

Disturbance 1: (As of 7:00 a.m. ET)


- Located 1,000 miles SW of the southern tip of Baja California

- The chances of subtropical or tropical development should end by early next week
- Formation chance: 48-hour Low (20%);7-day Med (40%)




National Weather Forecast






Snowfall Forecast
