Typhoon Bolaven (15W) - Guam/CNMI

Situation: (Advisory #14, as of 5:00 a.m. ET)

- Located 90 miles NNE of Guam; 45 miles SW of Saipan
- Moving NW at 10 mph

Rainfall

8-14 inches with locally higher amounts to 20 inches possible

- Up to 7 ft of inundation is expected along exposed shorelines of Rota,
 Tinian, and Saipan

Typhoon Bolaven (15W) - Guam/CNMI



Situation: (JTWC Advisory #14, as of 5:00 a.m. ET)

Typhoon Bolaven is located approximately 90 miles NNE of Guam and 45 miles SW of Saipan as it continues to intensify. The typhoon is moving NW at 10 mph with maximum sustained winds of 80 mph. Typhoon Warnings remain in effect for Tinian, Saipan, and Rota. Typhoon Watches and Tropical Storm Warnings remain in effect for Guam.

<u>Lifeline Impacts</u>: (EM-3601-GU/EM-3602-MP SLB, as of 4:00 a.m. ET) Food, Hydration, Shelter:

- Guam: 6 shelters open; pop. 437
- CNMI: 6 shelters open (4 in Saipan, 1 in Tinian, 1 in Rota); pop. 109

Energy:

- CNMI: Entire island of Rota without power
- CNMI: GSB recon ongoing for ARC and Saipan Airport






Eastern Pacific



Hurricane Lidia (Advisory #29A, as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located 235 miles SW of Puerto Vallarta, Mexico
- Maximum sustained winds 85 mph
- Moving ENE at 13 mph
- Hurricane-force winds extend outward up to 25 miles
- Additional strengthening is forecast today as Lidia approaches the coast of west-central Mexico; rapid weakening is expected after Lidia moves inland

Disturbance 1 (AL92) (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located several hundred miles SW of the Cabo Verde Islands
- TD likely to form in next couple of days
- Moving WNW or NW
- Formation chance 48-hour: High (70%); 7-day: High (80%)


Disturbance 2 (AL93) (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Formation chance 48-hour: Low (30%); 7-day: Low (30%)





National Weather Forecast






Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall
