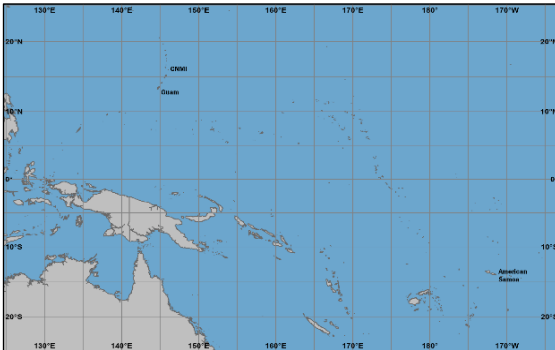

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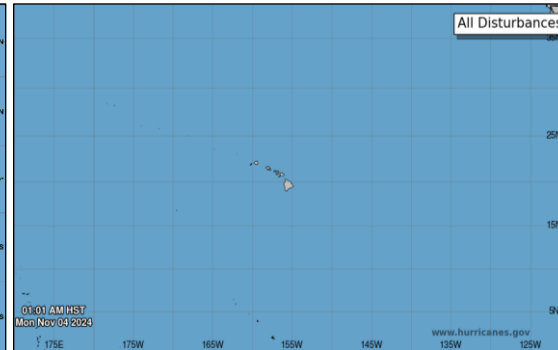

Western Pacific



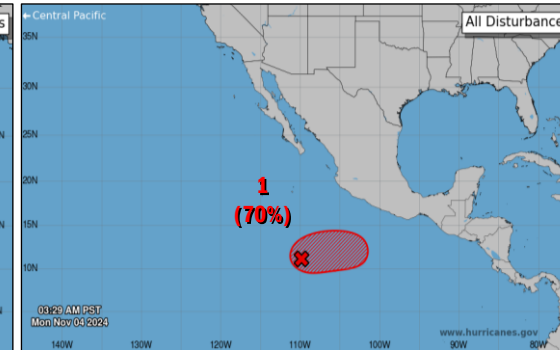
- No tropical cyclones threatening the U.S. territories

- No tropical cyclones expected during the next 7 days

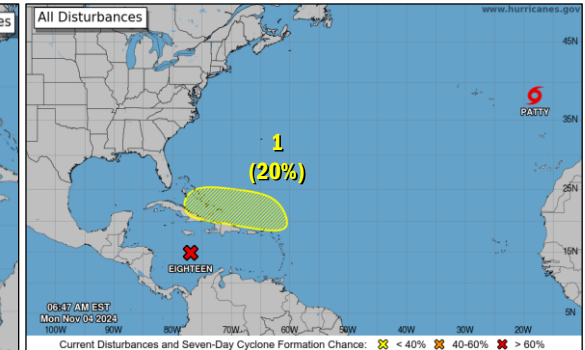
Eastern Pacific



Disturbance 1: (as of 7:00 a.m. ET)

- Located offshore of the southern tip of Baja California
- Some development possible; may form into a tropical depression
- Formation chance: 48-hour – High (70%); 7-day – High (70%)

Atlantic



Potential Tropical Cyclone 18: (Advisory #3A, as of 7:00 a.m. ET)

- See graphic below

Disturbance 1: (as of 7:00 a.m. ET)

- Located near the northern Leeward Islands
- Slow development is possible
- Formation chance: 48-hour – Low (near 0%); 7-day – Low (20%)

Tropical Storm Patty: (Advisory #9, as of 4:00 a.m. ET)

- Located 490 miles E of the Azores
- Moving ENE at 20 mph
- Maximum sustained winds of 40 mph
- Expected to become Post-Tropical Cyclone later today



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Potential Tropical Cyclone 18 – Atlantic

Situation: (Advisory #3A, as of 7:00 a.m. ET)

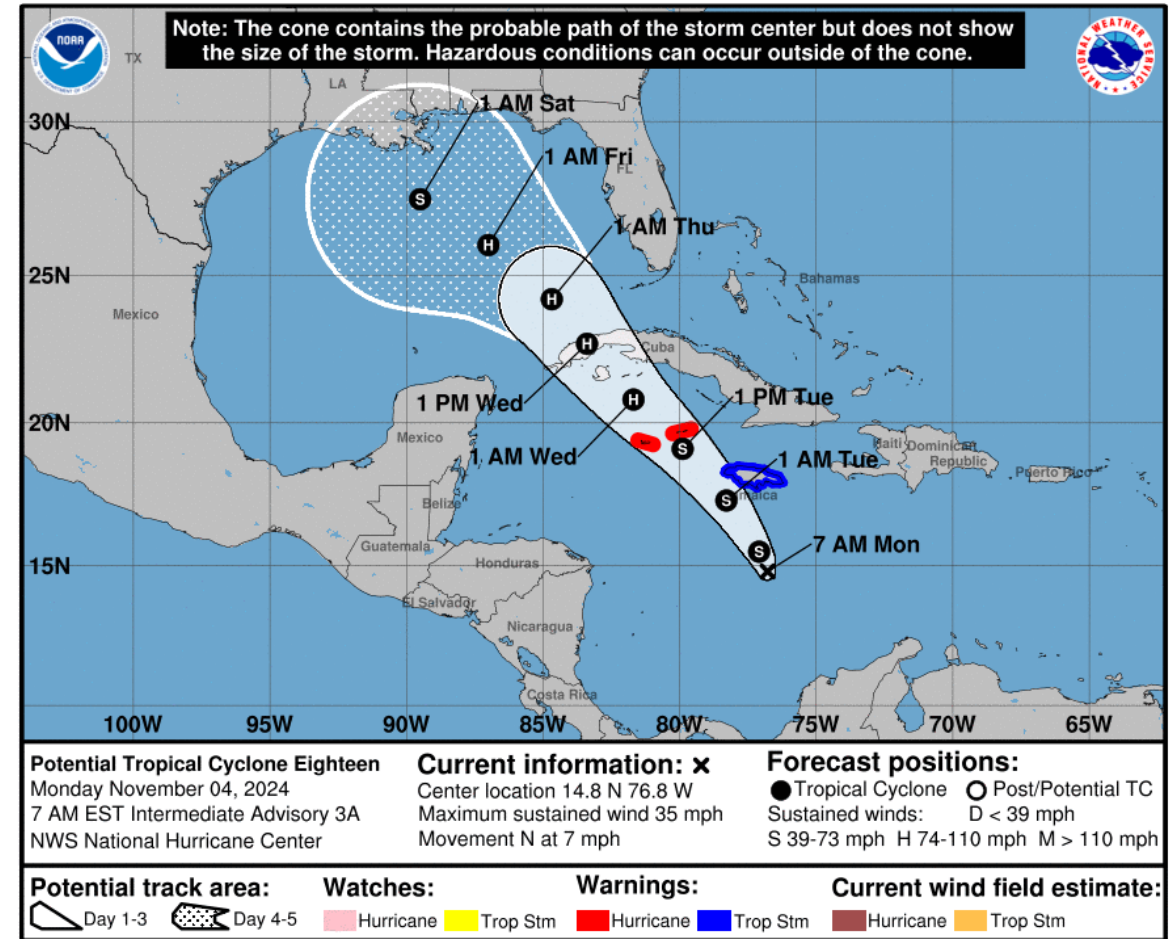
- Located 220 miles S of Jamaica
- Moving N at 7 mph
- Maximum sustained winds of 35 mph
- Forecast to strengthen and become a tropical depression or storm today

Hazards Affecting Land:

Wind: Hurricane conditions possible in the Cayman Islands on Tuesday. Tropical storm conditions expected in Jamaica by this evening

Rainfall: Heavy rain will spread N into Florida and adjacent areas of the SE U.S. mid to late week

Surf: Swells generated by the system are expected to affect much of the western Caribbean during the next few days

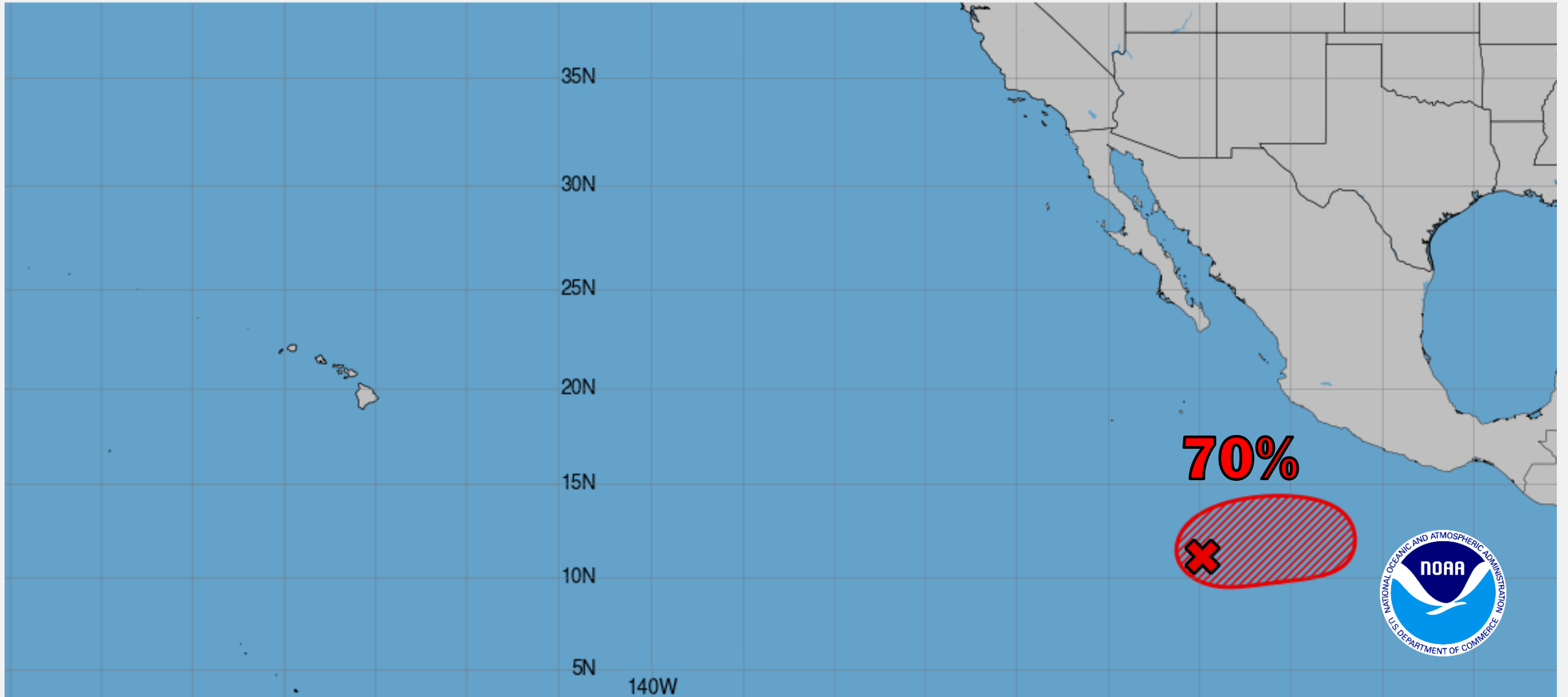


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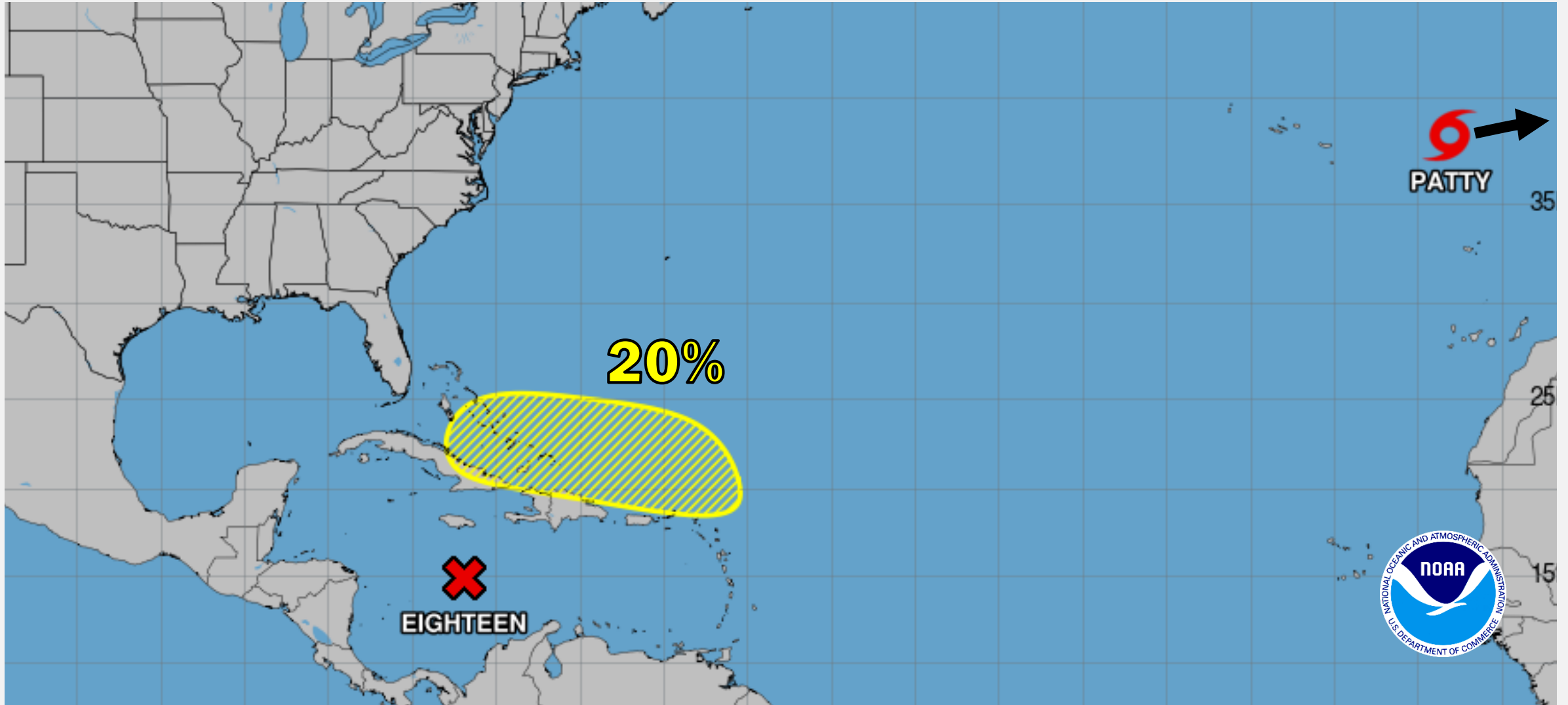

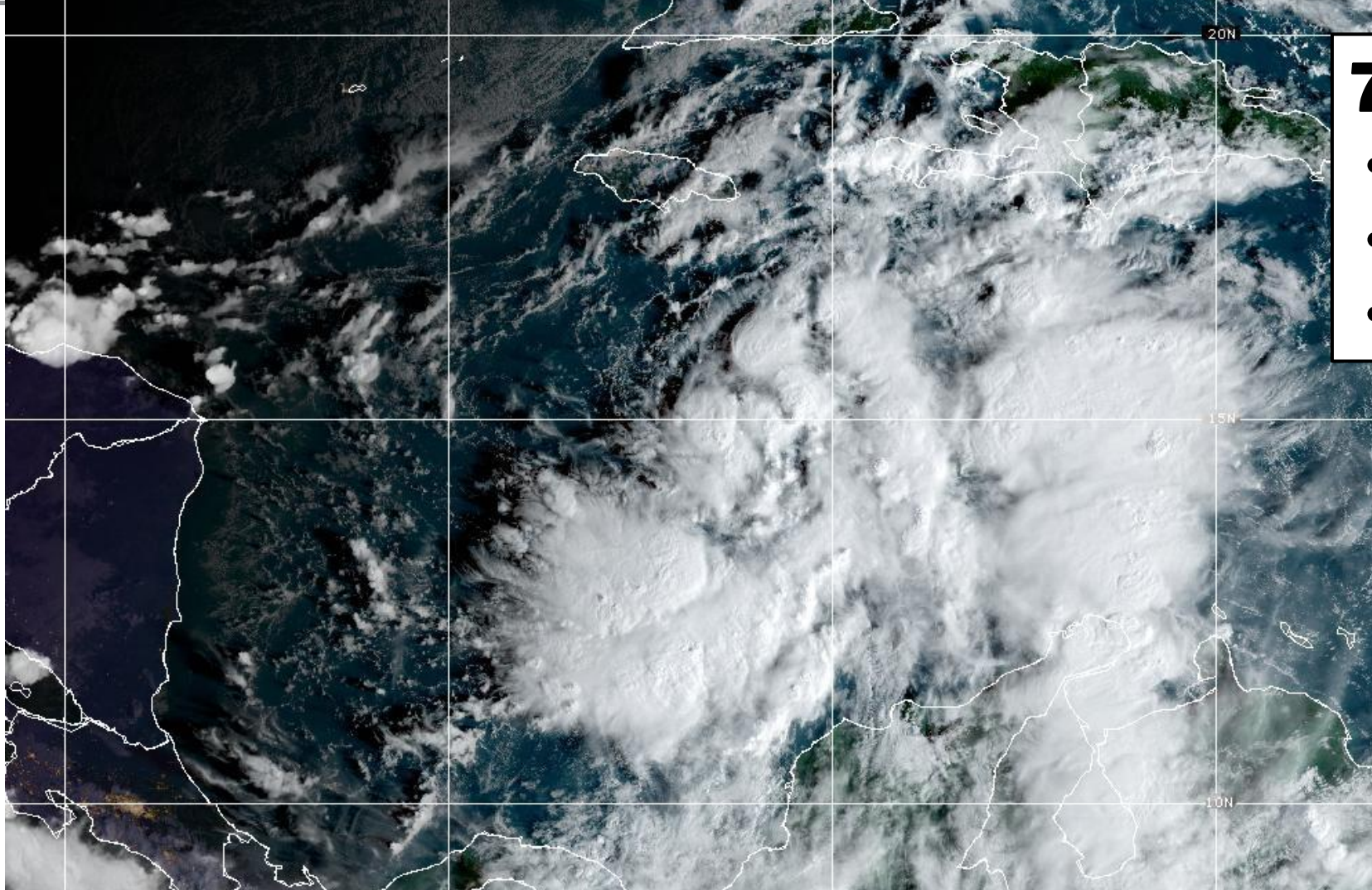

SATELLITE LOOP



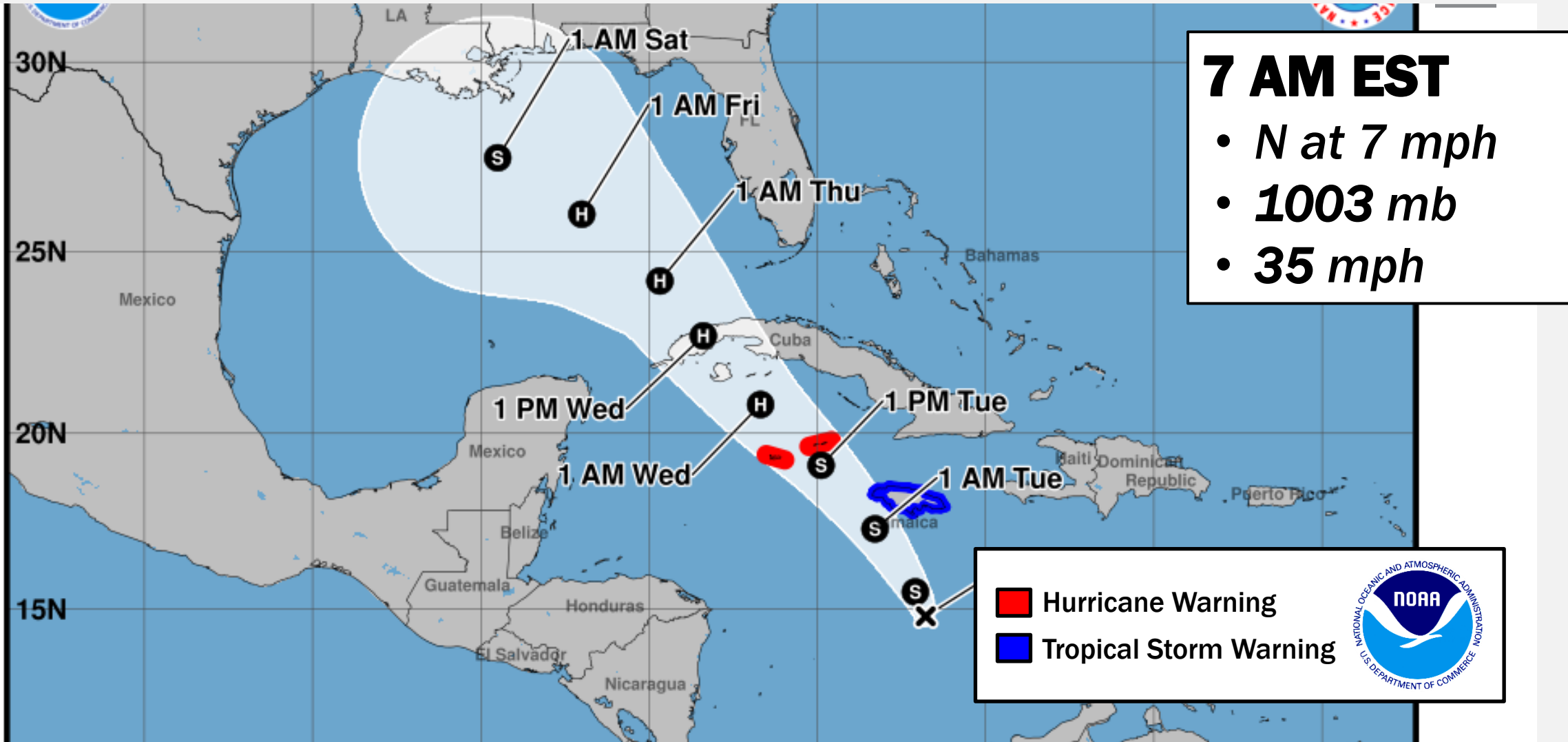

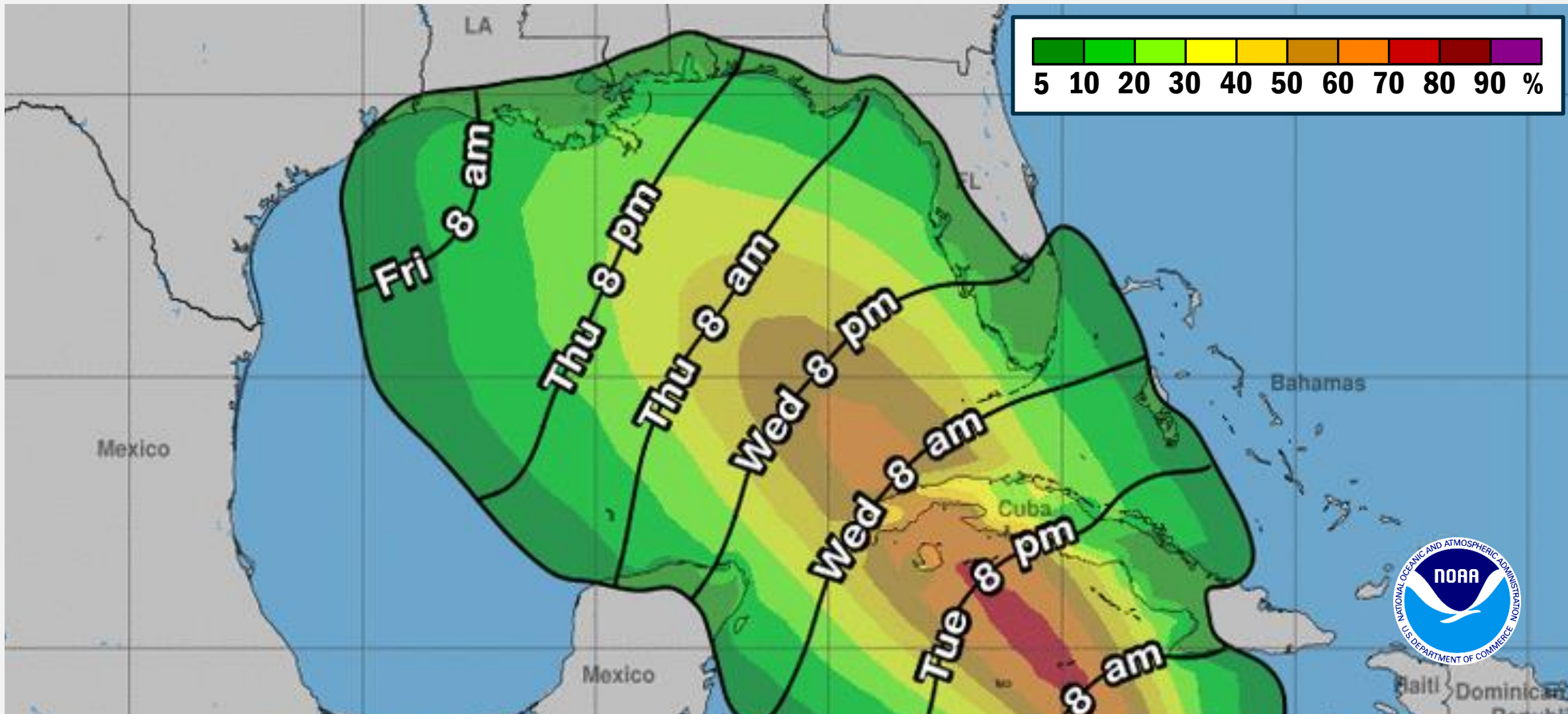

MOST LIKELY ARRIVAL OF TS WINDS



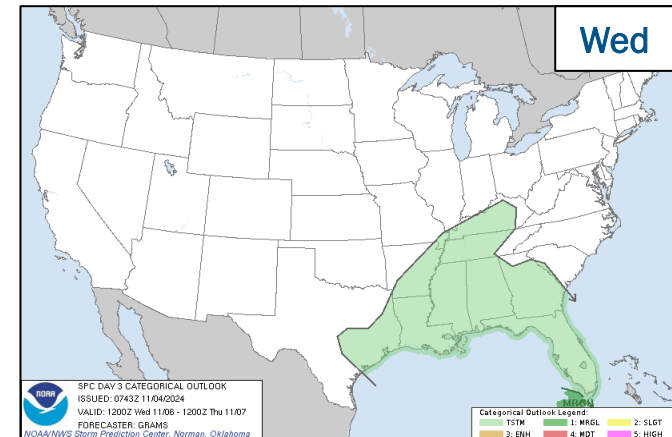
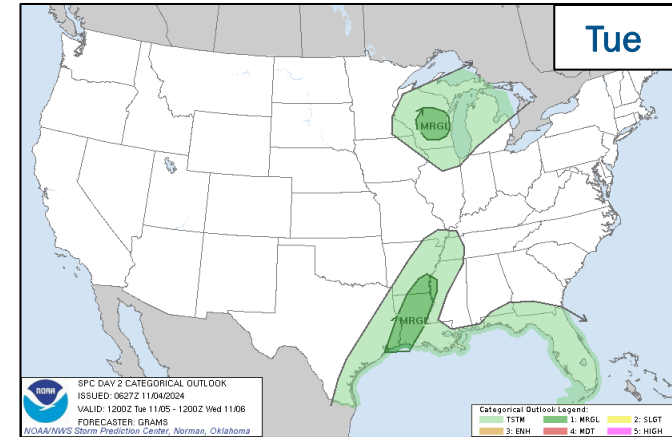
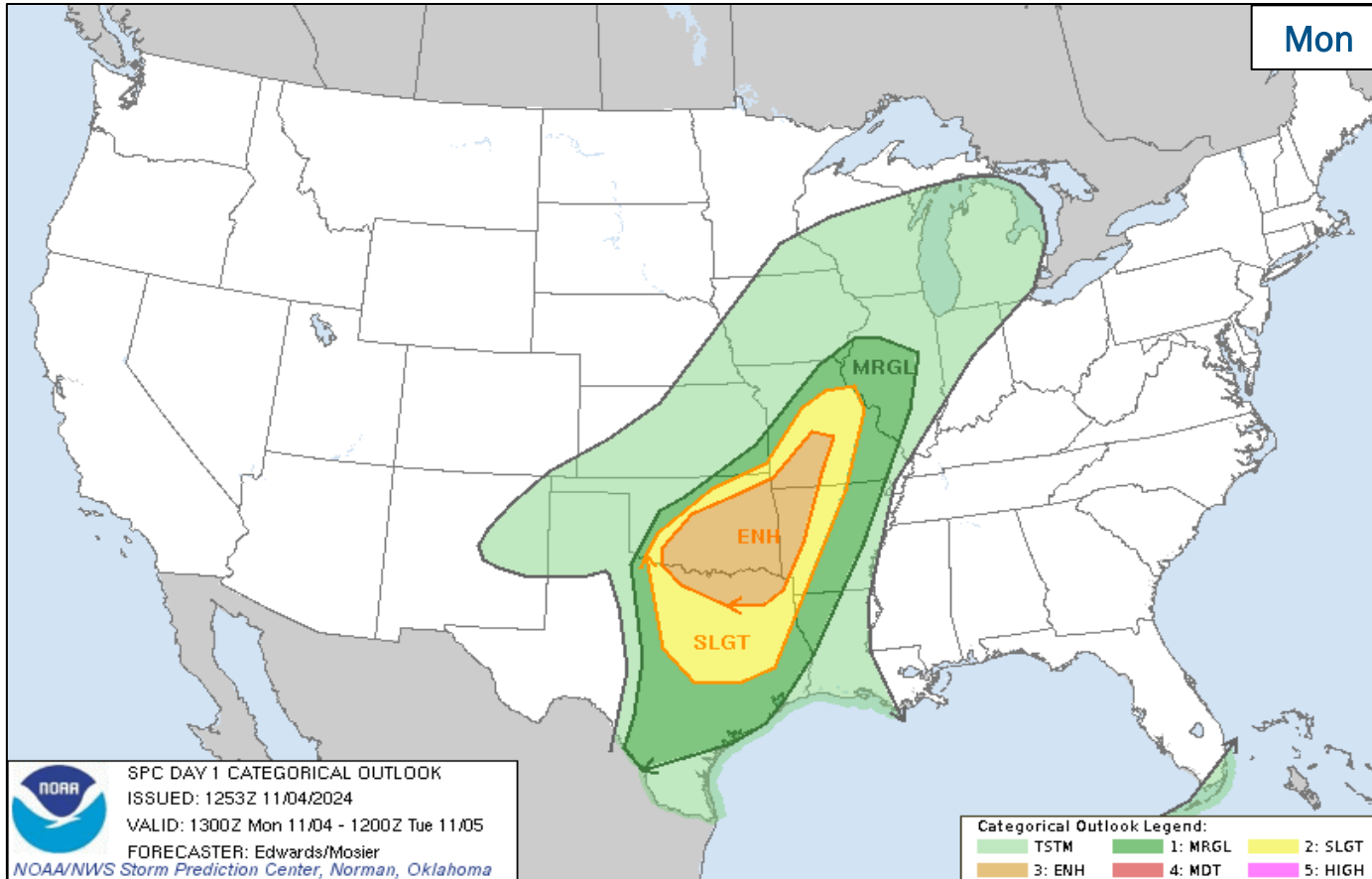
National Weather Forecast



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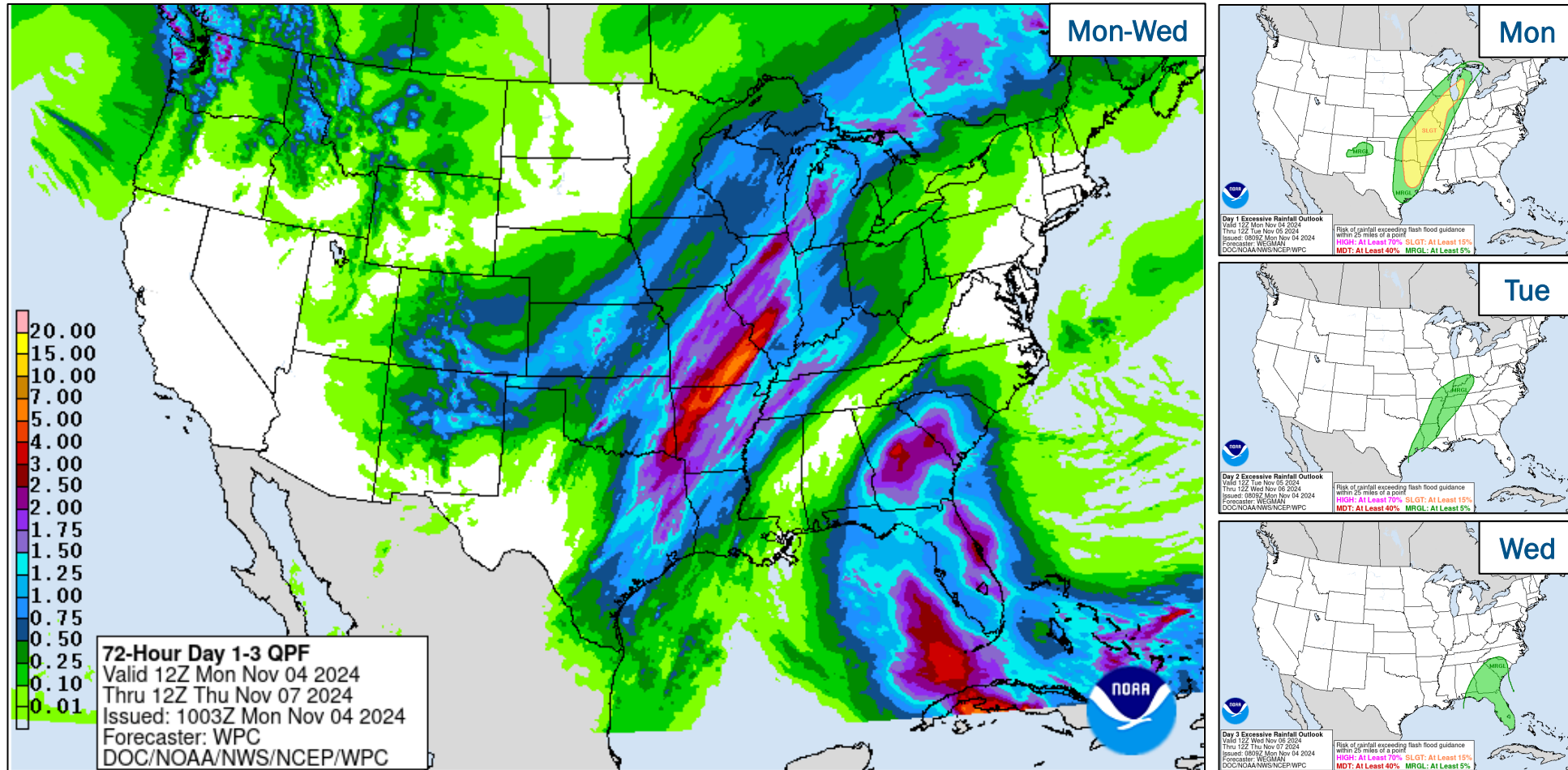
Severe Weather Outlook



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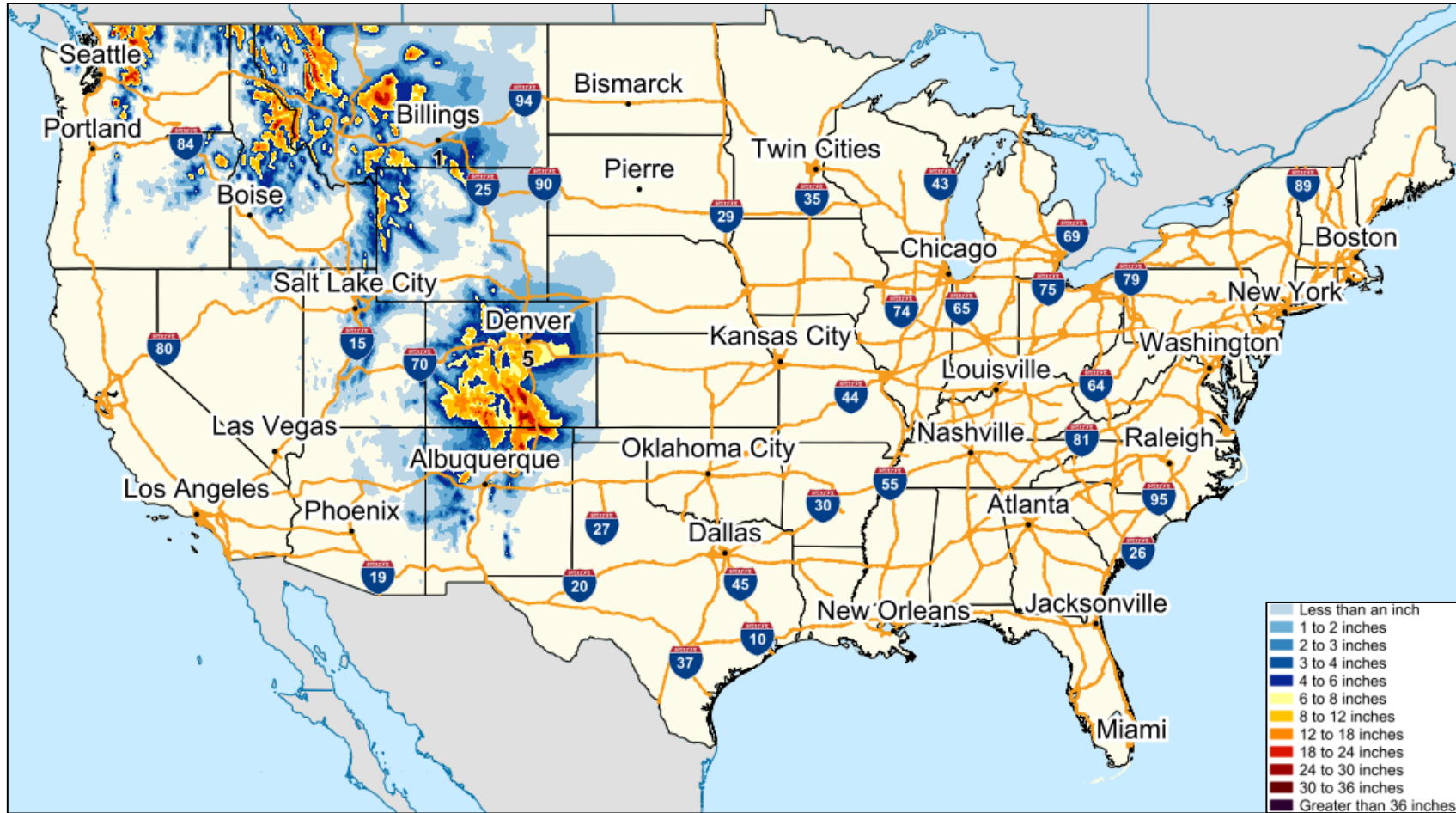
Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall



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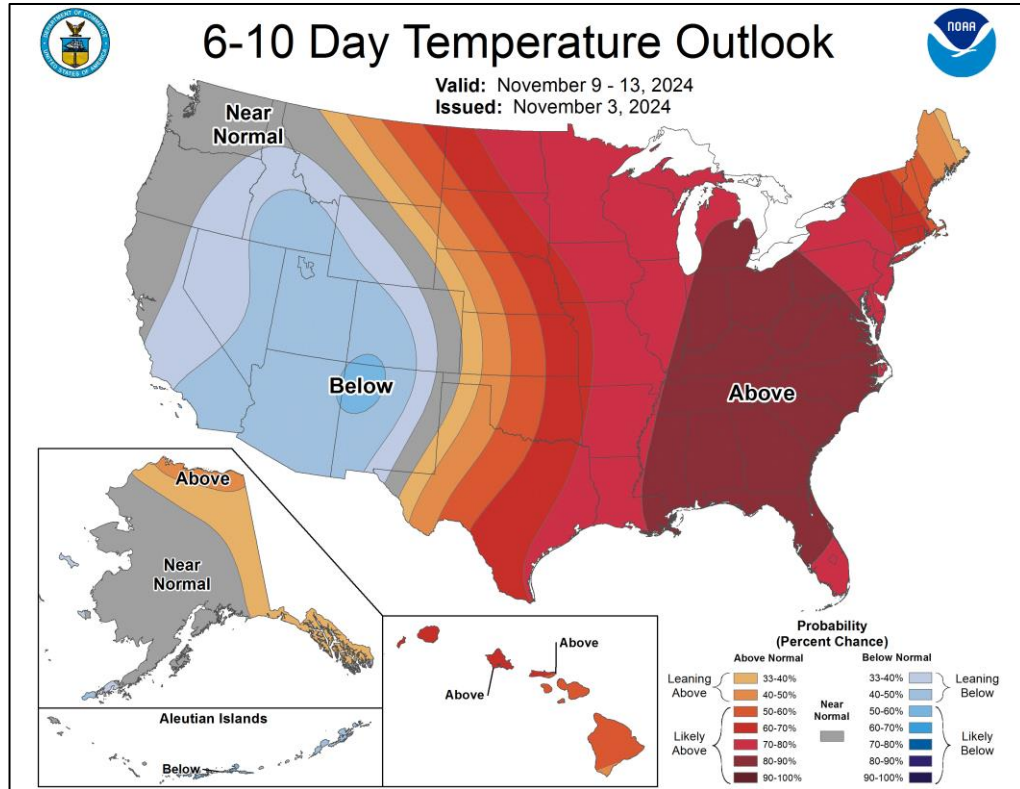

Snowfall Forecast

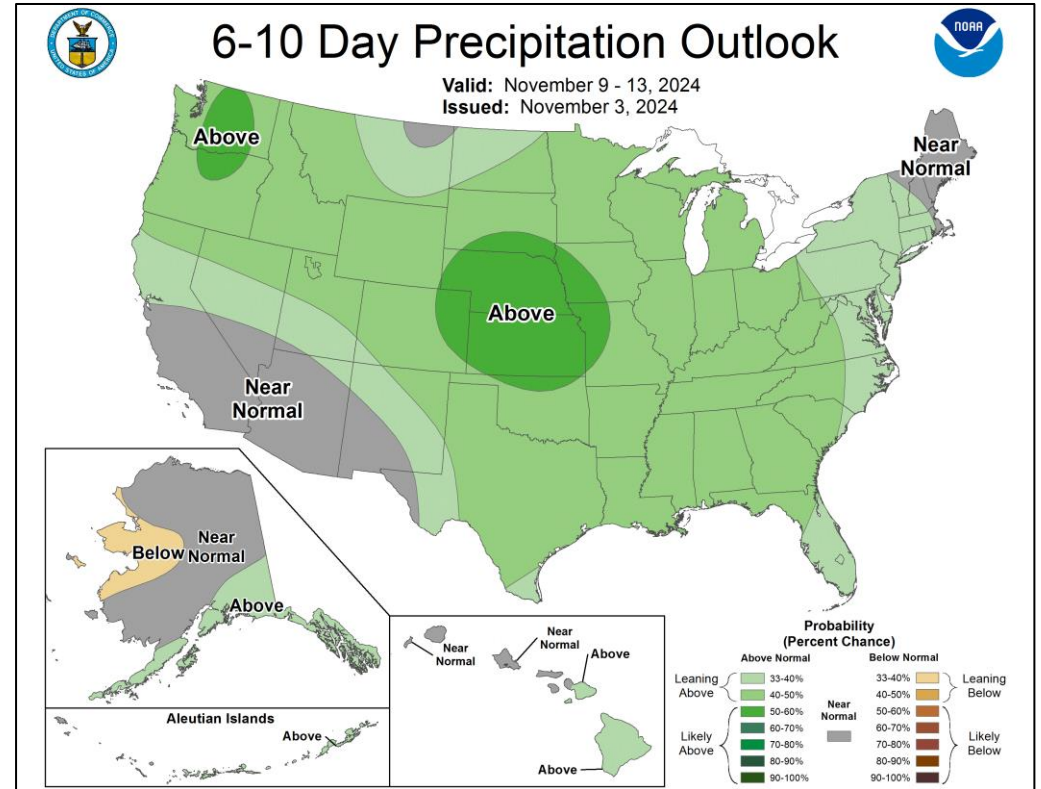


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Long Range Outlooks – Nov 9-13

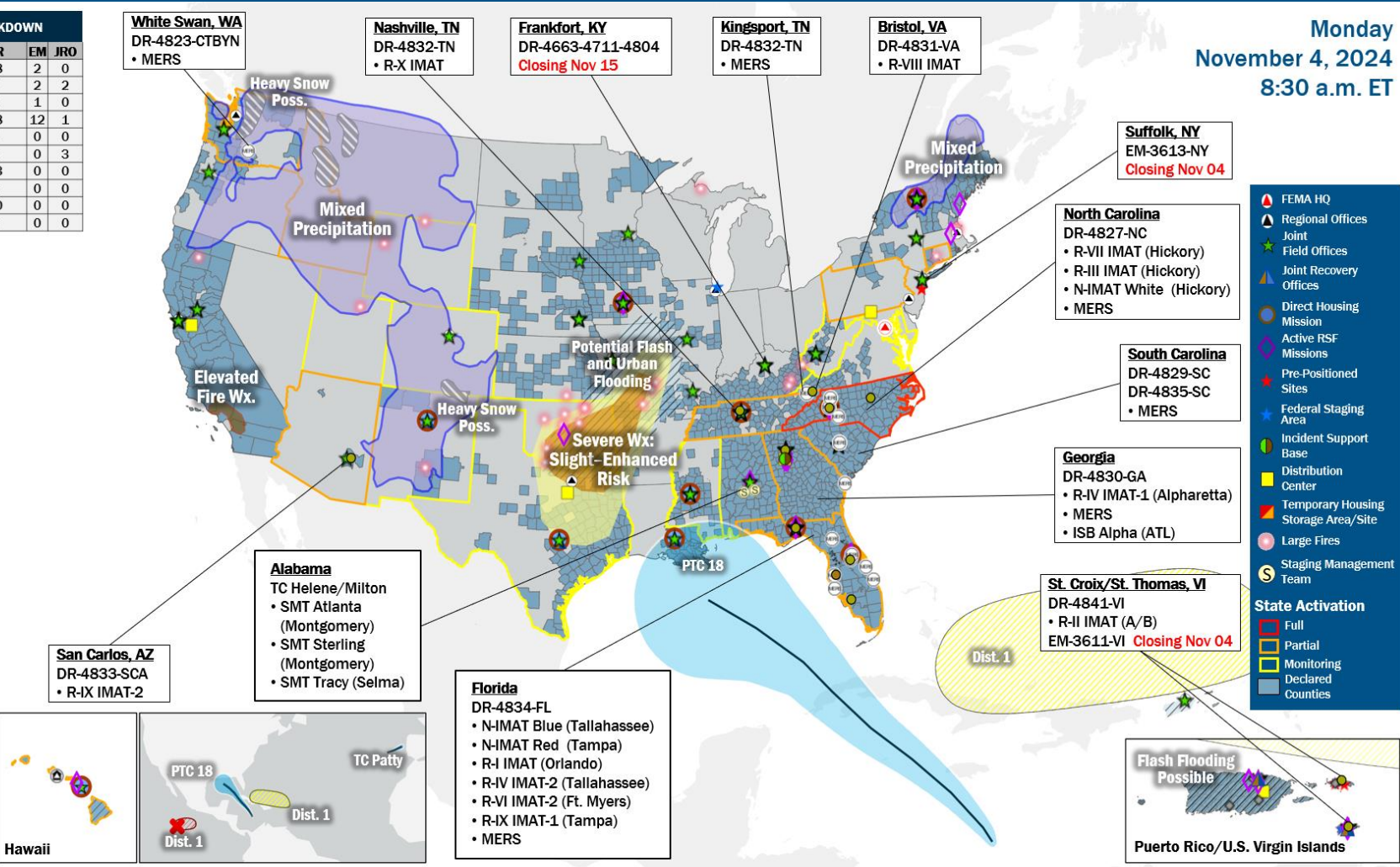
