


Tropical Outlook – Seven Day

Eastern Pacific





Disturbance 1 (Formerly TC Tammy): (As of 8:00 a.m. ET)


- Located a few hundred miles E of Bermuda

- Formation chance 48-hour: Low (Near 0%); 7-day: Low (30%)




National Weather Forecast






Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall






Snowfall Forecast




