
Super Typhoon Bolaven – Guam/CNMI

Situation: (Advisory #18, as of 5:00 a.m. ET)

- Located 290 miles NNW of Saipan; 330 miles NNW of Rota; 365 miles NNW of Guam
- Moving NNW at 14 mph

Winds

- Maximum sustained winds of 165 mph
- Typhoon-force winds extend outward up to 25 miles

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Super Typhoon Bolaven – Guam/CNMI - FINAL

Situation: (RIX SLB #2, as of 7:00 a.m. ET)

Super Typhoon Bolaven moved away from the islands; it rapidly intensified and was upgraded to a Category 5 Super Typhoon moving NNW at 14 mph. The Office of the Governor issued a Cancellation of Storm Conditions for Tinian, Rota, and Saipan while an issue of Tropical Storm Condition 1 remained for the Northern Islands. No major storm impacts from the typhoon have been reported.

Lifeline Impacts: (EM-3601-GU/EM-3602-MP SLB, as of 7:00 a.m. ET) Food, Hydration, Shelter:

- Guam: shelters closing today
- CNMI: 1 (-5) shelters open; pop. 2 (-107)


Energy: All power has been restored *Transportation:* Ports at Guam and Rota, at Whiskey (open); Tinian remains at Zulu will open today



No tropical cyclones expected during the next 7 days


Eastern Pacific

- Moving ENE at 23 mph
- This is the last public advisory issued by the National Hurricane Center on this system

Atlantic



Tropical Storm Sean (Advisory #2, as of 5:00 a.m. ET)


- Located 725 miles WSW of the Cabo Verde Islands
- Maximum sustained winds 40 mph
- Moving WNW at 13 mph
- Little change in strength is forecast during the next 72 hours
- Tropical storm-force winds extends outwards up to 90 miles

Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located several hundred miles SSE of the Cabo Verde Islands
- Gradual development of this system is possible over the next several days
- Formation chance 48-hour: Low (20%); 7-day: Low (30%)




National Weather Forecast





Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall









