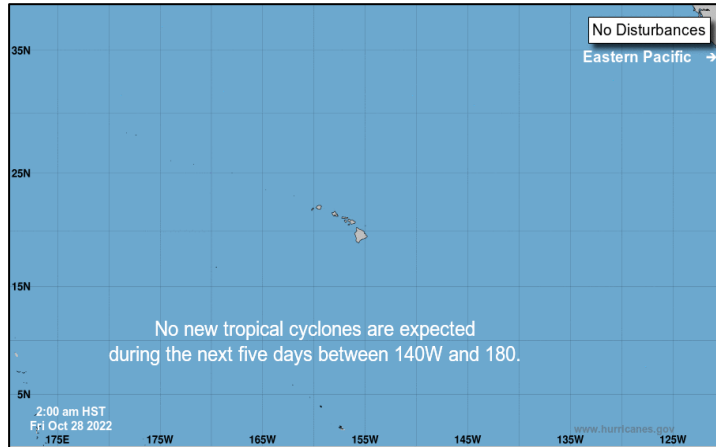

Central Pacific



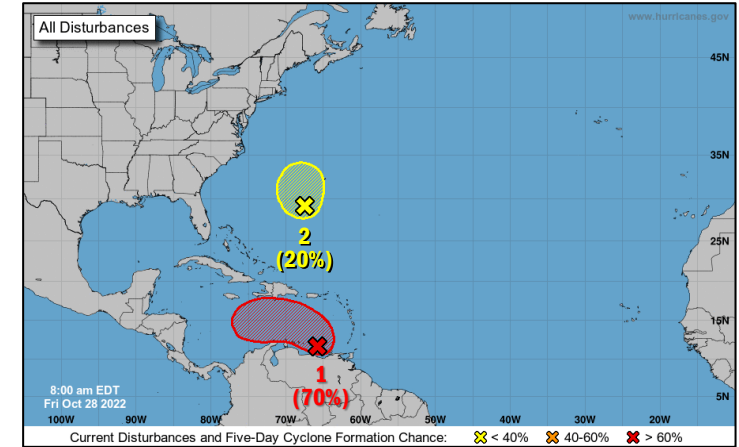

- Formation chance – 48-hour: Low (20%); 5-day: High (70%)

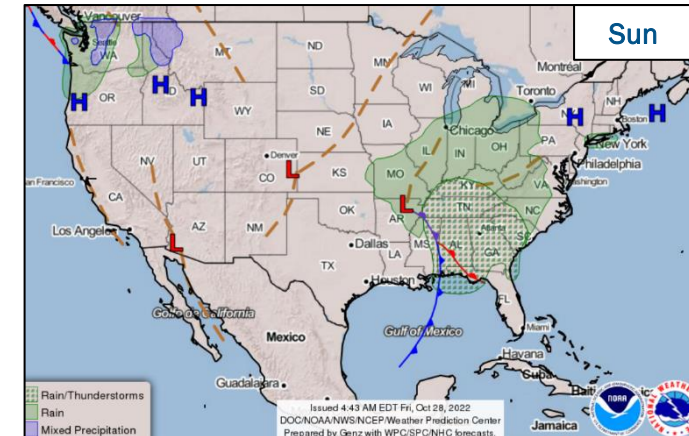
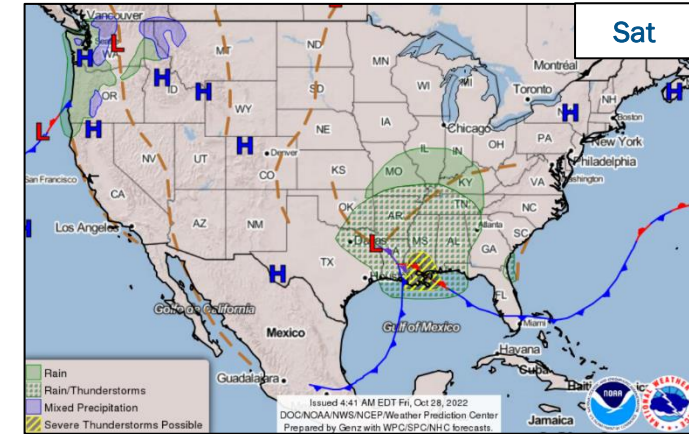
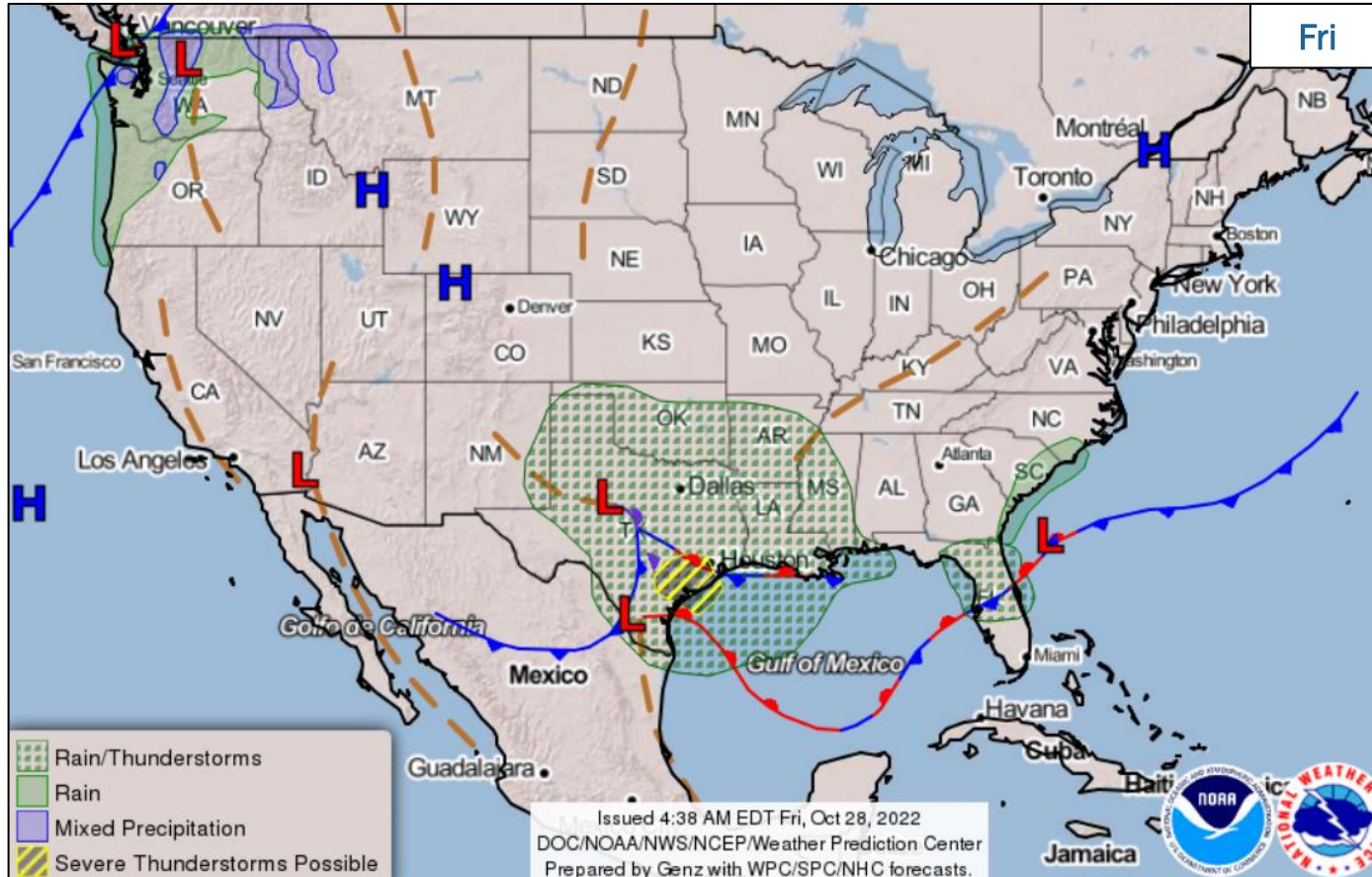
Disturbance 2 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Formation chance – 48-hour: Low (20%); 5-day: Low (20%)



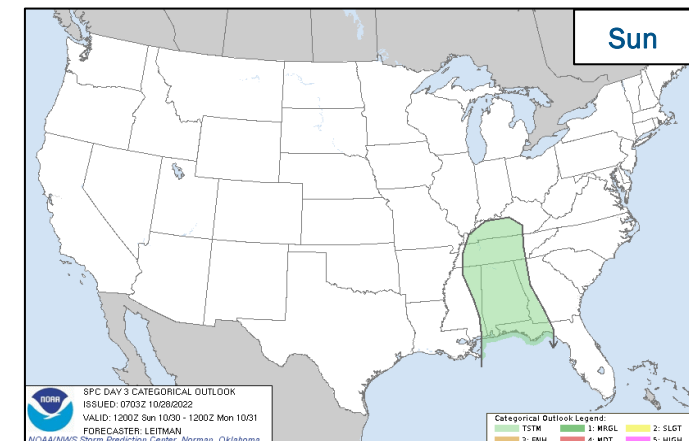
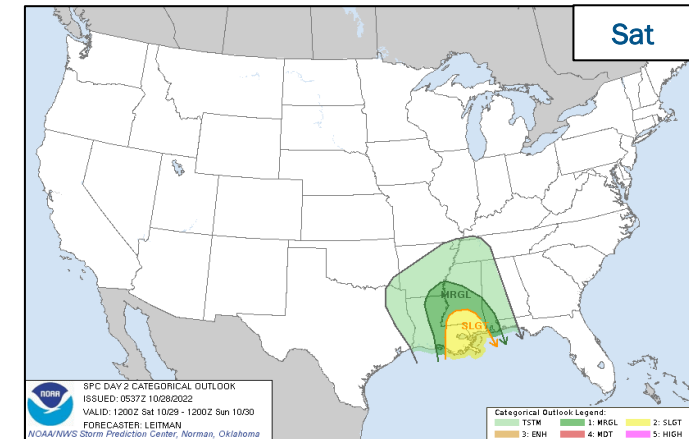
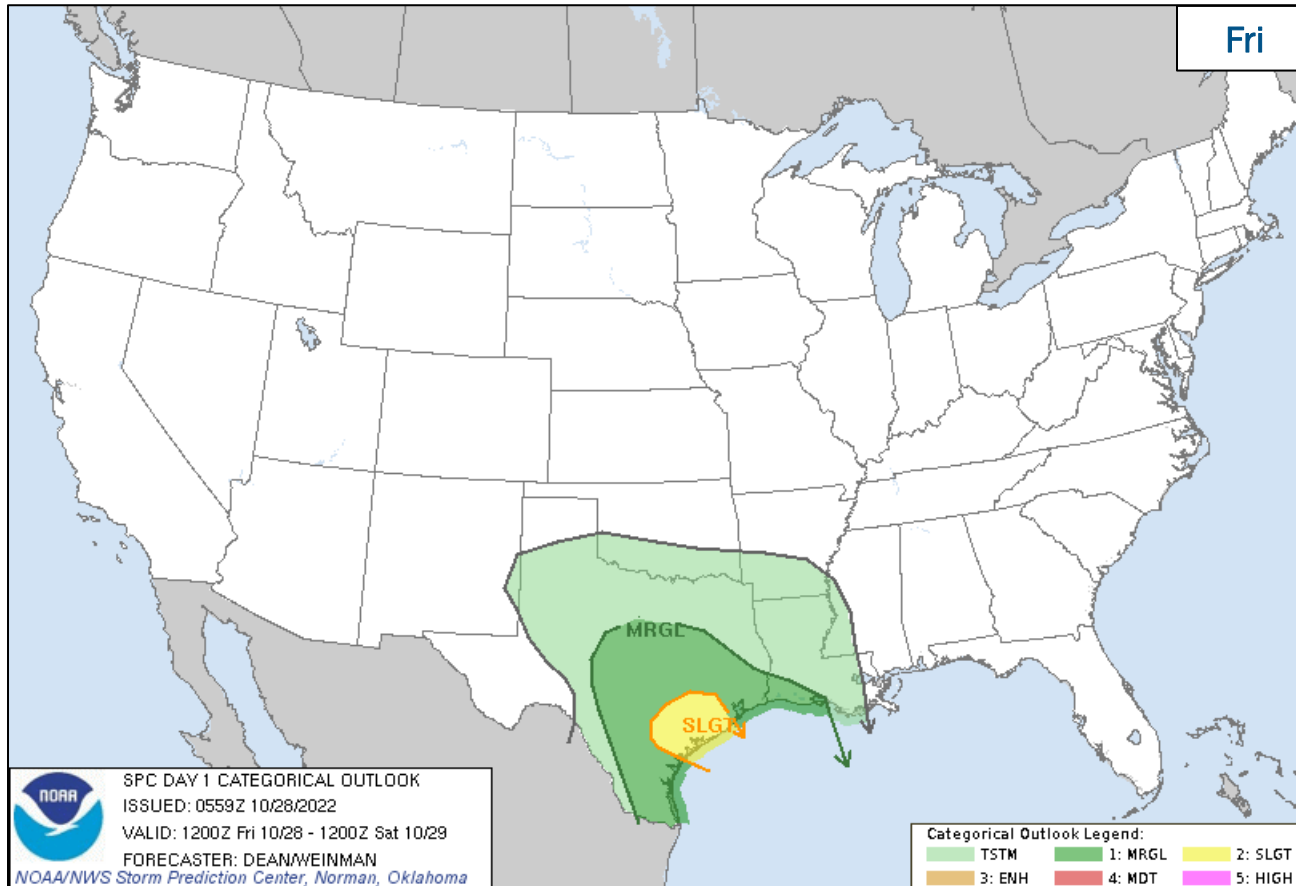
