
#### **Tropical Activity:**

- Atlantic:
  - Hurricane Delta (CAT 3)
  - Disturbance 1: Low (20%)
- Eastern Pacific:
  - Tropical Depression Norbert
  - Disturbance 1: Medium (60%)
  - Disturbance 2: Low (10%)
- Central Pacific: No new tropical cyclones expected during the next five days
- Western Pacific: No activity affecting U.S. interests

#### **Declaration Activity:**

- Request: Major Disaster Declaration UT
- Approval: Emergency Declaration MS



# Hurricane Delta Most Likely Arrival of ts winds




# Hurricane Delta HURRICANE WIND PROBABILITY



# Hurricane Delta STORM SURGE WATCHES AND WARNINGS




# Hurricane Delta PEAK STORM SURGE FORECAST










#### 3 DAY FORECAST RAINFALL


#### FLASH FLOOD POTENTIAL



#### Hurricane Delta – Preparations/Response



**Situation:** Hurricane Delta threats portions of the Gulf Coast. Personnel and resources are staged across, or en-route to, potentially impacted areas in the path of the storm.



#### State/Local Preparations and Response

Region IV:

- AL EOC at Partial Activation (TC Delta & COVID-19); Governor declared State of Emergency; EM requested
- MS EOC at Partial Activation (COVID-19); Governor declared State of Emergency; EM approved; National Guard activated
- FL EOC at Full Activation (COVID-19)


 LA EOC at Partial Activation (TC Delta & COVID-19); Governor declared State of Emergency; EM approved; National Guard activated





### COVID-19 Update



<u>Situation:</u> Upward trajectory in COVID-19 case count continues across 29 (-3) states/territories, with 10 (+2) states/territories in a plateau status, and 17 (+1) states/territories on a downward trajectory. 16,267 National Guard deployed / activated; 1,235 (-1) FEMA employees deployed. (COVID-19 SLB, as of Oct 8)

Nationwide Testing: 121,938,898 (+1,022,118) cumulative (COVID-19 SLB, as of Oct 8)

COVID-19 positive cases continue to increase globally

COVID-19 Confirmed Cases:


United States: 7,528,313 (+53,051)Worldwide: 35,897,739 (+360,248)




