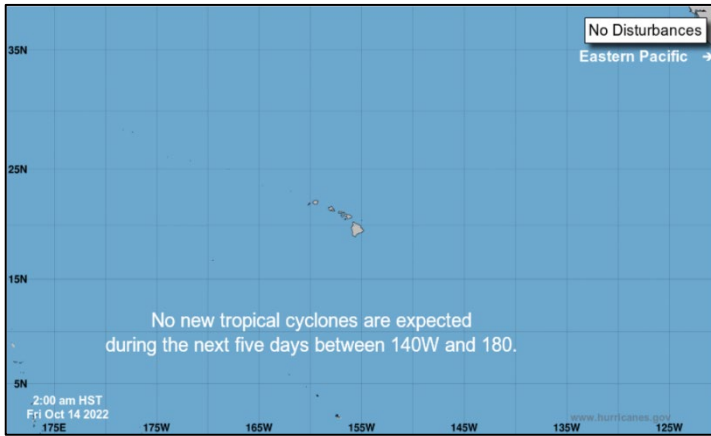

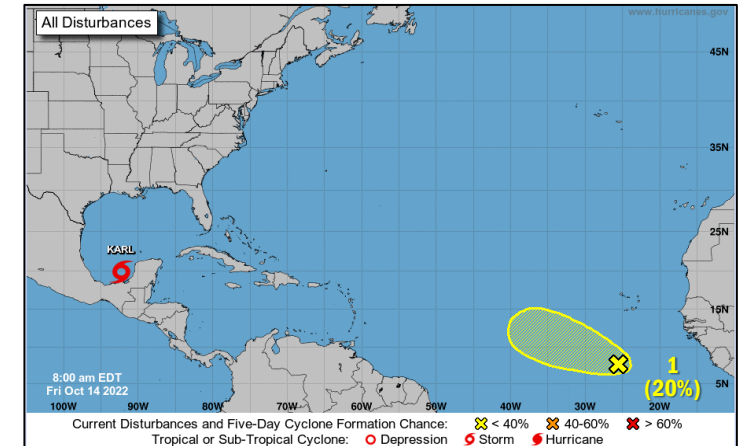

[Tropical Storm Karl](#) ([Advisory #12A as of 8:00 a.m. ET](#))

- Located 90 miles NNW of Ciudad del Carmen, Mexico
- Moving SE at 6 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 40 mph
- Tropical-storm-force winds extend out 60 miles
- Steady weakening is expected after the storm crosses the coastline, system is forecast to dissipate over southern Mexico by Saturday night

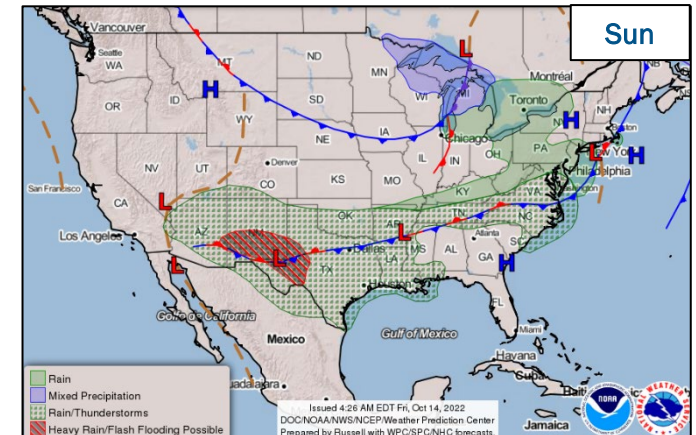
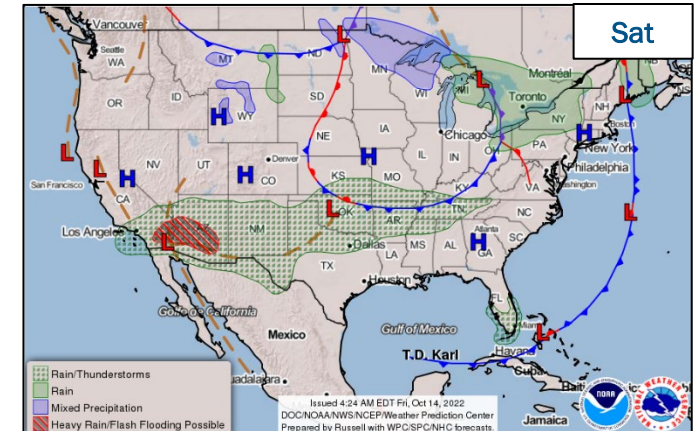
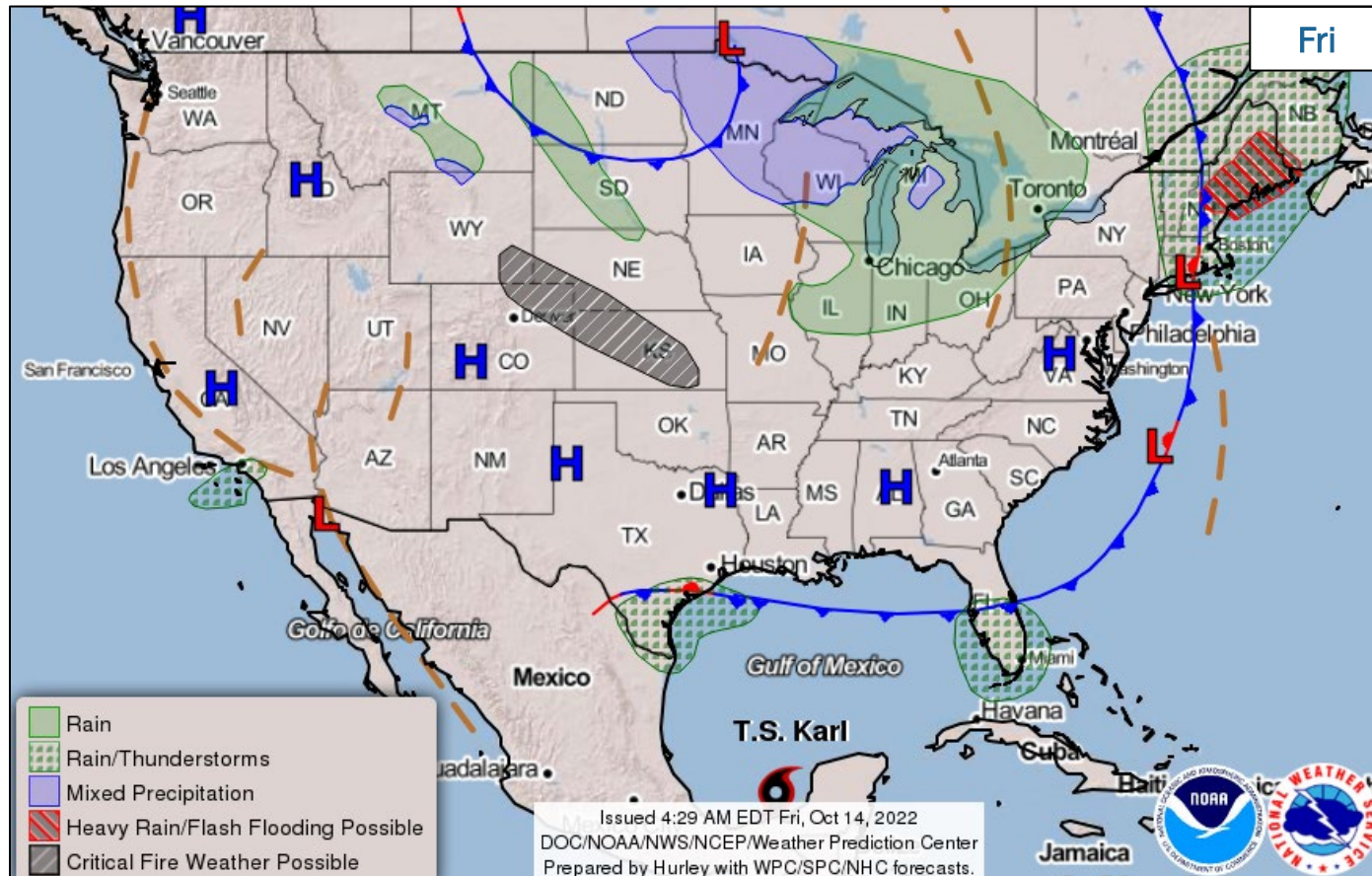
- Located several hundred miles SSW of the Cabo Verde Islands

- Formation chance – 48 hour: Low (10%); 5-day: Low (20%)



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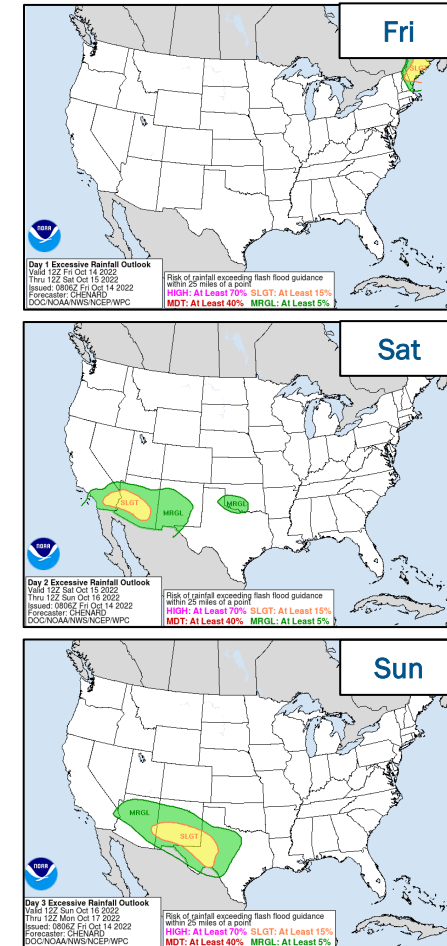
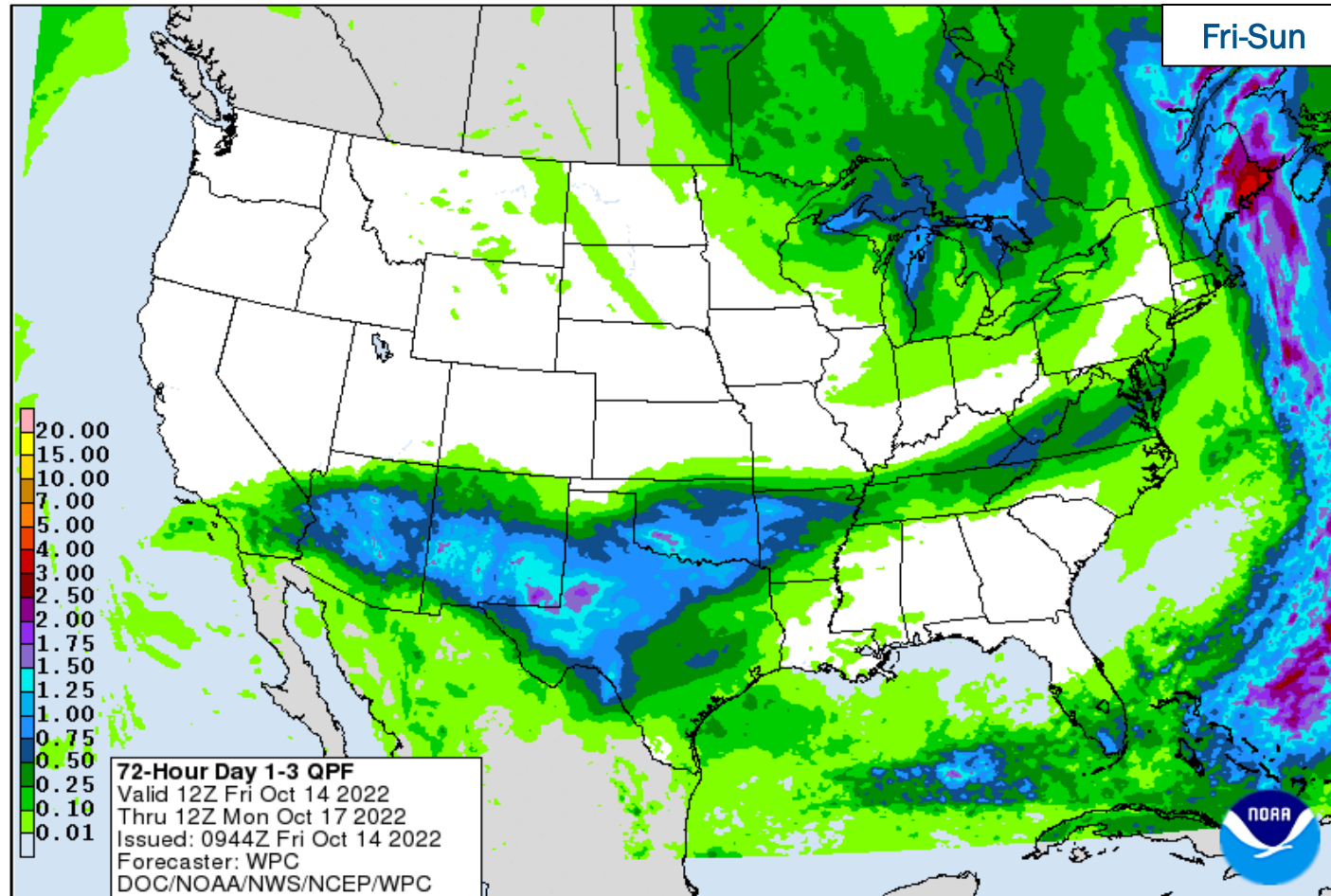
National Weather Forecast



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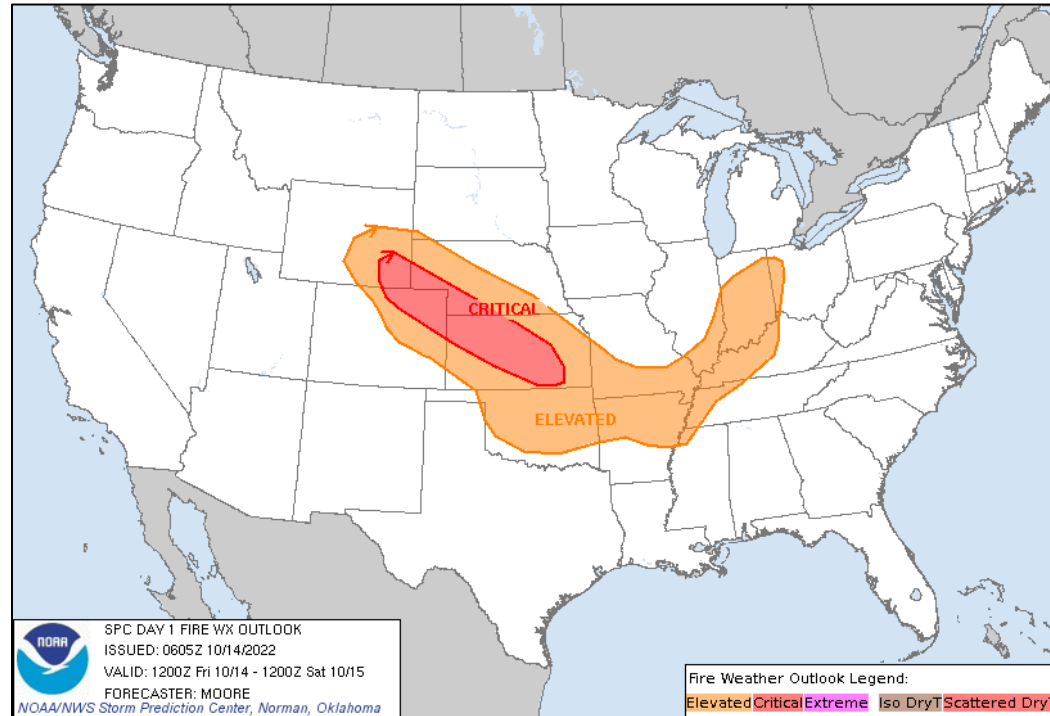
Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall



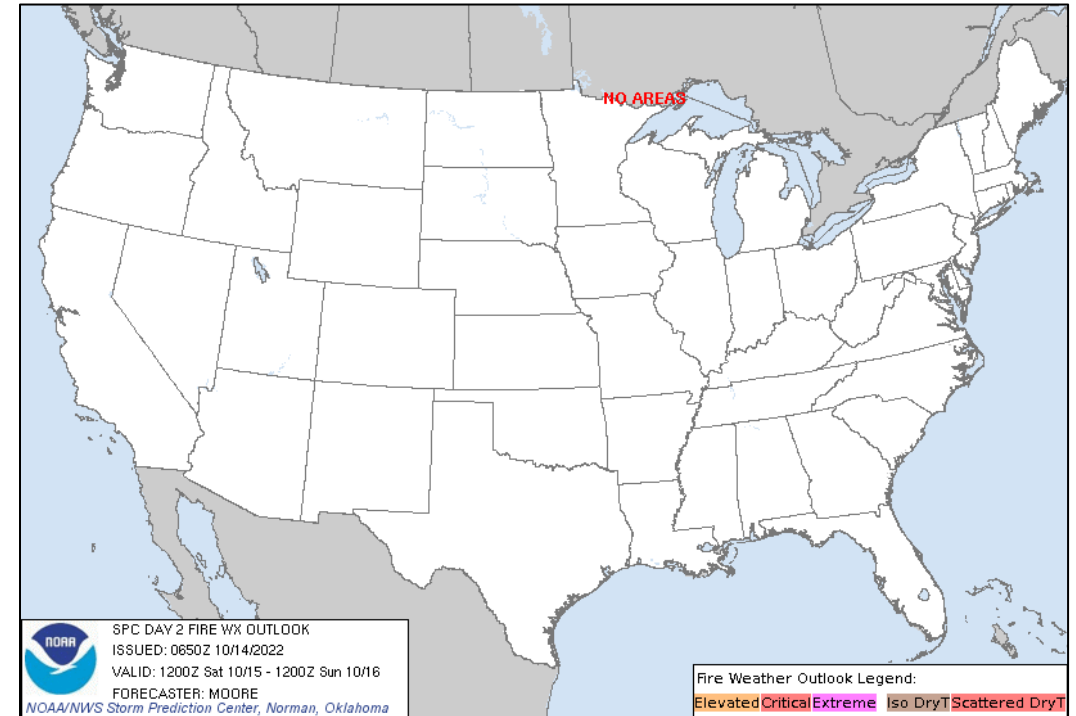
