


## **Tropical Outlook – Five Day**

#### **Central Pacific**




#### **Eastern Pacific**



#### Tropical Storm Polo (Advisory #7 as of 4:00 a.m. ET)

- 730 miles WSW of the southern tip of Baja California
- Moving W at 12 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 40 mph
- Tropical storm force winds extend outward up to 35 miles

#### Disturbance 1 (as of 7:00 a.m. ET)


- Could form over the southwestern Caribbean Sea
- Slow development possible
- 48-hour Formation chance: Low (near 0%)
- 5-day Formation chance: Low (10%)

#### Disturbance 2 (as of 7:00 a.m. ET)

- Could form between the Bahamas and Bermuda
- Gradual development possible
- 48-hour Formation chance: Low (near 0%)
- 5-day Formation chance: Low (20%)




### **National Weather Forecast**


