




- Located over the central Caribbean Sea

- Formation chance 48-hour: High (70%); 5-day: High (80%)




- Located 100 miles NE of Bermuda

National Weather Forecast











Long Range Outlooks - Nov 4-8

6-10 Day Precipitation Probability




