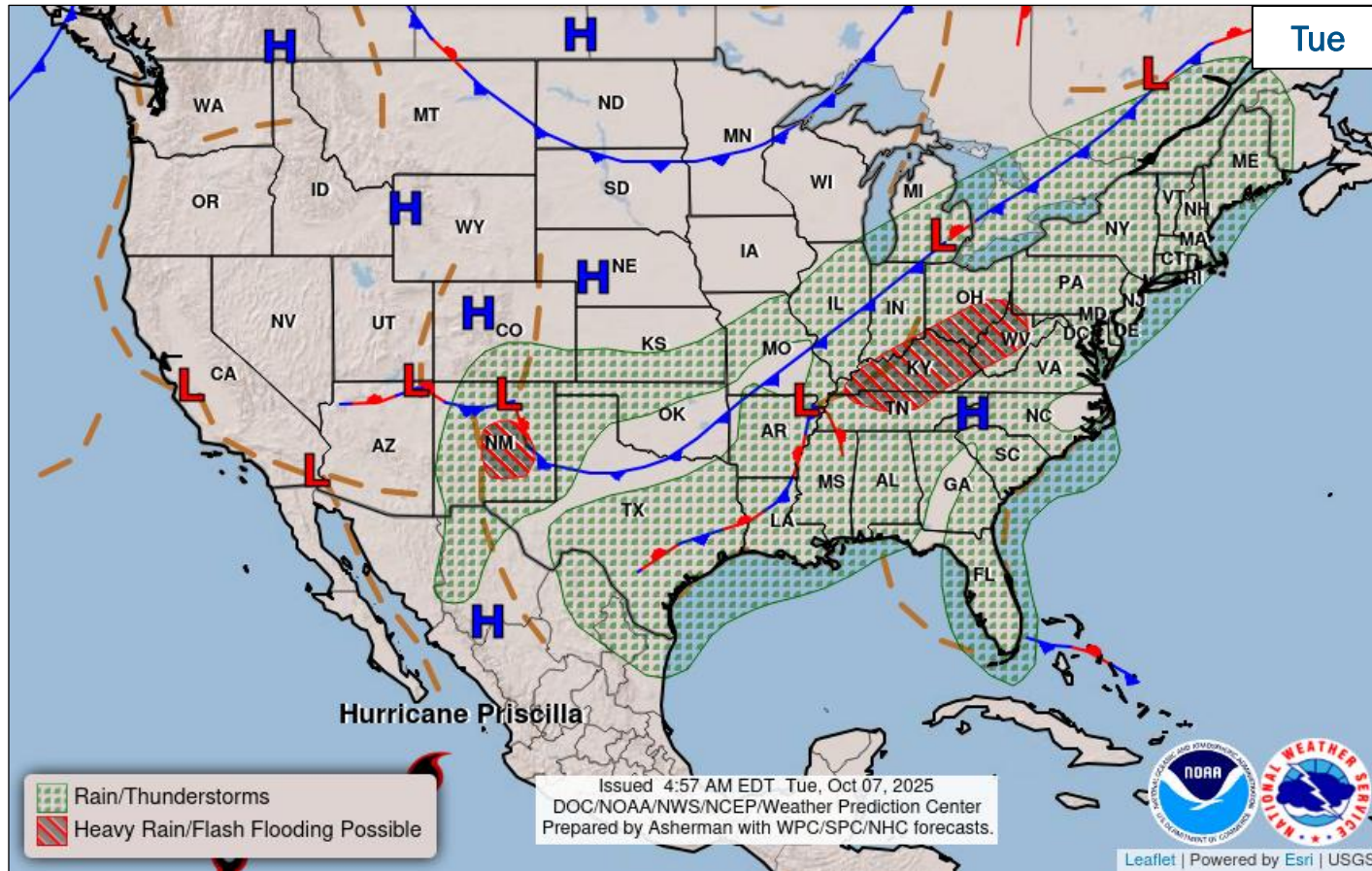
- Located approx. 80 miles N of Guam, moving NW at 20 mph

- No watches, warnings, or advisories are in effect for Guam or the Northern Mariana Islands



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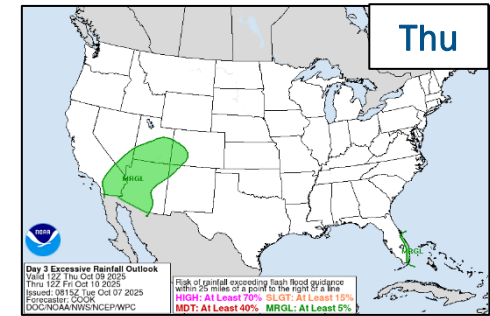
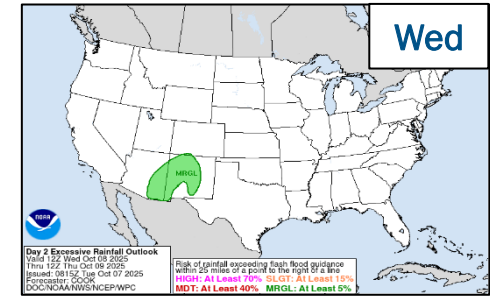
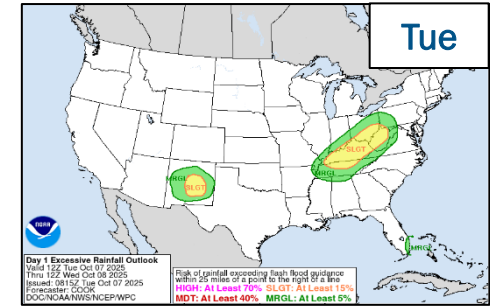
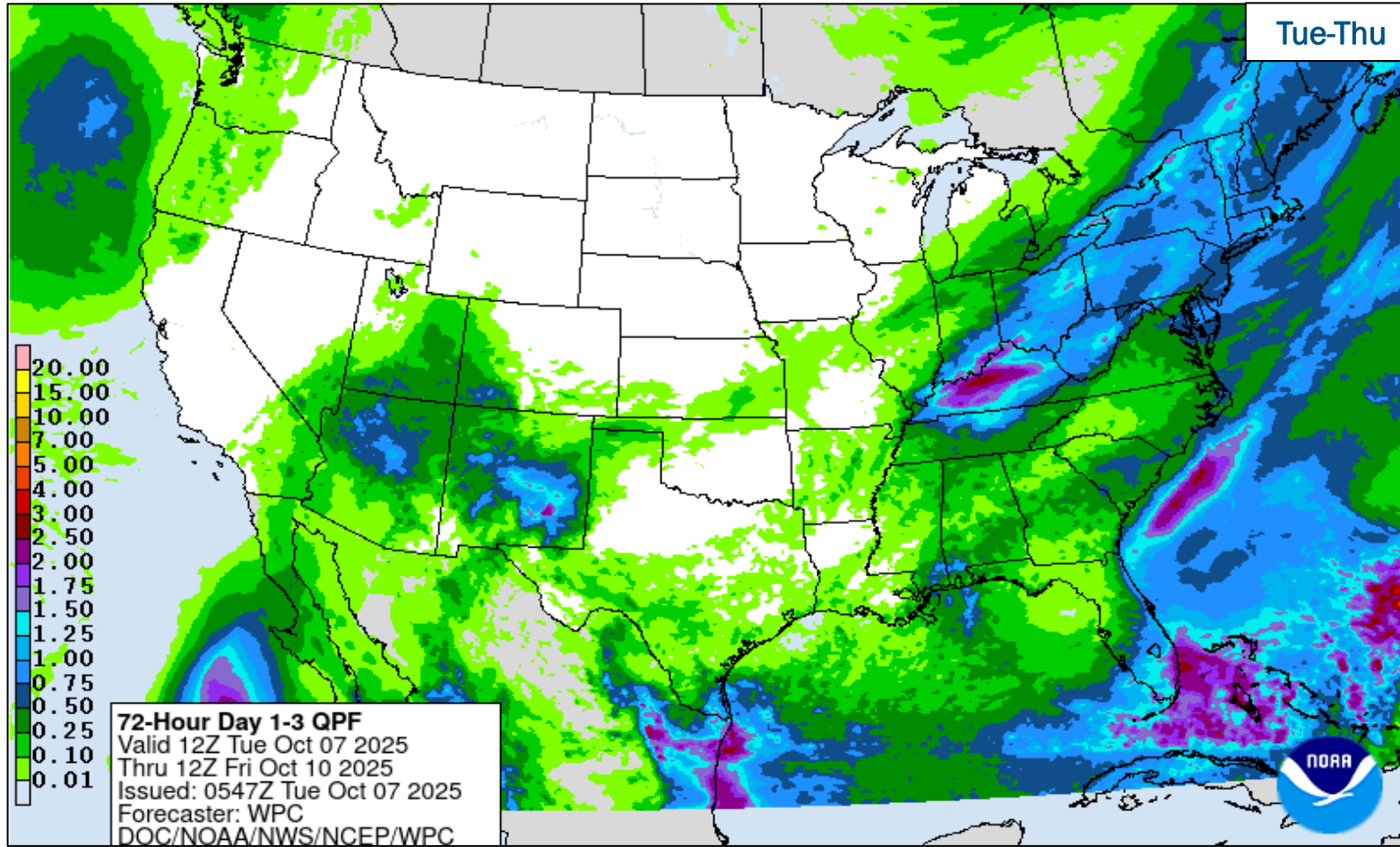
# National Weather Forecast



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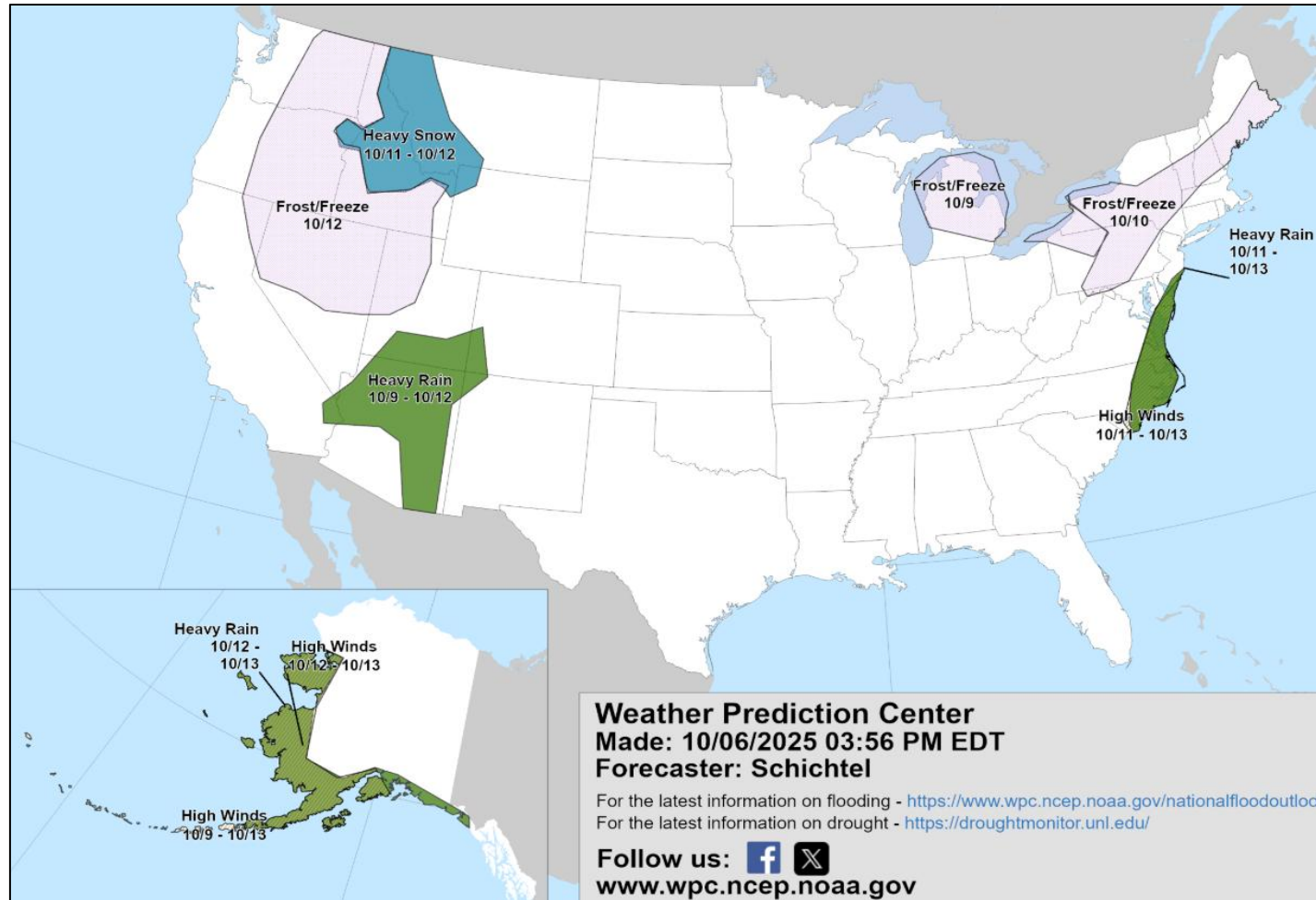
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# Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall

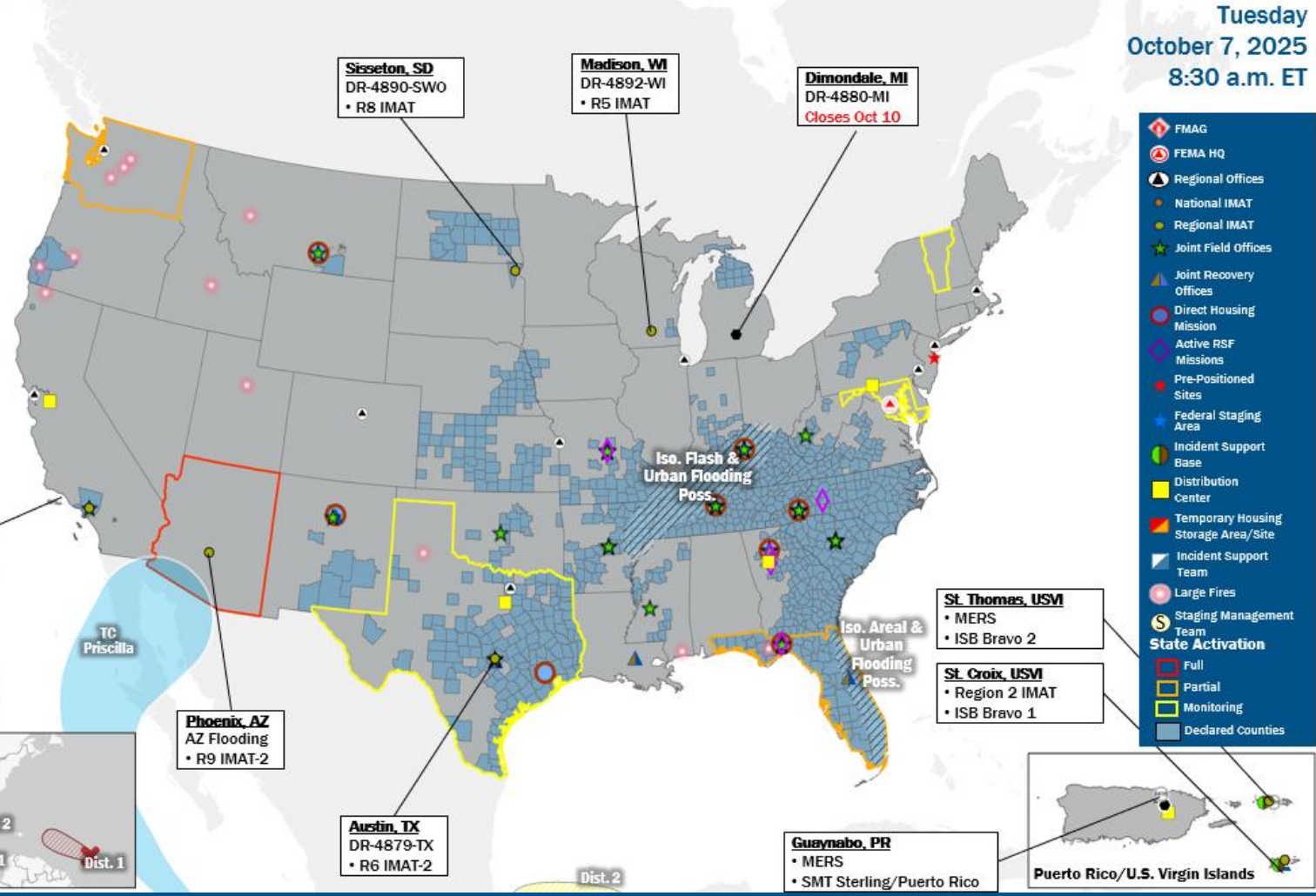
