

Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)


- Located 950 miles SSW of Honolulu, HI

Tropical Storm Sean (Advisory #14, as of 5:00 a.m. ET)


- Located 1,315 miles N of the Northern Leeward Islands
- Maximum sustained winds 40 mph
- Moving WNW at 8 mph
- Tropical-storm-force winds extend outward up to 70 miles
- Likely to become a post-tropical remnant low over the weekend

- Located several hundred miles SW of the Cabo Verde Islands
- TD likely to form within the next couple of days
- Formation chance 48-hour: High (70%); 7-day: High (90%)




