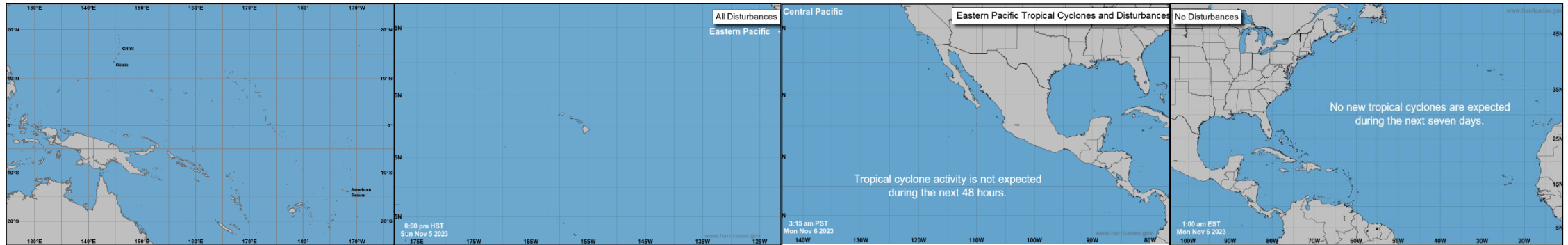

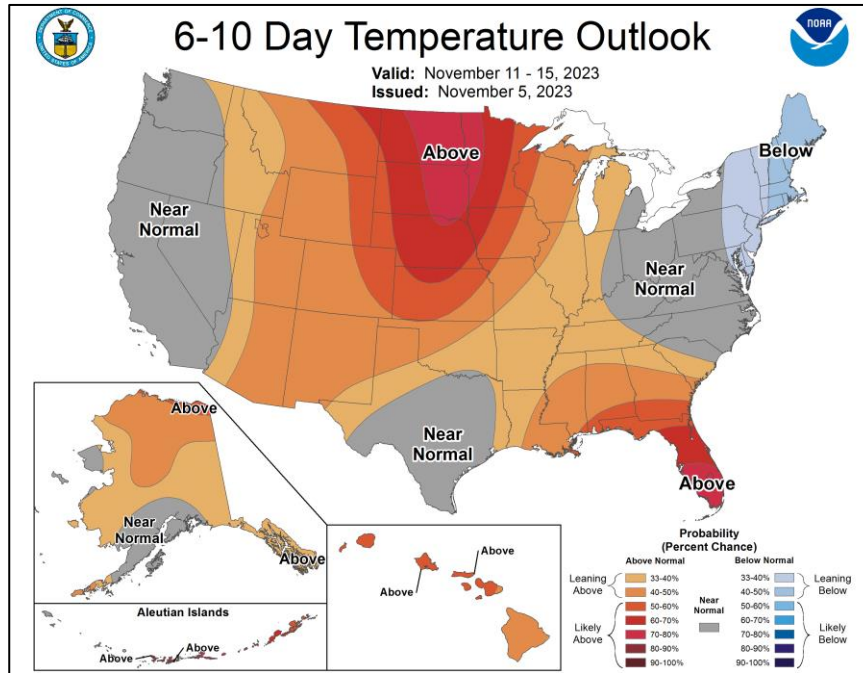
National Weather Forecast



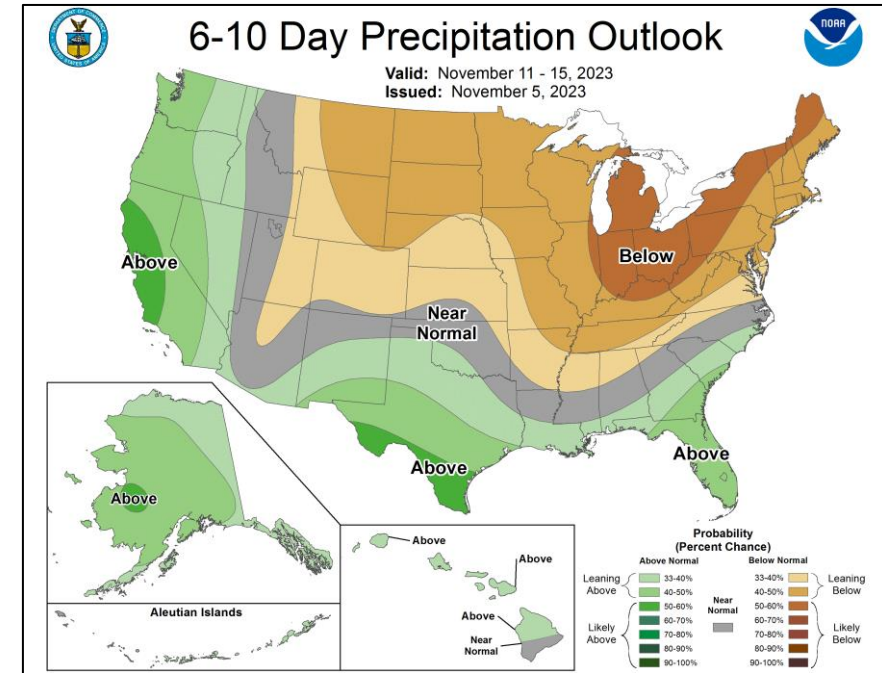

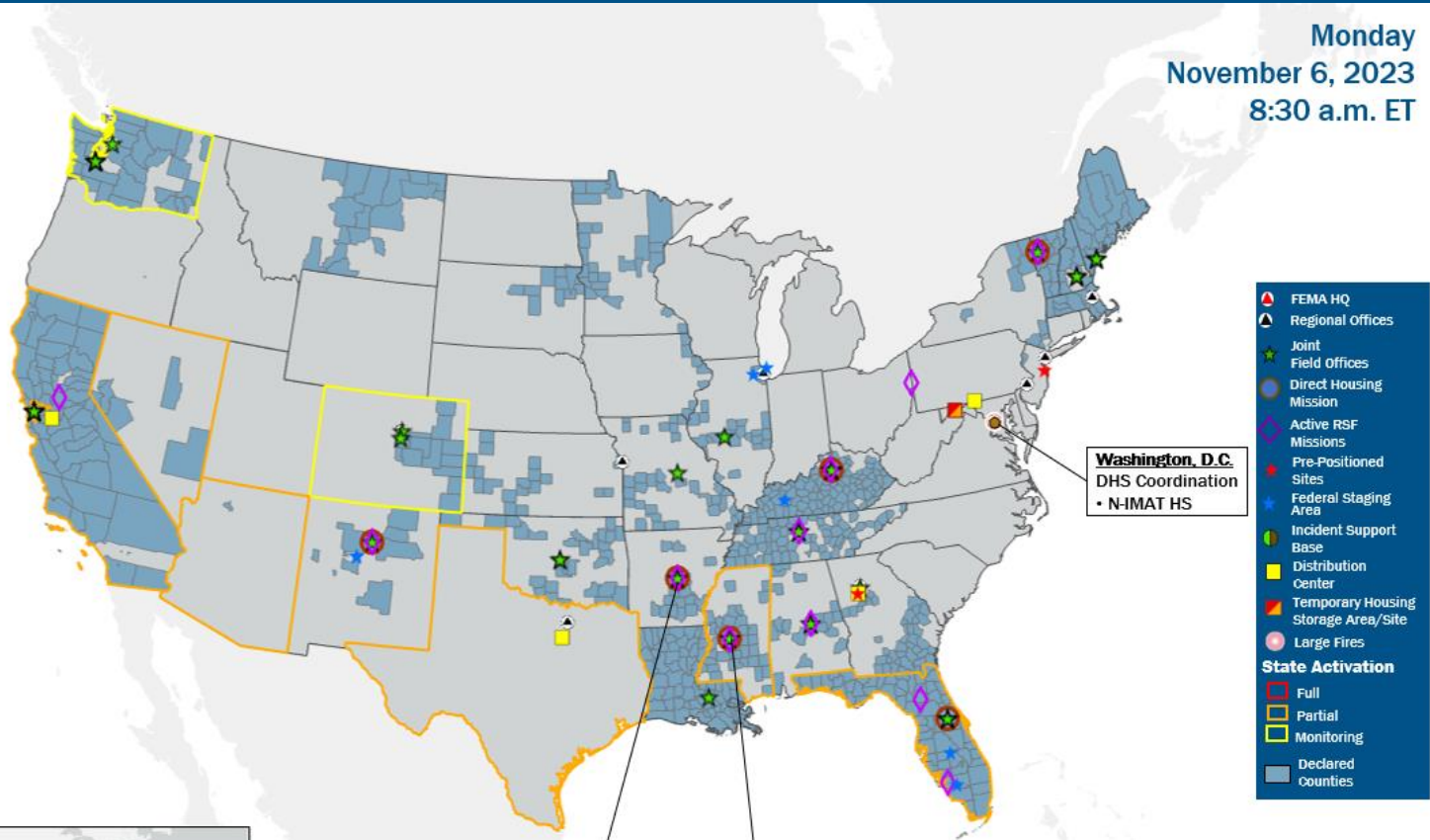
