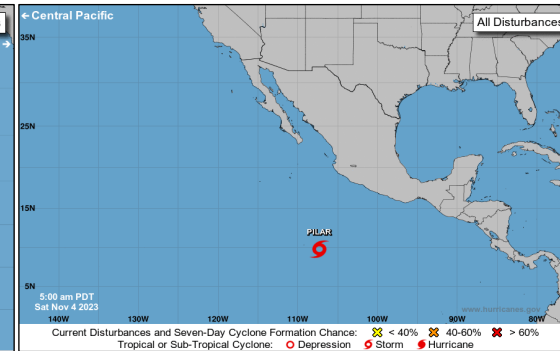

- No tropical cyclones expected during the next 7 days

### Tropical Storm Pilar (Advisory #27, as of 5:00 a.m. ET)

- Located 920 miles S of the southern tip of Baja California, Mexico
- Maximum sustained winds 45 mph
- Moving W at 16 mph
- Small intensity fluctuations possible during the next couple of days. Steady weakening forecast early next week
- Tropical-storm-force winds extend outward up to 60 miles

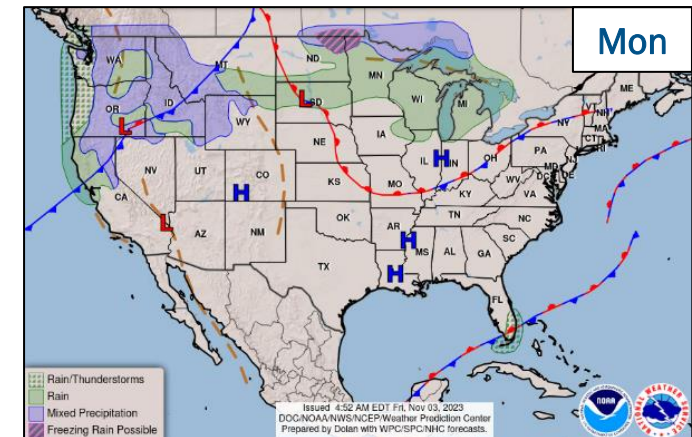
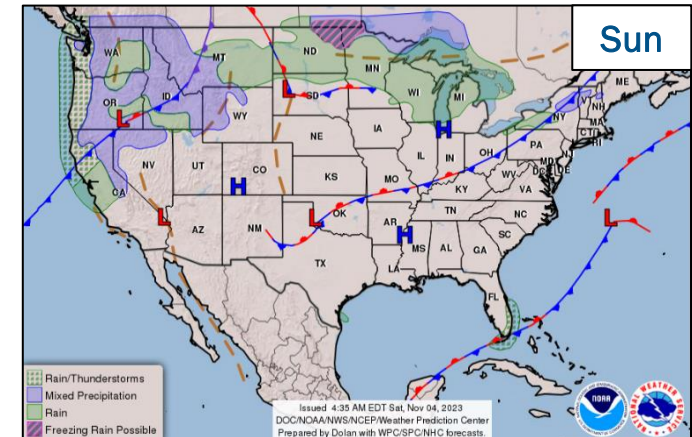
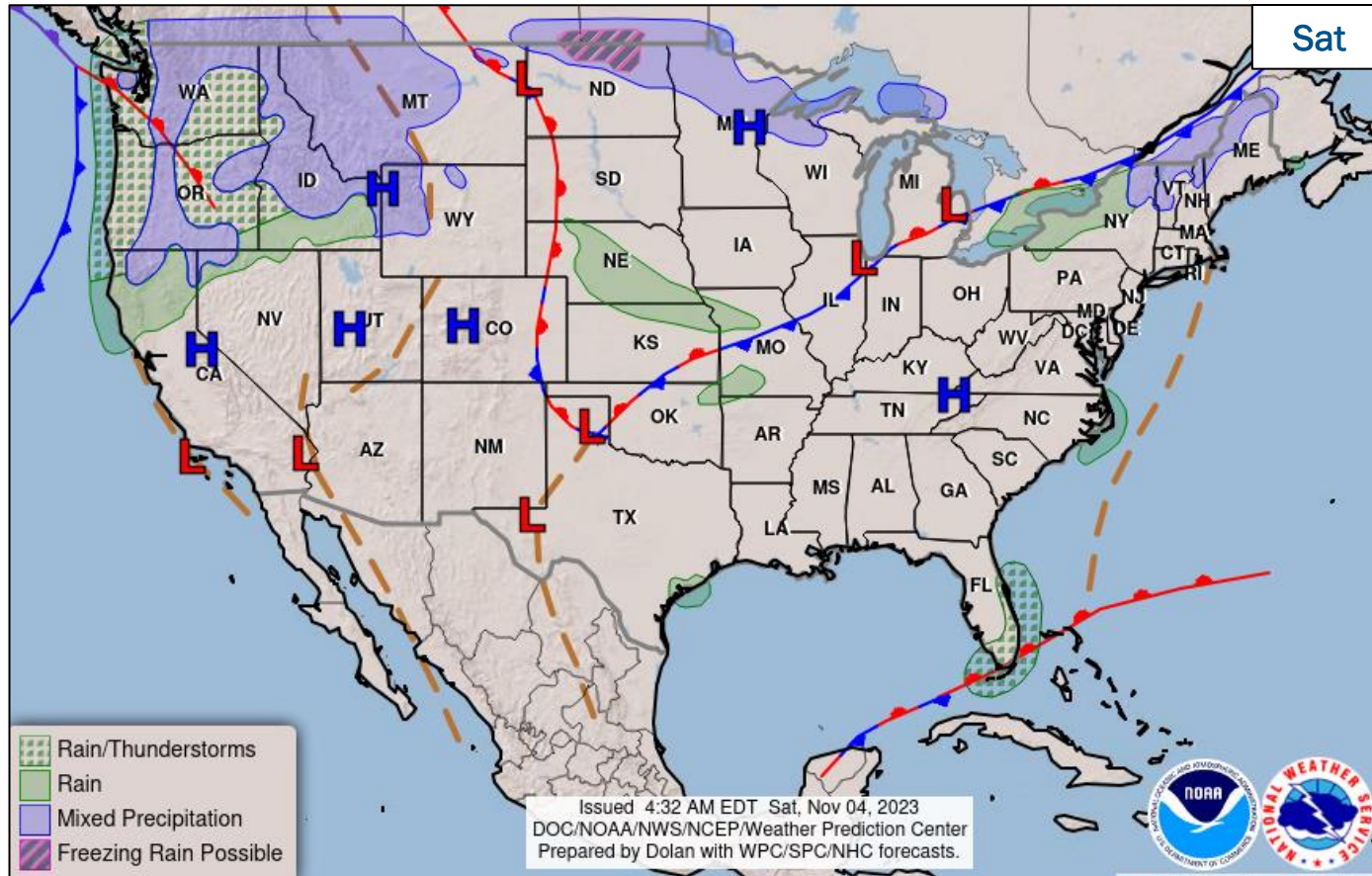
### Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located 100 miles E of the Nicaragua/Costa Rica border
- Some gradual development is possible before it moves inland today or tomorrow
- 48-hour: Low (20%); 7-day: Low (20%)



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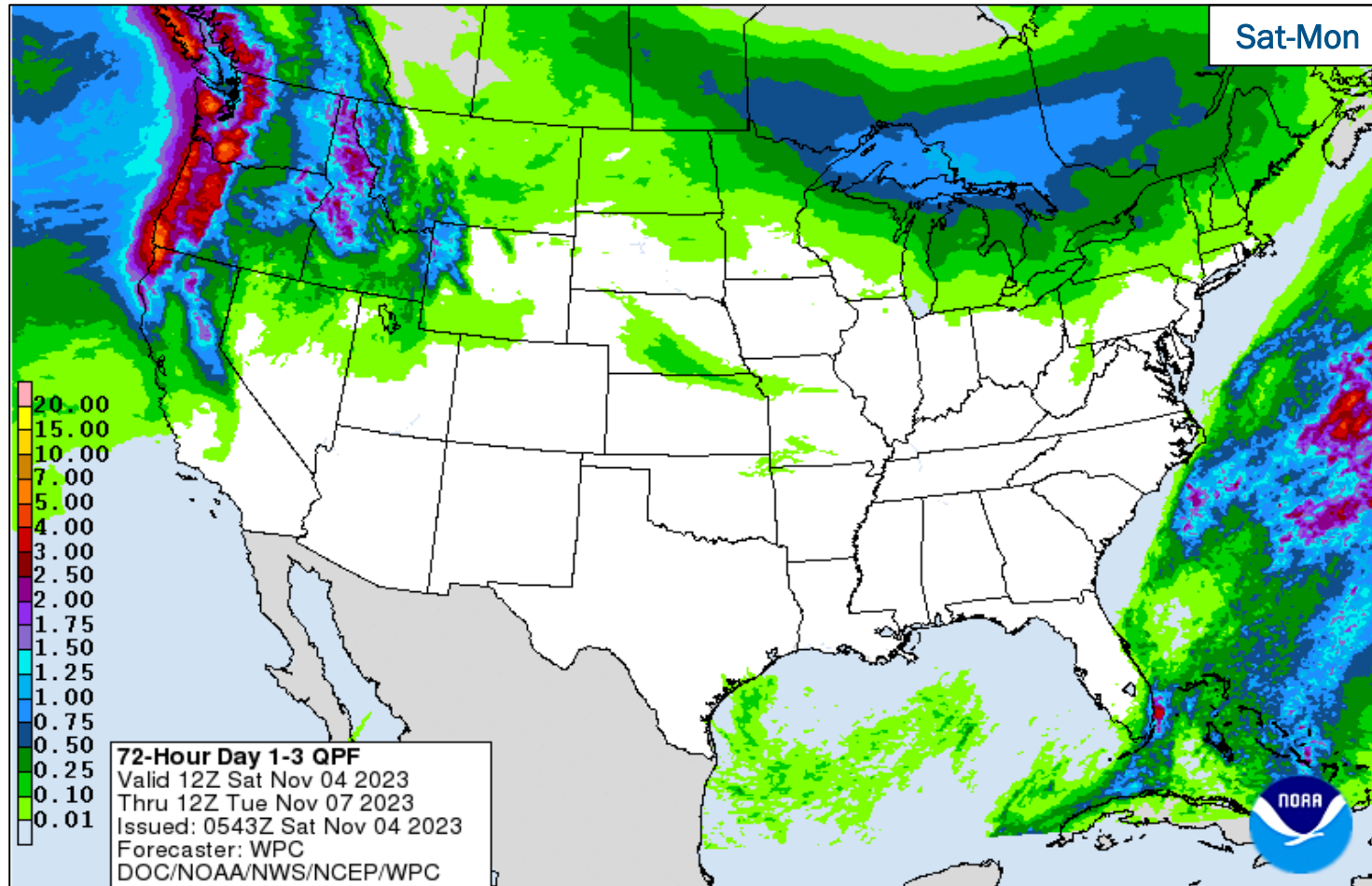
# National Weather Forecast



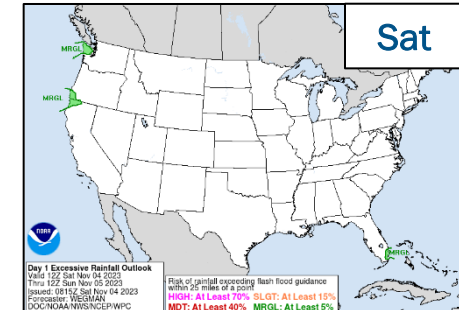
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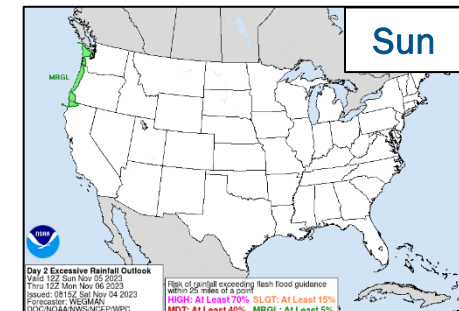
# Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall



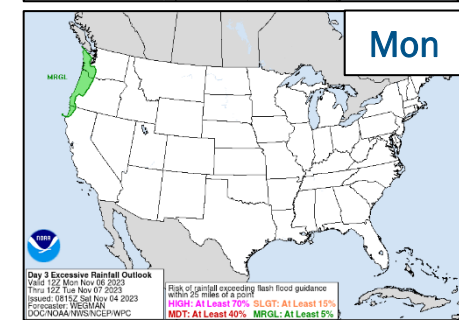

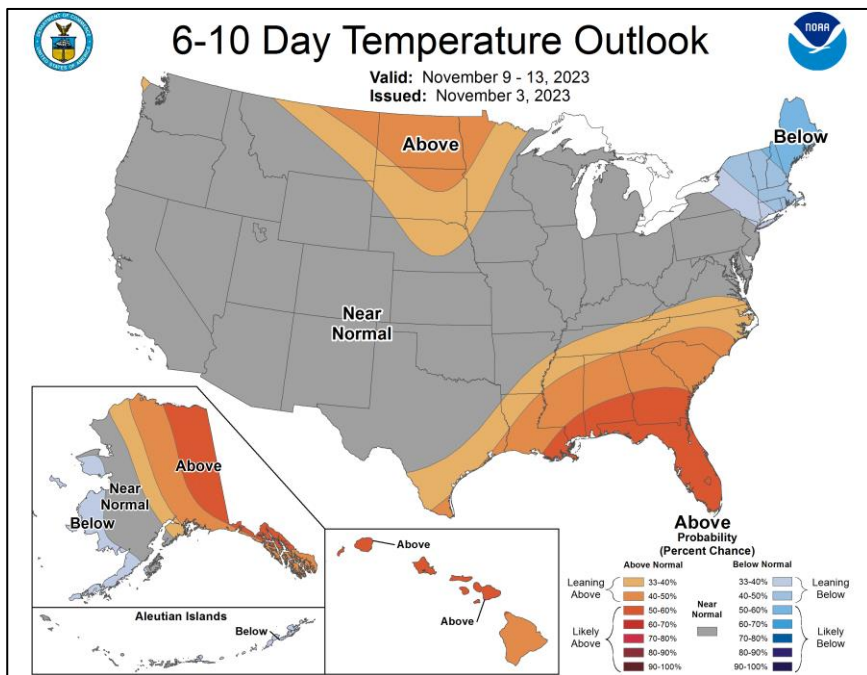

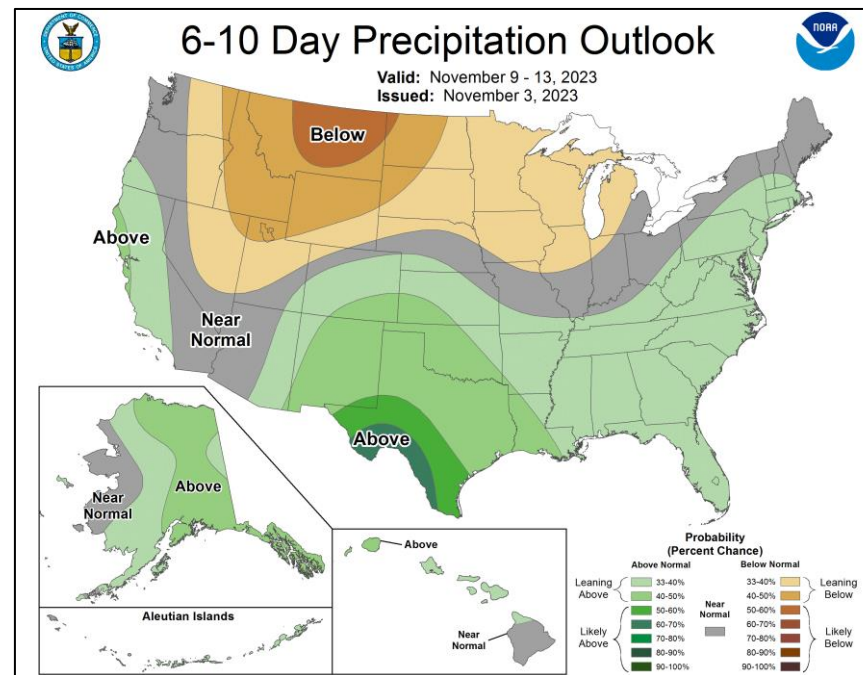
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# Long Range Outlooks – Nov 9-13

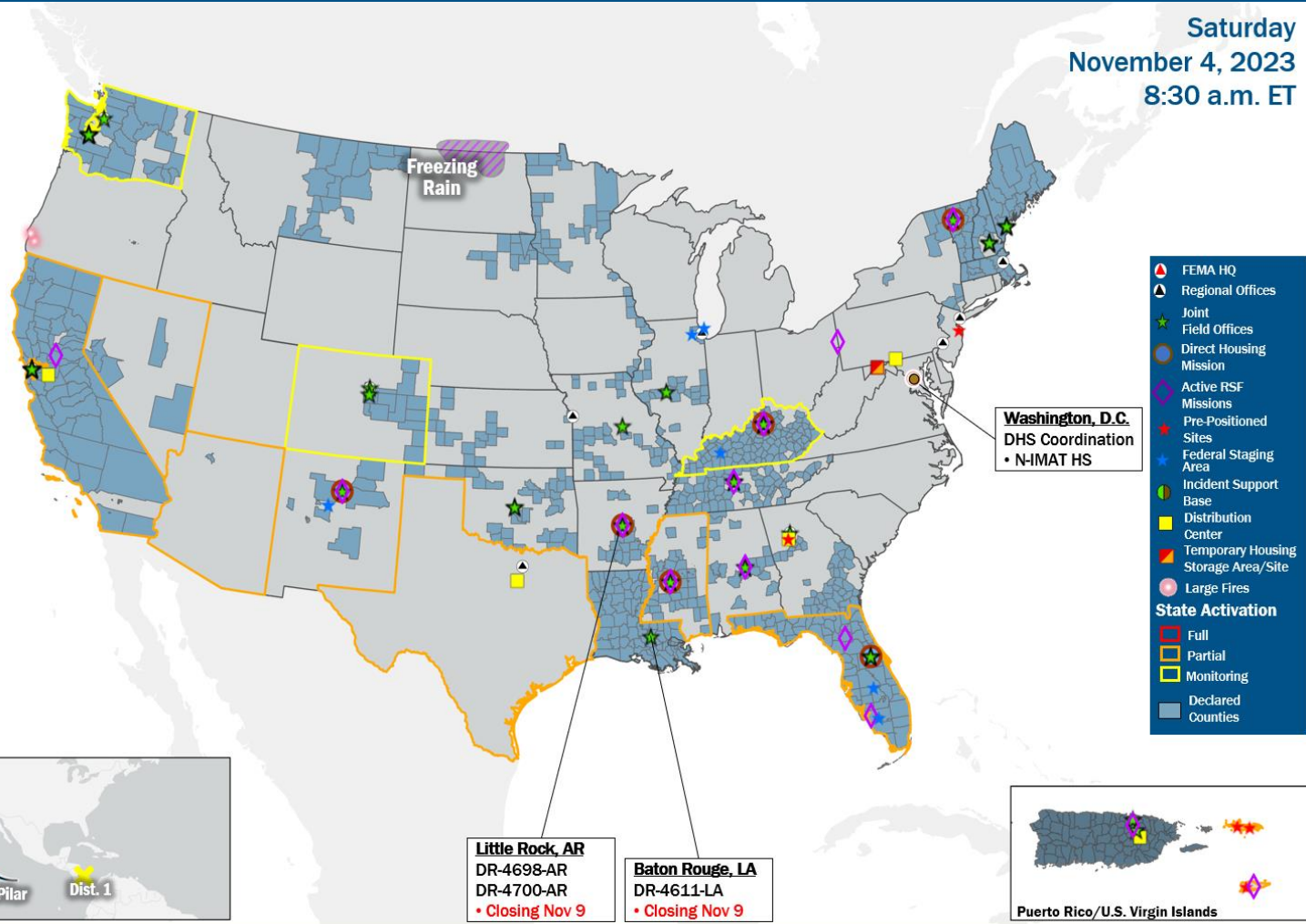
