
- Atlantic:



Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- 550 miles ESE of Bermuda
- Subtropical depression or storm is very likely to form during the next day or two
- Formation chance through 48 hours: High (80%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: High (90%)

Disturbance 2 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Expected to form in a few days over the southwestern Caribbean Sea
- Some gradual development possible
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (near 0%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (30%)

COVID-19 Update



<u>Situation</u>: Upward trajectory in COVID-19 case count continues across 39 (+1) states/territories, with 8 jurisdictions in a plateau status, and 9 (-1) jurisdictions on a downward trajectory; 1,255 (+7) FEMA employees deployed. (COVID-19 SLB, as of Oct 16)

Nationwide Testing: 130,846,380 (+944,391) cumulative (COVID-19 SLB, as of Oct 16)


COVID-19 positive cases continue to increase globally




- NRCC conducting COVID response operations

- NWC, all RWCs, and MOCs are monitoring




National Weather Forecast











Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall











6-10 Day Temperature Probability




6-10 Day Precipitation Probability





Current Situation:

- The fire began on October 17 and is burning on federal and private land
- Threatening 500 homes in and around the town of Jamestown, CO (pop 268), approximately 13 miles northwest of Boulder (pop 107k)
- Also threatening 750 other buildings, U.S. Highway 36, public utility distribution, powerlines, and the Lefthand Canyon watershed in the area
- Mandatory evacuations in effect for 1,000 people

- Region VIII / Denver MOC continue to monitor
- NWC continues to monitor
- FMAG approved October 17, 2020



Current Situation:

- The fire began on October 12 and is burning on federal and private land
- Threatening 135 homes in and around the city of Granby and the towns of Hot Sulphur Springs and Parshall, CO (combined pop 3,000), approximately 85 miles northwest of Denver
- Also threatening buildings, road and bridge infrastructure, and the Colorado River watershed in the area
- Mandatory evacuations in effect for 101 people

- Region VIII / Denver MOC continue to monitor
- NWC continues to monitor
- FMAG approved October 17, 2020


