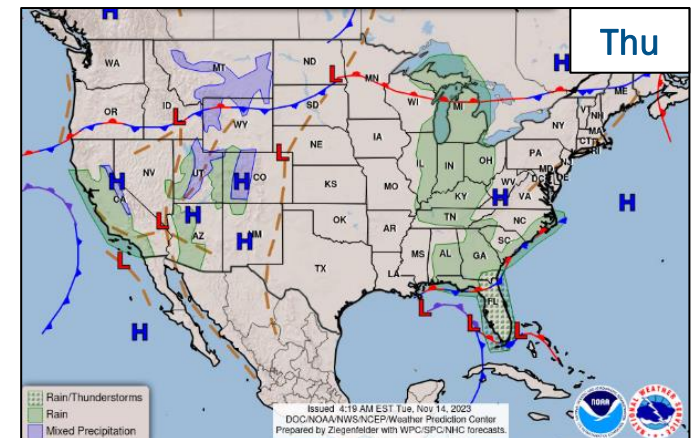
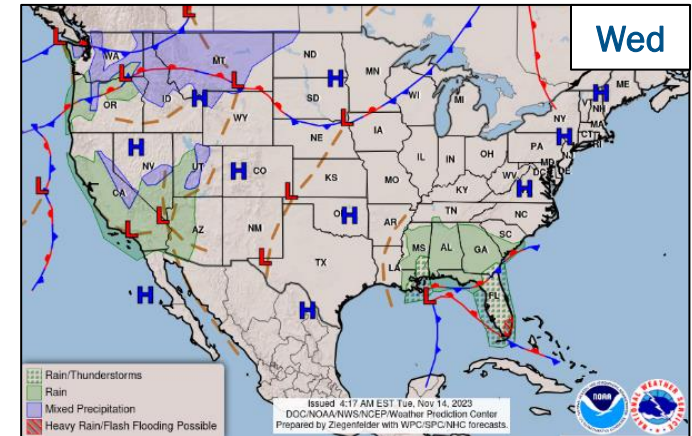
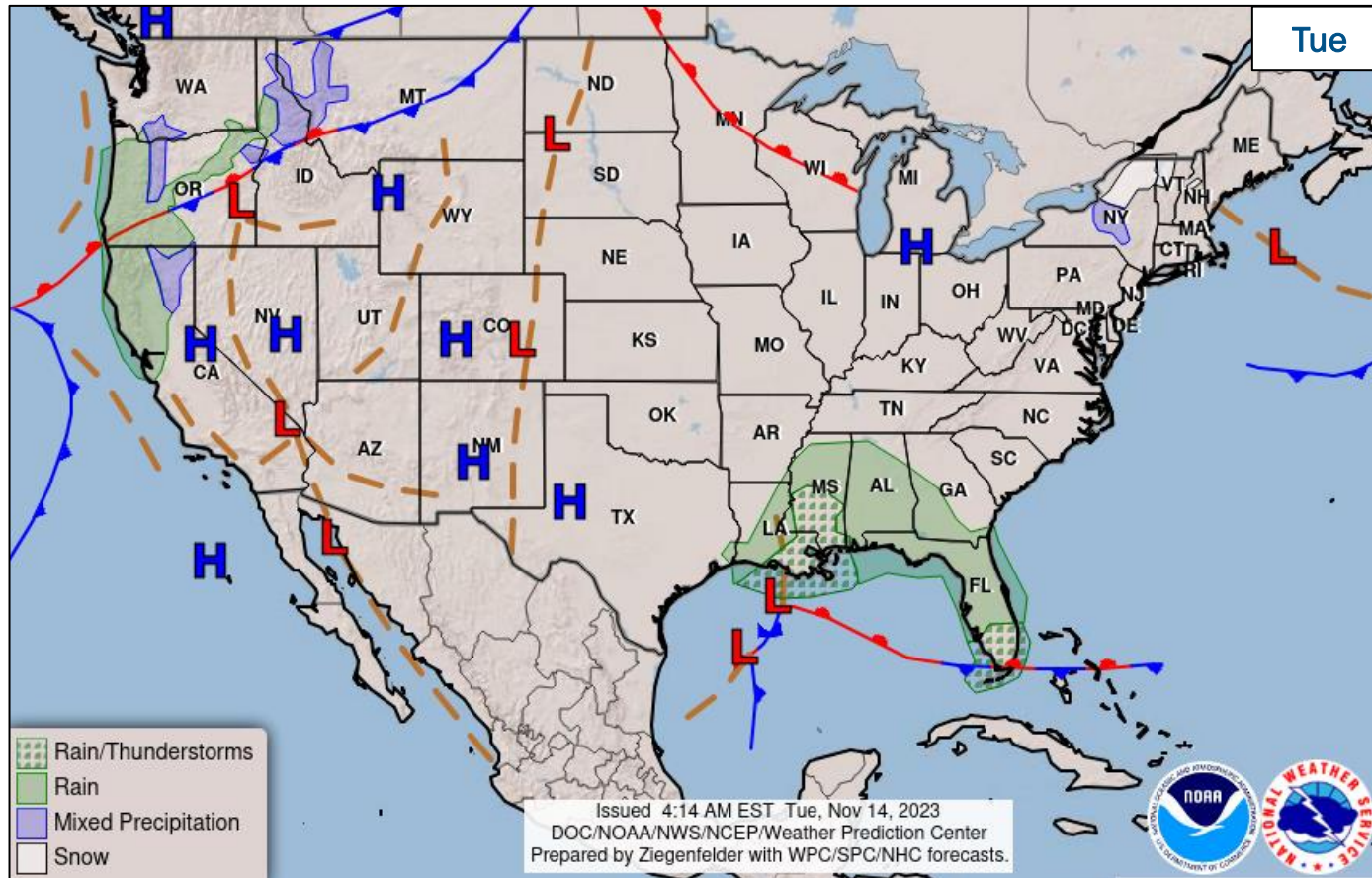
- Located over the southwestern Caribbean Sea

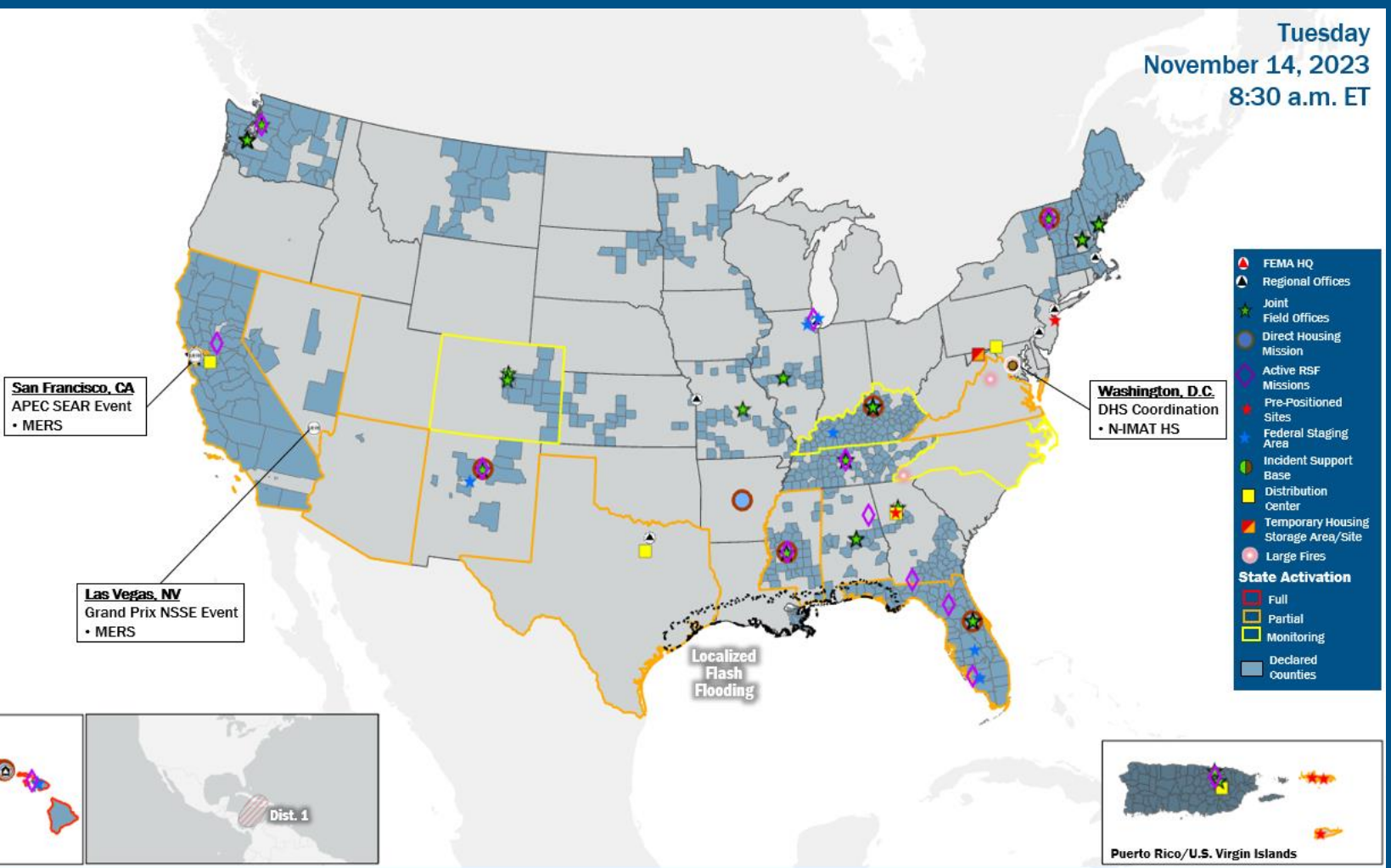

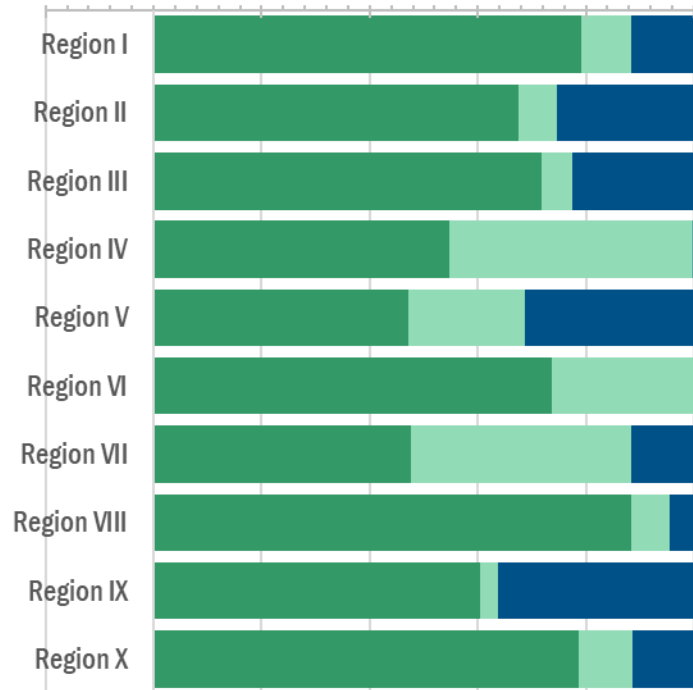
# Public Assistance (PA) Grant Program Activity – per Region

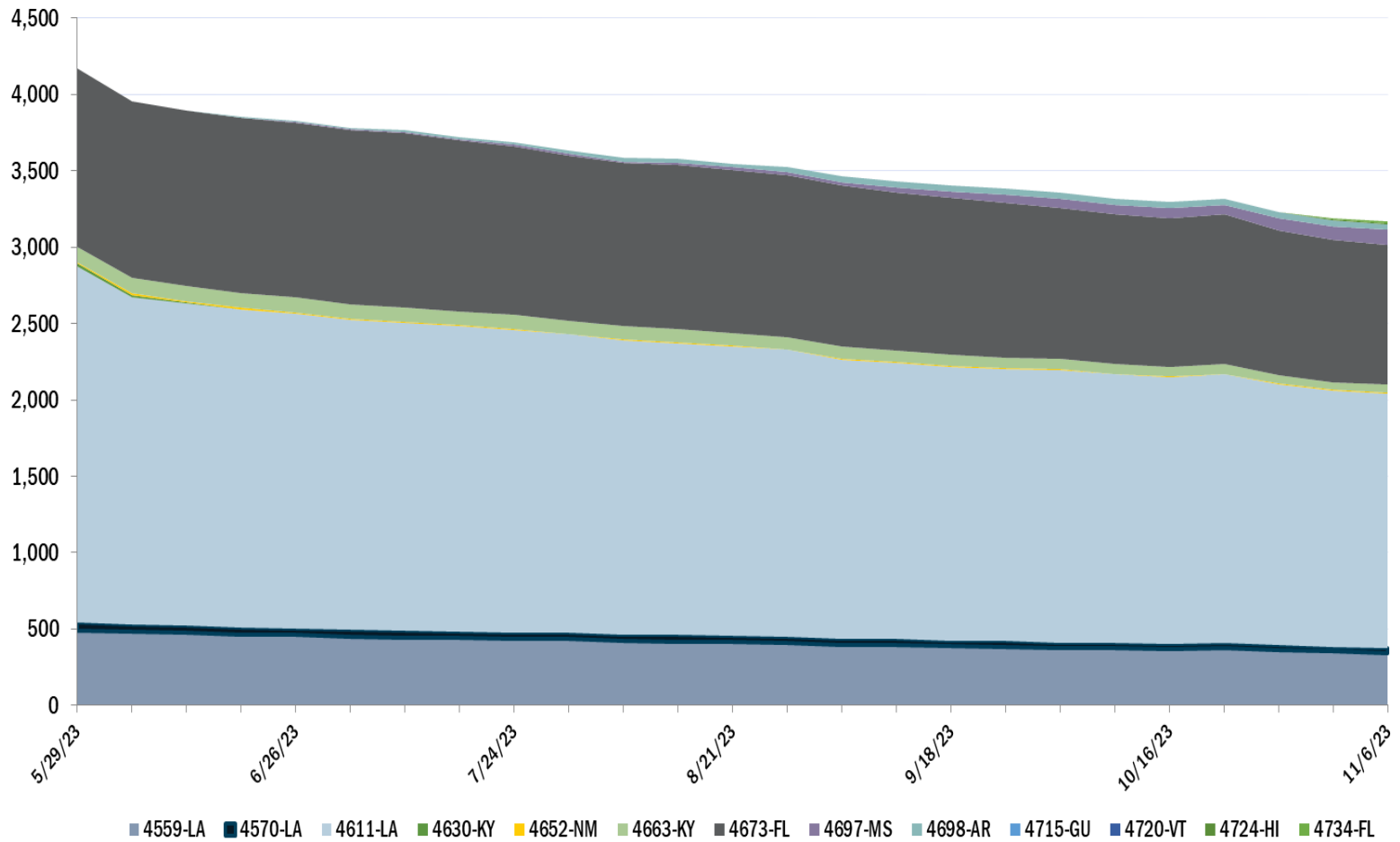

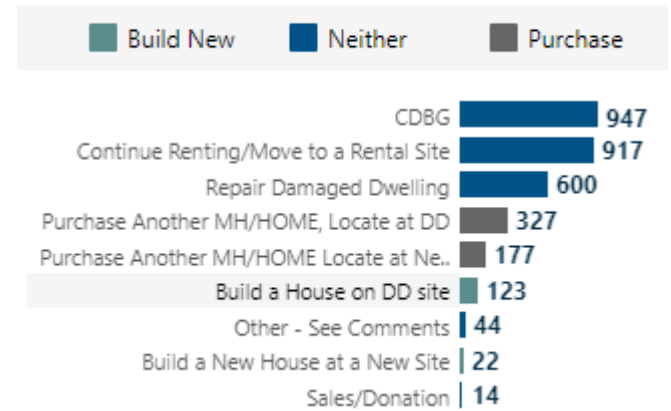
