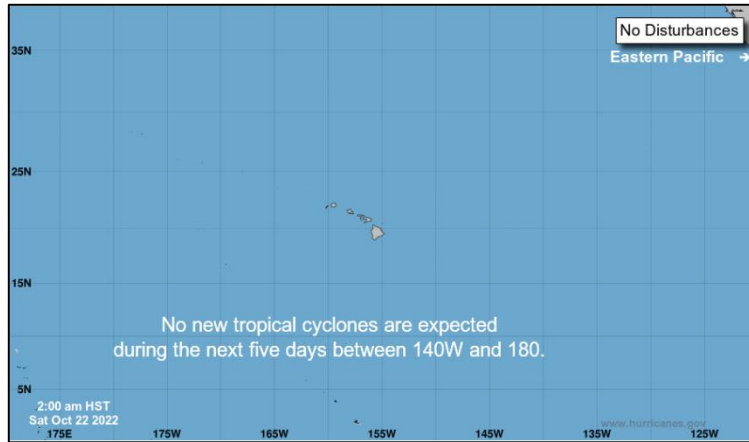

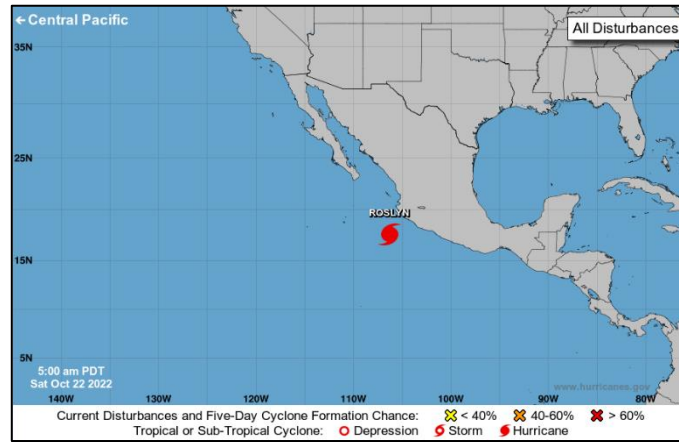
Tropical Outlook – Five Day

- No tropical cyclones expected during the next 5 days

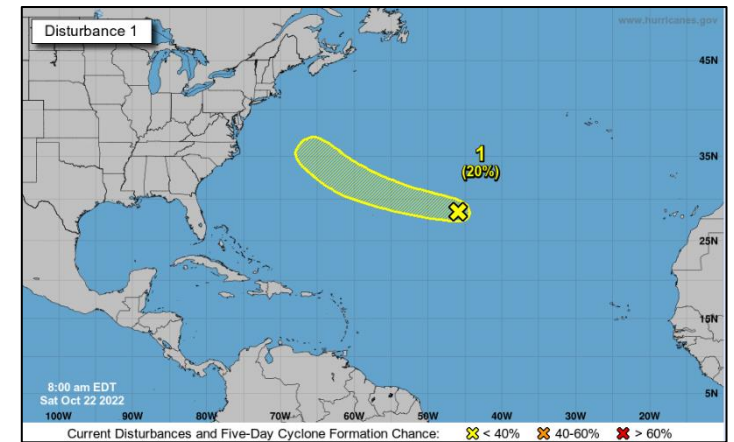
Eastern Pacific



Hurricane Roslyn (CAT 3) (Advisory #10A as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located 155 miles SW of Manzanillo, Mexico
- Maximum sustained winds 120 mph
- Moving NW at 7 mph
- Forecast to make landfall along the coast of west-central Mexico Sunday morning
- Expected to be near or at major hurricane intensity when it makes landfall
- Hurricane force winds extend 25 miles; tropical-storm-force winds extend outward up to 80 miles

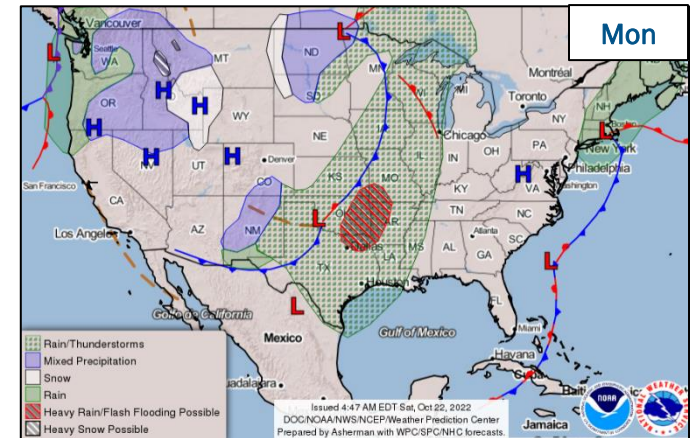
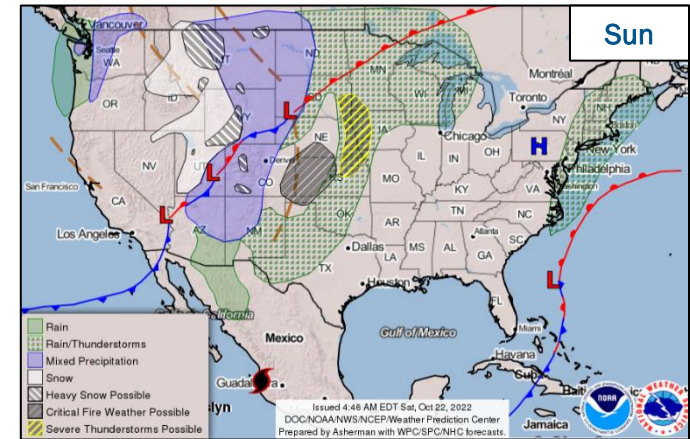
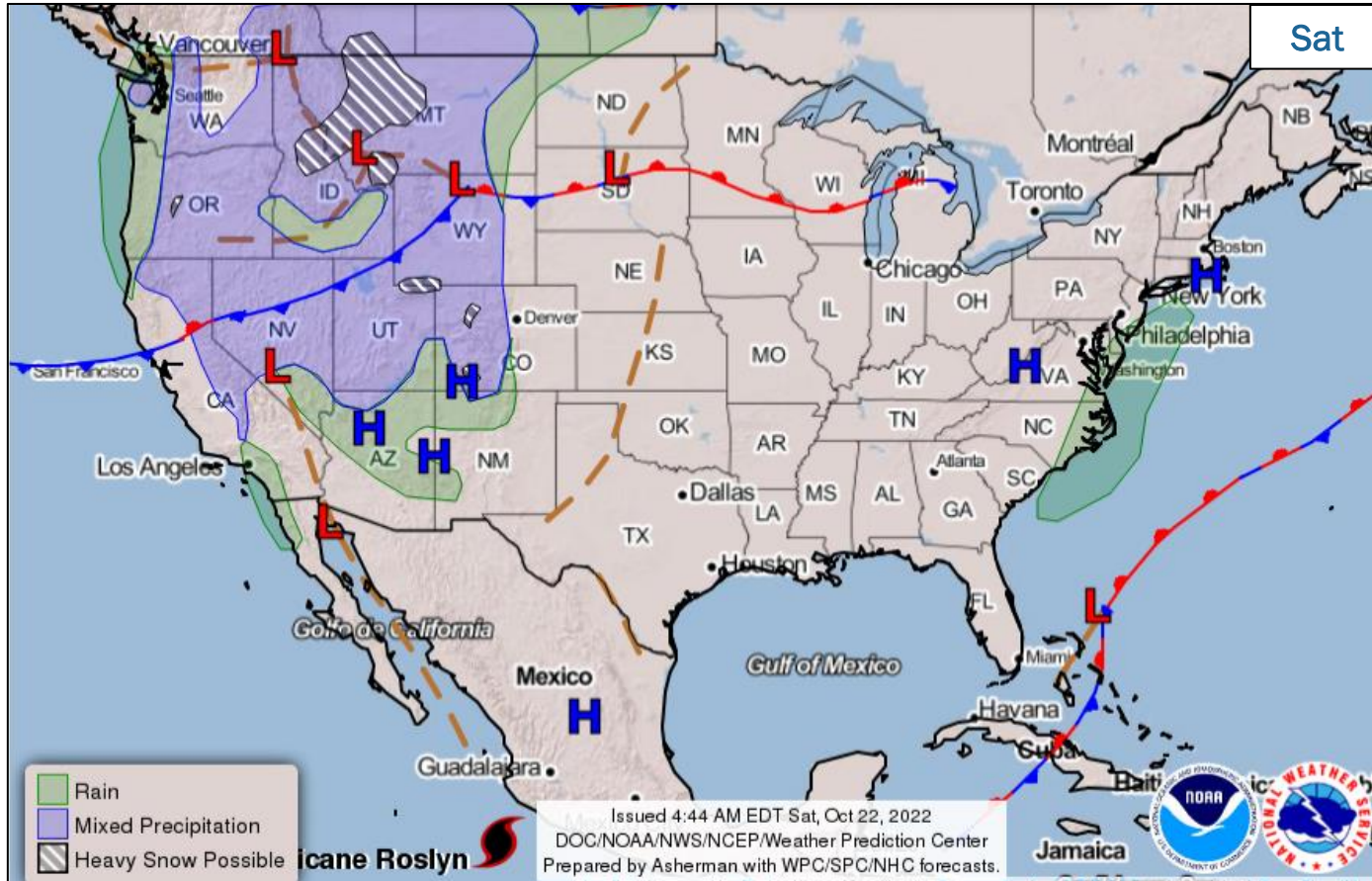
Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located 1,200 miles E of Bermuda
- Moving W to WNW at 15-20 mph
- Conditions are only marginally conducive for development during the next few days
- Formation chance – 48 hour: Low (10%); 5-day: Low (20%)

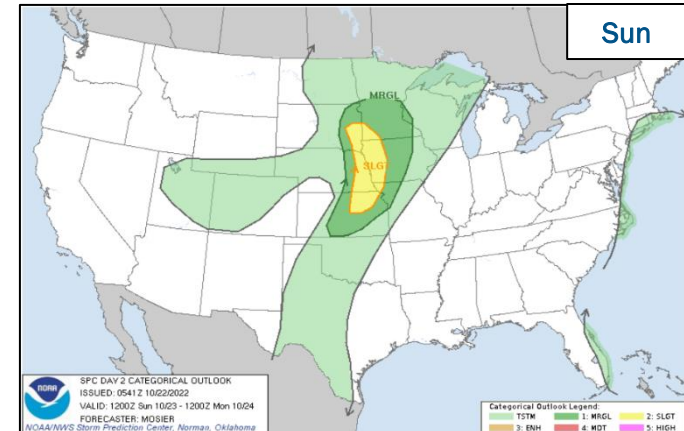
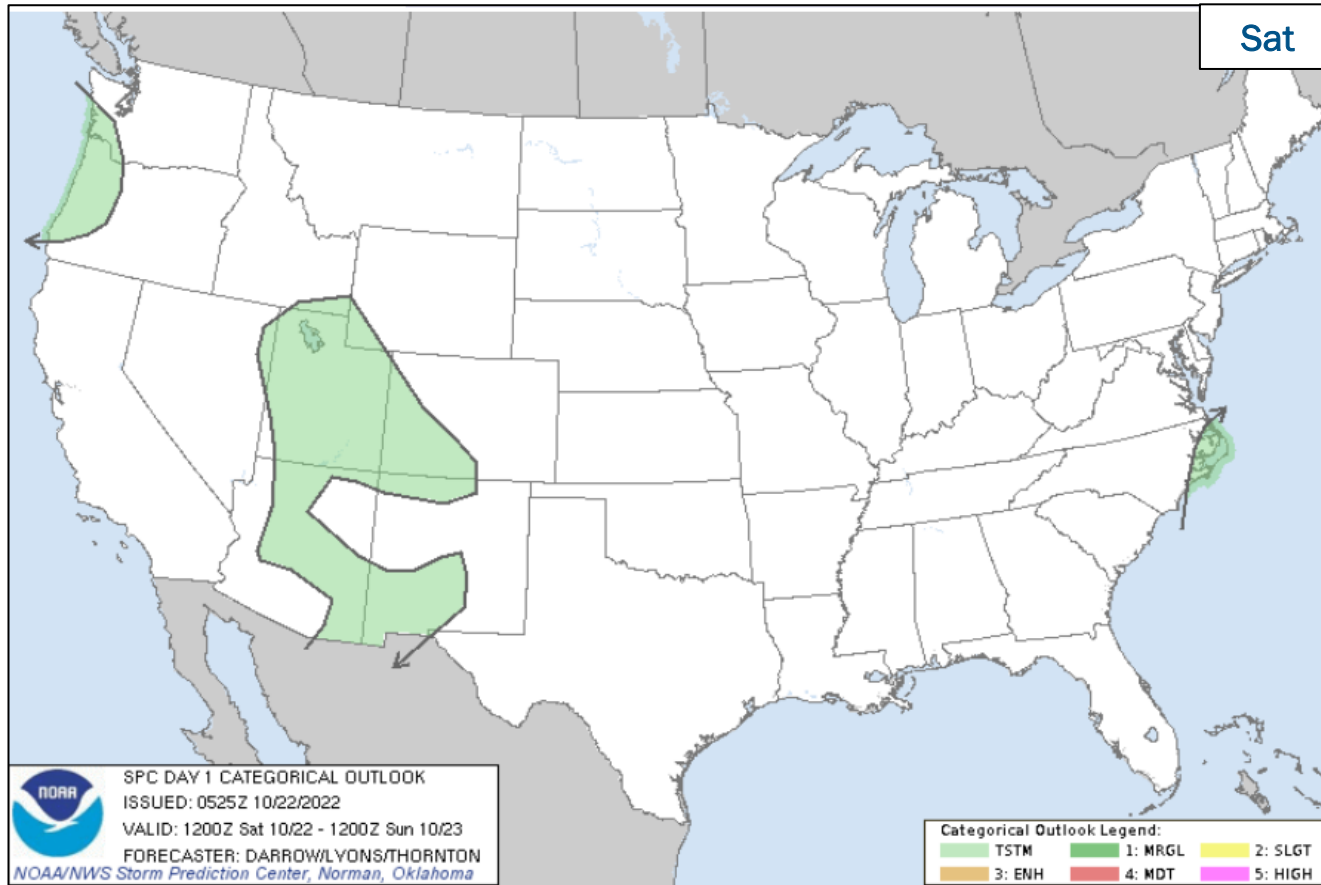
Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall

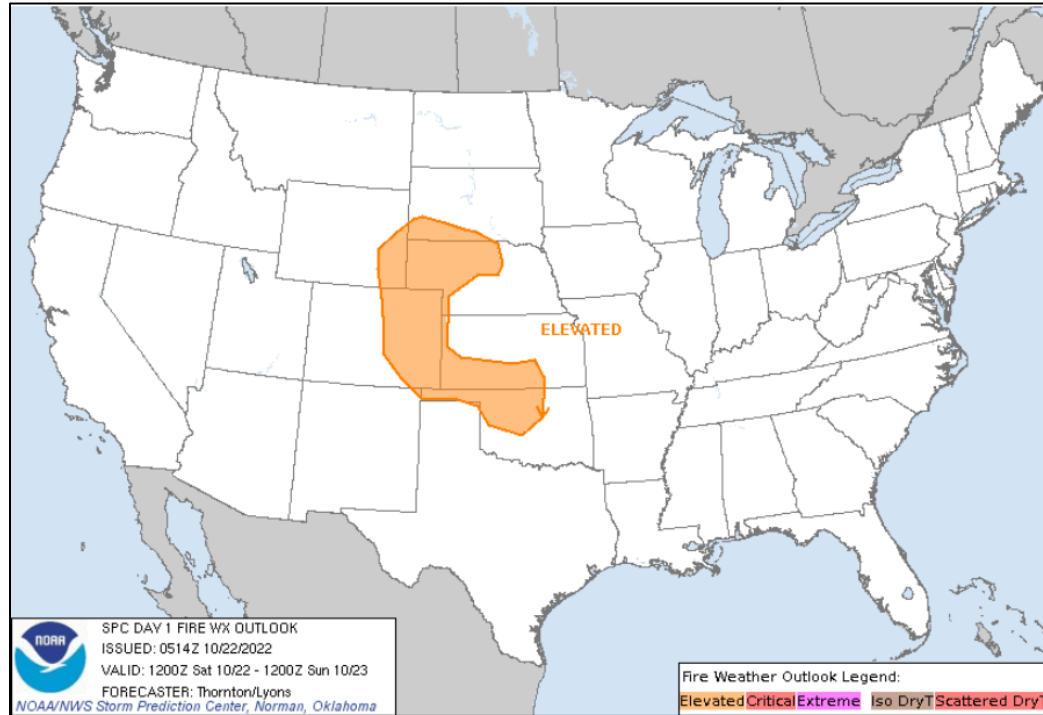
Severe Weather Outlook



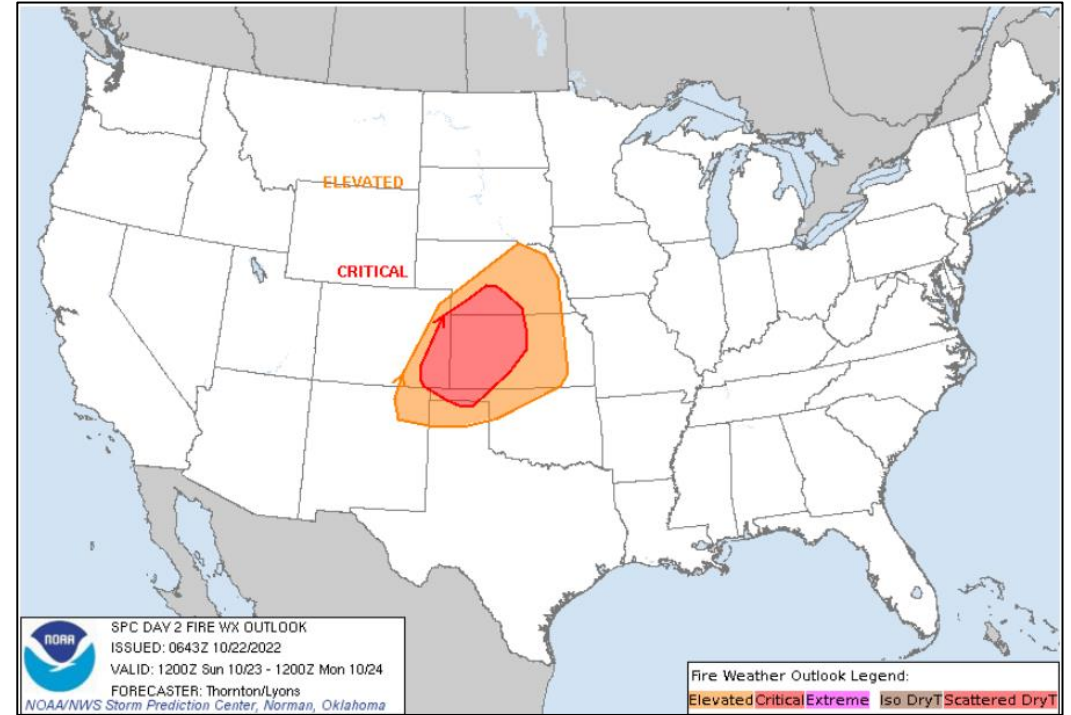
