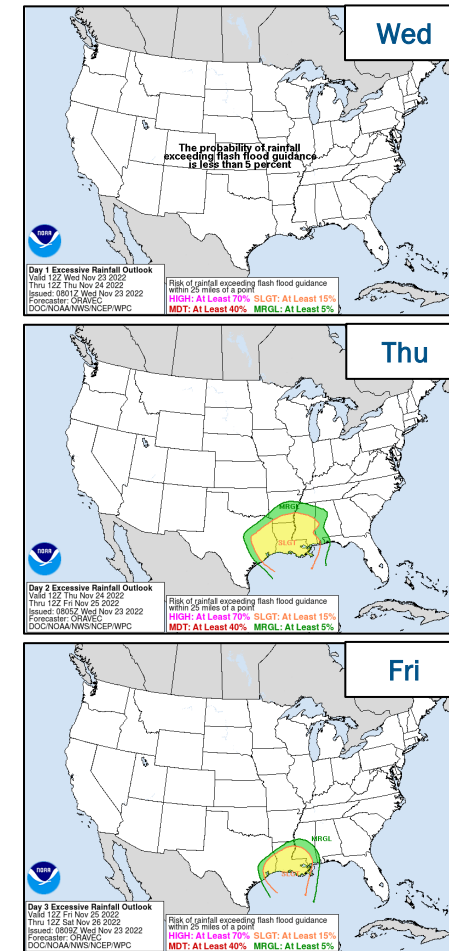
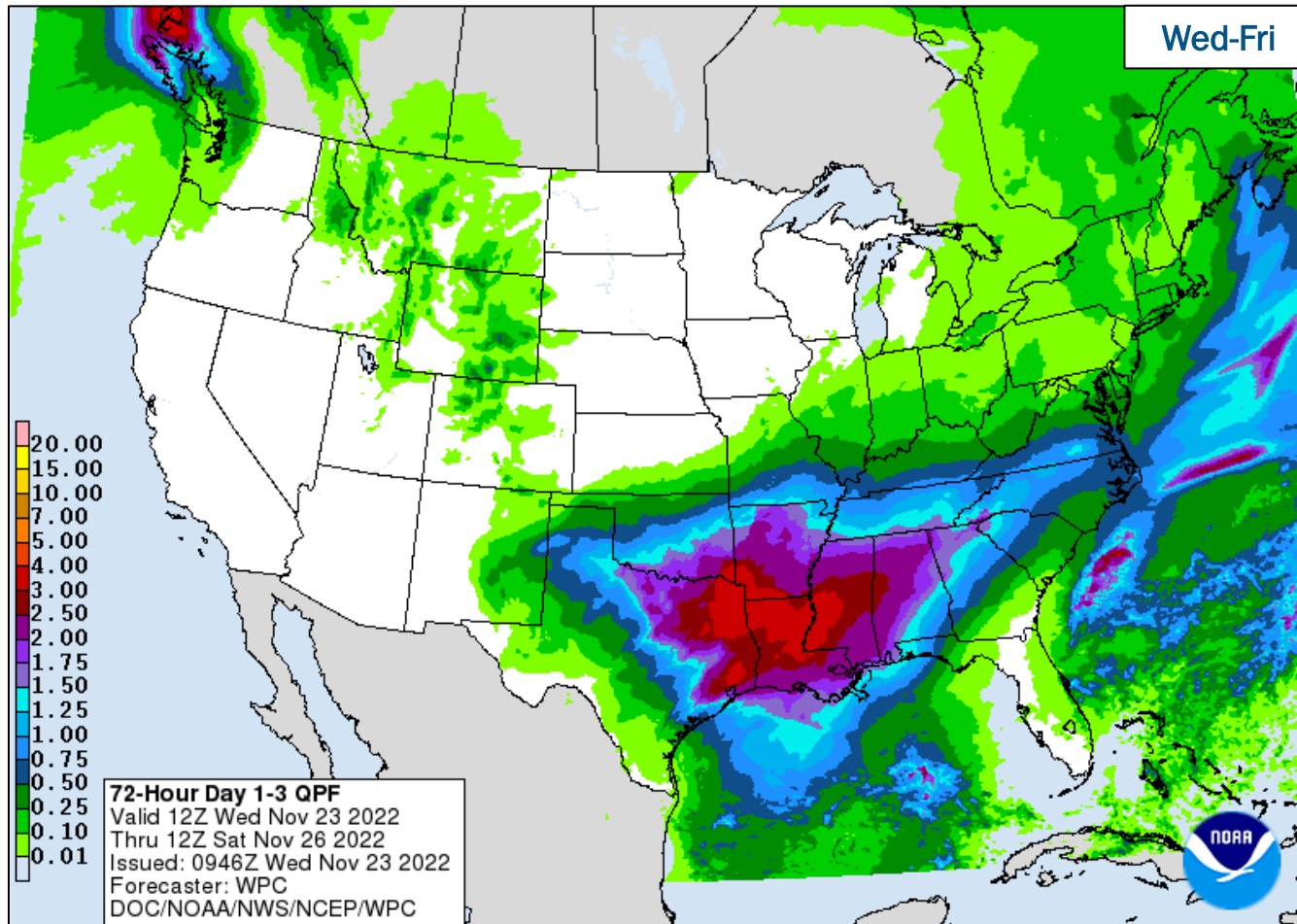
National Weather Forecast
