Significant Incidents or Threats:

- Tropical Storm Eta Preparations and Response
- COVID-19
- Heavy rain and flash flooding possible south Florida
- Freezing rain possible Central/Northern Plains to Upper Mississippi Valley


Tropical Activity:

- Atlantic:
 - Tropical Storm Eta
 - Disturbance 1: High (70%)
 - Disturbance 2: Medium (50%)
- Eastern Pacific: No new tropical cyclones are expected during the next five days
- Central Pacific: No new tropical cyclones are expected during the next five days
- Western Pacific: No activity affecting U.S. interests






Tropical Storm Eta SATELLITE LOOP




RADAR LOOP





Tropical Storm Eta Most Likely Arrival of TS WINDS




Tropical Storm Eta PEAK STORM SURGE FORECAST



Tropical Storm Eta FLASH FLOOD POTENTIAL





Tropical Cyclone Eta – Preparations/Response



Situation:

Eta is moving west over the southeastern Gulf of Mexico; gusty winds and heavy rains are still occurring over portions of south FL and the Keys

Impacts:

Safety & Security:

- FL: Monroe County, Miami-Dade, and Palm Beach government offices and schools closed; Broward County closed county services and offices; Lee, Martin, St. Lucie, Indian River county schools closed
- · High water vehicles positioned for quick response

Food, Water and Shelter:

- 6 shelters open with 94 occupants statewide (ARC Midnight Shelter Count as of 7:01 a.m. ET)
- FL pre-positioned 20 truckloads of food and water to southeast FL

Energy

• FL: 35k (0.4%) customers without power statewide (DOE Eagle-I as of 6:30 a.m. ET)

Transportation


- Key West: ports at port condition ZULU (closed)
- · FL: Multiple counties are evaluating bridge closures

State/Local Preparations and Response:

- FL Governor declared a state of emergency for 8 counties
- FL EOC at Full Activation (COVID-19 & Eta)

FEMA/Federal Preparations and Response:

- NRCC at Level III (COVID-19)
- · Region IV RWC is monitoring
- Region IV IMAT-1 deployed to MS (Tropical Cyclone Zeta); IMAT-2 is available
- No requests for FEMA assistance; any impacts are expected to remain well within State and local capabilities



COVID-19 Update



<u>Situation:</u> Upward trajectory in COVID-19 case count continues across 42 states/territories, with 3 jurisdictions in a plateau status, and 11 jurisdictions on a downward trajectory; 1,248 FEMA employees deployed. (COVID-19 SLB, as of Nov 6)

Nationwide Testing: 15,744,193 cumulative (COVID-19 SLB, as of Nov 6)




Response:

- Regions VII, VIII, & IX COVID-19 working from the Virtual JFO
- · NWC, all RWCs, and MOCs are monitoring



Flood Hazard Outlook






