

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

Disturbance 1: (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located more than 1,000 miles SW of the southern tip of the Baja California peninsula
- Some development is possible during the next few days
- Formation chance: 48-hour Low (30%);7-day Medium (40%)

Tropical Storm Lane: (Adv. #3, as of 5:00 a.m. ET)

- Located 1,525 miles WSW of Baja California
- Moving W at 7 mph
- Maximum sustained winds of 40 mph
- Little change in strength forecast during the next few days

Disturbance 1: (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located over the SW Caribbean Sea
- A tropical depression could form by early next week
- Formation chance: 48-hour Med (60%);7-day High (80%)

Disturbance 2: (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)


- Located near Puerto Rico
- Slow development of this system is possible during the next 2-3 days
- Formation chance: 48-hour Low (10%);7-day Low (10%)


Subtropical Storm Patty: (as of 5:00 a.m. ET)


- Located 420 miles WNW of the Azores












Severe Weather Outlook










Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall







