



SATELLITE LOOP





FORECAST TRACK









STORM SURGE WATCHES AND WARNINGS





PEAK STORM SURGE FORECAST





5 DAY RAINFALL





FLASH FLOOD POTENTIAL







Hurricane Delta – Preparations/Response



Situation: Hurricane Delta threatens portions of the Gulf Coast. Personnel and resources are staged across, or en-route to, potentially impacted areas in the path of the storm.



State/Local Preparations and Response

Region IV:

- AL EOC at Partial Activation (TC Delta & COVID-19); Governor declared State of Emergency; EM requested
- MS EOC at Partial Activation (COVID-19); Governor declared State of Emergency; EM requested
 - MS National Guard activated
- FL EOC at Full Activation (COVID-19)

Region VI:

- LA EOC at Partial Activation (TC Delta & COVID-19); Governor declared State of Emergency; EM approved







COVID-19 Update



Situation: Upward trajectory in COVID-19 case count continues across **33 (-2)** states/territories, with **8 (+2)** states/territories in a plateau status, and 16 states/territories on a downward trajectory. 16,763 National Guard deployed / activated; 1,253 (-13) FEMA employees deployed. (COVID-19 SLB, as of Oct 7)


Nationwide Testing: 120,916,780 (+1,533,466) cumulative (COVID-19 SLB, as of Oct 7)

COVID-19 positive cases continue to increase globally

- Confirmed Cases of COVID-19
 - United States: 7,475,262
 - Worldwide: 35,537,491
 - Deaths caused by COVID-19
 - United States: 210,232
 - Worldwide: 1,042,798
- (COVID-19 Response Update, as of Oct 7)

Response:

- NRCC conducting COVID response operations
- Regions I, II, III, V, VI, & X RRCCs at Level III
- Regions IV, VII, VIII, & IX RRCCs are rostered
- Regions VII, VIII, & IX COVID-19 working from the Virtual JFO
- NWC, all RWCs, and MOCs are monitoring
