


Tropical Outlook - Five Day

No tropical cyclones expected during the next 5 days


Eastern Pacific



Hurricane Roslyn (CAT 3) (Advisory #14A as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located 55 miles NW of Tepic, Mexico
- Moving NNE at 16 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 120 mph
- Made landfall at 7:20 a.m. ET near Santa Cruz, Mexico
- Rapid weakening expected as it moves inland
- Hurricane-force winds extend 25 miles; tropicalstorm-force winds extend outward up to 80 miles

Atlantic




Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located well to the E of Bermuda
- Moving WNW at 15-20 mph
- Conditions are only marginally conducive for development during the next few days
- Formation chance 48 hour: Low (10%); 5-day: Low (20%)




National Weather Forecast






Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall







Severe Weather Outlook





Fire Weather Outlook






Forecast Snowfall






Long Range Outlooks - Oct 28-Nov 1



6-10 Day Temperature Probability




6-10 Day Precipitation Probability




