



- No tropical cyclones threatening the U.S. territories
- No tropical cyclones are expected in the next seven days

Disturbance 1 (EP90): (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located S of SW Mexico
- Moving W at 15mph away from coast of Mexico
- Environmental conditions are favorable for additional development, and a tropical depression or storm is expected to form within the next day or so
- Formation chance: 48-hour High (90%); 7-day – High (90%)

Tropical Storm Oscar: (Advisory #9 as of 5:00 a.m. ET)

- Located 5 miles E of Guantanamo, Cuba
- Moving W at 2 mph
- Maximum sustained winds of 50 mph
- Tropical-storm force winds extend outward 45 miles
- Some additional weakening is likely








National Weather Forecast






Precipitation Forecast






Long Range Outlooks - Oct 26-30


