53rd New York City Marathon



New York City Marathon - New York, NY

Situation:

The 53rd New York City Marathon will take place today in New York, NY and will cross all five boroughs. Approximately 50k runners and 2.5M spectators are anticipated. This is designated as a Special Event Assessment Rating (SEAR) 1 by DHS due to its significant national importance that requires extensive interagency support.


State / Local Response:

- NY EOC is at Normal Operations
- Federal, state, and local law enforcement agencies are supporting
- The primary operations center is the NYPD Joint Operations Center

FEMA / Federal Response:

- NWC is Monitoring; NRCC is at Level III (TC Helene/TC Milton)
- Region II RWC is at Enhanced; RRCC is Rostered
- Maynard MERS deployed to New York, NY
- FEMA is the lead Federal agency for emergency and consequence management

NWC will continue to monitor in coordination with FEMA Region II



- No tropical cyclones threatening the U.S. territories
- No tropical cyclones expected during the next 7 days; see Eastern Pacific for Tropical Depression Lane

Disturbance 1 (EP93): (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located offshore of the southwest coast of Mexico
- Some development is possible during the next few days
- Formation chance: 48-hour Medium (50%); 7-day – Medium (50%)

Tropical Depression Lane: (Adv. #7, as of 5:00 a.m. ET)

- Located 1,605 miles W of Baja California
- Moving W at 6 mph
- Maximum sustained winds of 35 mph
- Likely to become a remnant low later today

Disturbance 1 (AL97): (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located over the SW Caribbean Sea
- A tropical depression is likely to form within the next couple of days
- Formation chance: 48-hour High (80%);7-day High (90%)

Disturbance 2: (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located a couple hundred miles E of SE Bahamas
- Slow development of this system is possible during the next 2-3 days
- Formation chance: 48-hour Low (10%);7-day Low (10%)


Subtropical Storm Patty: (Adv. #5A as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located 125 miles SE of the Azores
- Moving E at 18 mph
- Maximum sustained winds of 50 mph
- Gradual weakening is expected during the next couple of days













Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall






Long Range Outlooks - Nov 8-12



6-10 Day Temperature Probability




6-10 Day Precipitation Probability




