

No tropical cyclones expected during the next 7 days


#### **Eastern Pacific**

#### <u>Tropical Storm Sean</u> (Advisory #10, as of 5:00 a.m. ET)


- Located 1,105 miles W of the Cabo Verde Islands
- Maximum sustained winds 45 mph
- Moving WNW at 13 mph
- Tropical-storm-force winds extend outward up to 105 miles
- Gradual weakening is forecast for the next few days

#### Disturbance 1 (AL94) (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located several hundred miles SSW of the Cabo Verde Islands
- Moving W
- TD could form by middle of next week
- Formation chance 48-hour: Low (10%); 7-day: High (70%)




### **National Weather Forecast**


