



Disturbance 1: (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located over 1,000 miles SW of the southern tip of Baja California, Mexico
- A tropical depression is likely to form within the next few days
- Formation chance: 48-hour Low (20%);7-day Med (60%)

Disturbance 2: (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)


- Located several hundred miles SSW of the southern tip of Baja California, Mexico
- Some slow development is possible
- Formation chance: 48-hour Low (10%);7-day Low (20%)

Disturbance 1: (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located over the SW Caribbean Sea
- A tropical depression could form late this week or over the weekend
- Formation chance: 48-hour Low (near 0%); 7-day Medium (40%)





National Weather Forecast





Fire Weather Outlook








