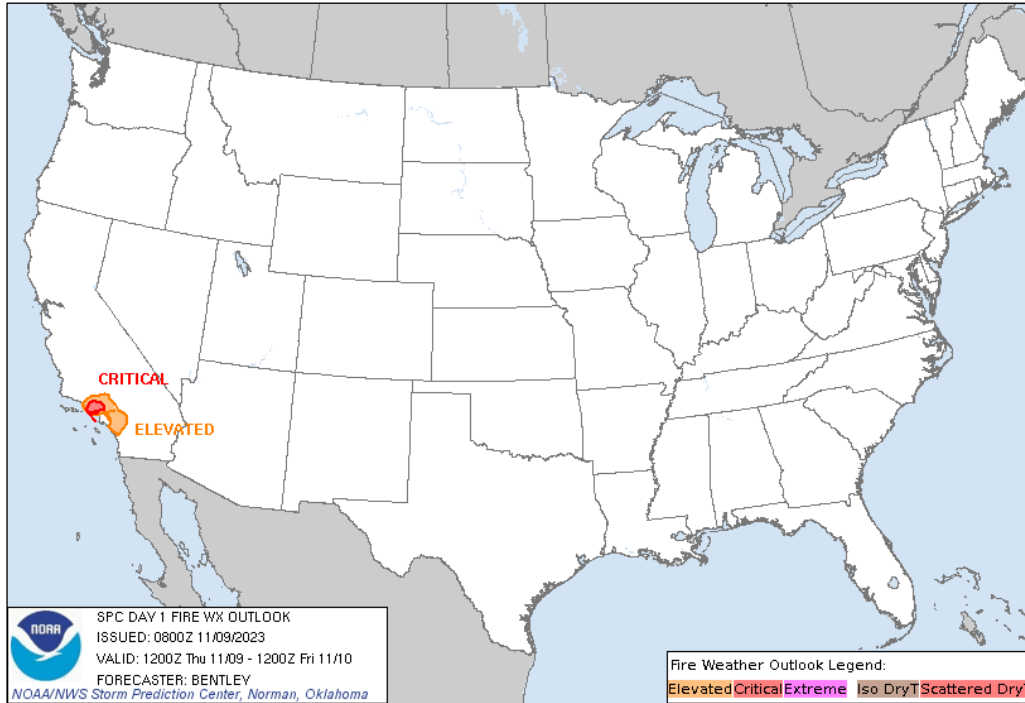
National Weather Forecast



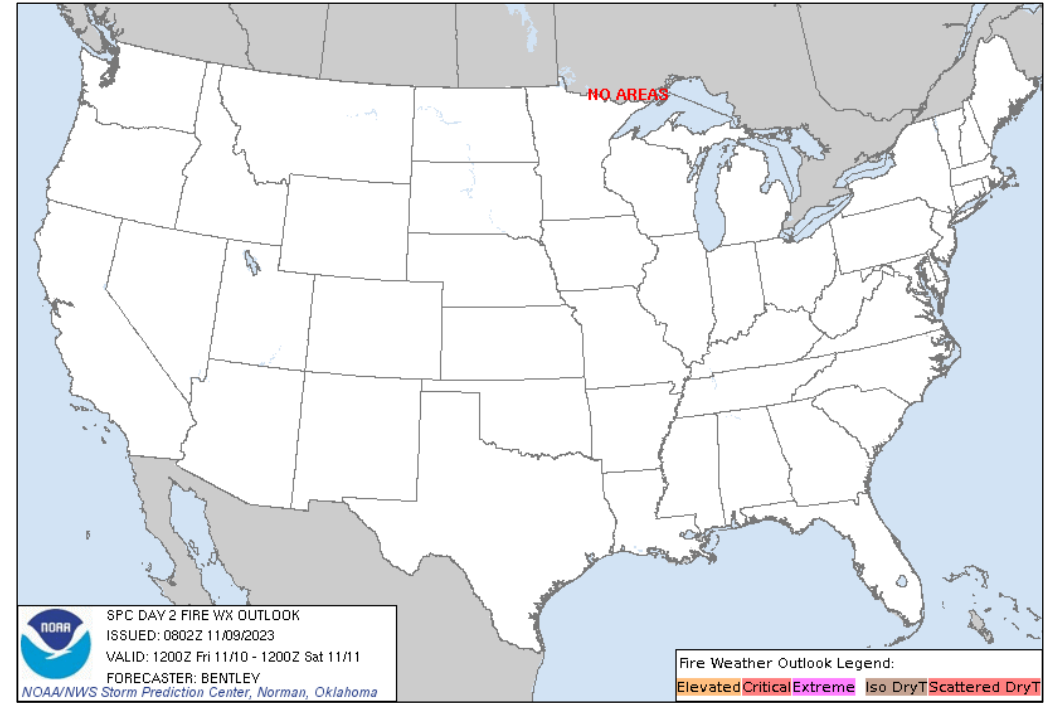

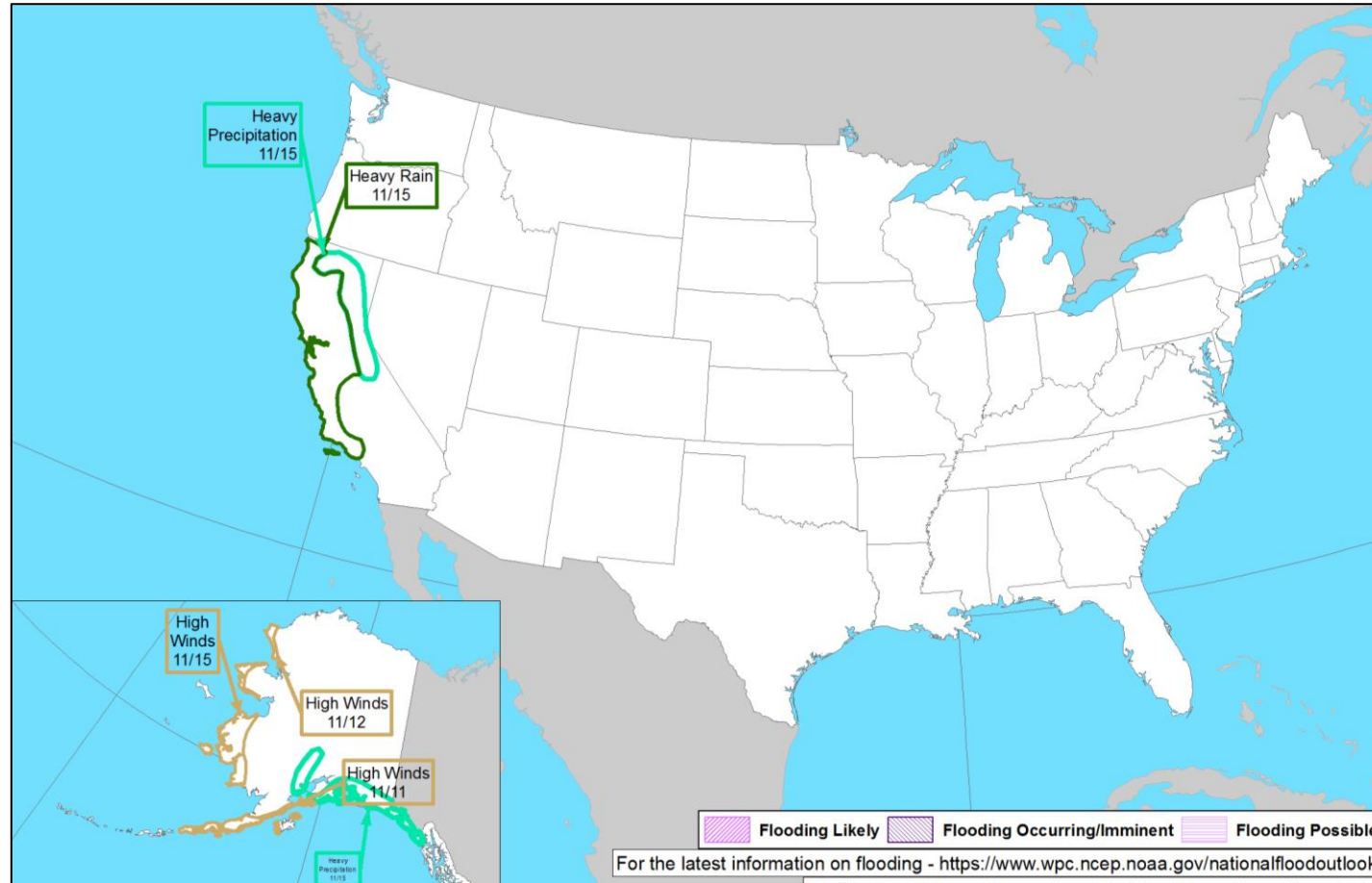

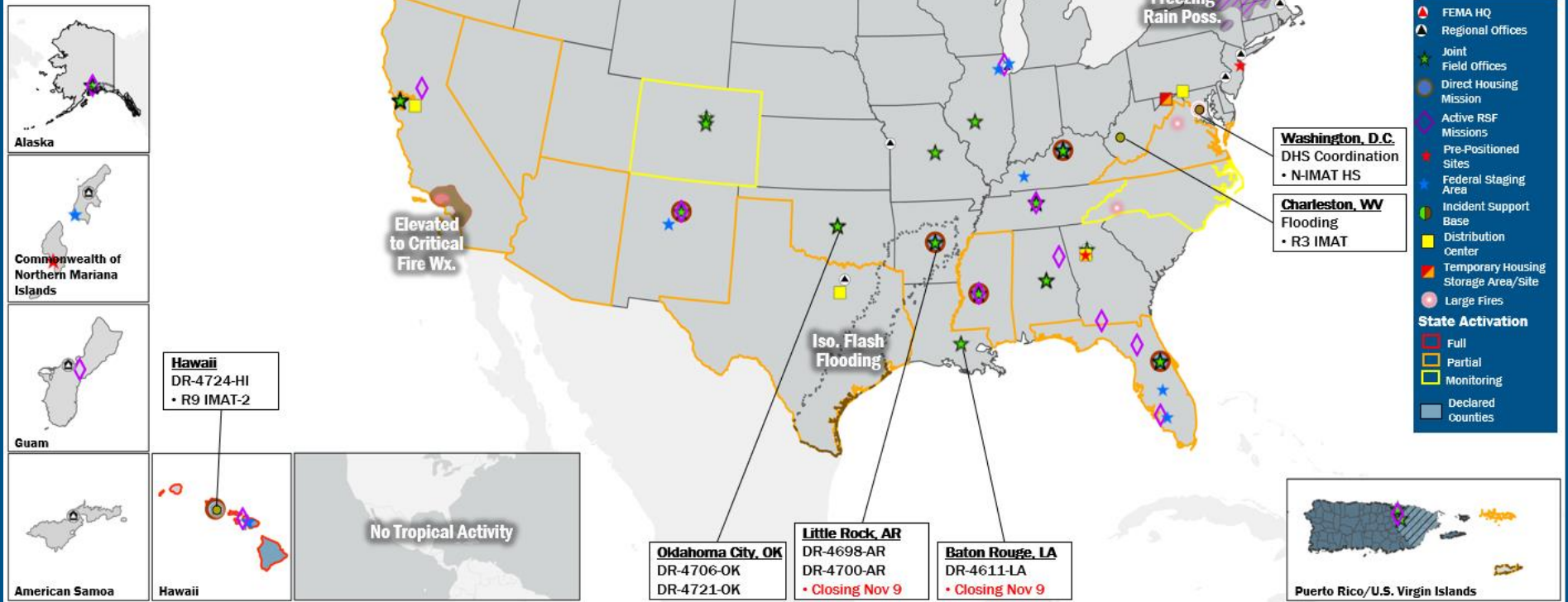
