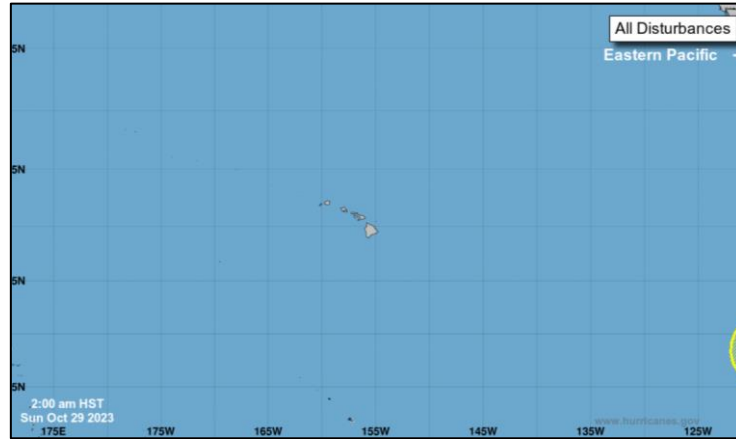

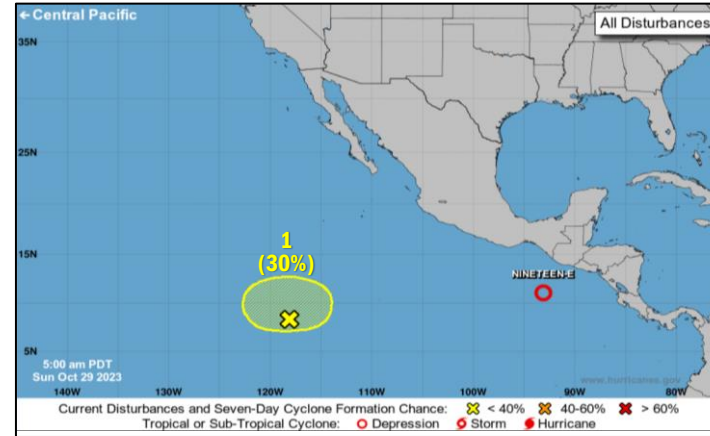
Tropical Outlook – Seven Day

Eastern Pacific



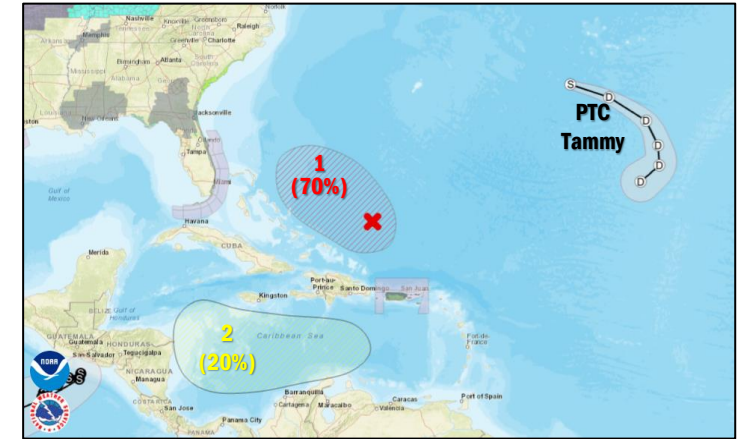
Tropical Depression Nineteen-E: (Advisory #3, as of 5:00 a.m. ET)

- Located 320 miles SW of San Salvador, El Salvador
- Forecast to begin moving NE by tonight
- Maximum sustained winds are near 35 mph

Disturbance 1: (As of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located more than 1,000 miles SSW of the southern tip of the Baja California peninsula
- Environmental conditions marginally conducive for slow development through the middle of the week
- Formation chance – 48-hour: Low (near 10%); 7-day: Low (30%)

Atlantic



Post-Tropical Cyclone Tammy: (Advisory #40, as of 5:00 a.m. ET)

- Located 670 miles E of Bermuda
- A turn to the south is expected tonight
- This is the last public advisory by the National Hurricane Center

Disturbance 1: (As of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located a couple hundred miles E of southeastern Bahamas
- Short-lived TD or TS likely to form later today or tonight
- Formation chance – 48-hour: High (70%); 7-day: High (70%)

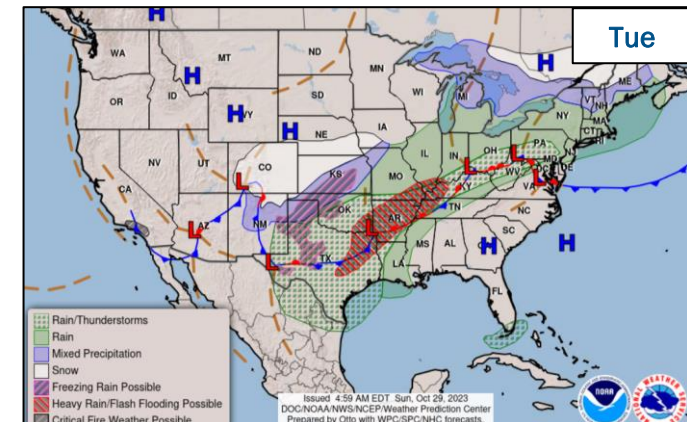
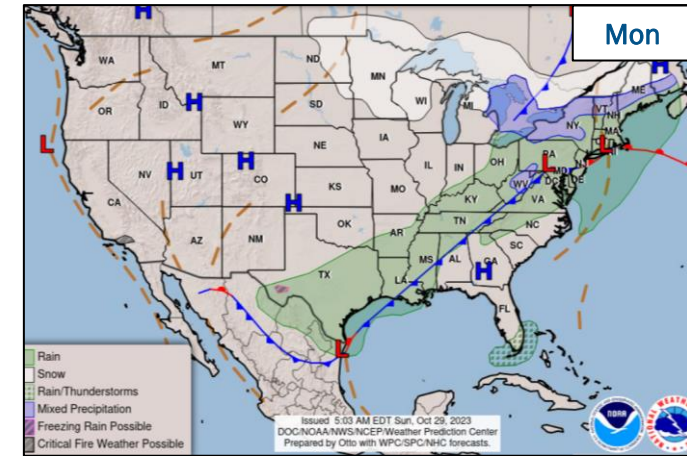
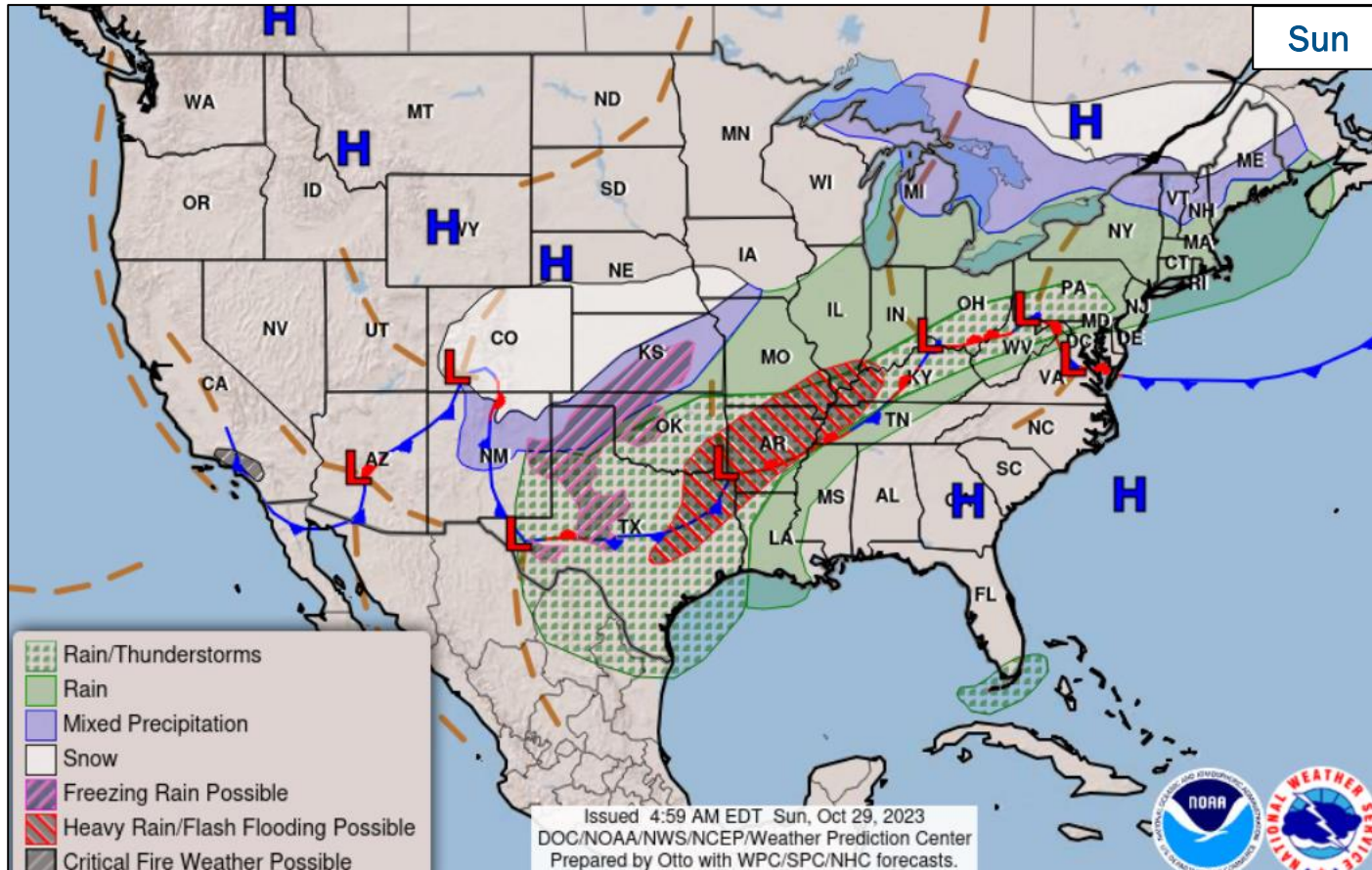
Disturbance 2: (As of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located in SW Caribbean Sea
- Gradual development possible while moving W at 10 – 15 mph
- Formation chance – 48-hour: Low (0%); 7-day: Low (20%)

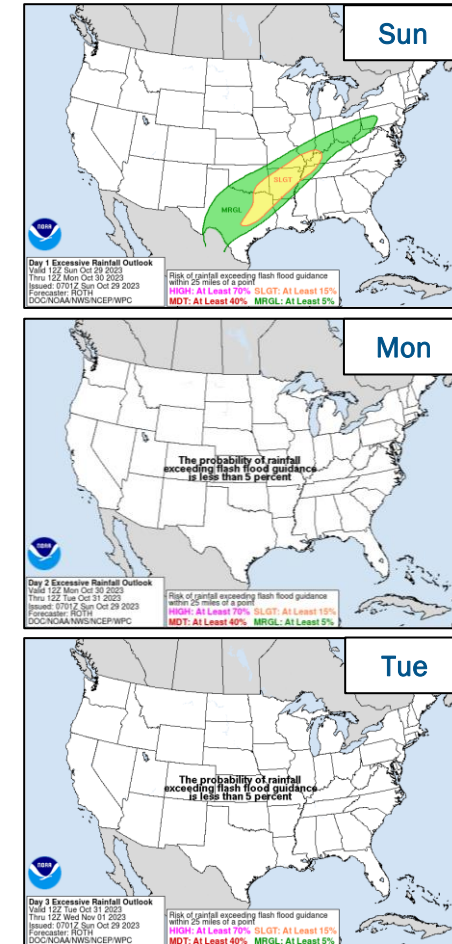
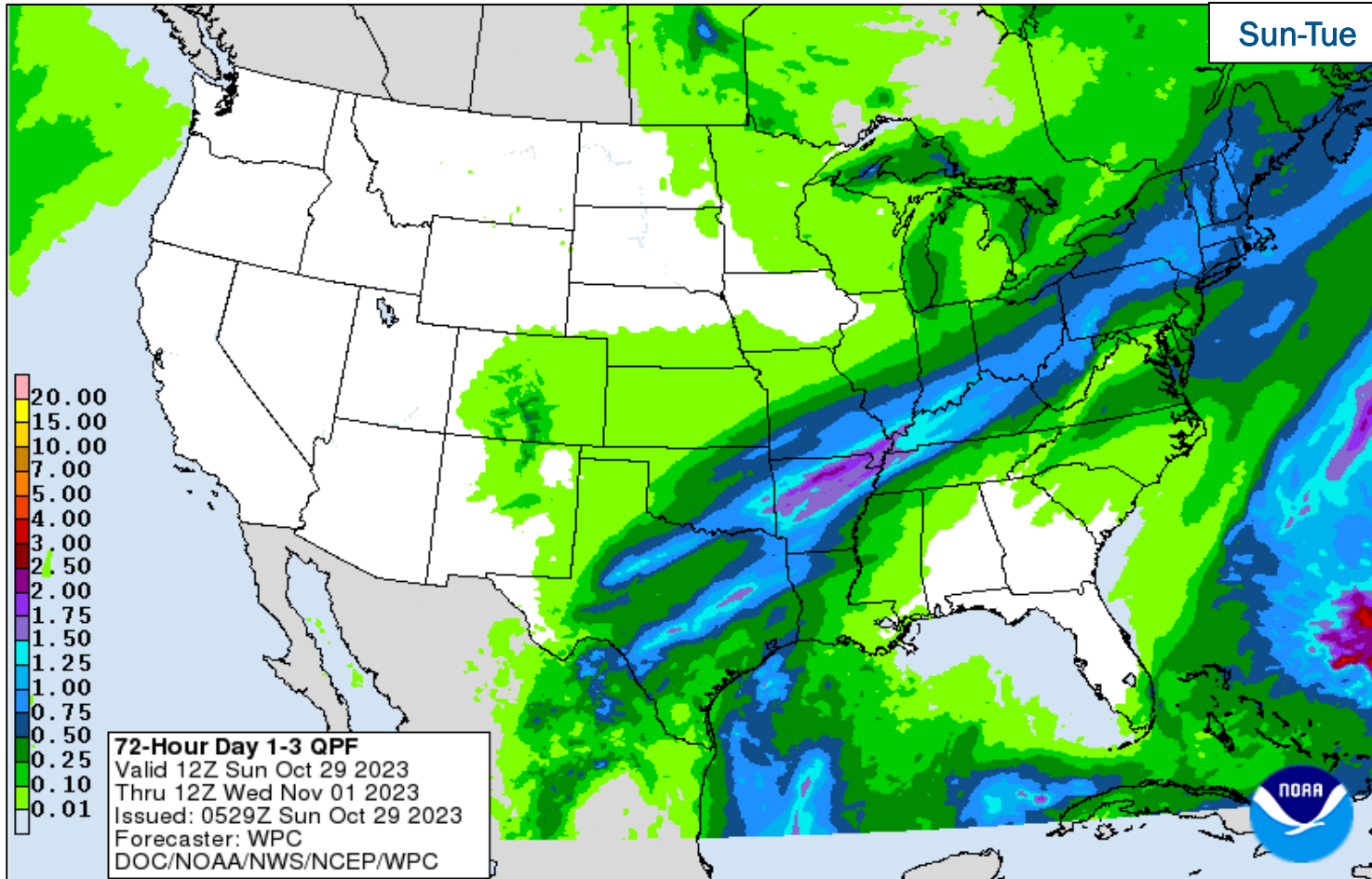

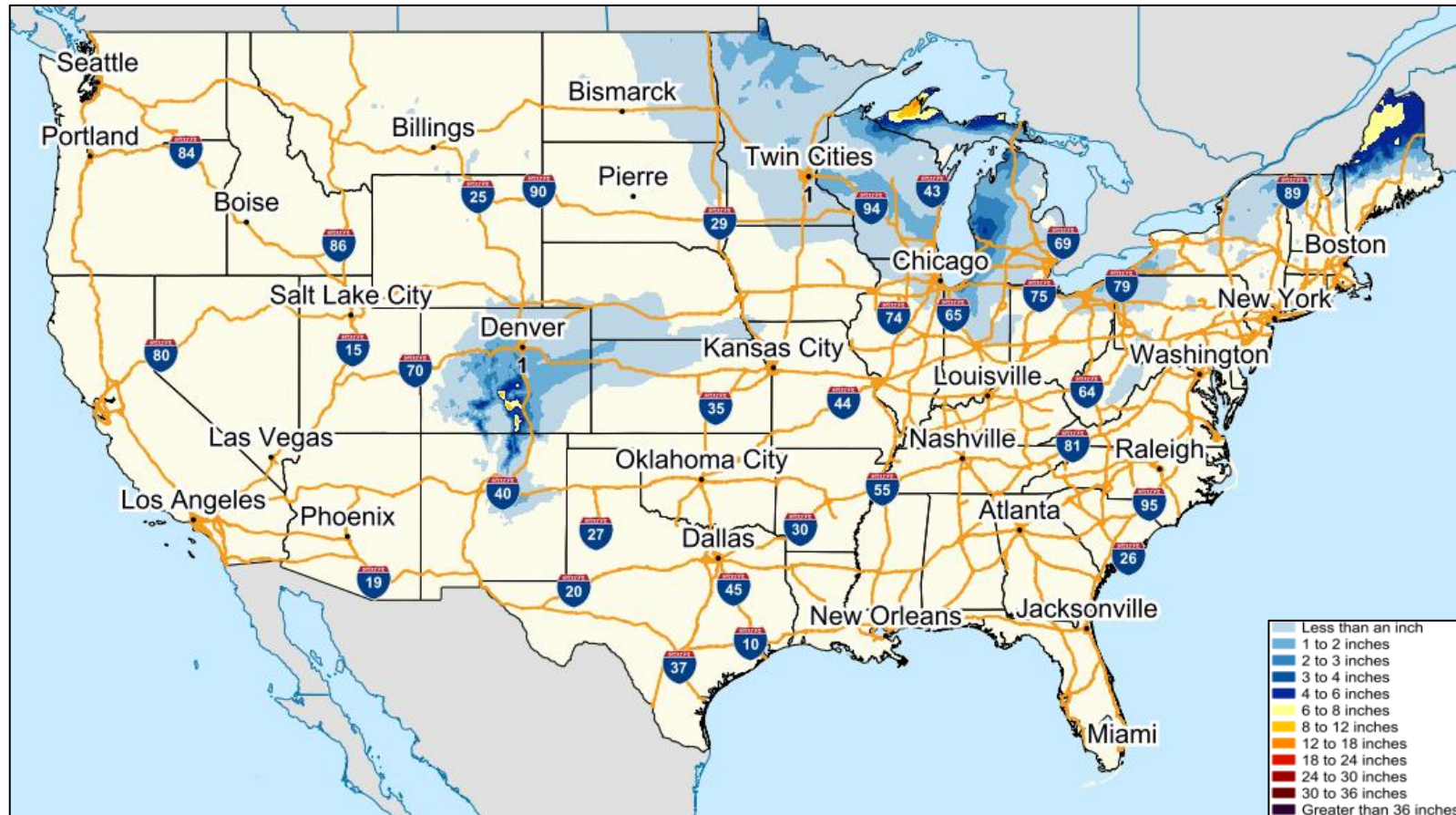

Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall



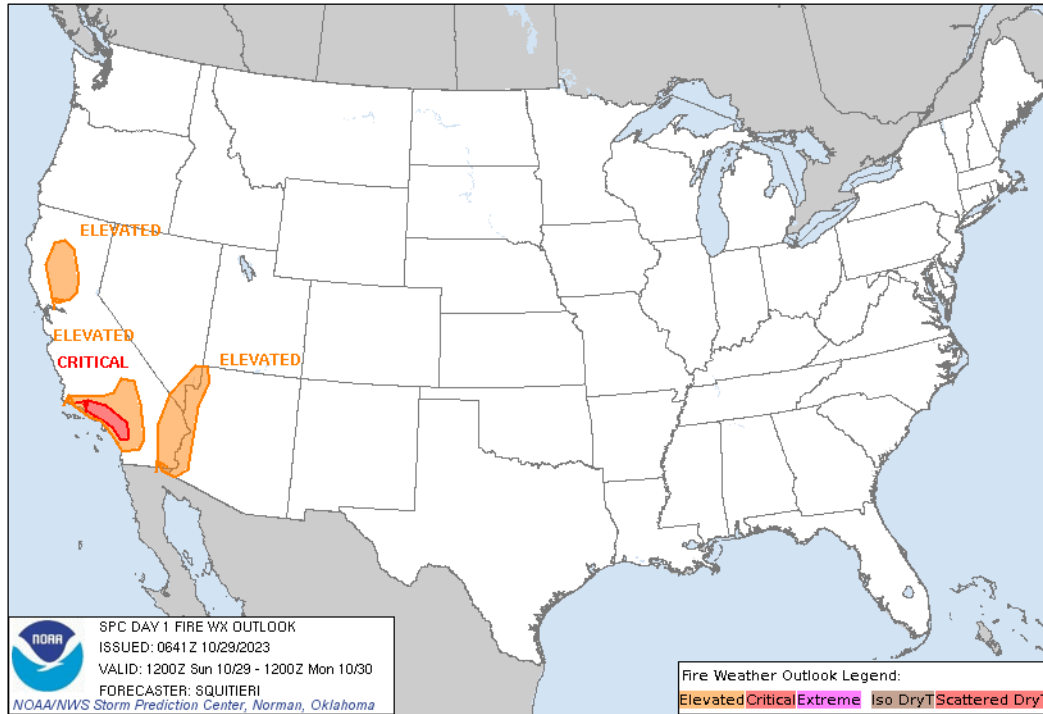

Snowfall Forecast

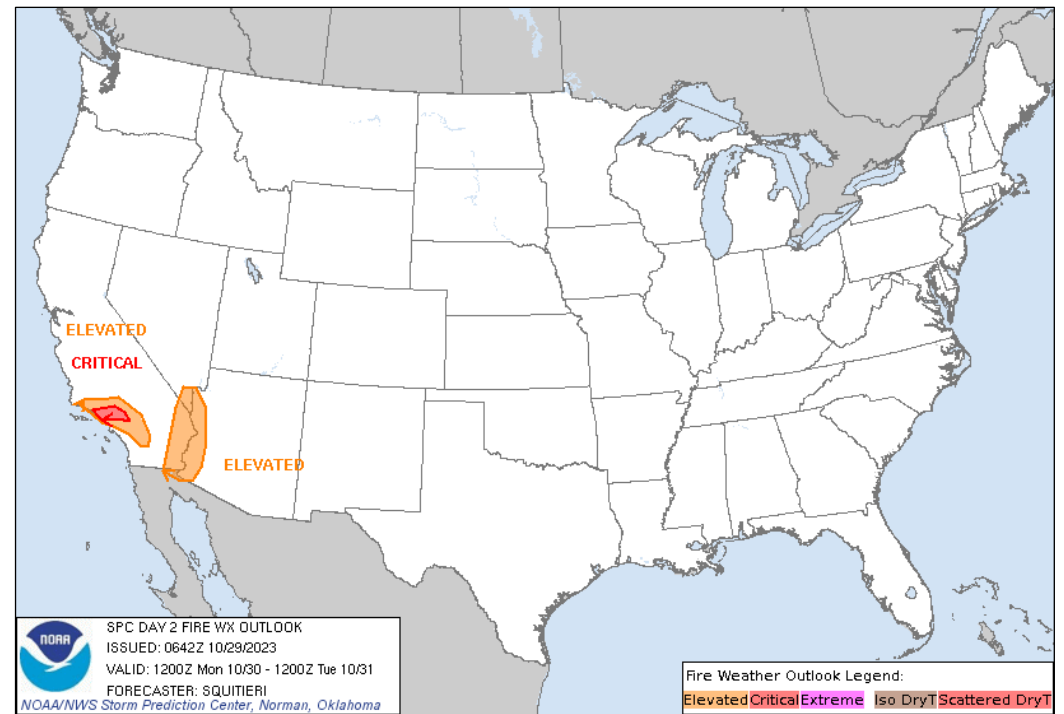
