

- Moving NE at 21 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 40 mph
- Formation chance through 48 hours: High (90%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: High (90%)
- Tropical Storm Warnings and Watches and Storm Surge Watches in effect for portions of FL, GA, AL, MS and LA
- Potential Impacts:
 - Storm surge: 2-5 feet in portions of FL
 - Rainfall: 2-4 inches (isolated maximum amounts of 5 inches)
 - Energy: Tropical Storm force winds could down trees and powerlines
 - Transportation: Expected transportation delays due to high winds, flooded roads& potential debris on rail & roadways


















Precipitation Forecast















