## Hazard Monitoring

- Critical fire weather – Central Plains
- Heavy snow – Rockies and Northern Plains
- Severe thunderstorms – Central Plains to Upper Mississippi Valley
- Tropical Activity:
  - Atlantic: Disturbance 1: Low (20%)
  - Eastern Pacific: Hurricane Roslyn (CAT 3)

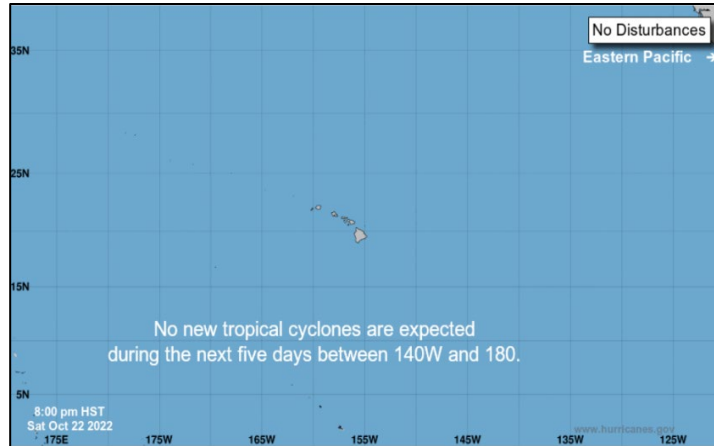

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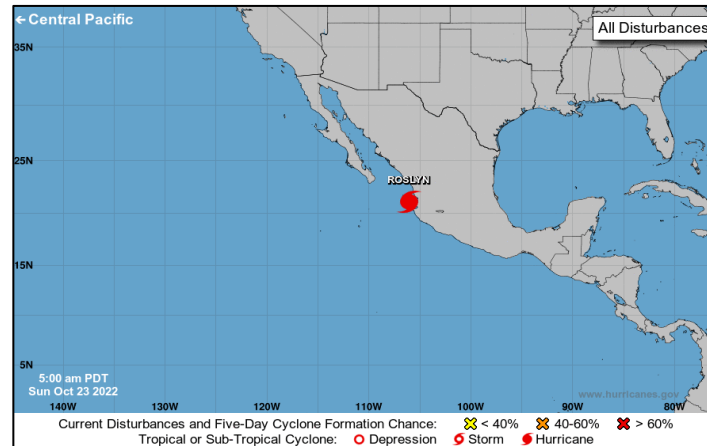

- No tropical cyclones expected during the next 5 days

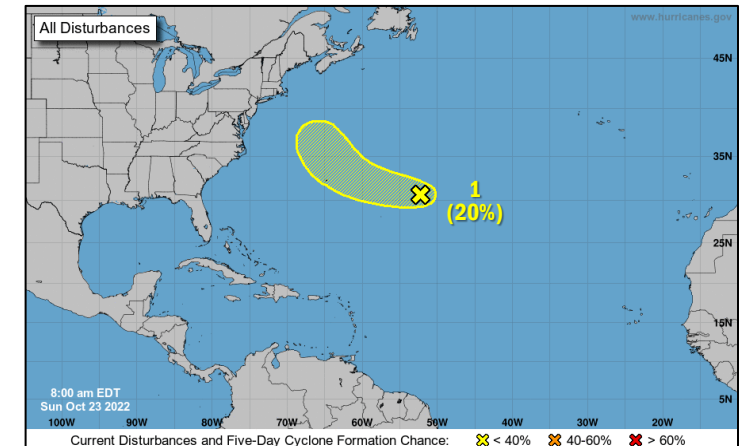
## Eastern Pacific



### Hurricane Roslyn (CAT 3) (Advisory #14A as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located **55 miles NW** of Tepic, Mexico
- Moving NNE at 16 mph
- Maximum sustained winds **120 mph**
- Made landfall at 7:20 a.m. ET near Santa Cruz, Mexico
- Rapid weakening expected as it moves inland
- Hurricane-force winds extend 25 miles; tropical-storm-force winds extend outward up to 80 miles

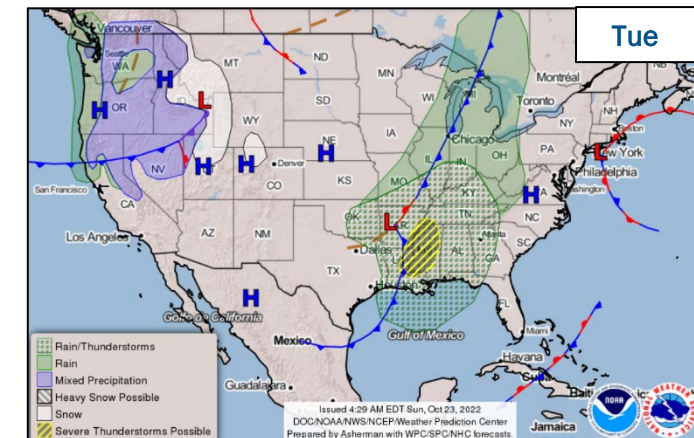
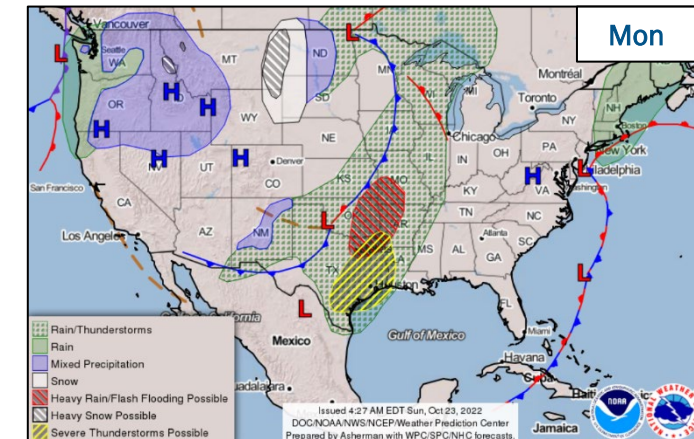
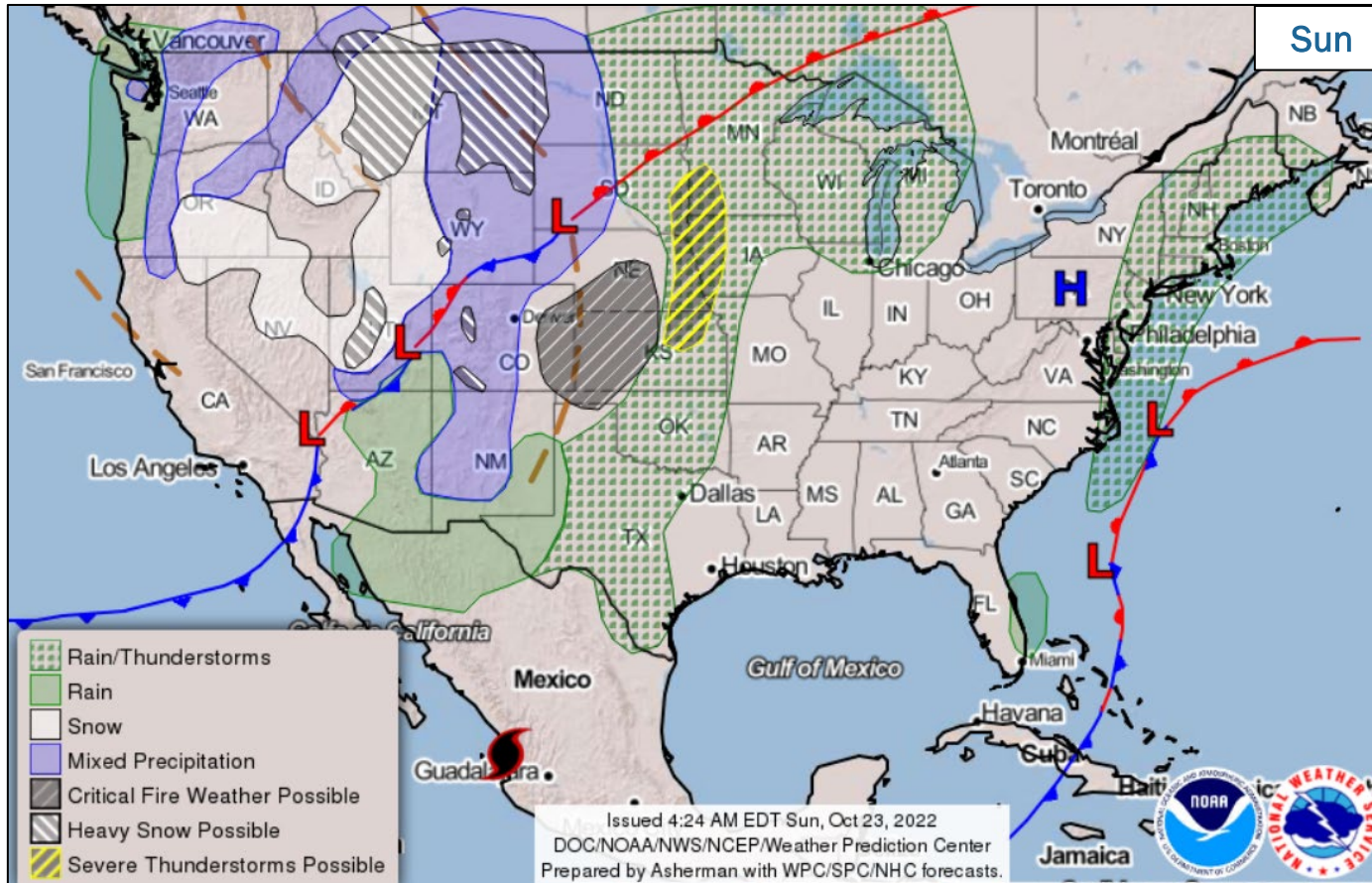
### Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located **well to the E** of Bermuda
- Moving WNW at 15-20 mph
- Conditions are only marginally conducive for development during the next few days
- Formation chance – 48 hour: Low (10%); 5-day: Low (20%)

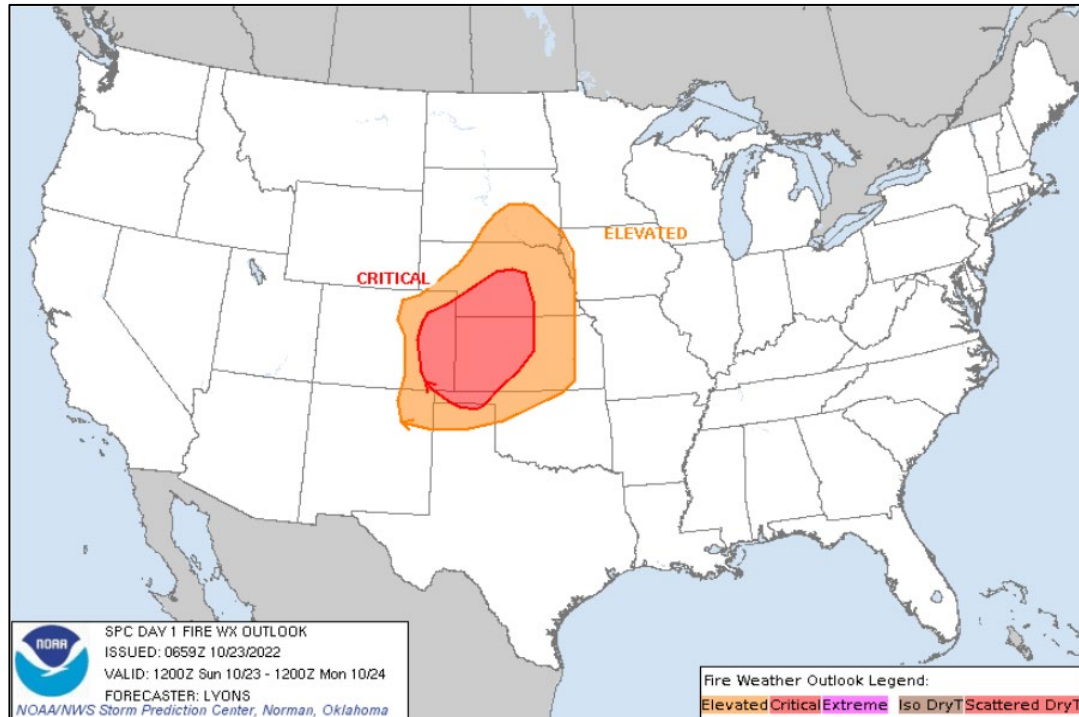

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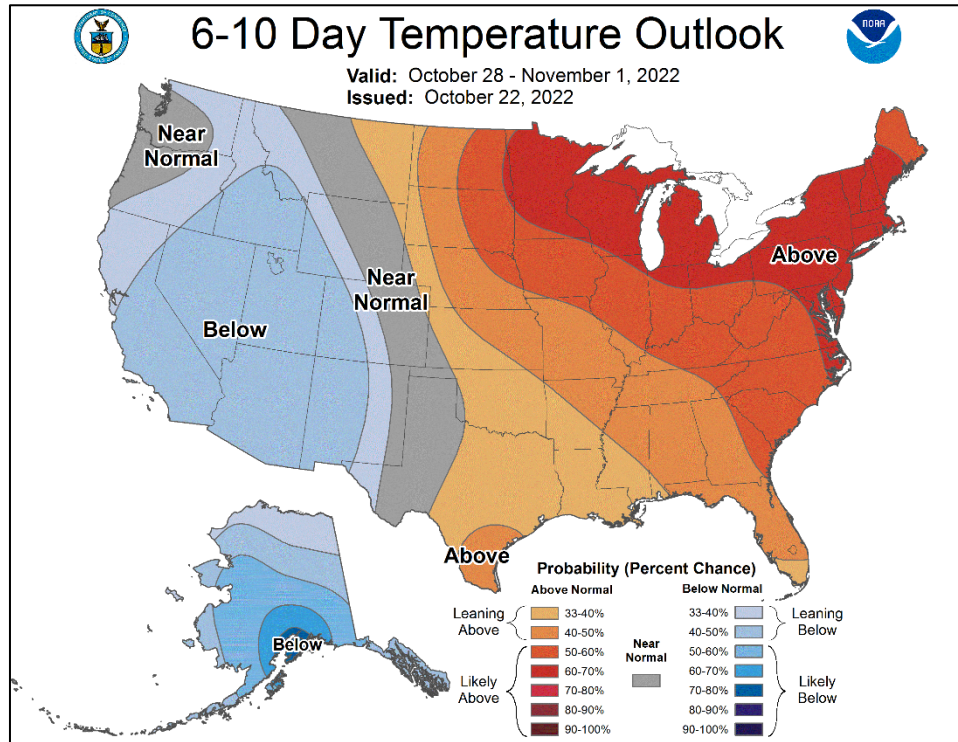

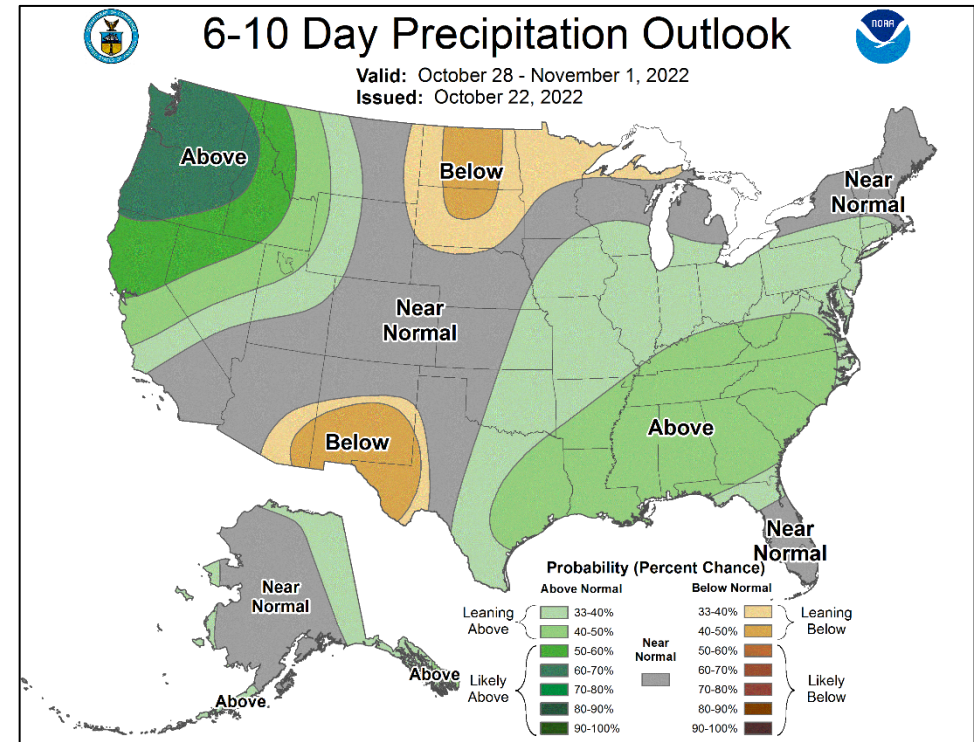
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# Long Range Outlooks – Oct 28–Nov 1

6-10 Day Precipitation Probability

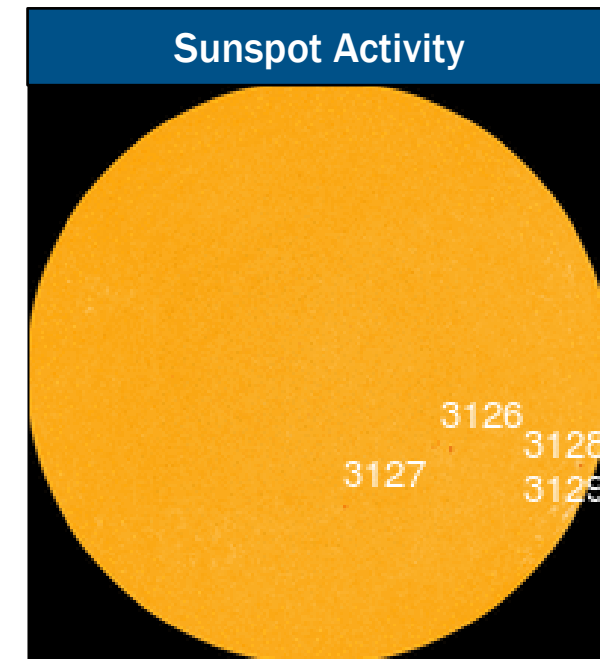
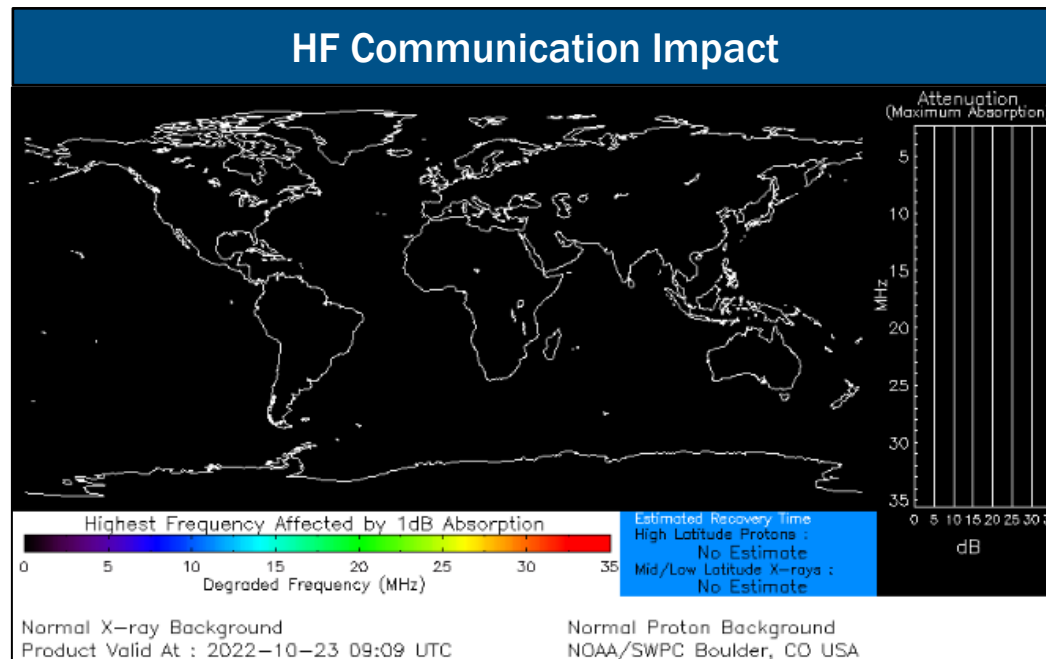
