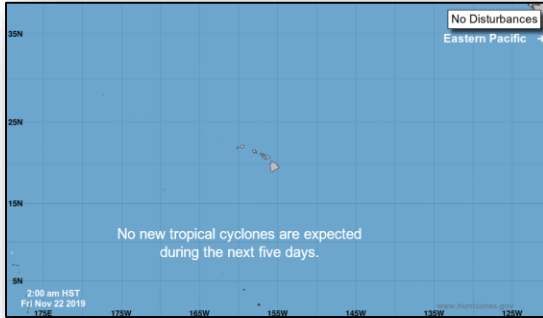
- Heavy snowfall - Southern Rockies

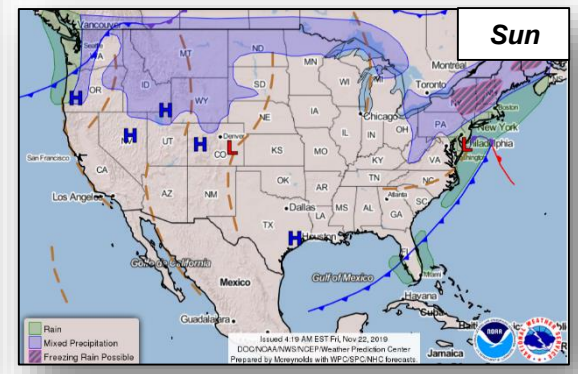
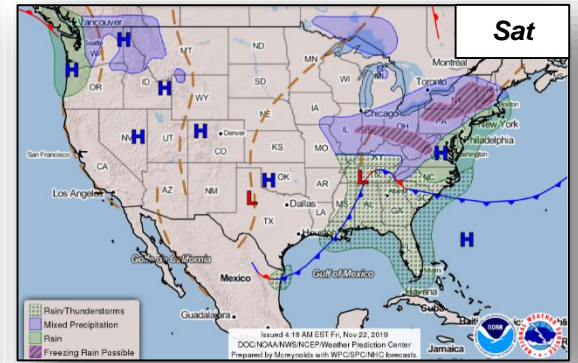
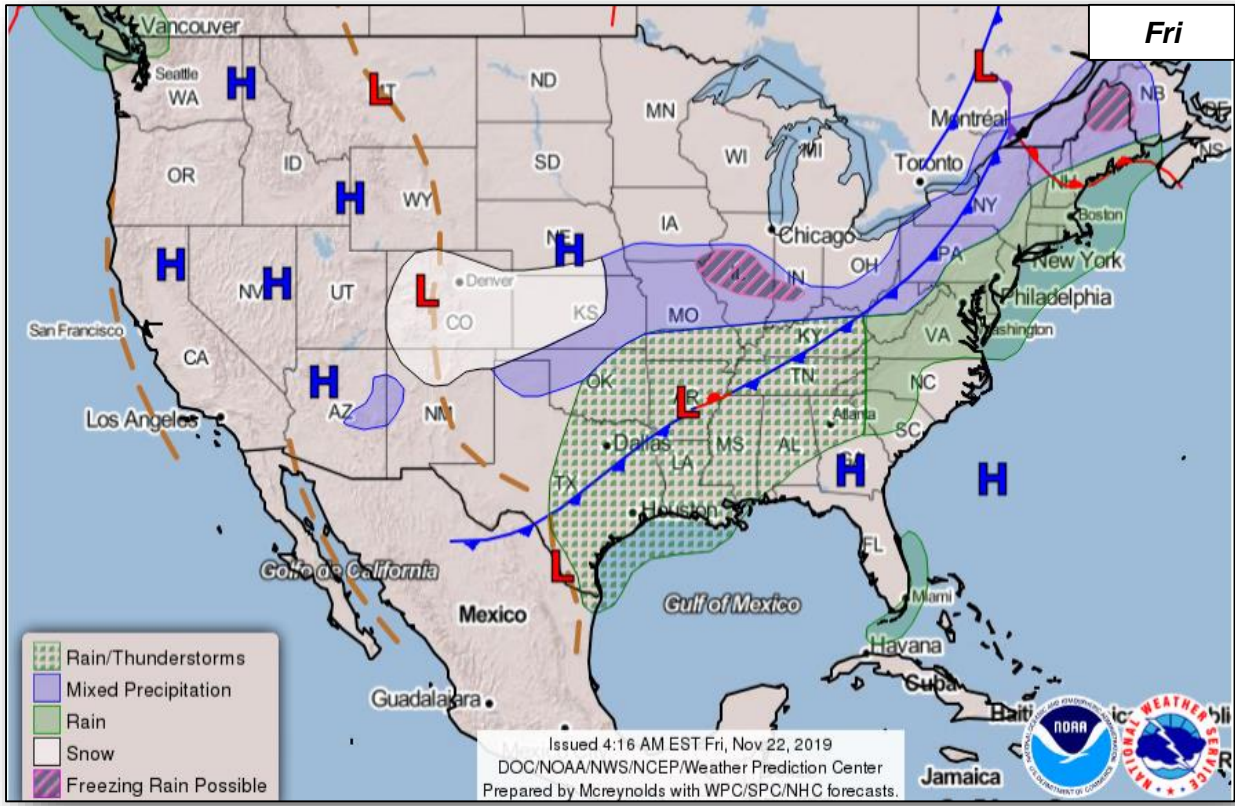
Tropical Storm Sebastian (*Advisory #12 as of 5:00 a.m. EST*)

- 600 miles NE of the Leeward Islands
- Moving ENE at 15 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 60 mph
- Tropical storm force winds extend 160 miles
- Forecast to become a post tropical cyclone this weekend
- No threat to U.S. interests

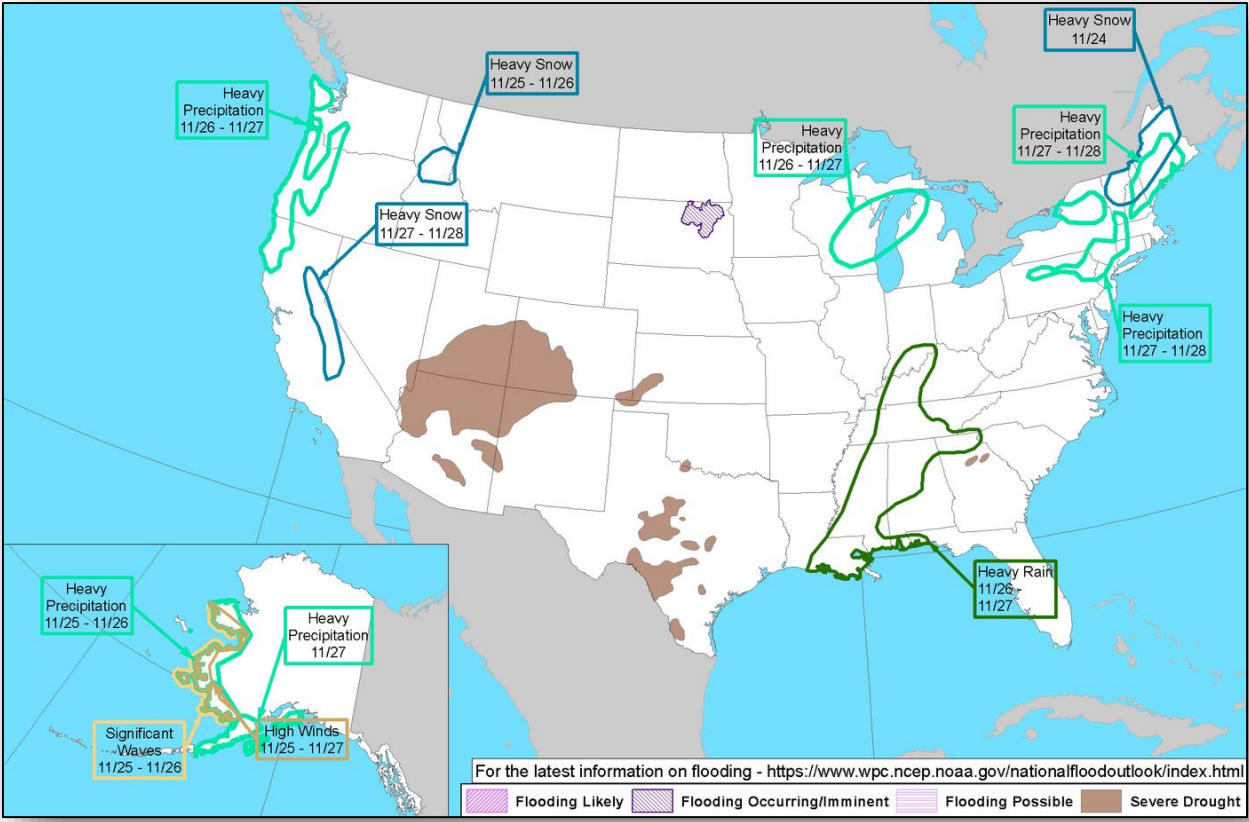
Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall

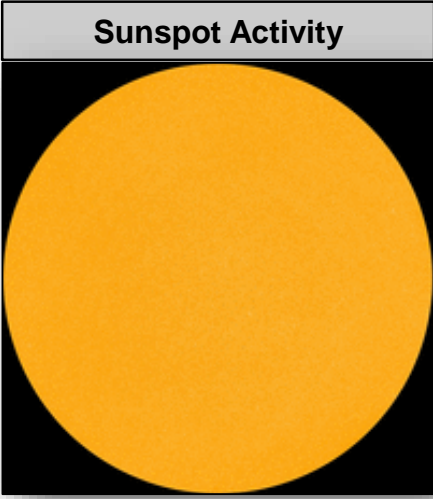
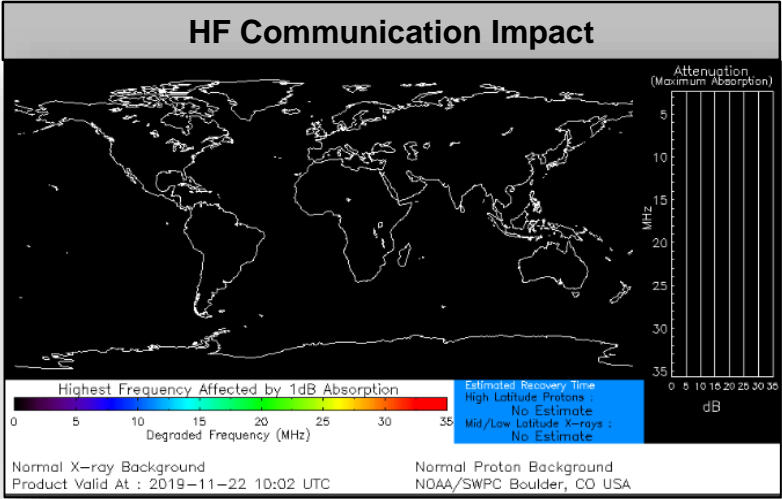

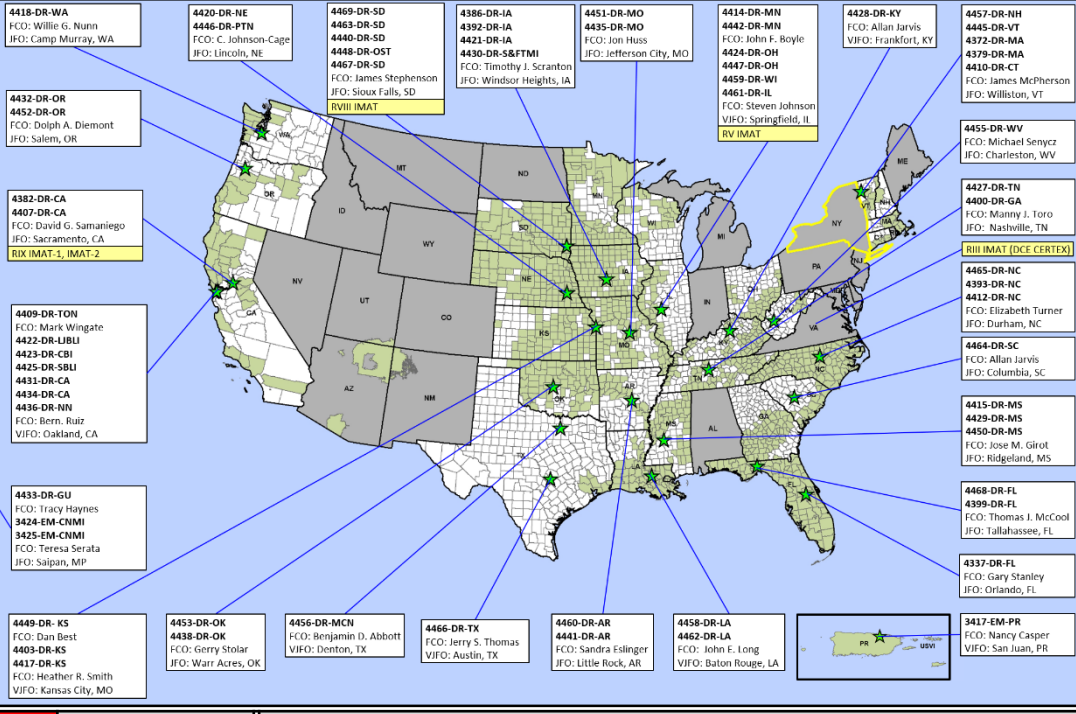
