



### **Tropical Storm Man-Yi – Western Pacific**


#### **Situation:** (Advisory #10, as of 4:00 a.m. ET)

- Located 470 miles E of Guam
- Moving SSW at 10 mph
- Maximum sustained winds of 40 mph
- Man-Yi is forecast to intensify through Tuesday
- A tropical storm watch is in effect for Guam, Rota, Tinian, and Saipan

#### **Hazards Affecting Land:**


*Winds:* 39 mph or higher expected to reach the islands late Tuesday night into Wednesday morning

Rainfall: 3 to 6 inches of rainfall is possible across the Marianas Surf: High surf of 9 feet or higher is likely for east-facing reefs. Increasing winds and surf may lead to localized coastal inundation up to a foot along windward shores.





# **Precipitation Forecast**






# **Long Range Outlooks – Nov 16-20**
