### National Current Operations and Monitoring FEMA

#### **Significant Incidents or Threats:**

- Tropical Cyclone Delta Response
- Severe thunderstorms Upper Mississippi Valley
- Heavy Rain/Flash Flooding Southern Appalachians
- Red Flag Warnings Central/Southern Plains & Central Great Basin
- COVID-19
- Wildfires Western U.S.

#### **Tropical Activity:**

- Atlantic:
  - Disturbance 1: Low (20%)
- Eastern Pacific:
  - Disturbance 1: Low (near 0%)
  - Disturbance 2: Medium (40%)
- Central Pacific: No new tropical cyclones expected during the next five days
- Western Pacific: No activity affecting U.S. interests

### Tropical Cyclone Delta



**Situation:** As the remnants of Delta move farther inland, heavy rain and local flash flooding is expected in the Ohio Valley and Mid Atlantic late on Sunday. Initial response, damage assessment, and restoration activities ongoing, significant power outages in the impacted areas.

Lifeline Impacts: (FEMA NRCC SLB, as of 6:00 a.m. ET, Oct 11)

#### Safety and Security

LA: Mandatory / voluntary evacuations in effect for 23 (+2) parishes

#### Food, Water, Shelter

- · Meals, water, tarps, and plastic sheeting pre-staged within Region IV & VI; No unmet needs
- LA: 98 drinking water systems serving a population of 63.5k (+59k) are non-operational; 32 systems under boil water advisories
- LA:
  - o 5 (-5) congregate shelters / 779 (-274) occupants
  - o 12 non-congregate shelters / 8.3k (-.3k) occupants

#### Health and Medical

- LA: COVID-19 testing sites closed; in LA Region 5 and 6 until impacts are assessed
- LA: 30 (-1) medical facilities evacuated or sheltering in place; 54 on generator power

#### Energy (Eagle-I as of 8:30 a.m. ET, Oct 11)


- LA: 348k (-70k) (16.2%) customers without power
  - o 7,500 utility workers on standby for restoration with another 8,000 available

#### Communications

- LA: 21 of 141 LWIN sites throughout LA are out of service impacting emergency responder radio communications; ETA unknown
- Three 911 Dispatch Centers offline; 1 parish unable to identify callers and their locations

#### **Transportation**

- · LA Port status:
  - Closures: Lake Charles, Morgan City, Houma, Offshore Oil Port, Terrebonne, Iberia, Vermillion Bay
  - Open w/restrictions: Baton Rouge, New Orleans, Plaquemines, South Louisiana, and Port Fourchon





  - o TN-TF1, OH-TF1 & FL-TF2 operational in Calcasieu, LA
  - o TX-TF1, MO-TF1 & IN-TF1 demobilized
  - o AZ-TF1, VA-TF1, & MD-TF1 alert orders cancelled
- MERS assets deployed in support of IMATs & US&R
- · Logistics team deploying to Camp Beauregard, LA
  - o Staging 1 RRT, 1 IMT and 2 DMATs in Dallas, TX
- Region VI
  - o Region VI RWC at Monitoring; RRCC Level III, dayshift (COVID-19)
  - o LA:
    - N-IMAT Red deployed to Baton Rouge
    - Region VI IMAT-1 and IMAT-2 deployed to Baton Rouge, LA
    - LNO deployed to New Orleans, LA



#### Eastern Pacific


#### Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- 1,900 miles WSW of Baja, California peninsula
- Conditions not conducive for further development
- 48-hour Formation Chance: Low (near 0%)
- 5-days Formation Chance: Low (near 0%)

#### Disturbance 2 (as of 2:00 a.m. ET)

- Several hundred miles SW of coast of Mexico
- Remnants of Norbert; slight development possible next week
- 48-hour Formation Chance: Low (20%)
- 5-days Formation Chance: Medium (40%)








#### Disturbance 1 (as of 2:00 8.m. ET)


- · 1200 miles east of the Winward Island









### Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall











### COVID-19 Update



<u>Situation:</u> Upward trajectory in COVID-19 case count continues across 27 states/territories, with 13 states/territories in a plateau status, and 16 states/territories on a downward trajectory; 1,231 FEMA employees deployed. (COVID-19 SLB, as of Oct 9)

Nationwide Testing: 123,094,477 cumulative (COVID-19 SLB, as of Oct 9)


COVID-19 positive cases continue to increase globally

- COVID-19 Confirmed Cases:
  - United States: 7,641,502 (+58,302)
  - o Worldwide: 36,754,395 (+383,359)
- COVID-19 Associated Deaths:
  - United States: 213,037 (+926)
  - o Worldwide: 1,064,838 (+8,575)

#### Response:

- NRCC conducting COVID response operations
- Regions I, II, III, V, & X RRCCs at Level III
- Regions IV, VI, VII, VIII, & IX RRCCs are rostered
- Regions VII, VIII, & IX COVID-19 working from the Virtual JFO
- NWC, all RWCs, and MOCs are monitoring


