

Tropical Outlook - Five Day



Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)


- Trough of low pressure stretching from the central Caribbean northward to the southwestern Atlantic
- Conditions appear conducive for some gradual subtropical development of this system over the next few days
- Formation 48-hour: Low (20%); 5-day: Low (30%)

Disturbance 2 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Could form over the eastern Caribbean Sea by early this weekend
- Conditions are forecast to be conducive for gradual development while moving WNW by the end of the weekend
- Formation chance 48 hour: Low (near 0%); 5-day: Low (30%)




National Weather Forecast







Hazards Outlook - Oct 28-Nov 1






