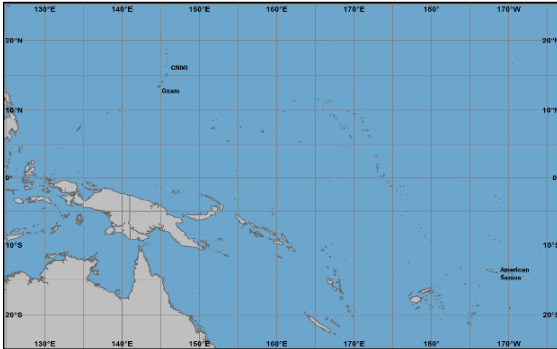

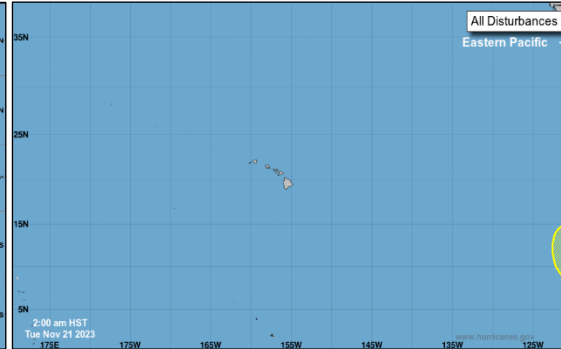

Western Pacific



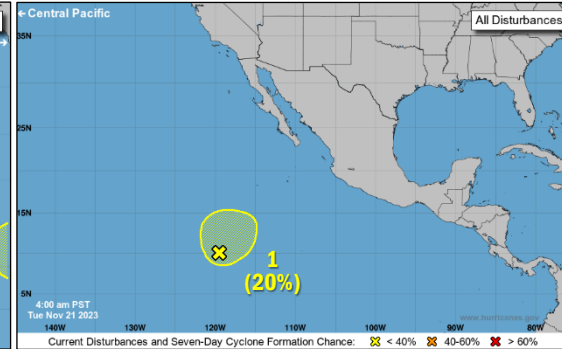
- No areas of concern for Guam, the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands or American Samoa

- No tropical cyclones expected during the next 7 days; see Eastern Pacific Disturbance 1 for details

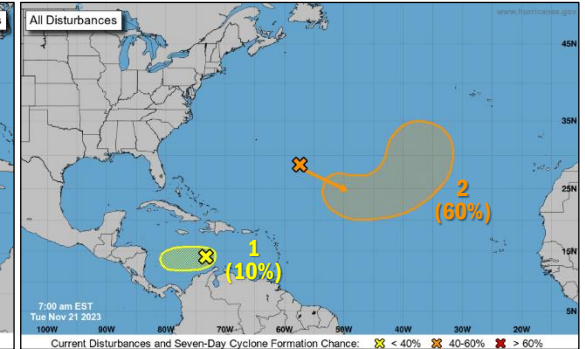
Eastern Pacific



Disturbance 1: (As of 7:00 a.m. ET)

- Located well to the SSW of the southern tip of the Baja California peninsula
- Conditions are forecast to become increasingly less conducive for development by latter part of week
- Formation chance – 48-hour: Low (20%); 7-day: Low (20%)

Atlantic



Disturbance 1: (As of 7:00 a.m. ET)

- Located over the central Caribbean Sea
- Development not likely
- Formation chance – 48-hour: Low (10%); 7-day: Low (10%)

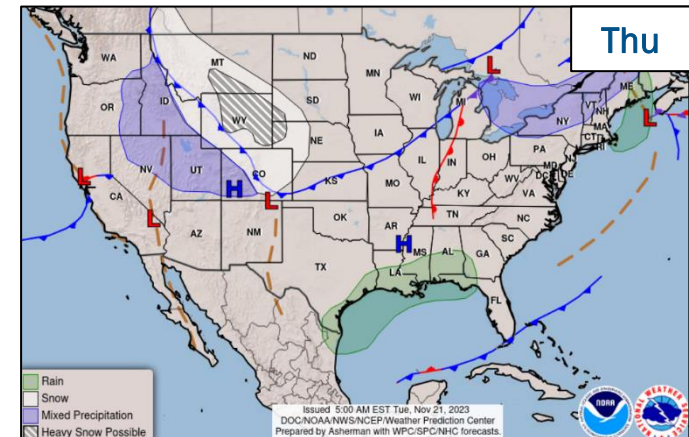
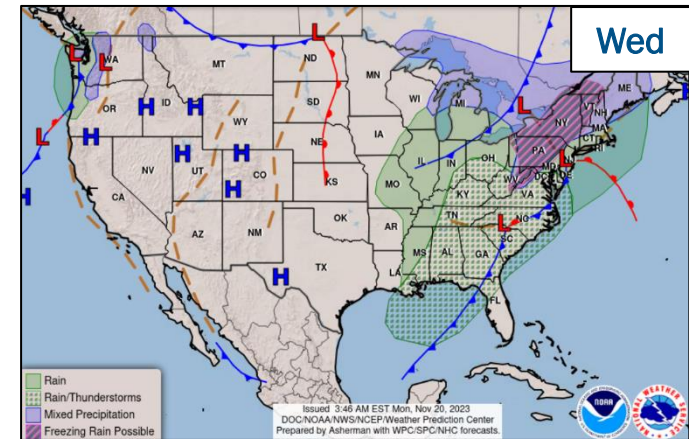
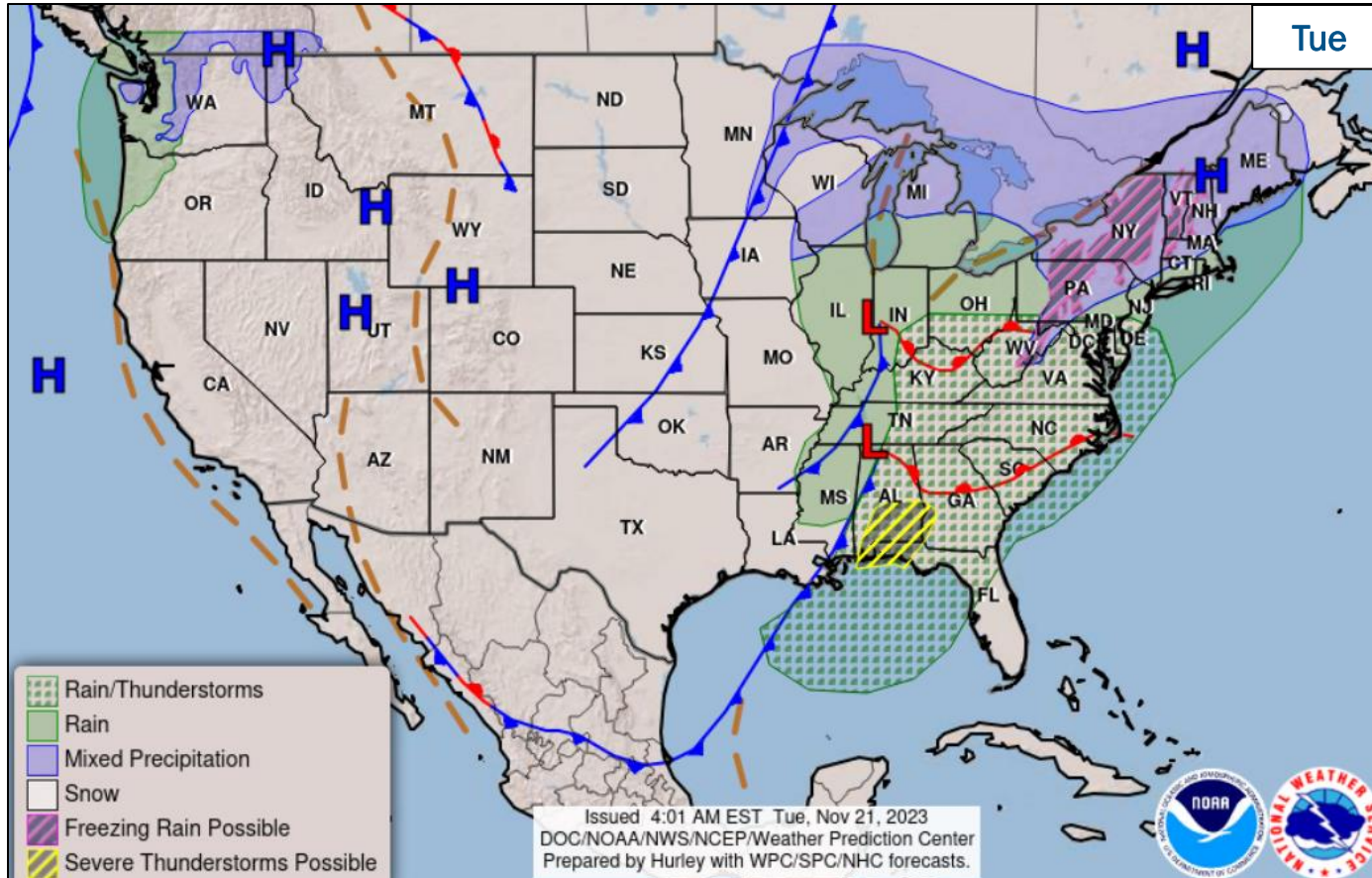
Disturbance 2: (As of 7:00 a.m. ET)

- Located over the central subtropical Atlantic
- Conditions appear conducive to gradually acquire tropical characteristics

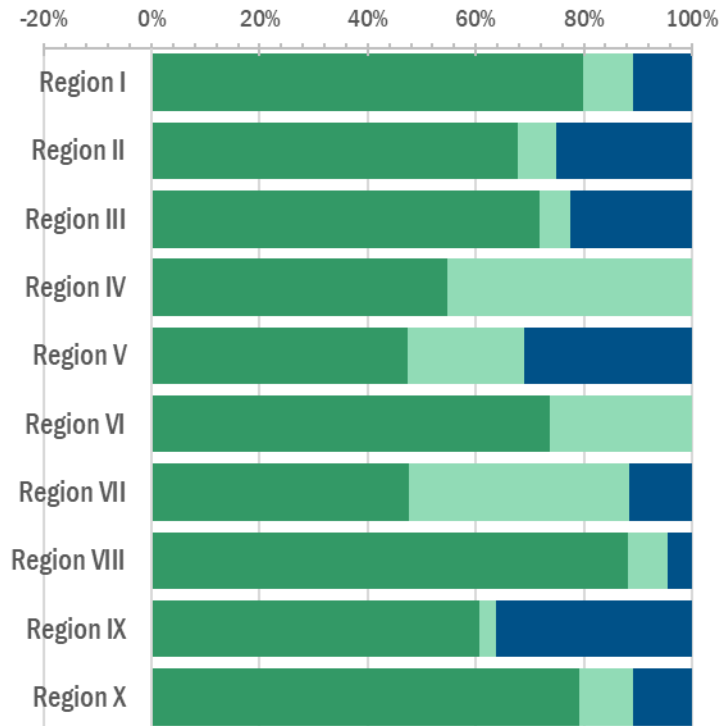

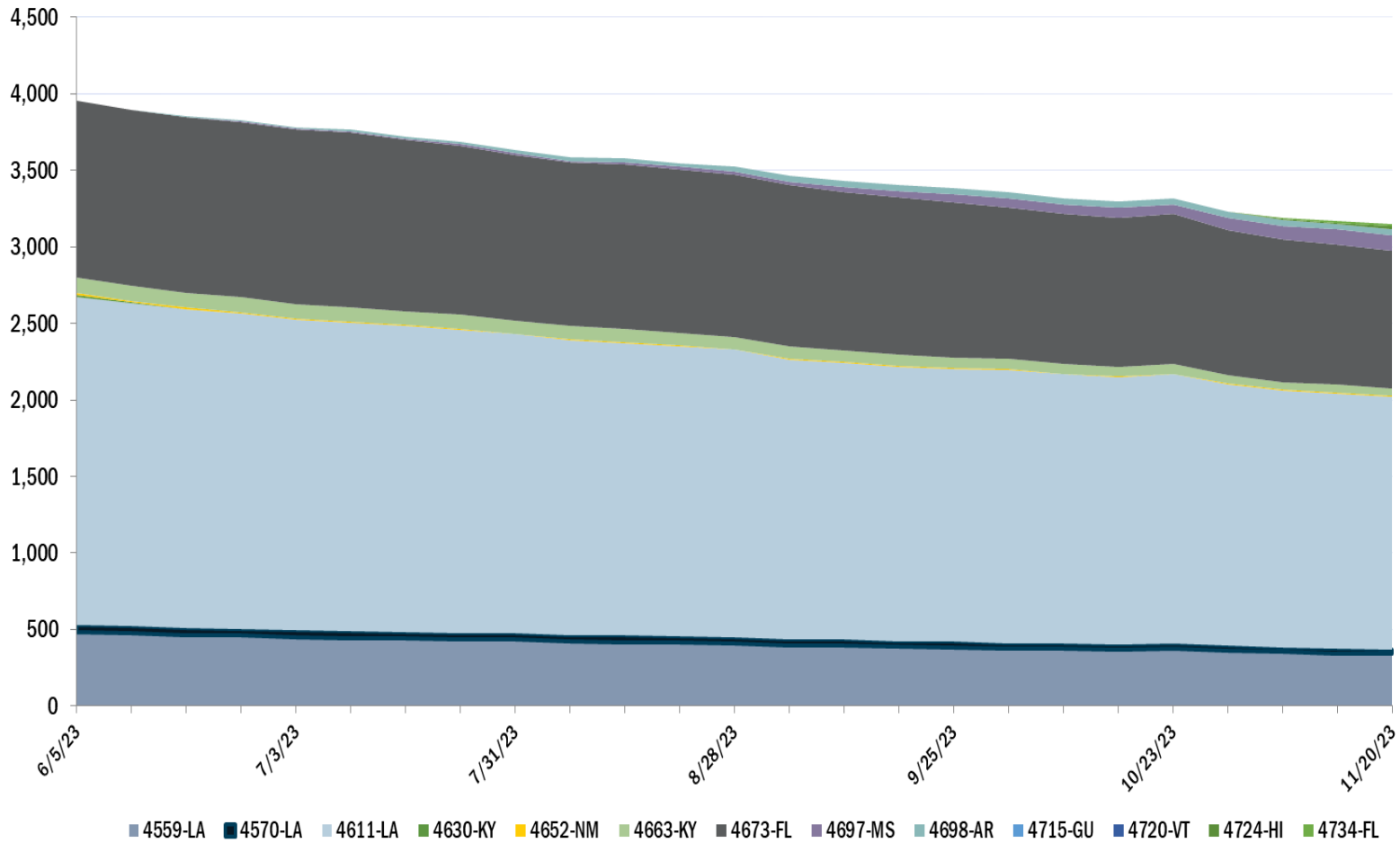

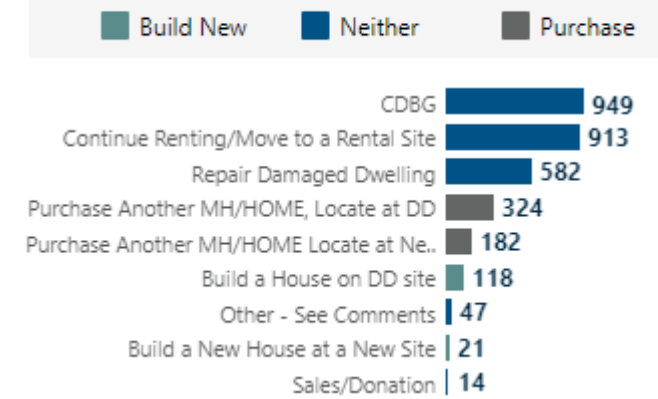
Total Households in FEMA Direct Housing per State
