



Hurricane Otis (CAT-2) (Advisory #13A, as of 5:00 a.m. ET)

- Located 60 miles NNW of Acapulco, Mexico
- Maximum sustained winds 110 mph
- Moving NNW at 10 mph
- Hurricane-force winds extend outward 30 miles; tropicalstorm-force winds extend outward 70 miles
- Otis will likely dissipate over Mexico tonight


Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located several hundred miles S of Mexico
- Development possible; tropical depression likely to form by the weekend
- Formation chance 48-hour: Low (20%); 7-day: High (70%)

Disturbance 2 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located 1,300 miles SW of the southern tip of Baja California, Mexico
- Slow development possible during the next several days
- Formation chance 48-hour: Low (near 0%); 7-day: Low (20%)



Hurricane Tammy (CAT-2) (Advisory #28, as of 5:00 a.m. ET)


- Located 540 miles SSE of Bermuda
- Maximum sustained winds 100 mph
- Moving NE at 10 mph
- Hurricane-force winds extend outward 25 miles; tropicalstorm-force winds extend outward 175 miles
- Slight strengthening possible today, followed by weakening late this week; forecast to become a post-tropical cyclone Thursday

National Weather Forecast






Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall





Forecast Snowfall







