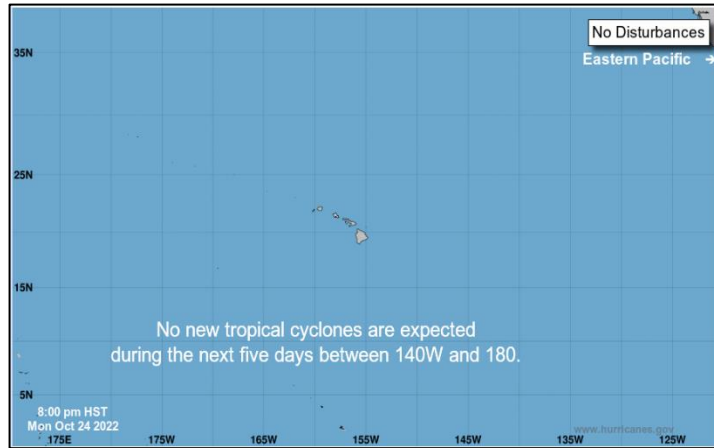

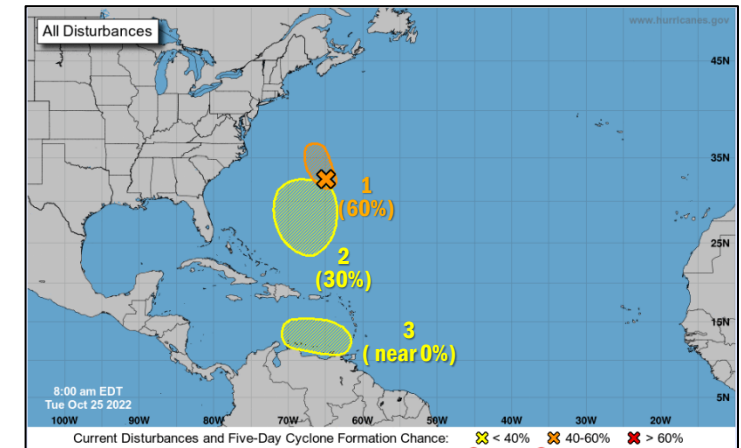

- Expected to form N of Puerto Rico
- Some subtropical development possible
- Formation chance – 48 hour: Low (near 0%); 5-day: Low (30%)

### Disturbance 3 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

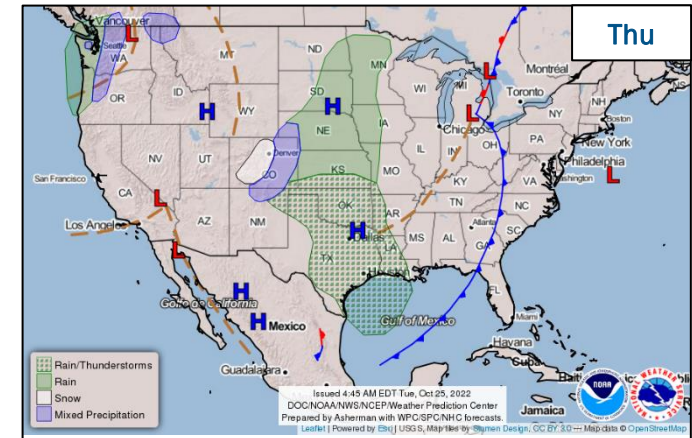
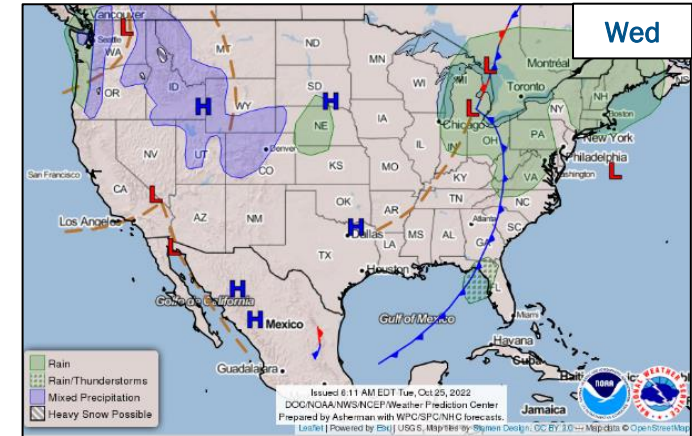
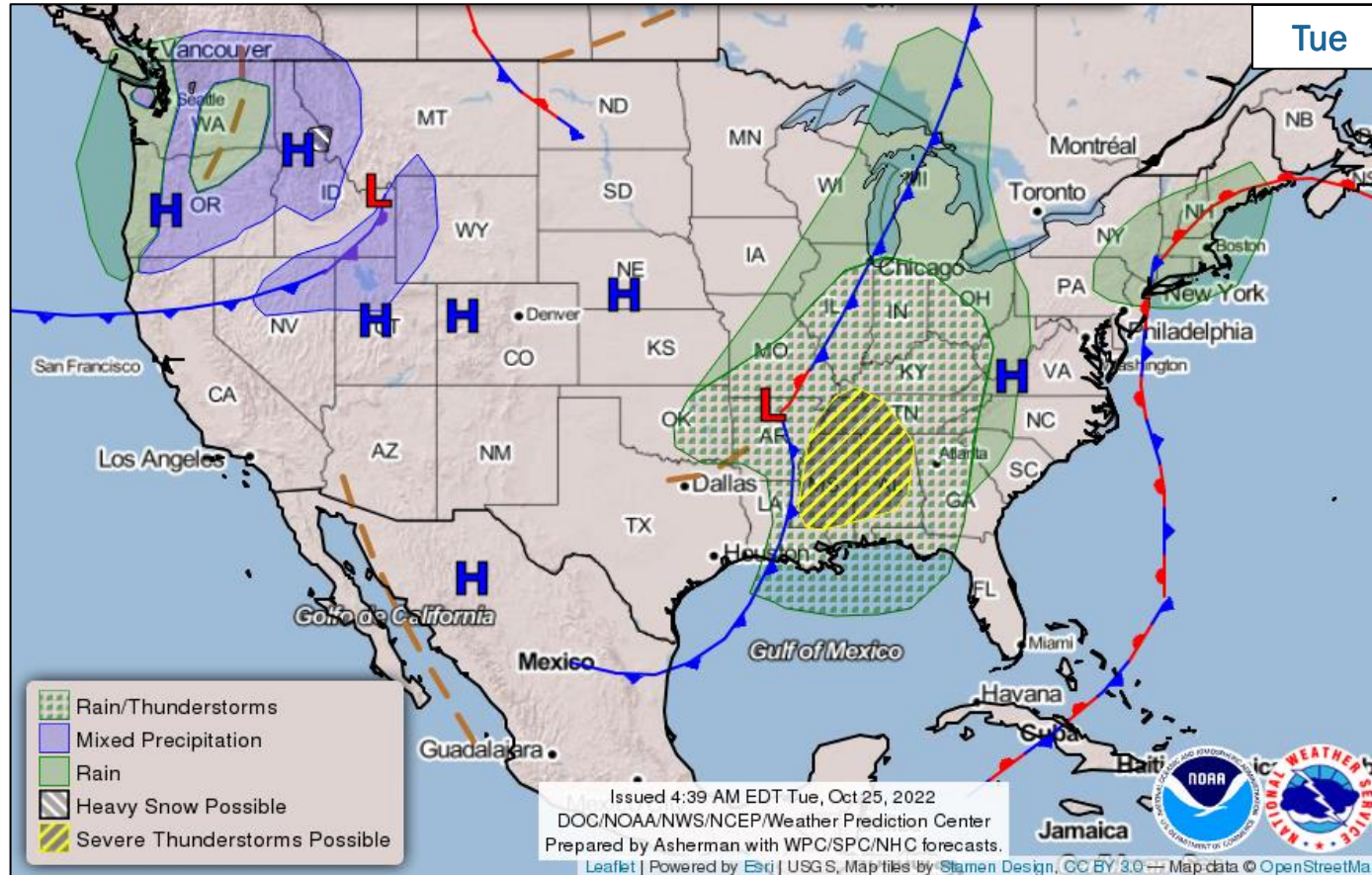
- Expected to form eastern Caribbean Sea

- Formation chance – 48 hour: Low (near 0%); 5-day: Low (20%)

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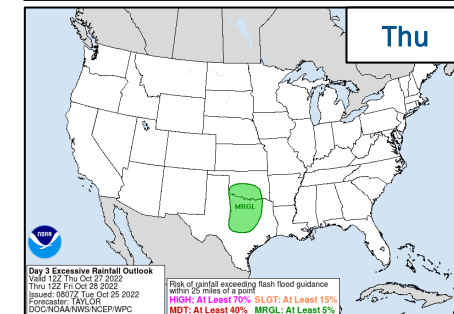
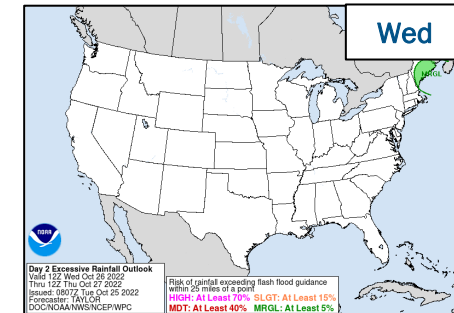
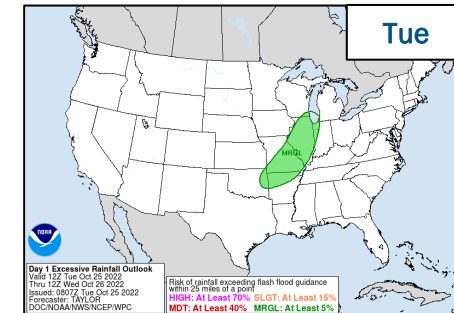
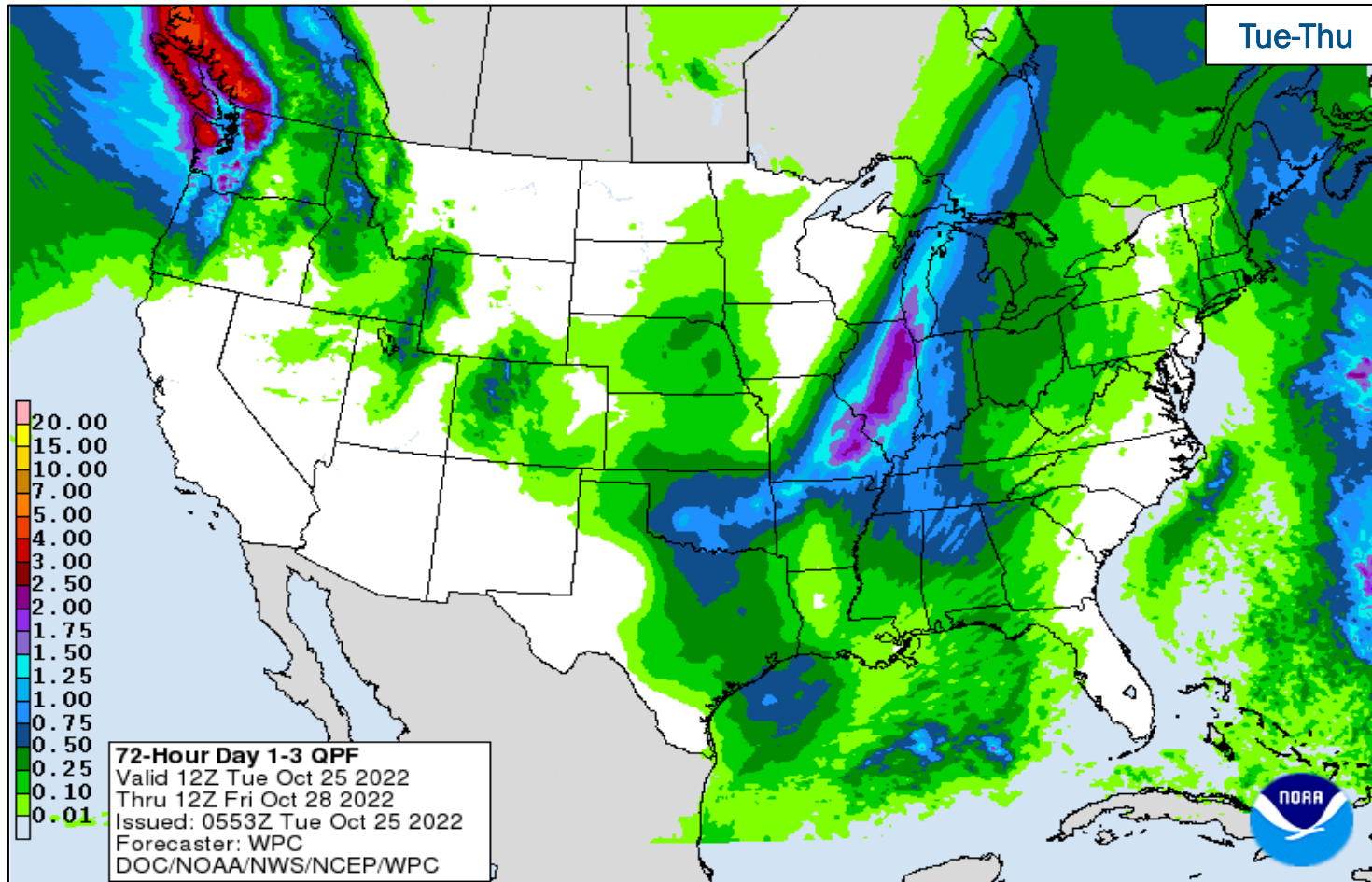

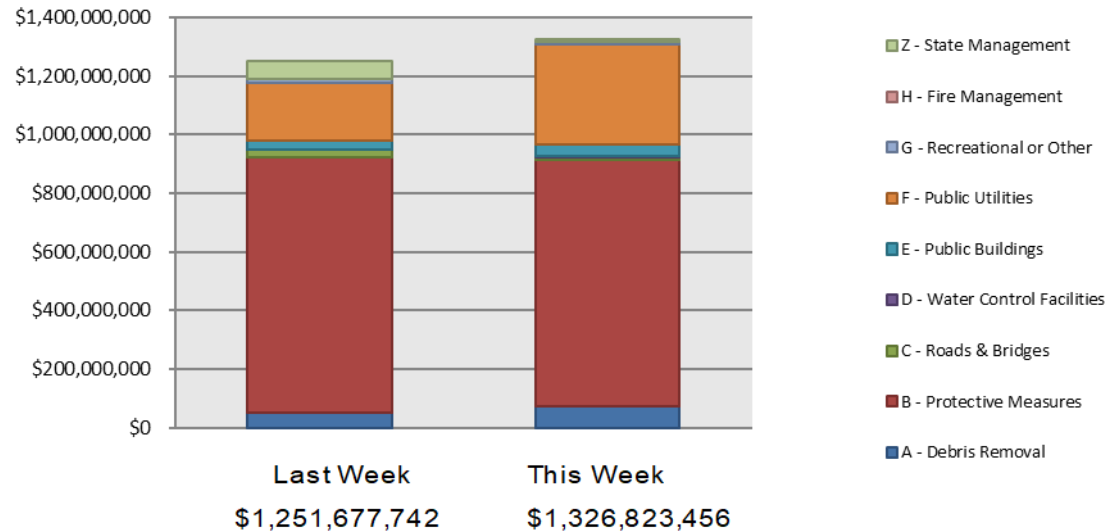

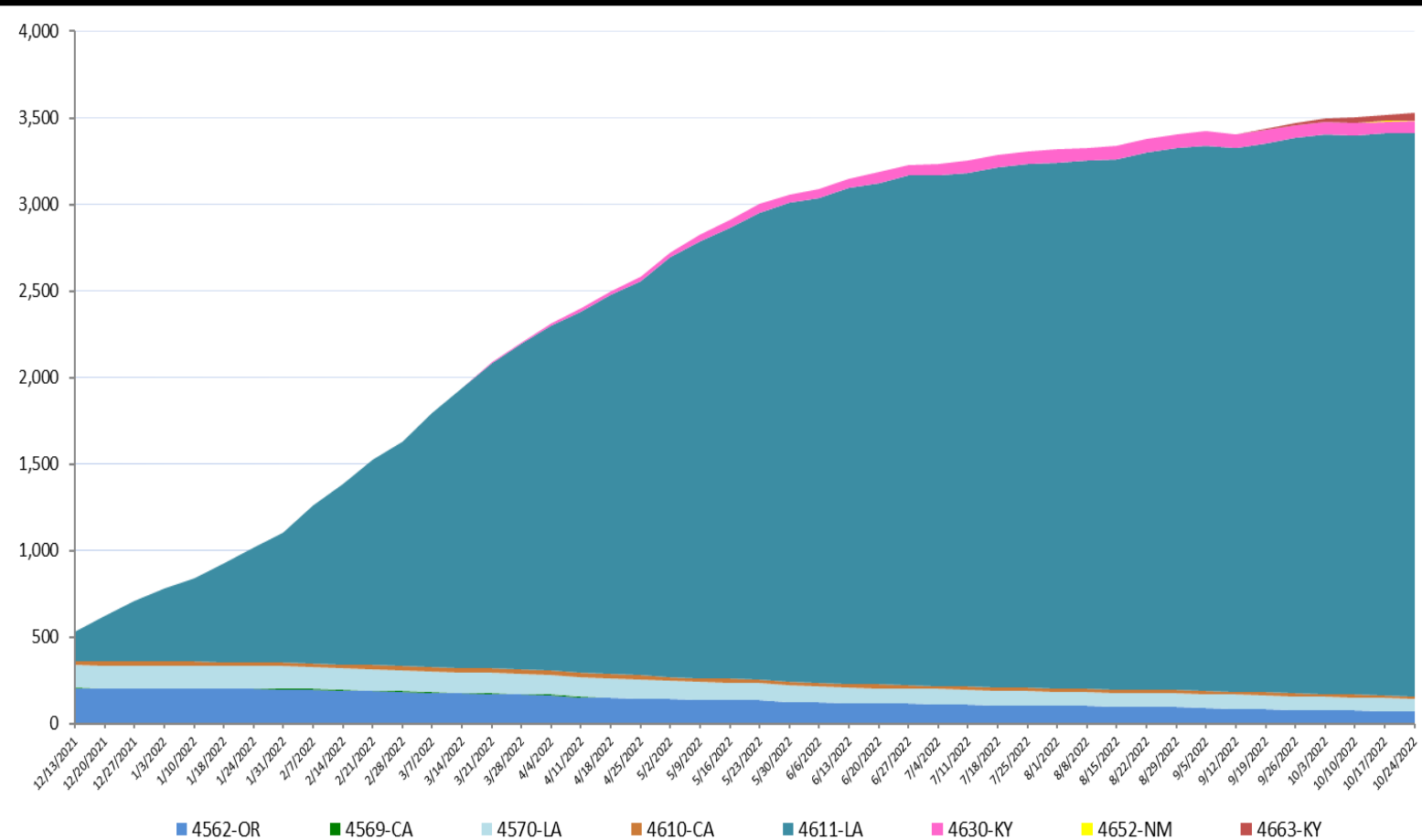

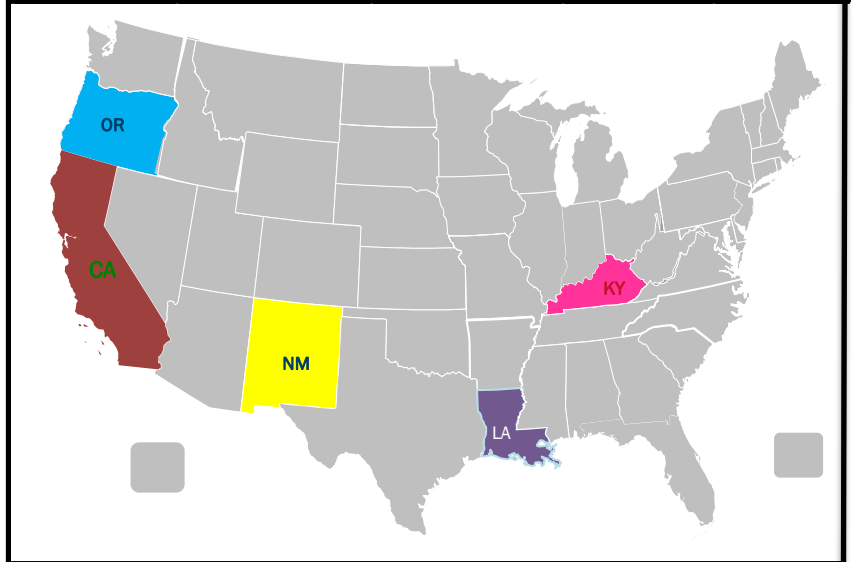
# Direct Housing

Past Year per Week, 12/13/2021 - 10/24/2022. There are currently **4,370** Households Occupying **4,394** Temporary Units.



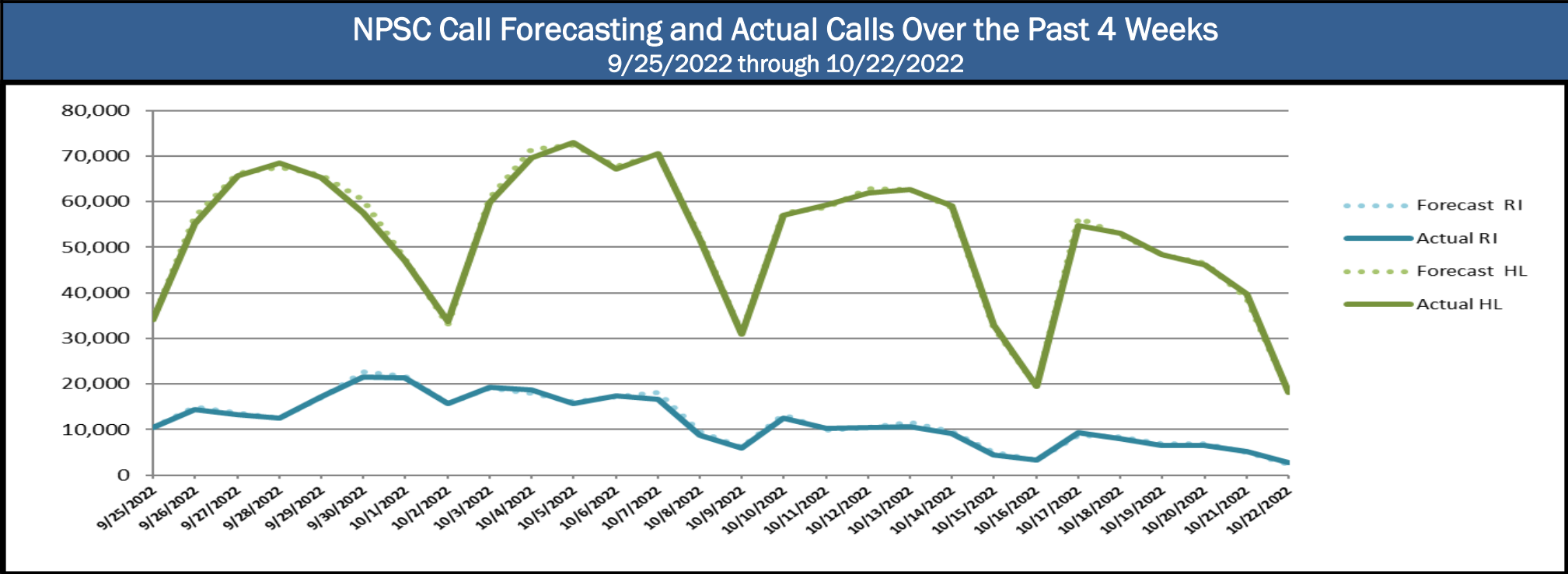

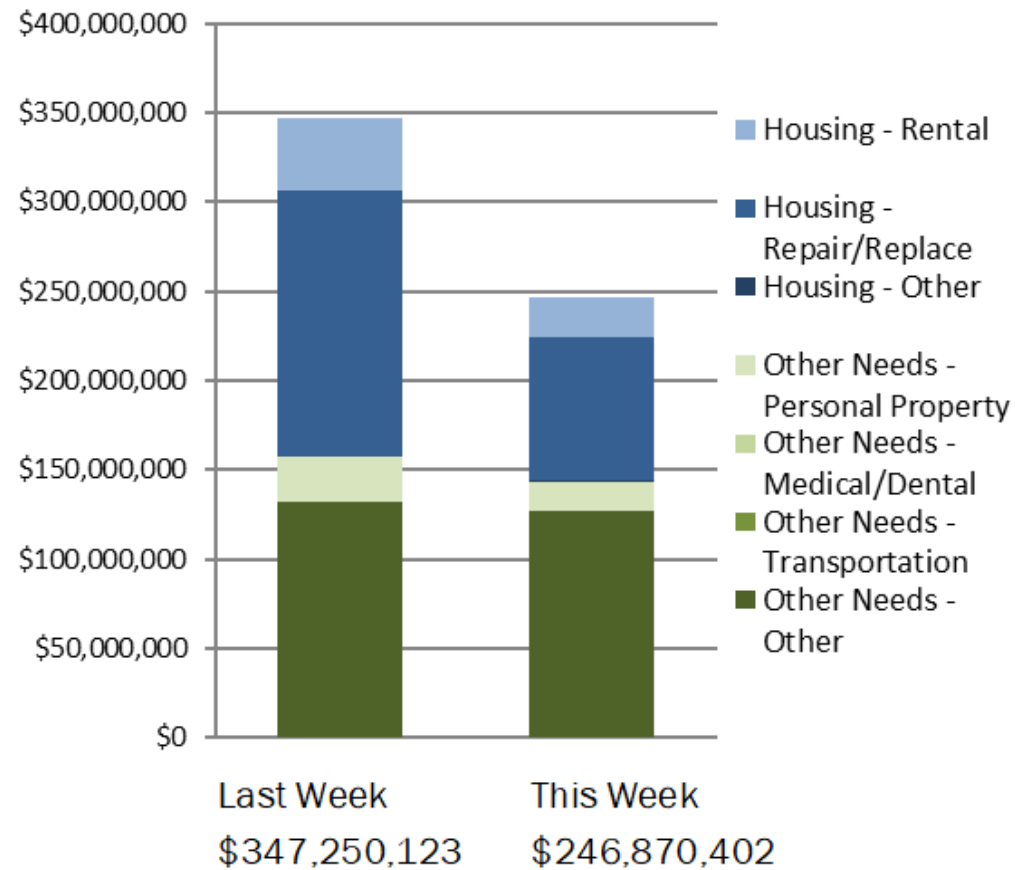
