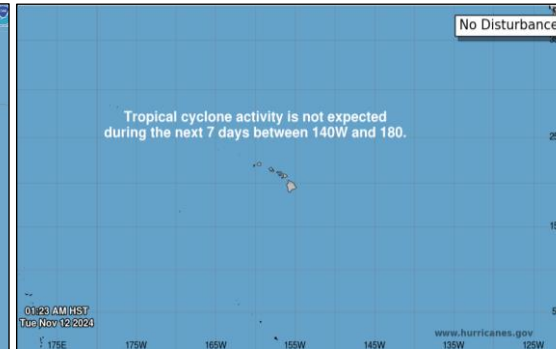

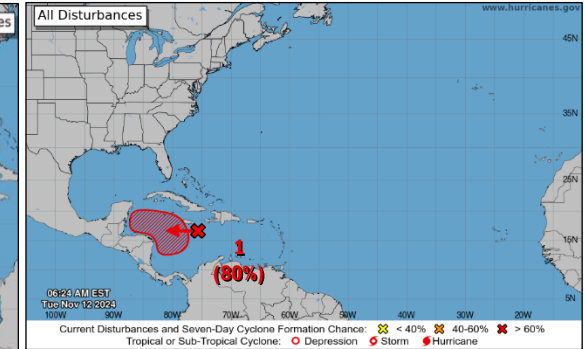

- Formation chance: 48-hour – **Medium (40%)**; 7-day – **High (80%)**

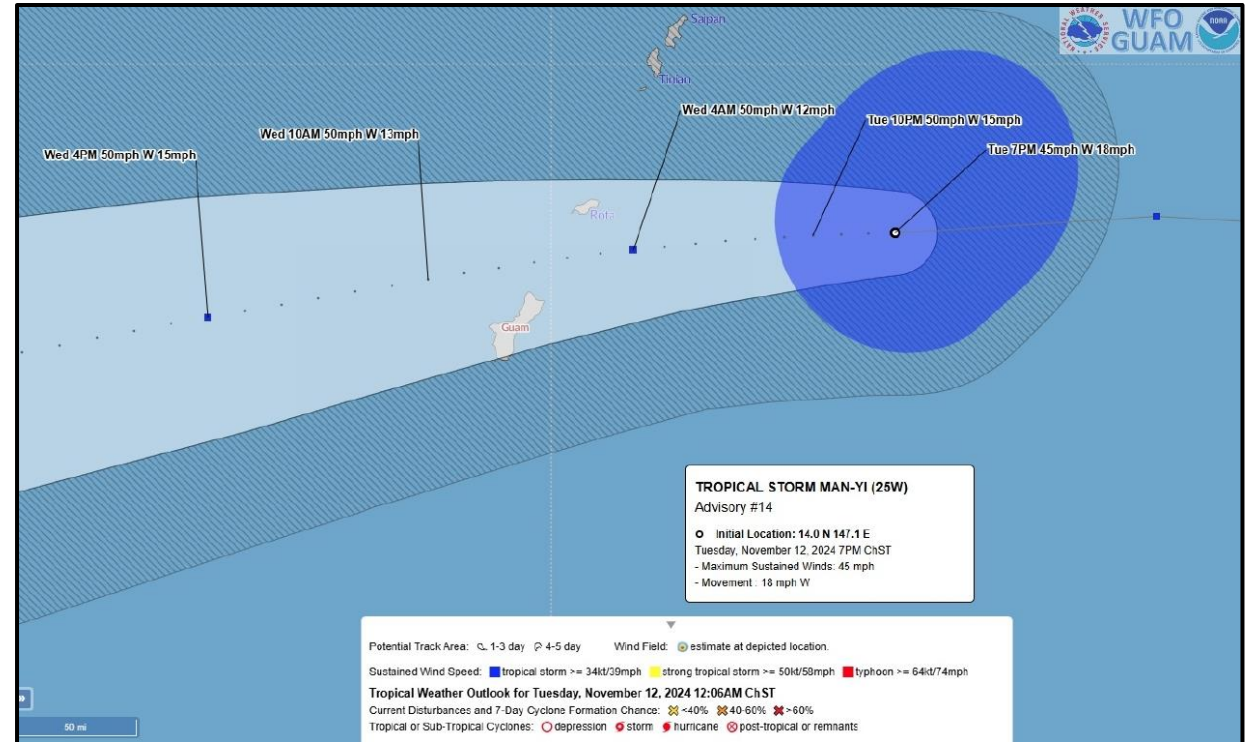

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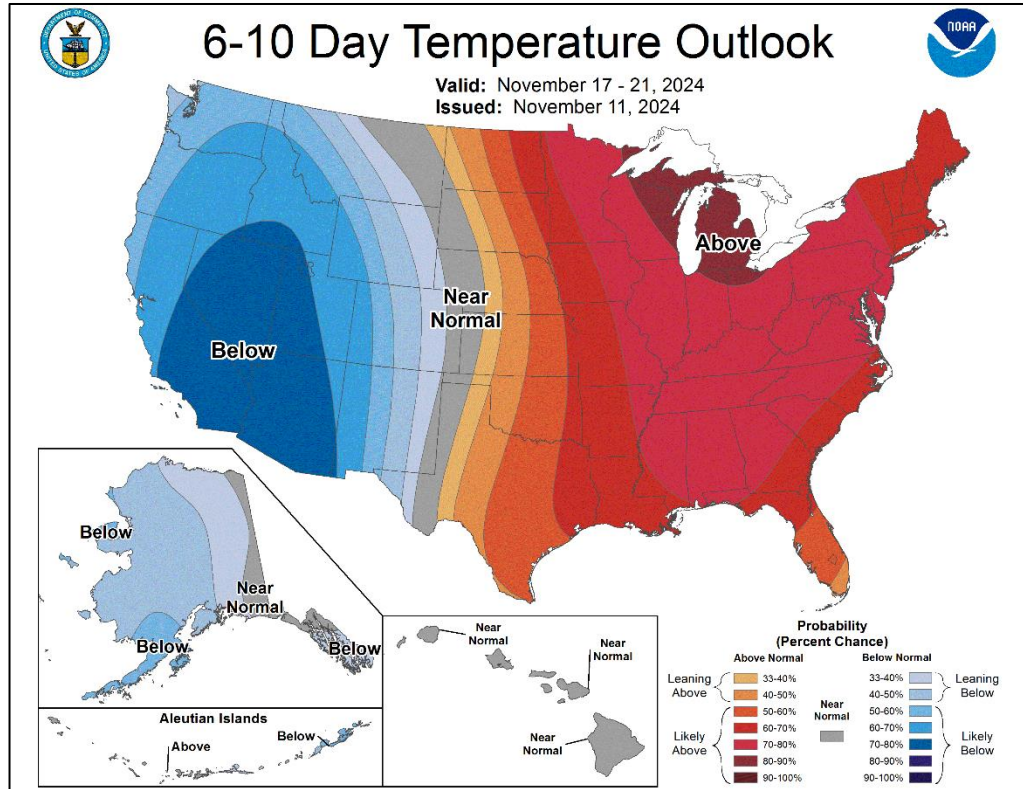

National Weather Forecast

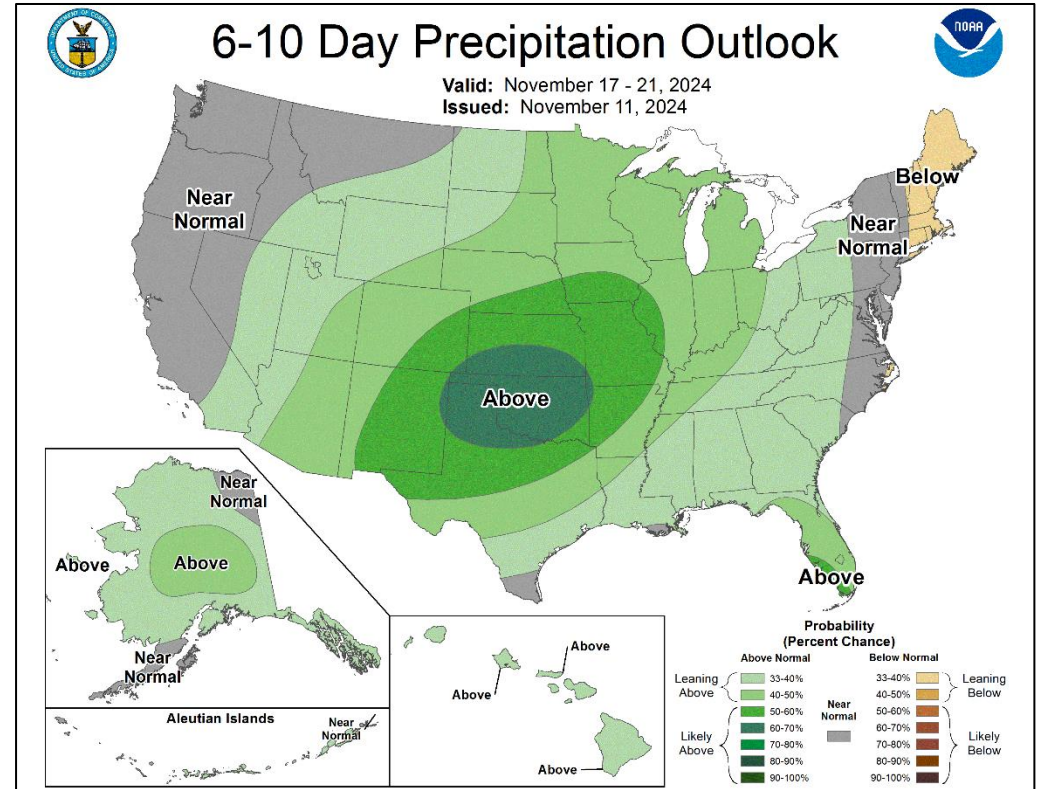


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Long Range Outlooks – Nov 17-21

6-10 Day Precipitation Probability



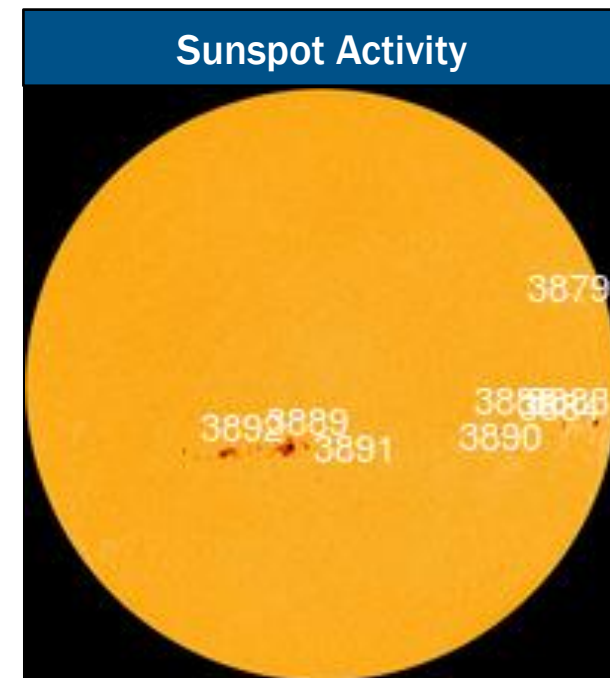
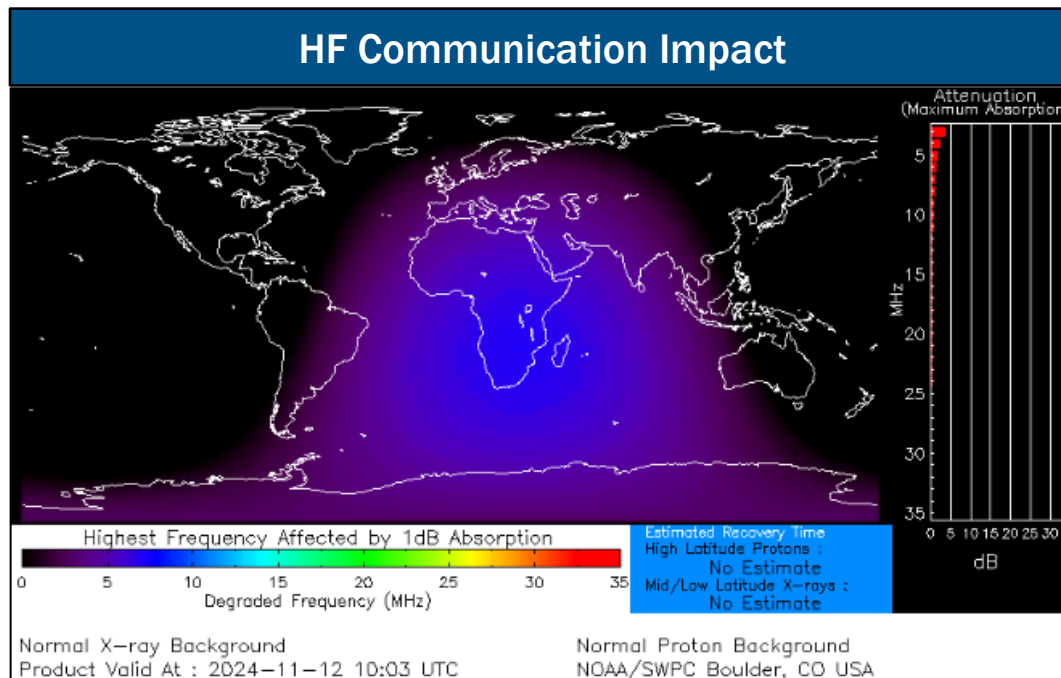

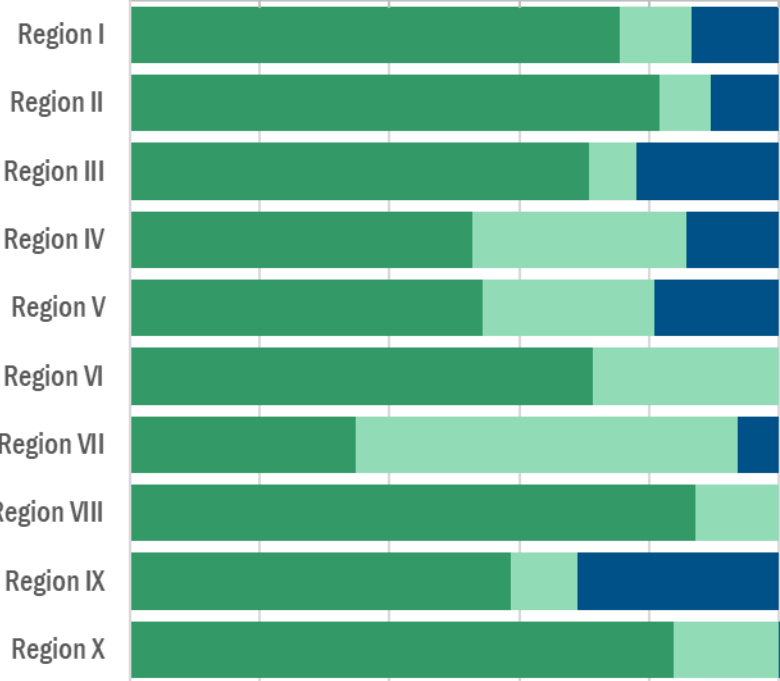

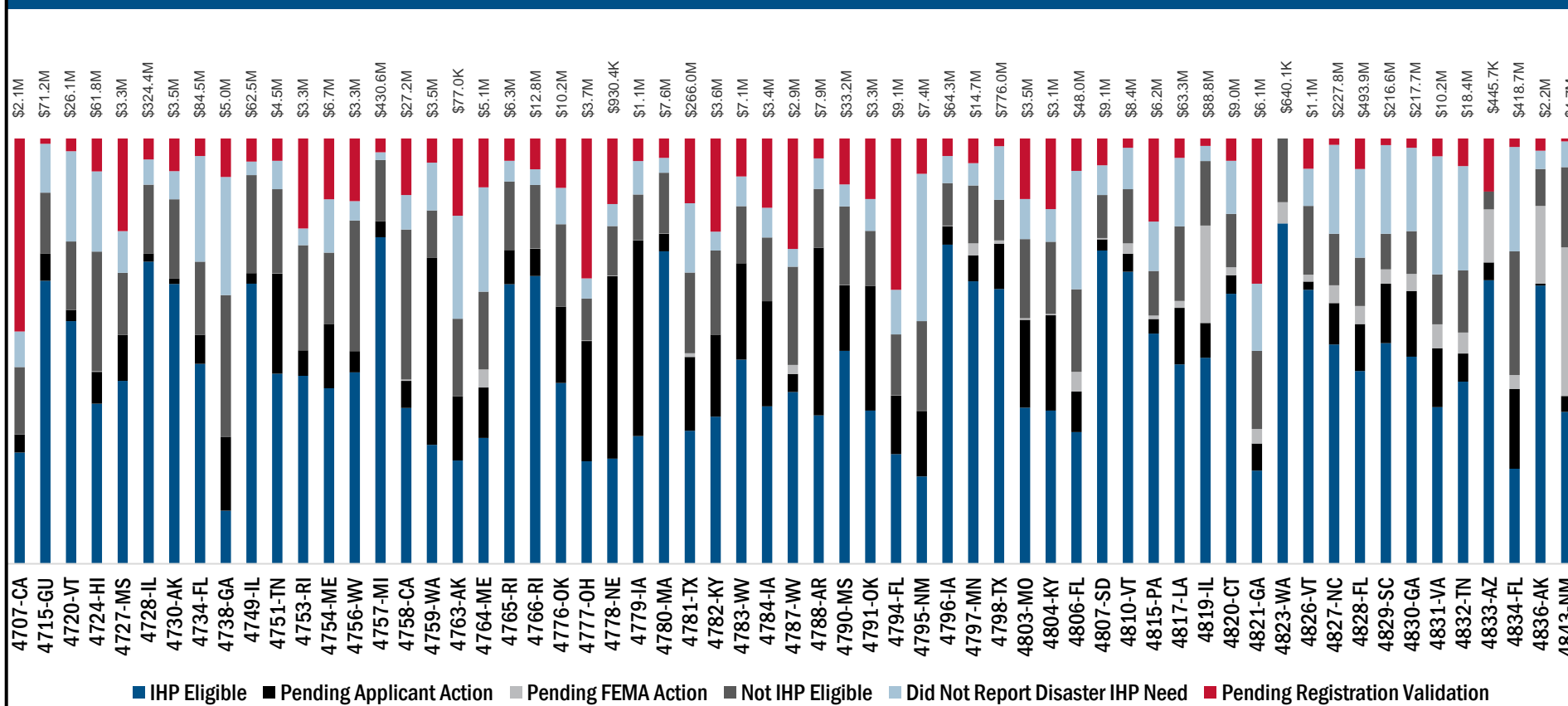

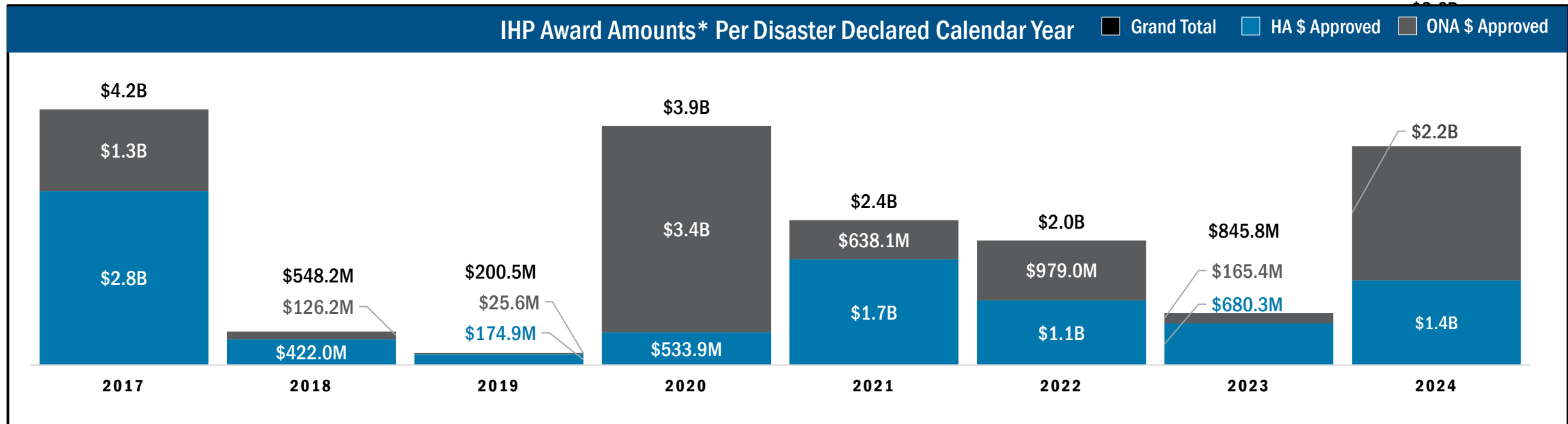
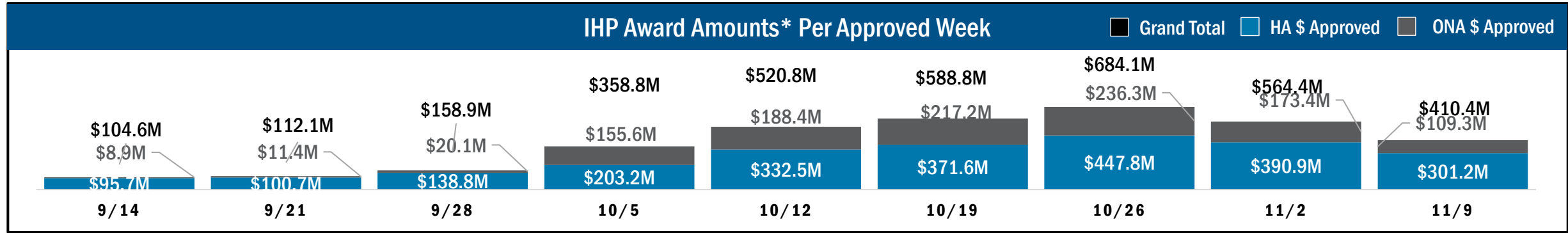
Registrations in Active Declarations

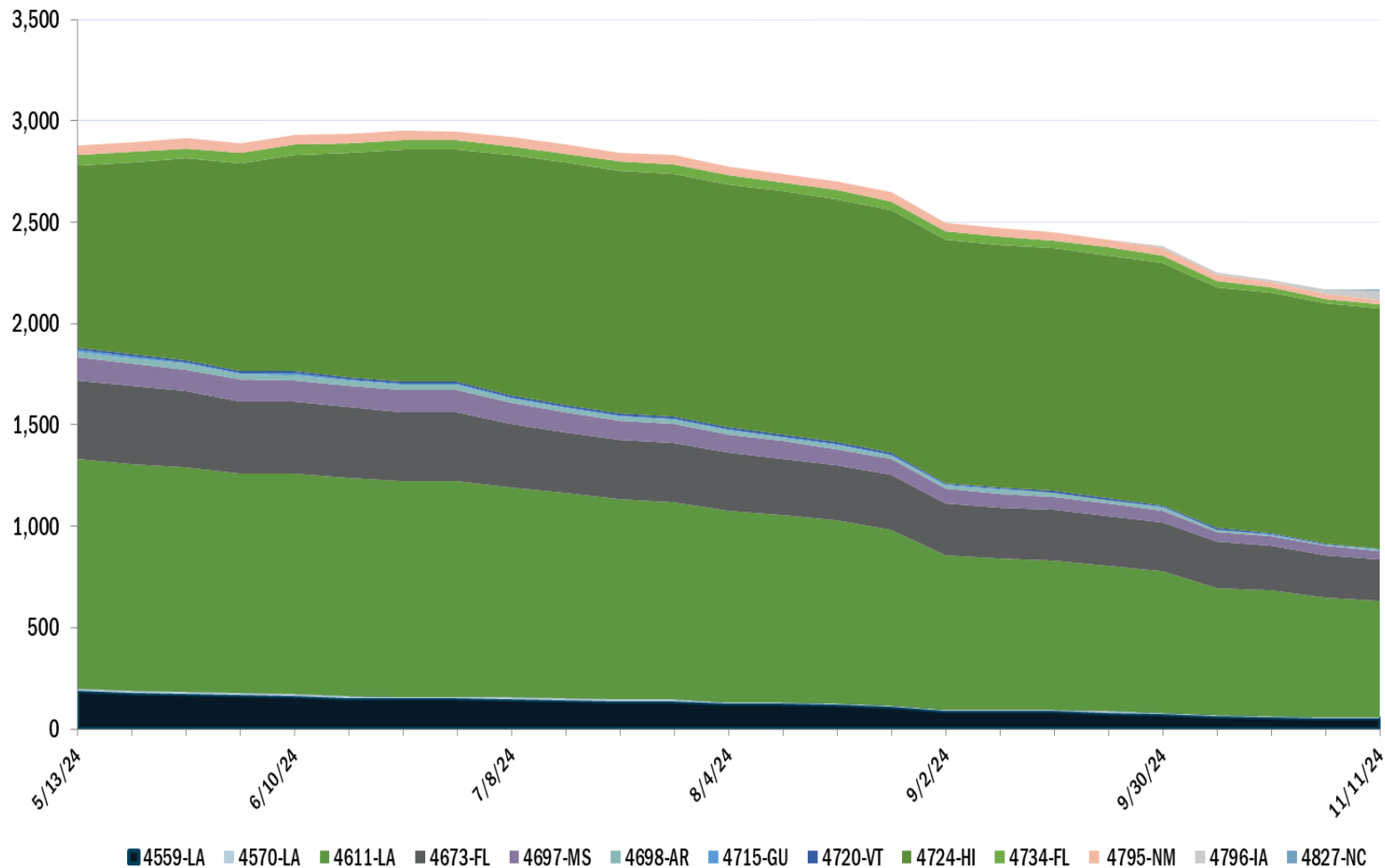
