


Tropical Outlook - Seven Day






Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located several hundred miles SW of the Gulf of Tehuantepec
- TD could form by middle to latter part of the week
- Formation chance 48-hour: Low (20%); 7-day: High (80%)

Disturbance 2 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located S of Guatemala and El Salvador
- Area of low pressure is expected to form by the middle of next week
- Formation chance 48-hour: Low (near 0%); 7-day: Low (30%)



Tropical Depression Sean (Advisory #18, as of 5:00 a.m. ET)


- Located 1.210 miles E of the Northern Leeward Islands
- Maximum sustained winds 35 mph
- Moving NW at 9 mph
- Likely to become a post-tropical remnant low tomorrow

Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located several hundred miles SW of the Cabo Verde Islands
- Tropical Depression or Tropical Storm likely to form within the next couple of days
- Formation chance 48-hour: Med (60%); 7-day: High (90%)


