- No areas of concern for Guam, Commonwealth of Northern Mariana Islands or American Samoa

- No tropical cyclones expected during the next 7 days

### Tropical Storm Pilar (Advisory #15A, as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located 110 miles SSW of San Salvador, El Salvador
- Maximum sustained winds 60 mph
- Moving NW at 1 mph
- Gradual weakening is forecast during the next couple of days
- Tropical-storm-force winds extend outward up to 80 miles

### Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located over the central Caribbean Sea
- Conditions appear marginally conducive for further development
- TD could form later this week
- 48-hour: Low (20%); 7-day: Med (50%)

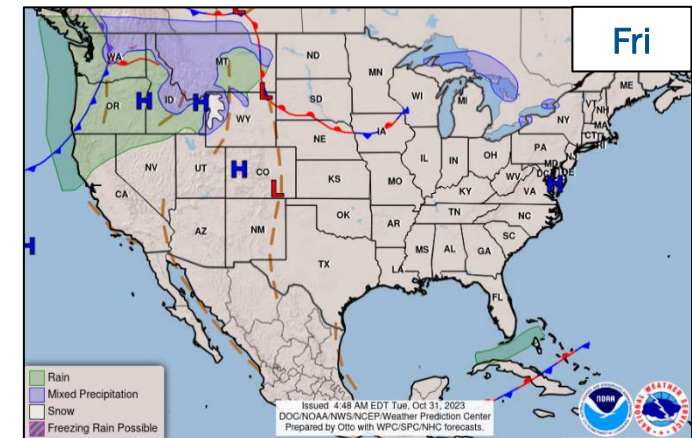
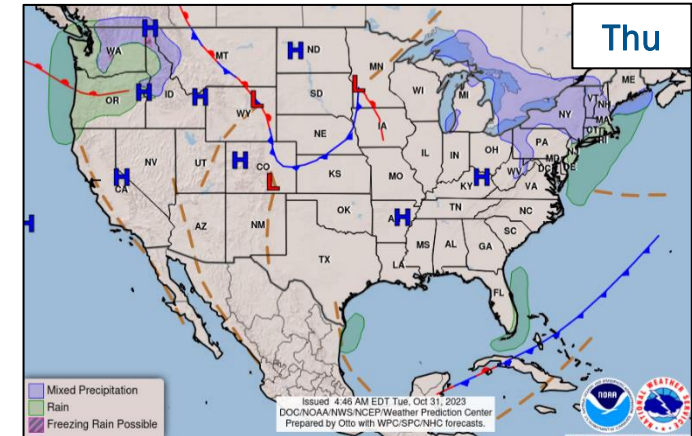
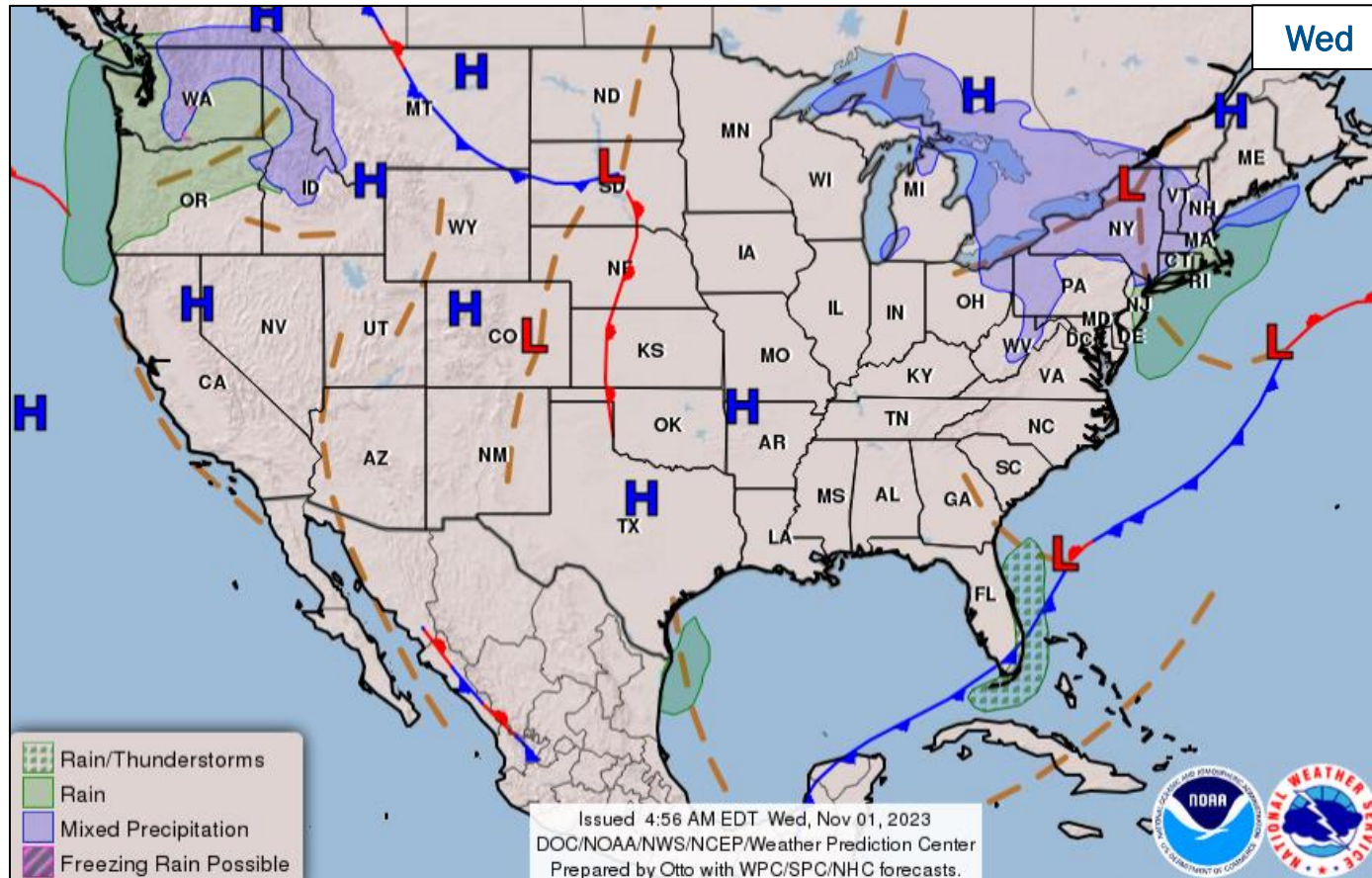
### Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located several hundred miles SSW of the southern tip of the Baja California peninsula
- Conditions are forecast to become increasingly unfavorable for development
- 48-hour: Low (10%); 7-day: Low (10%)

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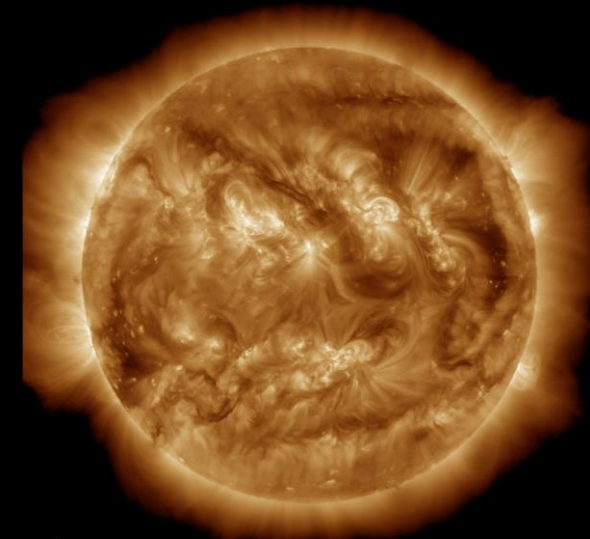

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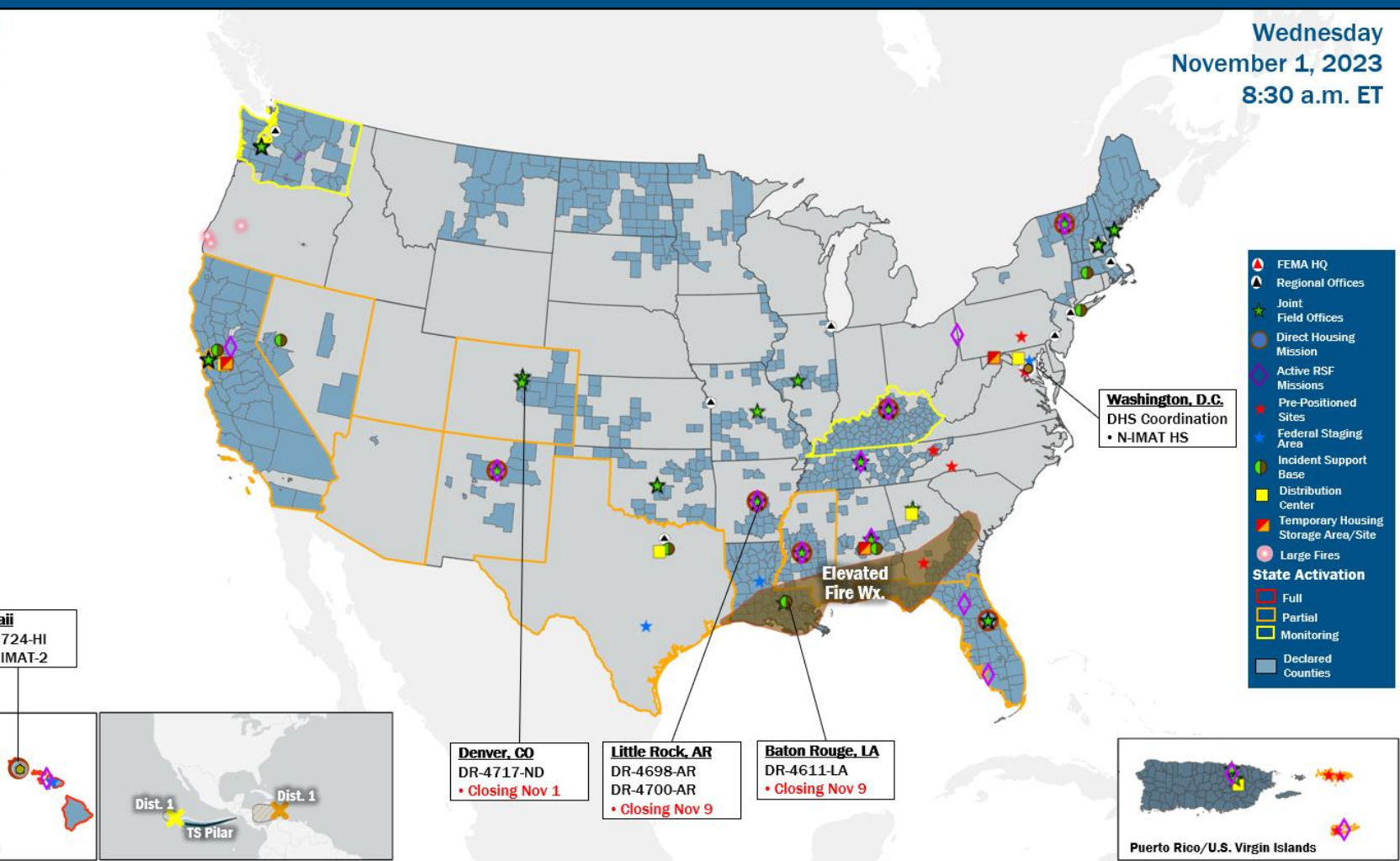
