



**Disturbance 1 (98W):** (as of 2:00 a.m. ET)

- Located 424 miles SE of Guam
- Moving NW
- Maximum sustained winds of 20-28 mph
- Forecast to develop into a tropical cyclone within 24 hours



 No tropical cyclones are expected in the next seven days



Hurricane Kristy (CAT-4): (Advisory #11, as of 5:00 a.m. ET)

- Located 845 miles SW of the southern tip of Baja California
- Moving W at 17 mph
- Maximum sustained winds of 150 mph
- Hurricane force winds extend outward 25 miles; Tropical-storm force winds extend outward 105 miles
- Rapid weakening expected by Friday



 No tropical cyclones are expected in the next seven days
