




Tropical Outlook - Five Day

Tropical Storm Roslyn (Advisory #6A as of 8:00 a.m. ET)


- Located 190 miles S of Manzanillo, Mexico

- Roslyn is forecast to become a hurricane later today





National Weather Forecast











Fire Weather Outlook




