

#### Disturbance 1: (As of 7:00 a.m. ET)


- Located over the central Caribbean Sea
- Significant development not likely
- Formation chance 48-hour: Low (10%);7-day: Low (10%)

#### Disturbance 2: (As of 7:00 a.m. ET)

- Located over the central portion of the Atlantic basin
- Conditions appear somewhat conducive for gradual development later this week
- Formation chance 48-hour: Low (near 0%); 7-day: Low (30%)






### **Severe Weather Outlook**











# Long Range Outlooks - Nov 25-29


